Thomas Everette Upchurch was born in Raleigh North Carolina to John R and Nora Upchurch. He was one of six siblings, Ema N, Harold A, Ada G, Lydia C., Ira Gilbert . According to the census, IRA was a cigar apprentice) and Pearson R. The census also says that all the siblings were born in North Carolina in Raleigh Township. Dad's siblings called him Everette but everyone else seemed to refer to him as "Uppie". He was a self taught man and extremely intelligent, as was his brother, Pearson. Pearson was a lawyer in Raleigh North Carolina. He enlisted in the Army and was discharged at Fort Lee, Virginia on March 25, 1917. Attached is a picture of him in his service uniform.

After the discharge from the service, Everette went on to entertain in Vaudeville. Attached is a clipping from the NC paper that told of his show at the VA Center in Raleigh. Everette then turned to newspapers. He was a typesetter with numerous newspapers, Columbus Dispatch, Detriot Times. We finally settled in Washington DC in 1955 where he worked for the now long-gone papers, The News, Evening Star and the Times Herald. He was liked by all and considered to be the best in the business. Dad was previously married to a lady named Vivian and had $\triangle \square$ two children, Elizabeth who died of a brain aneurism and one that died early on.

He and my mother, Clementine Cavalier Upchurch, had four children, Juanita Marie born April 2, 1943, Gary Lee born November 13, 1948, Robert Richard and a twin that was still born, born May 14, 1946. Robert (Sonny) later died when he was eight years old of Leukemia, buried in Mt. Olivet Cemetary, Washington DC. I am not sure of where the twin was buried, I don't even know if he had a name. Attached is Sonny's last school picture taken right before he died. Gary Lee died of a heart attack after a long illness, buried in Mt. Comfort Cemetary, Alexandria, Va. He had no children. I will get you his date of death. Attached is a picture of him also with my grandson, Brian Thompson.

Tuberculous ran in the family, he had it and Aunt Ada Upchurch Howard had it, as well as his mother, Emma Wicks. In his later years, it was not an issue. He got sick with cirrosis of the liver and went to the

Veterans Hospital in Denver. Alcoholism ran in the family I am told. They decided that there was nothing that they could do for him so he came home to die. He died on January 24, 1958 and is buried in Arlington National Cemetery.

**Ada Upchurch Howard
Mary Lee Howard Williams**

Ada Upchurch Howard was the first born in NC of the John R. Upchurch clan. She married Lee Howard and lived in Wake County. The marriage produced a daughter, Mary Lee Howard Williams. Enclosed is a small picture of Aunt Ada, I am looking for the rest of them and will forward when I find them. As the marriage ended, Mary Lee went to live with her maternal grandparents. She always told me the story that Grandma dropped dead hanging clothes on the line singing "Nearer my God to thee." She went to college and received a degree in Nursing and later joined the Armed Services as a nurse. She broke her back while nursing, had to have a steel plate put in, and retired. She then went to live with her mother, Ada U., and my parents in Washington DC during the war. She later married George Williams and settled in Richmond Virginia at 1301 Amherst Street in 1950. George died October 25, 1995. Mary Lee lived there until she was relocated to a nursing home. I have fond memories of that house and her. I don't have any pictures of Mary Lee, I thought that I did. I can remember the picture she had on her dresser of her in her military uniform and one of her as a nurse. She was a lovely caring person.

Aunt Ada gave me the enclosed pictures of her grandmother and grandfather with notes written on the back. I have photocopied the notes, hope that they come out. Also enclosed is a picture of her mother. I will provide copies of her handwritten notes about the pictures. I am not sure if you want data on Emma J. Upchurch but will include it in case.

3. I probably already mentioned that when I lived in Raleigh 1953-1965 Pearson and I used to get each other's mail by mistake as we are both R.P.U. I never met him
4. Re TEU as an entertainer:
 - a. He had a cousin in Raleigh - John Sherwood U, who managed stage shows, etc. Since the two had similar interests I wonder if they ever met. Guess we will never know.
 - b. Re the Old Soldiers Home - In the late 1930's I remember visiting there as a 10 year old - Can't remember why.
5. Re TB & Alcoholism - my study of family histories shows both common, especially TB prior to 1950, in Upchurchs and many other families - also many infant deaths. - All very sad. My father abused alcohol in his youth - but not when I knew him. - Probably caused his death at 67 due to poor liver function
6. I have a picture of Mary in uniform - a lovely lady.
7. You mention EMMA J. UPCHURCH (J=??) I assume she is nee Emma Nora Whikes.
8. Re Lydia - I carry her as LYDA CARSON U - I had extensive correspondence with her daughter Evelyn Lucille (U) Morgan who lived in Wilmington, NC and had a keen interest in family history. Lyda married Joseph Baldy Upchurch - which leads to a whole new story
9. Narrative on Nathan Upchurch - (Common ancestor for Juanita & RPH)
 - a. Mostly it is on the mark.
 - b. I don't know for sure how he got land in western Wake but there is no reason to think he was "given" the land.
 - c. He named "Mockey" - but there is no hard

evidence she was nee Johnson. I only theorized this since Nathan bought land from Julius Johnson. Years of searching have not resolved the issue

d. I have published quite a bit on Nathan U, I in various issues of the UB and have a large profile for him and each of his children & grand children.

10. My condolences on the passing of your son and at such a young age. I note you style his son as Herman D. Edmonds, I. I would ordinarily think it should be III but this is a matter of family choice

11. Pages 26 & 27 show a picture of Emma Nora Wicks with a note written by Mary Lee Howard. I am intrigued by the writing on the face of the photo which reads "I was born here". Does this mean that Emma or Mary Lee was born here - or possibly Ada made the entry on the face of the photo and it was Ada who was "born here".

12. Re Newspaper Article 13 DEC 1913. I have reformatted this (copy enclosed) and have placed a copy in files as indicated by A.

13. Have now essentially finished processing the pocket vid 3 FEB 2009 - so read our exchange in your profile. I note that we have been repeating some items. Going forward we can just concentrate on what ever is of special interest to one or the other of us - or both.

14. I see no reference to a Wicks Book I obtained on 1 SEP 1999. It is "The New Wicks/Wheeler Family"

by Richard Fenton Wicker, Jr, Editor 1997 (Apparently first published 1989). This is an excellent book and it takes Emma Nora Wicker's ancestor back to the 1500's in England. So you have access to this book?

15. I show Gary Lee to 13 NOV 1947. you show 13 NOV 1948 ??

I have now filed all the excerpt sheets and special items mailed in your packet. It is fun and satisfying (to me) to build profiles on individuals and to get a better grasp of what these family members were like - and how things were in the world that existed at the time.

Thank you for your letter of 24 Nov 97 about your Upchurch ancestors. I have a huge amount of information about the extended Upchurch family and am especially familiar with the members of the Upchurch family of Wake Co, NC & Raleigh, NC as I was born and raised in Wake Co, NC. If you are willing to exchange information, I can provide you with a great deal of information about your own line. While we know a huge amount there is always more to be learned.

The information in your letter does not agree with some details that I have. We need to sort out which is correct and to add more details insofar as possible. You and I disagree as to the husband of Emma N. Wicks. I show it was JOHN RUFUS U whereas you show it was ROBERT P(H) U. I am fairly sure I am correct. However, could you tell me the source of your information and let me know which is correct.

For several years I carried on an extensive correspondence with your first cousin Evelyn Louella U, now deceased. She had a great interest in the family and provided me with much information.

You will note that I have divided the Upchurch family into 22 clans each headed by a member of the 5th generation of the family in America. You and I both belong to the Nathan Upchurch, 1 clan. Naturally, I have a special interest in collecting information on the descendants of Nathan.

You mentioned Pearson U. I never met him but he and I lived in Raleigh, NC at the same time. He and I both have the initials R. P. Upchurch and sometimes we would get each others mail or phone calls.

I am looking forward to hearing from you and to the prospects of collaborating on our shared family heritage.

Dear Mr. Upchurch:

My maiden name was Upchurch. I am interested in tracing my family heritage and wanted to see if you had any information on the Upchurch family in Raleigh, NC. I can remember some from what my cousin told me and the other information that I have, I got from the Archives here in D. C.

My great Grandfather's name was Robert P (or H, illegible) Upchurch. He was born in N.C. in February 1851. His wife's name was Emma N. Wicker Upchurch, born August 1867 in N. C. They had four children at the time of the 1900 census: Ada G., Thomas Everette (my father), Leida, and an Ira Gilbert (16 at the time and a cigar apprentice).

I am told that Robert was the first magistrate of Raleigh, NC and that his picture hangs in the State Capitol Building in Raleigh. They had another son, Pearson, that continued to live in Raleigh until his death, about 10 years ago. He practiced law in Raleigh.

At the time of the 1900 census, Emma's mother, Emma J. Wicker, born October 1829, was living with them. Any information that you may have, I would appreciate seeing it. Please let me know of any costs associated with the literature.

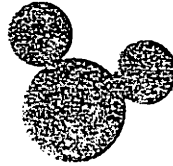

If it is possible for you to refresh the information related to footnotes 1) and 2) it would be helpful. Also, it would be useful to copy for them all the details listed including household members

The details you listed on the W.S. Bogwell family led me to look for other Bogwell/Upchurch interactions. In the process I came upon the prospect that your ancestor W.S. Bogwell may have been the William S. Bogwell who married Nancy Britt. Thinking this might be new and of interest to you I provide herewith copies of the 3 BRITT family histories (#114-121) recorded in the book "The Heritage of Wake County, North Carolina - 1983"

I did already have the four Revolutionary War Records you cited.

The Census Records are extremely helpful and I have many detailed abstracts but for quite

a few State/County/decade combinations I am missing the records. I have a pretty good set for 1880 across the country thanks to Cousin Roy White of Salt Lake City. Also my NC extracts are quite good (but not absolutely complete).

If you are willing to do more census extracts, may I suggest that you tackle the VA records. My Upchurch VA Census records are quite incomplete and if you generated an entire set from 1790 to 1920, decade by decade it would be very helpful. You would need to record all details available. I would then try to fit the individuals into the overall Upchurch family. If you undertake this project you will need to locate the index for each decade for VA so you can see which counties to search. As an example I provide herewith the index for 1850 for NC. (Cover page & 1 index page only).

I'm rechecking my Biopics on individuals named Thomas E. U. I came upon a citation for a person by this name which appeared in the June 1994 issue of Johnston Journal. [This is one of several publications

I take and scan for Upchurch details. It seems most likely this Thomas E. U. is your father. What do you think? A full copy of the article and of the Thomas E. U. profile are enclosed.

Tim Ferris and I continue to have productive exchanges. You, he and I are cousins.

Perhaps this will be enough for you to reject on this round. I'll look forward to your next letter.

I decided to go to the attic and dig through some stuff that my aunt Ada had given me before her death. Lo and behold, I had more stuff then I remembered so maybe I can help you piece together some more history.

First of all your questions regarding my father. Here's what I know:

I have a letter from my Uncle Pearson to my dad dated May 14, 1957. It says:

I have a picture of Emma Jane Williams Wicker, born in 1828 and passed away March 20, 1903. She was the wife of David A. Wicker, born October 12, 1824 and died in 1890. He was the second appointed marshall of Raleigh from 1869-1879. His pictures hangs either in the Supreme Court Library or the History Museum. (Aunt Ada was not very clear on this one).

I also have pictures of my great grandmother's mother's father, Wicker. Pictures of my grandmother Emma Wicker Upchurch and a picture of Emma Jane Williams Wicker. They are not in very good condition though. Something else that I came across was a reprint of an article in The News, dated July

22, 1880. It said: Mark Williams one of the oldest resident of this city died yesterday-aged 84. he was born in Franklin County in 1796. his home was at the southern extreme of Wilmington Street. Aunt Ada said that it was my great grandmother's father since her name was Emma Jane Williams.

Do you have an idea of where Judy is? Or any live members of my family? Would you please send me what you have? I am most anxious to see if I have any living relatives. Do you know if Pearson had any children? From what I can remember, he was married a few times. What ever happened to Ira G? I did not even know about him.

I plan to visit my cousin sometime in the next few weeks. She is Ada's daughter and not very well. She is 88 years old and I don't know how well her memory will be. If and when I find out any information, I will let you know.

Hi Cousin Juanita---

How exciting that you will be in London for 6-12 months. I'll have a suggestion about the prospects of your contacting Professor David Ransome later but first to the Apex Talk. I know you had hoped to attend and since you could not had requested details about a recording. That has now been worked out. The Apex Historical Society is selling DVD's of the talk for \$10 Post paid. Contact Debbie Douglas who is a good friend and just happens to live in the restored Mac Upchurch house in Apex. I have not seen the DVD and had hoped to do so before telling people about it.

It may be useful for you to do some Upchurch research while in London but let me set the stage for some options. First, perhaps you will recall that we have used Professor David Ransome since the early 1990's to search for our English Upchurch roots. He has done a magnificent job and much of what he has found has been published either in the UB or ENGLANDIA. A best option would be for you to acquire copies you do not already have and to study these. This would give you a sense of what has already been done and perhaps more important give you an idea of what you could go see in the way of Upchurch heritage in England. Given your departure this week we don't have much time to get issues in your hands. However, if you so desire I could mail issues to you after you get to London. I charge \$5 per issue and don't worry about the postage.

If it can be done a most productive venture would be for you to arrange for Professor Ransome to serve as a Guide to Upchurch sites for a day or so. This would depend on his time and interest. He has often gone the extra mile for the Upchurch Family but in a case like this I would expect that he would be compensated fairly. I might add that he does not offer himself as a paid consultant but helps us as he can spare time from his scholarly pursuits.

After you have reviewed the above and selected a course of action you may find a niche where you can obtain some useful facts through research. However, I think that pales beside the opportunity for you to enmesh yourself in what we already know about our English heritage.
