① On the 3rd of April, 1772 Richard U, Sr^(II) sold to Richard Jr^(III) in Bute Co NC 150 acres of land "5 side of Crooked Creek" (Recorded November Court of 1772, Bute Co NC).

"Richard U, Jr - born probably in Brunswick Co Va date unknown. He was of legal age in 1772 - proven by the fact that he bought land from his father, Richard Sr in Bute Co NC on the 9th of Nov of that year (Bute Co NC Records, presently in the Court House in Warrenton, Co seat of Warren Co NC)."

Richard U Jr b about 1748-1750 - Bute Co taken from Granville in 1764 - then divided into Warren & Franklin in 1779. Richard U Jr bought land in Franklin Co NC in 1788 (BK 7/9) in 1798 (BK 7/24) and in 1799 (BK 9/104) (Franklin Co NC Deed Books)

First wife of Richard U Jr is unknown. M^d 2ndly 14 SEP 1796 [SUSANNAH PACE] Polly (Soxby) Pace. In 1800 census show 7 in her home in Franklin Co NC - In 1810 he listed 5 + 27 slaves.

8. Burkely U, II b 1795 married 1815 at 20 ± 1 yr

The birthdates of 1-5 are quite well fixed by successive Census records. 6-8 are revealed by the census records only as born 1790-1800. The birth dates of 1791, 1793 & 1795 have been somewhat arbitrarily assigned. Larkin U needs to have the earliest (1791) birth date on the assumption that he had a daughter Susan U who died in 1831. Thus if Larkin U died in 1811 at age 20 he could have had a daughter Susan U b 1812 who could have died in 1831 at 19.

Since Richard U, II had no children between 1777 & 1787 it is possible they were born & died unrecorded - or perhaps he was between wives. In 1790 the home of Richard U, III has room only for a wife (#2?) & 1 child - the older children having been "farmed out".

The larger tract owned by Elecia Strickland must have been from one of his land grants. It seems reasonable that this transaction involved the land Richard II owned at his death in 1817 and probably the contiguous parcel Richard II gave to Nathans II, I in 1794. what is not clear is whether the 1798 transaction involved Richard II or Richard II, III.

Note that whereas this 1798 document is a Wake Co, NC document it deals with land that was actually in Southern Dan's Twp of later Franklin Co, NC as this area was in Wake 1771-1787

Note: In Julius Alford's Will, he left "the plantation John Rose lives on" to Goodrich Alford his son. The Will was written 13 July 1768 and probated in November 1771²².

1771 in Bute County Court

"Ordered that William Tant be Overseer of the road in the room of Francis Johnson & Ordered that he keep the same in repair with the Taxables usually working thereon"²³.

- △ □ "Ordered that Jacob Hartsfield be Overseer of the road in the Room of Francis Johnson & it is further ordered that he keep the Same in repair with the hands usually working thereon"²⁴.

Notes: Jacob Hartfield along with Julius Alford had crooked Creek grants. (See attached map.)

"Francis Johnston" is listed in the Bute County 1771 Tax List²⁵

1771 WAKE COUNTY was created in part from the Northwestern part of Johnston County SEPTEMBER 1772, Wake County

- △ Julius Johnston's name appears on a "Jurors Road List" to lay off a new road from the Bute County line, crossing Moccasin Creek and continuing on and intersecting a new road at Mark's Creek.
Some (but not in any order) on the list are William Pace (2), Benjamin, Moses, Richard and Charles Upchurch, Edward Hocutt, Pettypool Massey, Edward Earp²⁶.

1777 Nash County created from lands in western Edgecombe County

1778 Wake County Land Warrant 640 20 Oct 1778

- △ John Ledbetter enters 600 acres of land in Wake Co. lying on the north side of Neuse river, and on both sides of Rocky Branch joining the lines of Julius Johnston, Lodwick Alford, and Isreal Privitt, including said Ledbetter improvements. 600:50/15³⁰

"Caveat Entered by Julias Johnston. Land given up by Upchurch to Johnston and the money returned"³⁵.

- △ □ □ Feby 1, 1779. Julias Johnstone Enters 640 acres of land in Wake County, Beginning at Elisha Strickland's line at Pettypool Massey's corner, running south to Joel Bolton's corner, thence west, including said Johnstone's improvements.³⁶

December 1782 Richard Upchurch conveyed deed to Julius Johnson³⁹.

In 1782 or 1783, Julius Johnston is listed in Captain William Earps District in Wake County⁴⁰. He is the only Johns(t)on in the district. He owned 740 acres of land, 2 horses, 9 head of cattle and no Blacks. It appears that his neighbors were some from the earlier days on Crooked Creek but are probably a later generation.

The list contains Lodwick Alford, Charles Upchurch and Julius Johnston next to one another.

Two names away is Richard Upchurch Jr. and he is on the page with Benjamin Upchurch,

△ □ Charles and William Pace⁴¹.

Nash County, 1786 JULIOUS JOHNSTON of Nash Co, NC, planter to NATHAN UPCHURCH, planter, Aug 21, 1786, for 40 pds specie a tract of 250 acres on the waters of Mocoson Creek

△ □ and on Julius's Branch adjoining JAMES BOLTON, it being part of a survey taken up by said JULIOUS JOHNSTON. Wit: RICHARD UPCHURCH, BENJAMIN SEEGRAVES⁴².

Note: A search of the Nash County Court Minutes, Deeds and Land Entries reveals no Julius Johnston records in Nash County. However, this deed shows that he was in Nash County at the time. One must remember that the "corners" area of Johnston / Wake, Edgecombe / Nash and Granville / Bute / Franklin was not a large area.



His son-in-law John Pearce & his wife drew lot #1 of 28 Acres (Need to find where John sold this). A clincher is that John Pearce in Randolph Co, NC appointed WILLIAM RHEA in FC, NC to recover his right to a portion of the estate of Richard U, III.

- The records from IN show the wife of John Pearce b 1766 was "CLARISSA" never CLARA.
- The children of Richard U, III were born from 1774 to 1795 and a daughter born in 1793. Richard U, III and 2nd 14 SEP 1796 (FC, NC). His young sons show up in his name on the 1800 census but no young daughter b 1793. Perhaps she was staying with relatives??
- In the 1790-1810 era it is unlikely you would find a female with this name CLARA & FRANCES
- On balance I am inclined to say that the 1808 marriage was for John Pearce b 1787 and Frances II possible D/o Benjamin II - NOT for John Pearce b 1766 and Clara II
