Throughout the pre-1818 time period, there were many so-called Direct Tax lists which appeared in the newspapers. These were federal taxes which were imposed. The section of the National Archives website that describes the records of the Internal Revenue Service provides the following history on these taxes:

NOTICE is hereby given, that the Direct Tax laid under the act of Congress of August 2, 1813, on the following described property, situate in this State, having remained one year from the time of the notification of the Collector in whose district the said property lies, that the tax had become due and payable, the same, or so much thereof as may be necessary to satisfy the said tax due thereon, with an addition of twenty per centum, will be sold at public sale at the Courthouse in the Town of Hillsborough, in the County of Orange, on the 4th day of October, 1815, at 11 o'clock A. M.
