AMPLIFICATION OF THE WILLIAM U, IV FAMILY
BASED ON INFO FROM WARREN CO., KY RPU 9 OCT 2016

The family of W^m U, IV is represented on the 1810 Census of Warren Co, KY by 3 U^tchurch households. Evidence shows they got there after 1800 and left before 1820 (Tax Records). Slots in the John U, II Household are easily accounted for by his known family members.

The slots in the David U Household are imperfectly accounted for by known family records. Names are needed for 1 male + 3 females, children of David born 1800-1810.

A slot in the David U Household for a male b 1784-1794 (age 16-26) could be for William U, a brother of John + David.

DAVID U IS EXECUTOR. NOTE NO SLOT FOR AVERILA IN DAVID U HOUSEHOLD IN 1810 - HOW DOES SHE FIT IN LIKEWISE NO SLOT IN DAVID U 1810 HOUSEHOLD FOR PATSEY U. HOW DOES SHE FIT IN?

Child #1 is on the 1810 census but otherwise absent with more evidence the birth order could be rearranged. There could have been 3 more births between #8 & #9 (1814, 1816, 1818). This array should be considered tentative - RPU
