Earlier referred to by RPH as "HAWAIIAN" [RECORDED] (ph 1840-1860)

- ① RPH in visit to Hawaii 13-21 JUL 1985 discovered a family of Upchurch who trace back to an Upchurch ancestor who came to the Big Island in the 1820's or before. Looking a name I have coined the name "Hawaiian" U for this individual. On 15 JUL 85 I talked to a grandson, James K. U. who lives in Honolulu (see separate notes). On 15 JUL 85 I talked to a ggnd Charles Keola U who lives in Honolulu (see separate notes). On 19 JUL 1985 I talked to a gd Louisia U who lives on the Big Island (see separate notes). The outline of this family as determined from their relatives is shown on an attached sheet. ③

According to Louisia U, a gd of Hawaiian U, he came to the Big Island with 3 friends and in due course he returned to the mainland from whence he came. She could not substantiate the idea of her brother, James K. U., that Hawaiian U landed on the Big Island as a result of his whaling vessel being wrecked. The wife of Hawaiian U is not identified but Louisia U reports she would likely have been a Hawaiian from a village on the Big Island.

WHAT ABOUT MOKUAIKAU CHURCH?

During the forty years after the turn of the century, Mokuaikaua Church also suffered from the lack of missionary zeal. However, it was during this period of downward effect that the Rev. Albert S. Baker came to West Hawaii and Mokuaikaua. Not much is recorded of his ministry, except for scanty records of his work kept by the Rev. James Upchurch and his wife, Lucy.

His assistant was a young part-Hawaiian, who was later to be ordained. The Rev. James Upchurch joined Baker by the early 1920s and labored into the years of WWII. His records show that among the four Hawaiian churches included in his pastorate (Mokuaikaua, Helani, Lanakila and Kekaha [Mauna Ziona]), only a few families were involved. Some of these families are still with us, while others have gone elsewhere to live, or have died.

Can you imagine travelling by horseback along some of the narrowest and rockiest trails along the shoreline of West Hawaii? Even at the present time these pathways (parts of them called the "King's Highway") are in very poor condition. Kahu Upchurch not only regularly used them in going from one church to another within his parish, but did so while he was blind. Though without sight his sense of direction must have been phenomenally excellent. All through his ministry (and according to reports) he was ever faithful, diligent in his labor in behalf of Christ, coupled with a most pleasant personality. His wife, Lucy, must also have been exceptional, for this pastorate was primarily one of continuation, of feeding a slowly dying flock.

In support of the foregoing conclusion and in regards to the decline in church population, Alice Brown, the former curator of Hulihee Palace, stated that on that infamous Sunday morning of December 7, 1941, when they finally had received word of the Japanese sneak attack on Pearl Harbor (worshippers had already assembled at Mokuaikaua), that there were only four people present. Besides herself there were Emmaline Upchurch, the layleader; Charles Vioka and his mother.

During the 1940s there were other leaders who ministered to the needs of this historic church's membership, and they were the Rev. Stephen L. Desha, the Rev. E. K. Richardson, Licentiate Emmaline Upchurch, the Rev. Moses Moku and the Rev. Francis Endo. Their leadership was classified as "supply," or better known among the Hawaiian churches as "komite kahu." In other words they either served another church nearby in Kona, and on a part-time basis served at Mokuaikaua; or, they held the position of a dual or tri-ministry.

POST WORLD WAR II ERA

There were still the faithful few who steadfastly served the Lord's mission at Mokuaikaua. Endo and Richardson continued to supply the pastoral needs of the fellowship. Among the prominent members of Mokuaikaua were Akoni and Mabel Ako; Minnie Keamohuli; Charles Vioka and his mother, Maria; Aunty Lakana DeGuair; William and Emmaline Upchurch; Edward and Amy Hohu Ka. When neither of the two clergy was present, then Licentiate Emmaline Upchurch would lead in worship.

Wilma Lewis U moved Hawaii in about 1975 and at Mokuaikaua Church at Kailua-Kona, HI found a gravestone for David Sytee U and beside it one for Emmanuel Sytee U. Upon inquiry she received a letter dated 20 OCT 1975 from the minister of the church Henry K. Boskard who suggested she visits Ms. Elaine Upchurch or Mr James K.U. Information in this two page document fits into the Upchurch family as follows: (New information =):

Ren Boskard suggested that Wilma wrote to this James K. U at 1352 Ala Mahamoe 96819 (she did not write but noted she found a William U in the phone book for Volcano, HI) (This William = William Manono U - RPD) Ren Boskard also suggested she writes to Ms Elaine Upchurch c/o B. P. Bishop Estate 519 Halekauwila, Honolulu, HI 96813 - which she did but got no answer. (I don't know how this Elaine U fits in - possibly a widow of an Upchurch male - RPD)

Dear Cousin Phil Upchurch:

Ruth and I have just returned from a wonderful ten day trip to Hawaii. We spent three days in Honolulu where we visited the Arizona Memorial at Pearl Harbor and the Punchbowl Cemetery and many other sights. We then boarded the S.S. Independence of the America Hawaii Cruise Line for a seven day voyage with stops at Kauai, Maui, and the big island Hawaii. Our last port of call was at Kona on the big island of Hawaii. On our day trip on shore, we made a startling discovery. We are always drawn to old churches and right on the water front there at Kona was a beautiful old church, Mokuaiakaua Church (Congregational), and also known as "The Church of the Chimes". On the church grounds there is a very small burial plot of only a dozen or so graves. And among them were the headstones of two Upchurches! These were as follows:

Emmaline Liftee Upchurch
 June 4, 1890
 Feb 22, 1959

Robert Hoonani Upchurch
 May 9, 1936
 Jan 7, 1941

There were no other Upchurch graves as we could tell. The church was open to the public, but there was no one around that I could query regarding the two Upchurch graves. I did pick up this brochure about the church and a post card of the church which I am enclosing for you. What a coincidence, but to go half way around the world, visit a small, historic church and find two Upchurch graves.

Upchurch, b. 3-16-1844, hence four years older than Shell) made him work too hard. Shell joined a group of Confederate soldiers moving through Wayne Co. He went to Cumberland Co. He first became a water boy with the Confederate Army. When old enough became a soldier. After the war he walked from Burkesville, KY to Celina, TN. He was captured (probably by two Union soldiers). They tied him up by his thumbs from a tree limb. He almost died, but was rescued by a black man. Shell later found the two men in a tavern. He shot and killed both of them. Local people never reported the incident. Shell went to the Obie River area in Tennessee and had ~~two families~~
