My Tax list for Wilson Co shows one Stephen U He
 is on the index for being on 1820 census
 in Wilson Co, TN. David U is in Overton Co, TN
 in 1820 while Joseph U is in White Co, TN and
 William U is in Jackson Co, TN.

② Land owned by Stephen U in Chatham Co, NC in
 1802 was released in a deed whereby Samuel U
 (son of John U) sold 200 acres of land on 30 SEP 1801
 to his mother John U (XID-4168). This land, on Shadox's
 Creek (in SE Chatham Co, NC) adjoined land being
 sold - Adjoined also land of David Minard & of
 Littleton Daniel - witness Thomas Williams,
 William Castle - Proved FEB 2nd 1802 Chatham
 Co, NC. [Note: I speculate that Stephen, John &
 Samuel are brothers. We know that Samuel moved
 to Wilson Co, TN c 1812. I further speculate that 3
 unconnected U's md in Wilson Co, TN are children
 of Stephen U - They are:

Ahney U md 1828 Nancy Pyland

Many U md 8 MAY 1832 James P. Florida

Sally U md 14 SEP 1840 Henry Clark - RPH]

I have been back to the TN State Archives but have not found a Wilson Co., TN will for Stephen U. It may be that his son (name unknown - age 16-18 in 1820) had died and she and her husband had assumed "head of the household" without benefit of a will. Stephen's children Abner U & Sally U were living on adjoining farms in 1840.

Samuel U was the first documented U in Wilson Co., TN. He returned to his birthplace in Brunswick Co., VA in 1810 and to Chatham Co., NC. Samuel U organized a group to move to TN. His brothers Stephen U ↑ and their Chatham Co., NC neighbor John Pyland joined the Wilson Co., TN group by 1812 as Stephen U had a daughter b 1812 in Wilson Co., TN.

Stephen U and John Pyland and their descendants remained in the same location in Western Wilson Co., TN (later Rutherford Co., TN) from 1812 - 1984, within a 10 mile radius of each other.

Stephen U and his friend John Pyland were in dwellings 418 & 419 in Wilson Co., TN on 1820 census. Stephen U was the only U on the 1820 Wilson Co., TN census. In 1828 Abner U [Samuel Abner U] (son of Stephen U) and Nancy Pyland, daughter of John Pyland

The wife of Stephen U apparently died in TN between 1812-1820

1830 Census - Wilson Co, TN & Rutherford Co, TN. - No Upchuck found. Since Stephen U is not present, assume he died c. 1830. The older girl in Stephen's home on the 1820 census probably md and the 3 younger children - Abner, Sarah + Mary may be in her home under her husband's name.

1800 - John U (XID-4168) and his brother Stephen U ↑ are on the 1800 census for Chatham Co, NC - Records not readable.

Abner U had to be the son of Stephen U ↑ because Stephen was the only Upchuck in Wilson Co, TN in 1820. None were listed in 1830. Then Abner and two sisters show up in Wilson Co, TN marriage in 1828, 1832 and 1840. Sequence regarding John U III and his sons Stephen, Samuel + John U

(A) ¹⁸⁰⁵ Samuel U + wife Mary witness a land sale in Smith Co, TN and buy land in Wilson Co, TN - 1805

(B) 1810 - Samuel U returns to Chatham Co, NC to sell father's land to brothers John. Samuel's family listed in 1810 census - All are listed in 1810 Tax List - Chatham Co, NC

(C) Stephen U ↑ + family came to TN with Samuel unless he returned. All census records show that 3 children were born 1810 and before in NC. Dan may be 1812 TN

(D) 1820 - just before 1820 Samuel's family moved to IL. They are there on 1820 census. Stephen ↑ was left as only Upchuck in Wilson Co, TN. Ryland family was on adjoining farm

(E) 1820 Census - Stephen U ↑ - Males 1800-10, Females 20-100
Abner b 1801+ (NC), Sarah b 1810 (NC) Mary b 1812 (TN)
An older dan b 1802-1804 (NC) (16-18 yrs old)

(F) No U's on 1830 Wilson Co, TN census - Assume Stephen d < 1830, oldest dan md + two younger in someone else's household

 About 1810-1812 Stephen U↑ moved from Chatham Co, NC
 to Wilson Co, TN along with neighbor Robert Pyland
Stephen U↑ md in 1806 (NC). Don't know his wife's
 name. Part of Wilson Co, TN was added to Rutherford
 Co, TN and that is how Stephen U↑, his son SAMI and
 their neighbor Robert Pyland became citizens of
 Rutherford Co, TN. Stephen U↑ was father of three
 children: SAMI, Sarah and Mary Elizabeth. I think Stephen U↑ was
 named by his mother after a Chatham Co, NC neighbor & friend Stephen Smelt

RPN NOTE: The land in valued no doubt in close to Shaddocks Creek & the Wake Chatham Border where John U, III lived & died circa 1795 and where his sons owned land. I am a little surprised that these two Upchurch are living at as late as 1837 as I thought they cleared out of the area in the 1800-1820 era - 23 JAN 2011

Phil, you're probably aware of these. While at the NC Archives yesterday, I located 6 late 18th c - early 19th c Upchurch Family NC State land grants:

- △ - John 100 A [stream name not recorded] [JOHN U, III]
- △ - Moses 50 A, Pitts Cr
- △ - Samuel 42 A, Shaddox Cr (aka Shaddocks Cr)
- △ - Sims 14.5 A wtrs Foster's Br
- △ - Stephen 300 A, Shaddox Cr
- △ - Stephen 90 A, Long Br Shaddox Cr

All appear to be located in present-day SE Chatham Co. At least one is adjacent to a David Mimms (Mims) Chatham Co grant that is positioned precisely on the southwest corner of Chatham and Wake counties. By the time you arrive on your visit, I'll have more complete information and perhaps a tentative positioning. Jim.

The 9 MAR 1814 session of Pleas and Quarterly Sessions
(for Wake Co, NC?) involved a Lucy U who had or
was about to have a bastard child. She declined
to name the father and the County declined
to provide support. Signing in connection
with the case was Stephen U and Ursula
Holley.

Today at the Archives I studied more court
records for Chatham Co, NC. Stephen U was
mentioned in AUG 1816, FEB 1817, NOV 1817 and
FEB 1818, so he presumably still lived in
Chatham Co, NC at those times. Courtney, John
Moser and Anne were other Updunbers mentioned
