RALEIGH — Michael Jameson Gunter died after a fire engulfed his apartment Thursday in Southeast Raleigh, but more lives might have been lost were it not for a Raleigh police officer who called 911 and knocked on residents' doors when he discovered signs of the early morning fire.

Jim Sughrue, a Raleigh police spokesman, said Sgt. M.A. McKee's quick thinking enabled 10 other residents of the triplex to leave unharmed and helped firefighters to arrive in time to knock the fire down and stop it from spreading to other residents' homes.

"We will never know what might have happened," Sughrue said. "But if the officer hadn't been in the area and acted properly, there's a very real possibility other lives would have been lost."

Gunter, 29, wasn't weil-known by his neighbors. Mikea Woody, who lived two doors down from Gunter, saw him get up each morning for work and return home about 4 p.m., in time to greet his stepdaughter when she got off the bus from school.

McKee was on routine patrol on the small nub of a street about 4 a.m. when he smelled smoke coming from behind Gunter's apartment. After finding evidence of the fire, he called 911. Then he began banging on doors to awaken Gunter and his neighbors.

City Fire Marshal Larry Stanford said firefighters arrived at 4:02 a.m. and forced their way into Gunter's apartment at 1113-A Upchurch St. Stanford said firefighters had to battle back heavy flames and smoke before finding Gunter in a front bedroom of the apartment, where he lived alone.

Woody, 31, lives in a two-bedroom apartment in the triplex with her boyfriend, nephew and four children. She said she was awakened by McKee's insistent knocking at her front door.

"He told us there was an apartment unit on fire," Woody said. "He told us to get out as soon as possible."

Woody's heart dropped when she opened the front door to blinding emergency lights and a chorus of wailing sirens.

"I said, "Oh my God, what's done happened?" "

In the apartment next to the fire, Redel Jones, 22, hurried to get her son, D'artagnan, dressed. Then she grabbed photos, birth certificates and a change of clothes for everyone in the apartment.

McKee got no response at Gunter's unit. Woody, Jones and their family members stood outside with their neighbors and watched as firefighters forced their way into Gunter's unit.

"I saw when he was carried out of his apartment," Woody said. "His arm was on fire a little bit."

Gunter was taken to WakeMed Raleigh Campus, where he was pronounced dead, Sughrue said.

Cause still unknown

Fire investigators were trying to determine the cause of the fire Thursday afternoon, Stanford said. Police are working jointly in the investigation because someone died, Sughrue said.

Woody and Jones both said McKee cruised down their street right on time.

"it won't nobody but God that sent him back here," Woody said while slowly shaking her head. "Nobody but God."

Jones stood in the front door of her place late Thursday morning. She had a migraine, and her eyes were pink from the smoke and lack of sleep. After her family rushed out of the apartment before daybreak, she looked for the officer, but he had left.

"I wanted to tell him, 'Thank you' because my son could have died,' " Jones said.

After the fire was under control, firefighters dragged pieces of scorched insulation to the front yard next to a badly burned washing machine and dryer.

There were few signs of damage to the exterior of the apartment, which had about \$25,000 in fire and smoke damage, Stanford said.

Woody and her family moved into the apartment last spring. She said a woman who she thinks was Gunter's wife and his stepdaughter moved out of the apartment about two weeks ago. Woody's daughter, Klara, remembered a magic trick with a rubber ball that Gunter taught her when she went over to play with the little girl.

"He was nice," said Kiara, 10, who wants to write an essay about the fire when she returns to school.
