Robertus CLARKE and Beatrix CLERIC. wyf, both of York-shire, 1 and again Robertus CLERK .. (and) Johanna, uxoz (wife) plus Agnes CLERK doghter, all of Yorkshire, 1379.

In Scotland, the first men-tioned was one Roger CLERI-CUS, who held a land grant in Kelso 1174 - 78. Then came Thomas CLERICUS. 1246; James rhe CLERK, Aberdeen-1281; John CLERC owned a ten-ement in Edinburgh. 1400; Adam CLARK, CLERK, was burges of Dundee, 1406; Hugh and Alan CLERK burgesses of Irine, 1481; John CLARK was privine, 1481 John CLARK was prior of Scone. 1524; Richard CLARK of Montrose became vice-admiral of Sweden in 1620, and Hans CLERCK became a full admiral. Our George Rog-ers CLARK was of Scottish de-scent. The Scottish CLARKS were sents of the clans Chattan. Cameron, MacIntosh and Mac-Pherson.

In Ireland, the name is de-rived from the word CLERI-EACH meaning "clerk or cler-ic." The oldest forms are CLERY, O'CLERY, CLARKE Maccleary and CLERKIN. The O'CLERYs go back to the year 900, and were most nu-merous in County Galway where many of them were liter-ally scholars as well as priests. Two Irish sisters, Julie and Des-iree CLEARY, daughters of a merchant in Marseilles, be-came respectively queens of Spain and Sweden under Napo-leon.

The following were early set-tlers in Virginia: George CLARKE was living at Warwick "SQUARKE" in 1623; William CLARKE was living at Bass's Choice, near Williamsburg, in 1623; William CLARK, aged 20,

Leofwine Lange, Essex 1070; Herard Long, Suffolk 1122; Godfrey Lunge, Glouce-shire 1179; Henry le (the, Long, Buckinghamshire 1273; Nichol-as le Lung, Cambridgeshire 1292; Adam ye (the) Lange, Yorkshire 1297.

In Scotland, Johannes Longus of Soltre was a witness to two documents, one in 1180 and one in 1189; William Longus held lapd near Lyntonrothkirk c. 1200; Adam Long, Dumfries-shire, 1259; Gregory le Long was a burges of Dundee, 1268; William Long was a witness in Dryburgh in 1350.

Richard LONGE probably ar-rived in Virginia prior to 1620 as his wife is recorded as ar-riving that year. He had a son who was born in Virginia named Robert. Alias, John, Nicholas and William Longe were living in Virginia in 1621.

Robert Longe, an innkeeper, his wife and 14 children, includ-ing sons Robert, Michell, Jo., Joshua and Lackery (probably Zachery) were given clearance to sail from England in 1636 on the ship Defense bound for New England.

Upchurch

This is an English place name acquired from once having lived in the parish of the same name in County Kent. This place was spelled UPCYRCEAN around 1120 and UPCHIRCHE in 1241. The meaning is "Upper Church." The parish took the name of the church.

Only two persons of the name could be found in England. The Burial Register of St. Thomas the Apostle's Church of London lists the death in 1939 of Roger, son of William Upchurch. Un-doubtedly there were others who escaped notice. *Nodoubt.*

And one in particular that we're glad of
