James/Thomas, Dishman married Kiziah (possibly Doublehead) (1755–1850) (Guion Miller Rolls gives his name as James Dishman.)

Jefferson Dishman married Lydia Upchurch about 1802 in Virginia. She was daughter of George Upchurch and Rachel Bethshares.

Their known 11 children and their spouses:

Mary/Polly Jane Dishman (12-21-1803–1843) and Charles Campbell Ramsey married 01-21-1827 in Morgan Co, TN. His parents were William Ramsey and Catherine Gray

Sinah "Siney Brown" Dishman (1805–07-16-1870 married Riley Brown (1824–11-19-1857) His parents: Abraham Brown and (?).

Archibald Dishman (12-18-1806–06-22-1879) married Jane Cooper (05-04-1804–04 Jul 1879)

Marcus/"Markey" Dishman (1807–1894) married Serilda Martha Smith (1813–1869) Her parents: William and Mary (?) Smith.

Mr. Asahel Dishman (1808_?)

Thomas Jefferson Dishman (1809–1860) married Elizabeth (?) (1809–?)

Milus/"Miles" Dishman (1811–1880) married Susannah Raines (1816–1858). Milus' second wife was Margaret McCulley (1830–1880)

Joseph Dishman (06-12-1812–11-08-1903) married Millie Ann Williams (1817–1880).

Joseph's second marriage was to Rhoda Gooding (12-?-1839-1900). Rhoda's parents: William and Mary (?) Gooding.

Elender/"Nellie" Dishman (09-27-1814–?)

Moses Dishman (1817–08-?-1864) married Millie Upchurch (1817–1861). His parents: Moses Upchurch and Catherine Barker

Burrel/"Big Bird" Tremont Dishman (10-27-1820–05-23-1901) married Nancy Upchurch (04-09-1825–1884) on 22 Nov 1843 Her parents: John C. Upchurch and Sarah Bertram

Many of these Dishman families lived in Dry Holler in the southern part of Wayne County and Tennessee.

Nicholas Kenaston and wife Katie Kenaston of Fentress County sell to John Upchurch for \$150..100 acres on LSF. Bk D 478. John Upchurch to Moses Upchurch 75 A. Otter Creek. 1-25-1838 G-343. The 1850 Census of Wayne Co. KY and the will of John Upchurch gives a record of the family. In 1850 Nicholas Bertram was making his home with John and Sarah. John's will written in 1868 names the married daughters. His will was proved 6-23-1873.

Looking back at records, William
Harvey Gooding was born in
Palmerville, Ky near Mt. Pisgah
I believe Otter Creek may be
Order Creek instead. I'm not
well organized on my paper
work yet. But again the family
tells this story:

When the family was traveling
by wagon train, they reached
Otter Creek in Ky, and camped
over night. The ladies were
getting the fire ready & men
folks were out hunting. They

Put the baby (Henry Alvin) in a basket under the wagon, in the shade. The men came in & meal was cooked, they ate. The mother went to get baby & it was gone. The men folks started looking around and found lion or cougar tracks & where baby was dragged. They located the big cat on a ledge above creek, & it was playing with the baby. There was a chance that if they shot it might hit the baby, but took a chance, cause the cat would kill it anyway. So the father took aim across wagon wheel & shot. He killed the cat & got back a scratched & bruised boy but otherwise unhurt. The baby wasn't but a few days old. My Grand mother Theodosia, told this to us many times. Said her daddy's nick name was (Otter).

CHAPTER III

JOHN UPCHURCH - SARAH BERTRAM

John Upchurch, son of George Upchurch and Rachel Bathshares, was born ca 1799 in North Carolina, probably in the Salisbury district of Iredell County.

The "UPCHURCH" family has been traced back to John Upchurch who's will is dated 1502. He resided in Colchester, Essex, England.

John was the second generation of this family to be born in America -- the "UPCHURCHS" originally settled in Virginia, but later moved to North Carolina and then on to Wayne County, Kentucky where their off-spring married into the "CARTER" line several times. [WRONG - APR]

John's parents moved their family to Wayne County ca 1811 and settled on land in the Little South Fork area.

John was married to Sarah Bertram ca 1824 prior to the birth of their first child in 1825.

Sarah Bertram, daughter of Nicholas Bertram, was born in Tennessee ca 1800. Her parents were both born in North Carolina.

John and Sarah were the parents of at least seven children --

The 1850 Census for Wayne County Kentucky shows Nicholas Bertram living with his daughter, Sarah, and her husband John Upchurch.[↑]

The records of Wayne County show that John was very active in the buying and selling of property, as early as 1828.

John wrote his will in 1868 and died sometime prior to the 23rd of June 1873, when his will was proven.

It is not known where John is buried, nor when or where Sarah died. The "Cemeteries of Wayne County Kentucky" compiled by Bennie and Juanita Coffey, does not mention either one of them. Of course, in that time period, it was common to be buried on one's property and just marked with a field stone.

John Upchurch's will was written 23 March 1868, Wayne County, Ky. John said he was about seventy years of age. Will was proved 23 June 1873. Sarah was not mentioned in will, so she was deceased by 1868. He willed to his two sons, Daniel G. Upchurch and Henry Alvin Upchurch all the land he owned in Wayne County, Kentucky on the waters of Otter Creek. The residue of his estate of every kind to be divided between his five daughters, Elisabeth Dishman, Nancy Dishman, Nellie Carter, Lucinda Hughes and Rowena Carter. He signed his mark in the presence of his good friends John Sallee and Emsley A. Bertram. His wife Sarah Butram (Butram-Bertram) was daughter of Nicholas Butram, born 1781 in North Carolina. □ + □ + □


