## MURRY UPCHURCH

MURRY UPCHURCH, son of MOSES and Mary (Simms) UPCHURCH, was born 1 Nov. 1797, in Franklin County, N. C. ✓ While still young, sometime before 1810, he moved with his family ✓ to Chatham County, N. C., where his father had bought a rather ✓ large acreage. No facts of his youth are known, but he presumably grew up engaged in the growing of tobacco, along with his many brothers and sisters. ✓

On 23 Aug. 1820, MURRY married Nancy Scott, (b 29 Nov. 1801 d 26 July 1864) daughter of John and Rachel (Baucom) Scott of Wake County, N. C. ✓

On 10 Jan. 1826, MURRY bought 160 acres of land from his father, MOSES UPCHURCH, for \$250., "on Clifton's Spring Branch . . . RUFFIN UPCHURCH'S corner . . . Hugh McLane's corner." (CHATHAM COUNTY DEED BK. A-A/60). ✓

In Feb. 1849, MURRY bought 100 acres from his brother, SIMS UPCHURCH. (CHATHAM CO. DEED BK. A-H/128). ✓

The 1850 U. S. census of Chatham County, N. C. listed MURRY'S age as 52 and Nancy's as 48, with four children still living at home. ✓

The 1860 census gave MURRY'S age as 63 and Nancy's as 59. In their household, according to the census, still lived their daughters, Mary, aged 23 and Clara, aged 19. This same census showed, also, Nancy Carson, widow, aged 25, who was probably a helper in the household. Nancy (Scott) Upchurch died 6 July 1864, and MURRY married Nancy Carson. ✓

The date of Nancy (Carson) UPCHURCH'S death is not known, but she left a will, dated 22 Nov. 1869, leaving the property she had ✓

inherited from her first husband to her Carson children. (CHATHAM CO., N. C. WILL BK. E/45). ✓

MURRY UPCHURCH married, as his third wife, Sallie Temples, on 1 March, 1870, in Chatham County, N. C. ✓

MURRY died suddenly on the 19th of March 1872 in a neighborhood store. His will was dated 6 April, 1870, and is abstracted below: ✓

CONTINUED

"To my beloved wife, Salie—75 acres of land, including the homestead, adjoining the lands of SIMS UPCHURCH, Welthy, Elkins and H. Melton, as long as she shall live, or her widowhood; bedstead, one wheel and cards, cooking utensils, one year provision to be set aside and given to her by my executor.

To my daughter, CLARY—one cow and calf, one walnut folding table, one side saddle.

I give and devise to my son PASCHALL'S children one note that I hold against the said PASCHALL.

I give and devise to my daughter ELIZABETH LAWNRNCE'S children . . . one hundred dollars.

I give and devise to my son, ISHAM, the sum of one dollar.

It is my will that twenty-five dollars taken out of my daughter RACHEL'S children part and then for them to share equal with the rest.

It is my will that my executor rent my land until he, in his judgment shall see fit to sell it for cash or credit, and he shall sell all my personal property and divide equally, between my daughters; MARTHA, ELIZABETH'S CHILDREN, EMALEY, PASCHALL'S CHILDREN, MARY and CLARY.

Lastly, I hereby constitute and appoint Aderson Council by lawful Executor."

\*MURRY UPCHURCH and his wives are buried at his home place, today called The Mulholland Place, located on N.C. Route 751 in Chatham County, near White Oak Creek.

From the MURRY UPCHURCH Family Bible, which cannot be found at this date, comes the following information of the names and birth dates of the children of MURRY and Nancy (Scott) UPCHURCH. This was, fortunately, copied from the Bible, on 12 Feb. 1888, by the late Philip Nelson Foushee (son-in-law of MURRY UPCHURCH), at the request of ISHAM SIMS UPCHURCH, a son of MURRY, and was found among the papers of ISHAM SIMS UPCHURCH after his death. The additional information of the names of spouses was furnished by ORA (UPCHURCH) LEWTER, Deceased.

We rode south on HWY 757 from the H. O. Kelly Place (Adelia residence) and just south of the Nursery on the west side of the road Adelia pointed out the Mulholland Place which Adelia says was the place where Moses U & his son Sim U were buried in now unmarked graves. Adelia calls this the Sim U place - but at another place in the notes she indicates that Murray U, another son of Moses U were buried with Moses & Sim and as a result she refers to this as the Murray U place. Adelia says a distant relative of Moses U. authorized the placing over of the graves. The Mulhollands are apparently sensitive to many visits.

"Moses U & his wife nee Mary Sims are buried on what is called the 'Sims Upshurs' place in Chatham Co, NC on land originally purchased by Moses U when he left Franklin Co, NC." According to tradition Moses U died at 102 or 103 from a fall from a horse while crossing a small stream in which he died. Neither Moses U nor his wife nee Mary Sims left a will.

The parentage of JOHN SCOTT of Wake County, N. C., who was the ancestor of the line of SCOTTS in which this writer is interested, has not been proven. However, in 1762 one JOHN SCOTT of Wake Co., N. C., was buying and selling land on Crabtree and Walnut Creeks. He left a will, recorded on the first of November, 1819 (WAKE CO., N. C. WILL BK. 15/347), naming his wife, Hannah and children, without naming his children. Presumably JOHN SCOTT who was later active in land deals in this same section was one of those unnamed children.

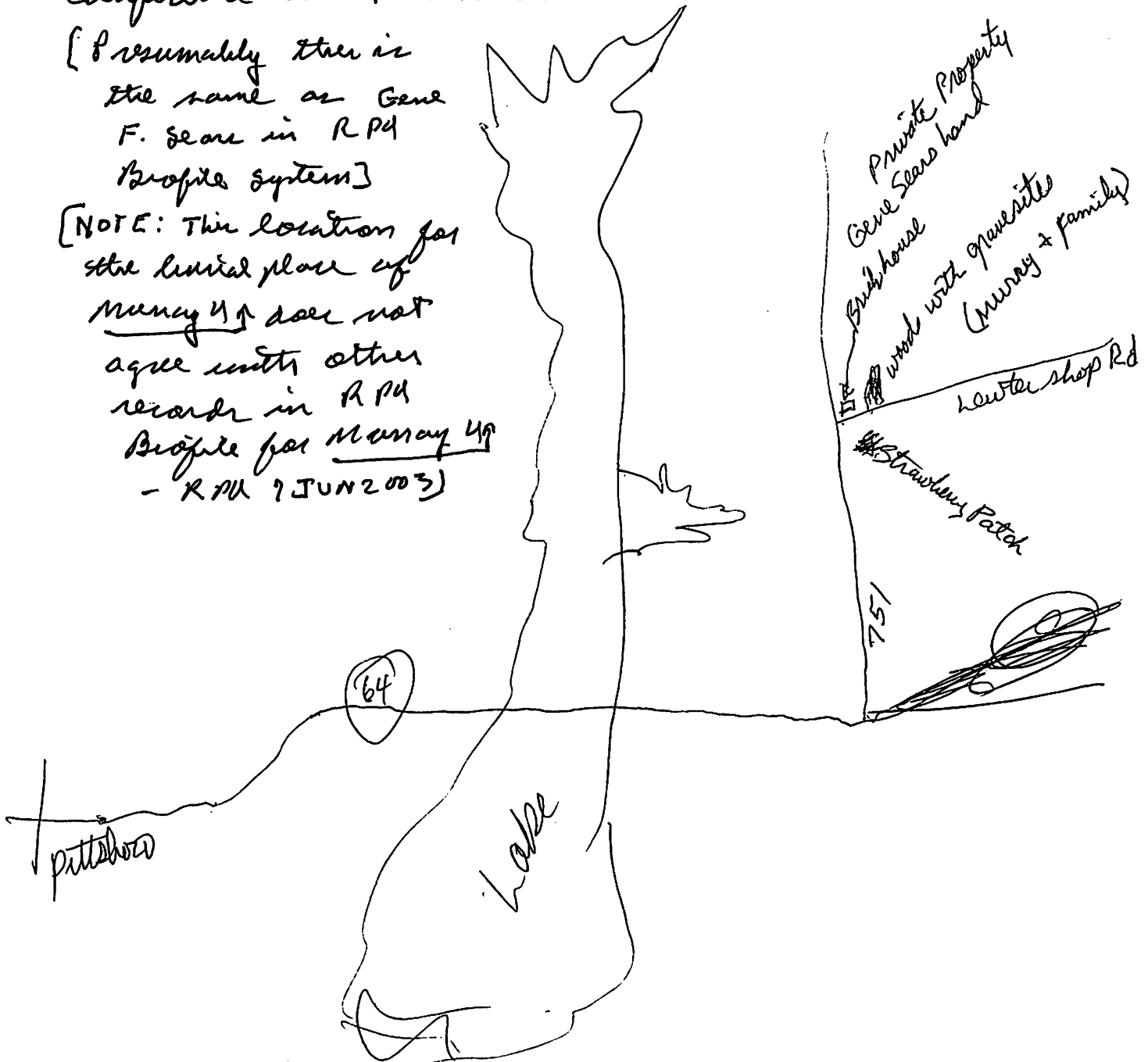

I Murry Upchurch of the County of Chatham and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and memory, but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence, do make and declare this my last will & testament in manner & form following that is to say:

First - that my executor (hereinafter named, shall provide for my body a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my relations & friends, and pay all funeral expences, together with my just debts howsoever & to whomsoever owing, out of the moneys that may first come into his hands as a part or parcel of my estate.

Item. I give & devise to my beloved wife Salie - Seventy-five acres of land including the homestead joining the lands of Sims, Upchurch; Welthy, Elkins; & H Metton to have & to hold so long as she may live on it or her widowhood one beadsitd, bead & furniture (her choise), one wheel & cards, cooking utensils, one year provision to be set apart & given to her by my executor.

Item.- I give & devise to my daughter Clary, one cow & calf, one walnut folding table, one side saddle, this I want to give to my said daughter Clary in order to make her up even with my other children, to have & to hold forever.

Item. - I give & devise to my son Paschal's children one note that I hold against my said son Paschal in full of there part of my estate.

Item. - I give & devise to my daughter Elizabeth, Laurence children first - that one hundred Dollars, be taken from there part & then for them to shear alike with my other children.

Item. - I give & devise to my son Isham, the sum of one Dollar and his full share of my estate to have & to hold forever.

Item. - It is my will that twenty-five dollars be taken out of my daughter Rashal children part & then for them to share equal with the rest.

Item. - It is my will that my executor rent my land until he in his Judgment shall see fit to sell it for cash or credit & that he shall sell all of my personal property and devide it equally between my daughters Martha, Elizabeth children, Emaley, Rachal children, Mary & Clary.

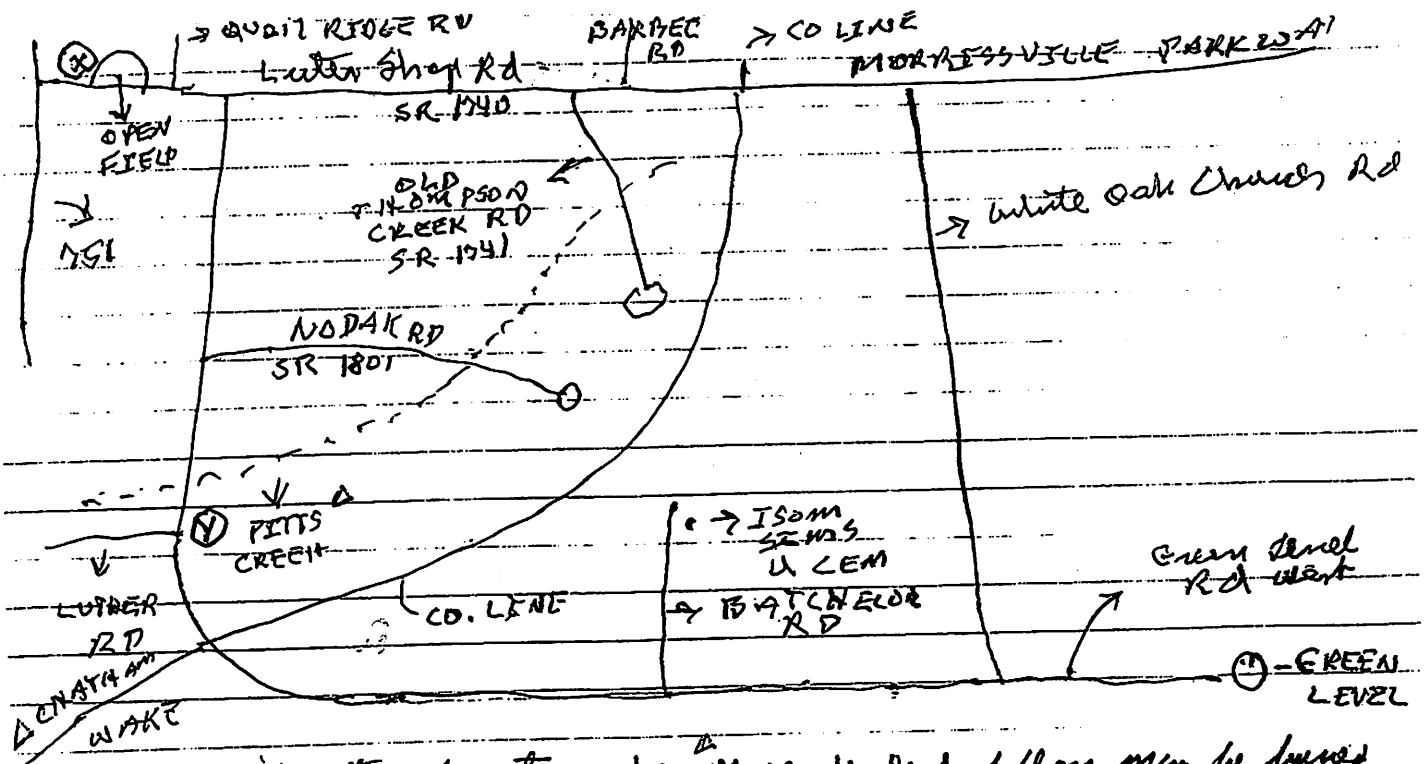
