

Dear Phil:

I thank you for your recent letter. I have enjoyed the articles in the Upchurch Bulletin on Charles Upchurch. It was nice of you to include them. I am concentrating my efforts at present on Charles - trying to find newspaper articles on his death notice. I have several good leads and will keep you informed.

I secured a copy of Charles's testimony to support his claim for a Revolution pension. It is dated May 21, 1833. In it he states that his brother Moses has the registry of his birth in his father's Bible. I am in the process of translating the entire document.

I had a telephone call recently from Charles } In AF  
 Robert Upchurch, 5133 Floyd Road, Mableton, Ga }  
 30059. He is 38 years old, and his line goes }  
 back through Charles Lloyd Upchurch (who wrote }  
 a letter in July 1932 to Mrs. Fred Upchurch of }  
 Austin, TX) to William Barnes U who was a son }  
 of Thomas Day SR. I was able to help him identify }  
 William. I believe you have a copy of the letter. }

Mabelton is about 20 miles west of Atlanta - about half way to Bowdon. He indicated that all his family back to William had remained in the Bowdon area. I wrote to him and encouraged him to write to you with dates of birth, death, marriages etc.

Thank you very much for your letter of 31 AUG 1995 and for all of the details. Thanks also for recopying the sheet which I have used as my new master outline for the Benjamin Franklin U Family. It saved me the trouble. I have to do a lot of recopying. Soon I should be set up to do this by computer.

Enclosed is a copy of the master outline for the Benjamin Franklin U Family with the XID's assigned for the new names you provided. There are a few missing items as shown on an enclosed sheet but the master outline is in excellent shape thanks to you and Ann. There has been a lot of "activity" in your families in the last few years. Congratulations to you both for your developing families.

I wonder if there is some way we can make some more progress on Joseph Cephus U and his children. A copy of the Master outline for this group is enclosed along with a list of missing items. I am assuming that all of the children of Joseph Cephus U and their spouses are deceased although this may not be the case. As matters stand I show that Joseph Cephus U had 13 children. You and Ann and two of the daughters of Colquitt Alfred U, Sr are the only contacts I have in this family. If you and Ann have any ideas on how to proceed they would be appreciated. Perhaps you know answers to some of the questions or can locate some. If you want me to write or call any potential sources I'll be glad to do so. I realize your father's early passing may have reduced your contact with his side of the family.

The fact that your mother and 2nd James Harney Rountree caught my eye. During 1994 I worked closely with a DIRK ROUNTREE who was an attorney in a firm in Washington, DC. In late 1994 or early 1995 he and his wife (also an attorney) moved to Atlanta, GA. He is

a really nice fellow. He was anxious to get back to the South, the land of his birth. There are several cases where Ransome and Upchurch descendants named. I have not yet figured out how DIRK relates to any of these managers, if indeed he does.

Thanks for your comments on the Upchurch project in England. I have obligated \$1,000 from the Upchurch Research Fund to support Professor Ransome in some more work in England this fall. I hope he comes up with more useful details. What he has given us so far is spectacular in my opinion.

Enclosed herewith is a 19 Page Outline showing what I have organized on Thomas Gay U Sr. I am sure you have much more and I would certainly be pleased to have anything you can supply to make the Outline more complete or correct. I also provide for your use, <sup>copies of</sup> my Profiles on Charles U & Thomas Gay U Sr. Perhaps you will find a nugget in this material or place a new interpretation on something. You need not return the Outline or Profiles.

Here are some specific questions:

① In your letter of 17 MAR 1980 you listed 11 children of Thomas Gay U & including Elizabeth U b 1841 and Joseph U b 1843

In the "Missing Link" article provided with your letter of 29 MAR 1980 you list only 10 children. There is a Joseph E U b 1841 but no Elizabeth U at all. Could you study your records and give me a report.

② What was the maiden name of your Aunt Sally Upchurch Aldredge? I can't pick her out from the list I have.

③ For wife of Thomas Gay U & I have PATRICIA BARNES rather than PATTENCE BARNES as you show. I presume your records are correct?

④ I show a son of William U or Joseph Cephus U b 1860. You show JOE CEPHUS U. I assume you are correct?

⑤ Dan of Joe Cephus U = QUIDA GAY U (d 2 MAY 1902) Is spelling "QUIDA" correct?

⑥ Dan of Joe Cephus U = LOUISE U born 21 JUN (JAN?) 1908 Is JUN or JAN correct?

⑦ Son of Joe Cephus U = Homer Berman U b 2 JUL 1886.

I have Homer Benjamin U. Assume you are correct?

⑧ I have your birth date as 6 OCT 1926 & as 5 OCT 1926 ??

⑨ I have a Ben I U Jr, 6425 Westheimer Rd, Houston TX 77027. Is this your son?

I appreciate all of your kind remarks about Upchurchs Bulletin. I am enjoying it and it really does work to encourage sharing of information. If we can build up the subscriber list we can keep the operations going nicely.

Have you ever had a chance to visit the Moccasin Creek Area in NC where Charles U, Morell U, Benjamin U, Richard U Jr, Nathan U, etc (all brothers) lived at about the time of the Revolutionary War? When I worked at NC State University (1942-1965) I passed through the edge of the community thousands of times (well hundreds anyway) without knowing its significance to Upchurches. I have been back once or a genealogy search for Upchurch information. There are still Upchurches there and many gravestones of Upchurches - probably mostly descendants of Benjamin U + Richard U Jr.

Many thanks for your letter and the information on the Lychurch's especially the summary on Charles and Thomas Gay SR. They are excellent. Your research is thorough and you write beautifully.

I have corresponded briefly with Belle West having been motivated by you to request a copy of her book. She mentioned to me that she has a collection of thirty Lychurch wills, some from England, which were given to her by Martha Tidd. I hope to be able to go to Newham, visit with her, and make some photo stats of a select few.

I don't understand the difference in the number of children of Thomas Gay SR and Patience Barnes. In rechecking it I feel confident that eleven is correct. Here is what I found.

Letter from Walter U, at 1, Atkins, TX, dated June 22, 1932 (2)

\* Grandfather had 10 children, 6 boys and 4 girls. The boys names were Willis, Bud, Tom, Johnnie, Joe and father Poney and the girls names were Elizabeth, Rada, Mat and Mollie.

Copy of a newspaper clipping

died: at his residence 4 miles west of Ashland on the 23rd of June 1885, Day Upchurch.






