A. Roy searched TN records and finds that one Ambrose F. U whose will was made 8 OCT 1851 and proved on 3 NOV 1851 in Warren Co, TN was the executor for one Joseph U of DeKalb Co, TN who died in 1850. The presumption is that this Joseph U was the father of Ambrose F. U. It appears Ambrose F. U died before he completed duties as Exec of the Joseph U estate and that Felix G. U replaced him. [It appears that Felix G. U and Ambrose F. U could be brothers and that a third bro could be Enoch S. U - RPI]

B. The heirs of Joseph U appeared to be Ambrose F. U, Amery Davis, Silas Davis, and Joseph's widow - Martha + others. Martha got a dower of 87 acres and the remaining 300 acres appears to have been sold.

C. "In 1838, I think it was, Joseph U of Warren Co, TN who was one of the Executors of a certain David Fisher."

Ray has searched the Rutherford Co, NC Records and reports the following:

A. "Here's further circumstantial evidence re Joseph U. He bought land in Rutherford Co, N.C. in 1801 or 1802 when he was 25 or 26 years old. Presumably he had just been married as his son Ambrose F. U was born in 1804.

I believe I placed Joseph's birth date to late in my letter to you (1800). Recent research shows that a Wilson U who may be Joseph's son, may have been born prior to 1810 in NC with another son being born about 1810 in TN. If so Joseph U would have had to have been born earlier than 1800. The Joseph U you show to be 74 in the 1850 census of DeKalb Co, TN would have been born about 1776 and would fit better in that case. If that is true, I feel that Joseph U would fit more as a brother to Samuel U (XFD-4129) whom your chart shows to have been born in 1772, and Stephen U (b 1775-1794) than as Stephen's son. [See RPL Ltr 11 JUL 1984 to Clyna Jayne Pruitt in which he suggests that Joseph U b ca 1776 is not a likely brother of Samuel U + Stephen U - RPL]

The White Co, TN surveys from 27 APR 1824 - 28 MAR 1828 show that in Book "A" at the TN land office on pages 89, 362 and 374 are records for Joseph U and on page 359, F. Ambrose U [Ambrose F. U - ?? - RPA]

Joseph U (Enoch's father?) was on the tax lists for White Co, TN in 1811 but not in 1825 (no Upland churches were). This information from "Early Tennessee Tax Lists" compiled by Byron & Barbara Suttles, Evanston IL 1977.

The 1840 TN census shows Felix U, Joseph U and Wilson U living in DeKalb Co. The 1850 TN census reflects that Felix U & Joseph U remained in DeKalb Co but that Wilson U had moved to White Co.

Many people have tried to find the father of Joseph Upchurch, born 5 Dec 1775

Brunswick Co. Va, died 2 Sept 1850 in Dekalb Co. Tenn. Married Martha Patsy

Bradley 21 July 1804 in Rutherford Co, N.C. Joseph is in my direct line.

Until recently I thought there were only four brothers and one cousin who could have been his father because of dates.

I have wills of three of the brothers and the cousin none of which mention Joseph.

The fourth brother died instate. Michael III Upchurch was born 1733 Brunswick Co.

Va. and died there 24 Oct. 1795. (filed Brunswick Co. court 25 Jan 1796)

I have a copy of the appraisal of his estate filed in the Brunswick Co. court. It does not show any heirs nor the disposition of the assets. I believe Michael III was Joseph's

father and that Joseph had siblings: William IV, George, Sherwood, Elizabeth, James and possibly David.

I know Joseph, Sherwood and James were all in Rutherford Co. N.C. in early 1800.

According to Census all Upchurchs were gone from Virginia before 1800. Sherwood

witnessed a deed for Joseph and James witnessed Joseph's married and then James

married another Bradley lady (sister to Patsy?) in Dec 1804 also in Rutherford Co.

Another clue I think is that George named his son Joseph in 1800.

Now some one has found a Bartholomew Upchurch who also lived in Brunswick Co.

near the four brothers. None of the Upchurch researchers I know have ever heard of him.

In a nutshell that is what we think we know. The primary object is to prove Joseph's father.

Your rate sounds fine, but we have been had so often, we would like to ask what your game plan will be. We have all worked on the Library of Virginia records but at a distance. One recommendation has been that the Brunswick Co. orders be researched for final disposition of the estate. Others include Estate papers 1795-1820, vouchers and receipts from estates.

I understand you could not make a commitment before you get into the work but could you at least tell us what your first ideas are. While time is important to us we understand Joseph has been dead 250 years.

David U., b. ca 1765 and Joseph U., b. ca 1779.

The presence of David U. and Joseph U. in Rutherford Co., NC. on the 1800 census is described elsewhere in this issue of UB. They head separate households and are known not to be descendants of Sherwood U., Head of 166 Clan, who was in the same county at the same time. The subsequent census records in Rutherford Co., NC are such that it appears neither David nor Joseph nor their descendants stayed in this county long after 1800.

In the household headed by David U. we find two males and two females under age ten (b. 1790-1800), one male and one female age 16-26 (b. 1774-1784), and one male and one female age 26-45 (b. 1755-1774). We assume that the male age 26-45 was David U. and that he was b. ca 1765. We assume one of the individuals age 16-26 was his child and that the four youngsters were his grandchildren.

Heading a second household and living alone in it was Joseph U., age 16-26, hence b. 1774-1784 or ca 1779. We assume this was a son of David U., b. ca 1765.

And now for some speculation as to who David U., b. ca 1765 might and might not have been. Given the age of David U., b. ca 1765 and the ages of the various generations of Upchurches it is almost certain that David U., b. ca 1765 was a son or a gs of a fourth generation Upchurch. Let us assume he was a son or gs of one of the four fourth generation Upchurches known to have had offsprings. (It is possible David U. could have been a son, or a gs of a fourth generation Upchurch not previously known to have had children, but let's skip that possibility.) Here are the prospects.

1. James U. III - Fourth generation Upchurch, b. 1724 and d. 1784 155 and Head of the Southampton Branch (#4) of Upchurches. Not a good prospect, had 5 children and five grandchildren and none with the name of David. However, from an age standpoint, James U. III could have been the father of David U., b. ca 1765.

2. William U. II - Fourth generation Upchurch, b. 1735, d.- and 161 Head of the Oxford, NC Branch (#2) of Upchurches. Not a good prospect, had two sons and one grandson and none with the name of David. From an age standpoint William U. II could have been the father of David U., b. ca 1765.

3. Richard U. II - Fourth generation Upchurch, b. ca 1725, d. 152 before 1800 and Head of the Moccasin Creek Branch (#1) of Upchurches. Not a good prospect, had eleven children and 30 gc and not a David among them. From an age standpoint Richard U. II could have been the father of David U., b. ca 1765. However, the records are sufficiently complete and abundant to make parentage quite unlikely.

4. Michael U. III - Fourth generation Upchurch, b.-, d. 1795 and 159 Head of the Brunswick Branch (#3) of Upchurches. An extremely good prospect, had four children (none named David) and 26 grandchildren, one of whom was named David U. and probably is David U., b. ca 1765.

Of course it is possible from an age standpoint that Michael U. III could have been the father of David U., b. ca 1765. However, many thorough searches for children of Michael U. III have failed to turn up more than the well known four - William U. IV, George U., Elizabeth U. and Sherwood U. Among these four we can rule out the last three as potential parents of David, b. ca 1765. The children of George U. are well known and there is no room for a son David. Elizabeth is ruled out because her offspring would not have carried the Upchurch name. Sherwood can be ruled out because Sherwood was not old enough to have had a son born as late as 1774 the last date on which David U., b. ca 1765 might have been born.

This leaves William U. IV, b.-, d. 1787 (Wilkes Co., NC) as the most likely prospect for the father of David U., b. ca 1765. This is reinforced nicely by the fact that William U. IV did actually have a son named David U.

David U. was in the home of his mother, Sarah _____ in Wilkes Co., NC, when his father, William U. IV died in 1787 as he appears in the WILL probated July 1787 in said county. Sarah continued to live in Wilkes Co. for a time and was there for the 1790 census. With her are three of her five sons, one of whom is under 16 years of age and two of whom are over 16 yrs. of age. The five sons are William U., David, U., John U., Edward U., and Abel U., Sr. It is likely that John U. (b. 1772 hence age 18 in 1790) and Abel U., Sr. (b. 1775 hence age 15 in 1790) were two of the sons in the home. It seems likely that son, David U., was the third male in the home with his mother, Sarah, in 1790 and, if so, he would have been over 16 and hence b. in 1774 or before. In support of the presence of David U. is the fact that he witnessed a deed when his mother, Sarah, bought 105 acres of land in Wilkes Co., NC in 1794. Presumably, he would have been age 21 at least at that time and hence b. in 1773 or before. We have never found another record for Sarah's son Edward U., and presume he may have been an older son who was gone from the nest in 1790. We have poor records on son William U., but presume he may have been the William U. on the 1800 census in Wake Co., NC since his brother Abel U., Sr. was definitely in Wake Co., NC at that time.

Sarah _____ sold her land in Wilkes Co., NC on 1 OCT 1902 which transaction was witnessed by her son David U. At the time Sarah was shown as living in Greenville Co., SC. Sarah appears on the 1800 census in Greenville Co., SC with two of her five dau. Heading a separate household is her son John U.

Our hypothesis is that David U., Missing Link No. 12, who appeared on the 1800 census in Rutherford Co., NC is one and the same as the David U., son of William U. IV (Head of Clan 9). After William U. IV died in Wilkes Co., NC we visualize the family gradually scattering. Son Abel U., Sr. moved to Wake Co., NC, where he married, and thence to Alabama where we have good records for him. Possibly son William U. followed the same path as Abel U., Sr. Son Edward U. disappears as far as we know. Son John U. moves first to Greenville Co., SC, where he marries, and thence to KY and thence to Henry Co., TN in the early 1800's where he died 27 OCT 1854. Sarah stayed on in Wilkes Co., NC for a few years but soon followed son John U. to Greenville, SC,

where she probably died. Our speculation calls for son David U. to
move to Rutherford Co., NC and to be there in 1800. Thus, in 1800
brothers John U. and David U. had resettled to new locations not far
apart. Sherwood U. an uncle of these two men, was in Rutherford Co.,
NC starting about 1790 and could have enticed his nephews to the area.
Since David U. is not found in Rutherford Co., NC after the early 1800's
we are tempted to speculate that he moved to KY or TN along with his
brother John U. If he did, it is entirely possible that David U. could
have been the father of David P. U., b. ca 1811 (Missing Link No. 5 -
see UE, Vol. 1, No. 3, 1980). We know that John U. was not the father
of a David P. U., b. ca 1811 as he has his own son David U., b. 10 SEP
1809 who has a known family that is different from the known family of
Missing Link No. 5.

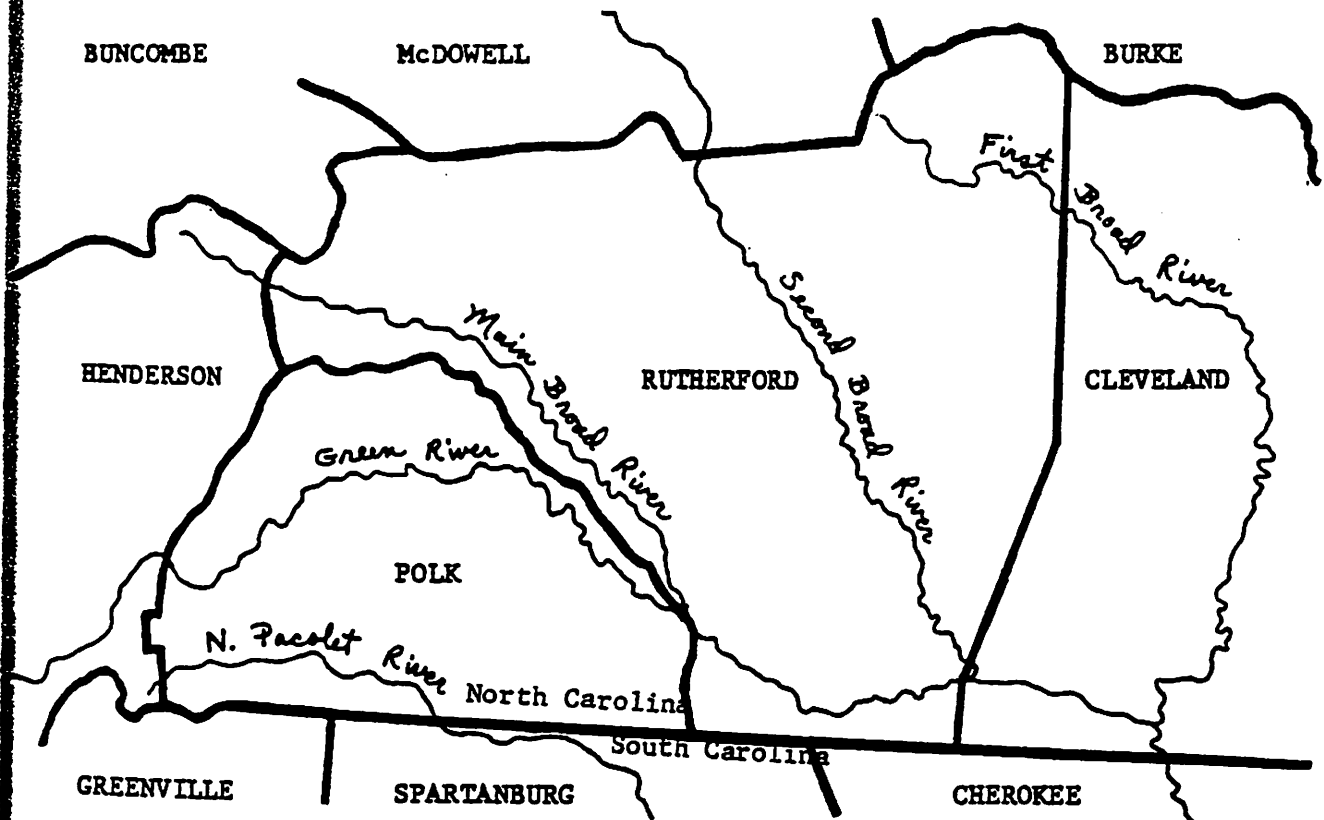
RUTHERFORD COUNTY, NC

A. General Comments.

Rutherford Co., NC is located in southwestern NC on the SC border. It was formed in 1779 from Tryon Co., which was abolished at that time. Lincoln Co. a more eastward county was formed from Tryon at the same time. In 1841 Cleveland Co. was formed out of Rutherford Co., as was Polk in 1855. Upchurches are on record in Rutherford Co., NC prior to 1800. For some of these Upchurches we have connections identified with the main part of the family and others must be counted as missing links. Over the years we have assembled information about our family members in this county. Details are given below to provide visibility for the individuals having connections and in hopes that the unconnected Upchurches cited will cause some of the readers of the UB to provide more information.

B. Review of "Rutherford County, North Carolina Will Abstracts 1779-1910".

This book was written by Grace Turner of Wilson, NC, and Miles S. Philbeck, Jr. of Chapel Hill, NC and was published in 1982. By permission of the authors we publish below a copy of the map which appears on the front of the book. This shows the present-day county lines and the location of five rivers which will serve as good reference points over time.



The WILLS referenced in the Turner-Philbeck book are on file in the NC State Archives in Raleigh, NC (C.R. 086.081.1 through C.R. 086.801.8). In due course some of us who are keenly interested in Upchurch history should examine the full documents relating to Upchurches. This may provide key information not shown in the abstracts given in the Turner-Philbeck book. The book contains 981 entries. All surnames that appear in the entries are shown in an alphabetical index.

There are three individuals indexed under the Upchurch surname. They are:

Anna Upchurch - Entry 854
Elias Upchurch - Entry 854
John Upchurch - Entry 248

Entry 248 deals with a Peter Freeman WILL written 12 NOV 1856 and probated in 1858. It is in Will Book E on page 355. Peter mentions his wife Elizabeth and eight children (dau. Ridley Guffey, Clarissa Moorehead, Margaret Hecker, Polly Luquire and Fathy Marire Moorehead and sons - Peter, Andrew and George). Viny Truelove is mentioned. The Executor was John Freeman. Witnesses were W. B. Freeman and John Upchurch. Without having definite proof we propose that this John U. is John U., the son of 8331 Sherwood U. (Head of Upchurch Clan 17). This John U. was md. in 166,8313 Rutherford Co., NC on 24(27) FEB 1849 and he had a son born there in 1854 or 1855. So we do know that John U. (XID 8313) was in Rutherford Co., NC in the mid-1850's and therefore could easily have been the signer of the Freeman WILL in 1856. Without evidence to the contrary we will assume that this is so. The John U. who signed the Freeman WILL could have been a relative of the Freeman family by blood or marriage but so far we know John U. was simply a nearby friend who was considered an upstanding citizen and asked to witness the WILL. (See UB, Vol. 3, No. 3, 1982 for an outline on the Sherwood U. Clan). 166

Entry 854 concerns the WILL of Elias U. which was written on 22 JUL 1844 8307 and probated in the summer of 1844 (must have been written on his deathbed!). The WILL mentions his wife, Anna, who is named Co-Executor and makes 8316 reference to unnamed children, all of whom are reported to have been minors. The other Co-Executor was John Tomerlaen. Witnesses were J. M. Webb and Moses Logan. The item is recorded in Will Book E, page 133. This Elias U. 8307 is another son of Sherwood U. and they are shown in outline form in the UB 166 as referenced above.

The Turner-Philbeck book does not provide us with any Upchurch surprises or breakthroughs. It does tell us that the Upchurch surname did not persist prominently beyond the mid-1850's in Rutherford Co., NC since not a single Upchurch WILL was found recorded in the county between 1844 and 1910. Of course it is quite possible and likely that some Upchurch females married and stayed in the county. Future knowledge may lead us to a discovery that some of 979 non-Upchurch entries reflect Upchurch heritage tracing back to an Upchurch female.

Turner and Philbeck have also compiled "Cleveland County, North Carolina, Will Abstracts, 1841-1910", and "Polk County, North Carolina, Will Abstracts, 1855-1910". Turner reports to your Editor that no Upchurches are listed in either book. This indicates further that Upchurches by the name Upchurch did not abide in the area much beyond the mid-1850's.

2. Commentary on Census Records for Upchurches in Rutherford Co., NC.

First is should be understood that these records are a composite of segments copied and reported by different individuals. A thorough search of these census records would be relatively easy and would no doubt yield more complete details and perhaps more faithful representations of the original materials. In the meantime, we shall analyze the material available.

The 53 entries provided for Rutherford Co., NC in relationship to Upchurches divide clearly into three groups. Group one consists of entries 1 and 2 (David and Joseph U.) who are undefined in relationship to the Upchurches subsequently found in the Rutherford Co. census records. More of group one later.

Group two consists of entries 3 - 7 which embrace the 1810, 1820 and 1840 listings. We are persuaded that all of these are of the Sherwood U. family. Sherwood U. is known to have md. in Rutherford Co., NC in 1790.

He is reported by Morgan in her UPCHURCH STORY as being on the 1790 census but your Editor has not seen such a listing. Sherwood U. should have been on the 1800 census for Rutherford Co., NC as he took title to land near the Second Broad River in 1798 and also in 1802. Again, we have not found such a census listing. 166

Group three consists of entries 8 - 53. Many of these are clearly identified as descendants of Sherwood U. For those who are not so identified it is probably only a matter of time for us to verify that they are in fact descendants of Sherwood U. An outline of his clan is found in UB, Vol. 3, No. 3, 1982. 166

For the 1810 listing for Sherwood U. we feel that the younger male is his son, Adam U., the middle male is his son, Elias U. and the older male is Sherwood U., himself. As to the females, in order of increasing age, they would be Nancy U., Elizabeth U., Mildred U., and Lucy U. Although Sherwood U. had md. again in 1804, it appears that all of the children in the home in 1810 are by his first wife. It is strange that no children appeared from this second marriage until three sons were born starting in 1824. 166 8311,8307 8312,8310,8309,8308

For the 1820 census, Sherwood U. is down to three children at home. They appear to be Adam U. and two of the three girls (Mildred, Elizabeth, Nancy). For the 1840 census, he has only one child at home, a girl born 1820-1825. We do not have the name of a child in this age bracket for Sherwood U. and presume that she is part of his second family. In the 1820 census, Elias and Adam, two sons of Sherwood U., are shown as heads of their own households.

For the 1850 census we see the children of Elias U. maintaining a household (entries 10-14) and Adam U.'s widow heading a household (entries 15-22) and a younger son of Sherwood U., John U., heading his own household. Entries 8 and 9 are somewhat confusing and are, in fact, incomplete and perhaps even inaccurate renditions. We suspect that entries 8 and 9 should be a single listing and that it could be Anne (Campbell) U., the widow of Elias U. who d. in 1844 in Rutherford Co., NC. She would have been age 48 in 1850. 166,8313 8316

For 1860 we find one household headed by the widow of Adam U. She is nee Elizabeth Freeman. Two other homes are headed by children of Elias U. 8311 8320 8307

For 1870 one household contains Elizabeth (Freeman) U. and the other contains two females, Nancy U. and Martha U., whom we are unable to identify. In 1880 we find Elizabeth (Freeman) U. again and three other homes in which there are unidentified Upchurches. We feel that these 1870 and 1880 entries belong to the Sherwood Upchurch Clan and that more research will correctly place them. 8320

With respect to group one, David and Joseph U., we are persuaded they are not of the Sherwood U. Clan because they are too old. No other linkage has been defined for David and Joseph so that they are hereby declared to be official missing links and are so described elsewhere in this issue of UB.

VIII. MISSING LINKS

A. MISSING LINK NO. 13. JOSEPH UPCHURCH.

1. Background.

In the JULY 1983 issue of the UB (Volume 4, No. 3, pg. 103-107) Missing Link No. 13 was defined as the need to locate the father of Joseph U. who was b. ca 1779 and found on the 1800 census of Rutherford Co., NC. We have subsequently concluded that this Joseph U. is one and the same as the Joseph U. who later appeared in TN. Currently, we are using

a birth date of 5 DEC 1775 for this Joseph U. Although we have not yet identified a father for this Joseph U. we have identified a large number of descendants, some of whom are actively assisting in the effort to solve the missing link. In order to encourage and further the search we have prepared an outline for Joseph U. and his descendants. This outline has been shared with interested parties and is continually being upgraded. This has resulted in even more interest in this part of our Upchurch family. In order to take this process one step further we have decided to publish the Joseph U. outline through his greatgrandchildren to the extent that information is available. The outline has been set up in conventional form as if Joseph U. were a 6th generation Upchurch and his greatgrandchildren therefore 9th generation Upchurches.
