This Indenture made the 26<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year of our lord one thousand eight  
Hundred and two Between Kinchen Strickland of the County County (sic) of Franklin & State of  
North Carolina of the one part and John Pace of the Said County and State of the other part  
Witnesseth that for and In consideration of the Sum of five Hundred pounds to him in hand paid  
unto the Said Kinchen Strickland the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and that I the said  
Kinchen Strickland Hath given granted Bargained Sold and Possessed & by these presents doth  
fully & absolutely give grant Bargain Sell and lien Enfeof (sic) unto the Said John Pace his heirs  
and assigns forever a Certain Tract or parcell (sic) of Land Situate lying and being on both Sides  
Mockerson Creek part in Wake and part in Franklin Beginning at the Said Creek at the Mouth of  
Richard Upchurch Branch then the mianders (sic) of Said Branch to James Upchurch<sup>line</sup> along  
his line to Widowe (sic) Pearce line to Sd Creek thence down the Creek to the sd fork to the fork  
then up the South Prong to the Mouth of the Grave Rock in Wake County then up Said Branch to  
a red Oak in Stephen Pearces line then along his line to Corner black oak Nathan Upchurches  
thence along his to William Ray line thence along his lines to the Said Creek thence up the Said  
Creek to the first first (sic) Station Containing by Estimation three Hundred acres more it being  
the land held by Elisha Strickland Deceas'd and given to his son Kinchen Together with the  
improvements appertaining thereunto belonging Clear of all Manner of Claim Whatsoever To  
have and to hold the said Land and premises unto the Sd John Pace his heirs and assigns forever  
and that the Said Kinchen Strickland doth warrant and defend the right and Title of Said Land  
unto him the Said John Pace his heirs and assigns forever against the Claims of him the Said  
Kinchen Strickland his heirs Excrs. Admrs. or any other person Whatsoever In Witness whereto  
he the Said Kinchen Strickland hath hereunto set his hand and Seal this day and year above  
written.

RPU NOTES 3 APR 2004

The record for James U, II is brief and inadequate. His tentative birth date of 1768 may need revision. The allocation of slots and ages for his 1790 Household is subject to some uncertainty. As to the birth date of James U, II:

- If born 1768 (as proposed by Clyde Charter U, Jr) he would have been 22 in 1790 and OK to have had a young wife and 1 or 2 young children.

- However the 1800 census shows him as 45+ which exceeds the projected age of 32 in 1800 if born 1768. If 45+ in 1800 he should have been born 1755 or before - possible but not likely

The male 0-16 with James U, II in 1790 has been tentatively designated as a nephew he being tentatively a s/o Richard U, III. However, the male & the 2nd female in the home of James U, II in 1790 could be children of James U, II - but do not surface in later records. The nephew = Buckner U

Alfred A. U b 1805 has tentatively been designated as a s/o James U, II but there is no 1810 household air record and James U, II is presumed to have died 1807 ± 3 yrs

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RE BIRTH DATE OF JAMES II

(Generally considered to be b abt. 1768)

- On 1790 census in home of RMT Richardson age 16<sup>+</sup>  
If barely 16 in 1790 would have been born no later  
than 1774 (but could have been born earlier) [b 1768 = OK]
- If 1800 census listing for James II is listed as age 45<sup>+</sup>  
If barely 45 in 1800 would have been born no later  
than 1755 (unlikely - RPA) [b 1768 NOT OK]
- If 1800 census listing should read 26-45 (as was the  
case with his wife -  
He would have been born between 1755 and 1774 [b 1768 = OK]

OF JAMES U, II b abt 1768(?) Head of clan.

FRANKLIN CO, NC - James U, II heads a household in 1790 & 1800 in Franklin Co, NC but not thereafter and he is presumed to have died  $1807 \pm 3$  yrs. A separate summary of census records for James U, II & his presumed wife show a record quite inadequate for them. THIS INADEQUATE situation continues as regards their presumed children:

We have assumed that the young male in the household of James U, II in 1790 & 1800 is to old to be a s/o James U, II if James U, II was indeed b 1768. The young male (0-16 in 1790 & 16-26 in 1800) has been tentatively designated as a nephew of James U, II - possibly Bushnell U b abt 1777. If James U, II was born earlier than 1768 then the young male described above may not be a nephew but could be a son - possibly Peyton U. This Peyton U, a presumed s/o James U, II, was a witness in 1813 and thus should have been on the 1790 & 1800 census in his father's home.

One of 2 females in the home of James U, II in 1790 and the lone female in the home in 1800 is presumed to be the wife of James U, II

James U, II is thought to have had a daughter Penny U who md in 1813 who could thus have filled one of the female slots in the home of James U, II in 1790. There is no corresponding slot for such a daughter in the home in 1800.

James U, II is also thought to have had sons Alfred A.U b 1805, Calum U d 1824 & Culbarn U d 1835. NO SLOTS FOR THEM 1800?

James Calvin II is not among those who surfaced in 1850. "Calvin" II Farmer Calvin II and 3 OCT 1860 Frances W. Gaptan - in Franklin Co, NC


