○ Input from CIVIL WAR - SEE REVERSE - Capt[△] James Henry Foote of the Wake Light Infantry (Co I 1st Rgt, N.C. State Troops) writes on 5 OCT 1861 to thank those of Wake Forest, Forestville & Ralesville, NC for sending articles to the troops. This unit was organized in Wake Co, NC at Forestville, NC on 16 JUL 1861 and assigned to 1st Rgt, NC State Troops. Capt[△] Foote joined 16 MAY 1861 and left 19 DEC 1862. He therefore overlapped the service of [△] Bartley Jefferson who enlisted on 15 JUL 1862 and served in Co G of the same Regiment. Letter addressed to: [△] Brother Huffman and reference [△] James S. PUREFOY, MOG (probably Hus of Mary R. Purefoy) who brought the items & also ministered to the troops.  Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, August 23, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until discharged at Camp Bee, Virginia, November 17, 1861, by reason of disability.
- △ CLIFTON, YOUNG B., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 16, March 1, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Malvern Hill, Virginia, July 1, 1862, and reported as absent until returned to company on February 5, 1863. Wounded at Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, July 2, 1863, and his leg was amputated. Captured in hospital at Gettysburg on July 5, 1863, and confined at U.S. General Hospital, Chester, Pennsylvania until transferred to City Point, Virginia, August 17, 1863, for exchange. Received in exchange on September 23, 1863. Retired to the Invalid Corps on November 4, 1864.
- △ COPPAGE, WILLIAM, Private
 Born in Franklin County where he resided as a farmer prior to enlisting at age 33, July 15, 1862, for the war. Discharged at Richmond, Virginia, September 12, 1862, by reason of "chronic rheumatism."
- △ DAVIS, GEORGE W., Corporal
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 18, July 18, 1861, for the war. Mustered in as Private and appointed Corporal, November-December, 1862. Wounded in action at Winchester, Virginia, June 15, 1863. Present or accounted for until paroled at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, April 9, 1865.
- △ DENTON, JAMES, Private
 Resided in Wake County and enlisted in Wayne County at age 29, May 12, 1862, for the war. Wounded in action at Payne's Farm, Virginia, November 27, 1863, and died in hospital at Orange Court House, Virginia, December 20-30, 1863.
- △ DUNN, CHARLES E., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 19, July 16, 1861, for the war. Discharged October 12, 1861, by reason of disability.

Captured at Boonsboro, Maryland, September 15, 1862, and confined at Fort Delaware, Delaware, until sent to Aiken's Landing, Virginia, October 2, 1862, for exchange. Declared exchanged on November 10, 1862. Deserted near Hamilton's Crossing, near Fredericksburg, Virginia, June 5, 1863.
- △ BRINKLEY, THOMAS H., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 28, July 1, 1863, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 12, 1865.
- △ BROGDEN, JAMES I., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 21, August 13, 1861, for the war. Present or accounted for until killed in action at Wilderness, Virginia, May 5, 1864.
- △ BROWNING, LOUIS R., Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 23, July 16, 1861, for the war. Wounded in action at Ellerson's Mill, Virginia, June 26, 1862, and at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Released after taking the Oath of Allegiance at Elmira on June 12, 1865.
- △ BUFFALOE, DAVID, Private
 Resided in Wake County where he enlisted at age 19, March 4, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, August 6, 1864. Paroled at Elmira on February 9, 1865, and transferred for exchange. Paroled and exchanged at Boulware's and Cox's Wharf, James River, Virginia, February 20-21, 1865.
