Dan & Susanne said they would be glad to see me if I can visit.

Dan said he drank some but knew when to stop.

Dan says he did not have any children because he was in an institution when he was 19 & thought any offspring might have mental problems. Later he found out that he only had reaction to drugs.

Dan's mother asked Noble to go see Dan while he was in the hospital at Donald Co. Hospital. Noble brought Susanne & this is how they met.

→ On 20 OCT 1985 RPK called Dan Martin at 10:30 AM Dan's time as a result of a call from his niece Eleanor Jane Andrew (see her biofile for notes).

Dan answered and we talked for about 5 min. I had to shout my name 3 times before he could understand & then he came through with a nice "sunnyboy".

Dan was pleasant but in a very gruff fashion. Mentioned his late wife & her father. Either the cane or the watch was given to Noble U when he completed Vanderbilt.

Dan says he remembers when I was born. Also he quoted something Uncle Rex said when my father was buried - something about tubes in nose & goats (or goats) - (did not make sense).

Dan said he had a photographic memory & did not take notes until after two years in college.

Dan said Susanna's father was a Dr & one of her GF was a Dr & the other was Dr Blacksmith (Nathaniel Smith U)

Dan offered a philosophical statement "you can hand out more manure (he used the numeral) with a shingle than you can with a shovel" - then he terminated the conversation.

Dan's bro James loaned him the money and Dan paid it back. Suzanne mother lived with Dan & Suzanne and used the cane - once hit a monkey with it when he made an absence gesture at her.

Becky commented on her Uncle Dan & James. James got into trouble with IRS because he did not keep her Hospital financial records in order. He, therefore, left & went to Myrtle Beach. Dan put things in order. Both Uncle drank. James would start at the end of the day. Dan's wife Suzanne was also an alcoholic & Becky was put in charge of her once with instructions not to open the liquor cabinet until 5:00 PM. Suzanne pleaded for an earlier drink. Becky eventually despaired of waiting her Uncle as Dan in particular under the influence would release a tirade about family matters which Becky found hard to take.

The Martin children probably got a break as  
education costs in college as they went to  
Baptist institutions.

Dan apparently had several reactions to drugs  
& was institutionalized twice following such  
reactions. He was handsome but a hardy  
taskmaster. He was in the Philippines during  
the war. Jane reacted to him there. Aunt Ethel  
occurred Jane of wanting to be his heir.

(a) Did George Hawkins U have children? names? (He mrd 20 APR 1972 Edith Brewer)

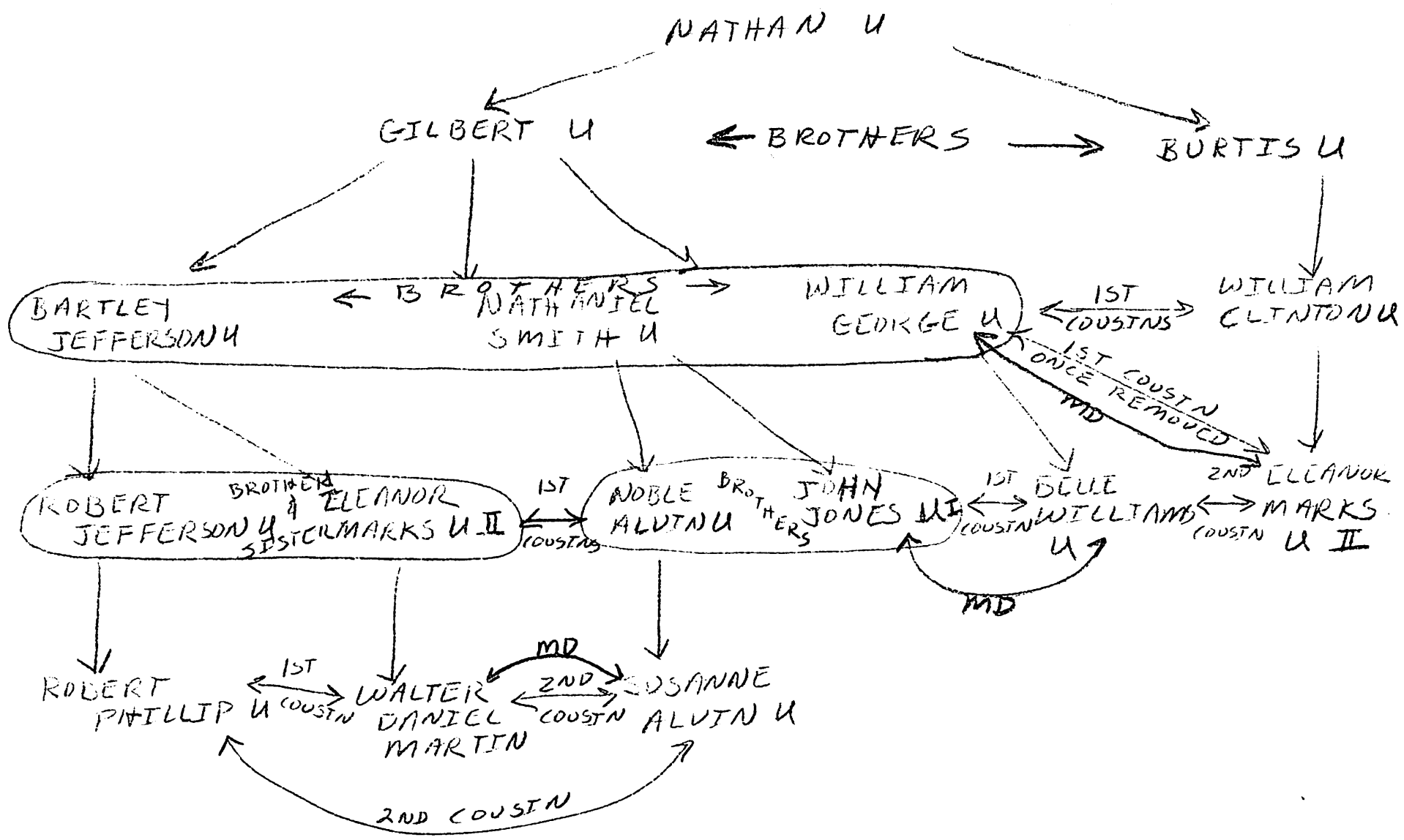
(b) Any details on Susie Eleanor U b 7 JAN 1878?

They said Aunt Ellie suffered in that she never had a home of her own after Uncle Martin died.
