Thank you for sharing these details and the ones in your more recent email.

I am on ancestry.com and my username is "imagesinblue", but as was stated earlier in this email thread I have 2 young children (2 yo and a newborn) and between them and work I've not had time recently to devote to some much needed cleaning up of dates and other minor details in my tree. When I do get some free cycles I'm going to be assisting with Dr. Upchurch's initiative of getting the William Yates family documented and enrolled on Allied Families. I should also state that my tree is certainly not as complete as the Allied Families' data as I've not fanned out much beyond my direct lines.

Genealogy and family history, being the diverse fields that they are, often revolve around our own personal interests and pursuits. I originally became interested in genealogy casually out of curiosity of my background, but later became more involved with hereditary societies. The interest in the societies has led my focus to be more upon genealogy substantiated by records and building strong cases based on available data. Given that motivation and my own lack of understanding of the complexities of the various offerings and their accuracy for the far back ancestors, I have not put any emphasis on DNA. That having been said, I did order a kit from ancestry.com last week.

It is not unusual to not find birth/death documents for Margaret Yates. Birth/Death certificates, as you may know, were not started until the early 1900s and for female ancestors we generally have to track their movements as it related to the males in their lives (wills, probate, dowers, occasionally in deeds). Sometimes we get lucky and marriage bonds or

certificates survived. Again, like other documents of that period they range in the information they provide, but in general the further back we go the harder it is find and ultimately harder to trace.

With my interest in the hereditary societies I strongly share your desire to connect the dots as far back as possible and get excited if it looks like it is connecting to someone of note. These types of connection must (for their approval and acceptance) be proven. I often wonder what connections lie beyond our "William of Wake" as that mystery shrouds our many branches that were likely in VA, MD or similar and keeps us from knowing the gateway ancestor(s), who first came to the colonies (and under what circumstances). I digress.

I encourage you to support the Allied Families' enrollment of the Yates family and to leverage any focus that DNA allows - meaning that if DNA suggests a connection to George Yates, then perhaps doing focused research on everything available about that location and those people may produce something to prove the connection.

While in my Valley Office yesterday I retrieved the records I needed to study re your question. This morning I have gone over the records in detail and will offer comments as follows:

- 1. There is clear evidence that Gilbert Burtis Upchurch, son of Burtis Upchurch and grandson of Nathan Upchurch had a son James B. Upchurch and that he had a son John Lee Upchurch, Sr who was your grandfather. I assume you have proof for all of this but if you need more input from me let me
- 2. In my view there is adequate proof that James B. Upchurch is a correct designation. Family literature further defines the "B" variously as "Bart", "Bartley" and "Bartlett" I do not think there is enough hard evidence to chose among the three versions but after many years of research I have satisfied myself that "Bartlett" is most likely the correct name and that is what I use in family reports. Some of my reasons are as follows:
- a. James B. Upchurch had an uncle named Bartlett and it is reasonable to assume James B. Upchurch was named after his uncle.
- b. James B. Upchurch had a brother named Ernest Frederick Upchurch who named a son James Bartlett Upchurch, Sr who went on to name a son James Bartlett Upchurch, Jr who in turn named a son James Bartlett Upchurch, III. I think it is clear that Ernest named a son after his brother using the middle name Bartlett which he had every reason to know was factual.
- c. Mrs L W. Priest was an avid family historian and a sister of Ernest. She and I often corresponded. On October 31,1977 she wrote to me saying "---they (in her family) refer to her brother James Bartlett Upchurch as SR rather than II since there was a generation gap between her brother and her grandfather both with the same name."

I do not know if this helps. My Biofile for James Bartlett Upchurch 1856-1928 involves 28 items covering 10 pages. I will be glad to send you a copy if you desire.
