Ariadne Cross to Anne Rebecca Cross, John Richard Cross, and Nicholas Cross
August 16, 1860
"For love and affection I bear my children and one dollar all right, title, interest to land on which I now live lying on waters of Fall Creek which was allotted to me in the division between myself, my brother Thomas, and my brother Silas. . . .

This record clearly established the family relationships and proves that Ariadne was the mother of John Richard Cross and that Silas was his uncle. It also shows that Ariadne inherited the land on Fall Creek, not far from the Cross cemetery, through a land division.

Silas Cross to Ariadne Cross
November 30, 1850
"For natural love and affection for my sister all my part of land received from my grandmother Rachel Cross" along with personal property.

This not only establishes Silas and Ariadne as grandchildren of William and Rachel but indicates that the land came from Rachel's estate. However, William had directed in his will that his land was to go to son Thomas after Rachel's death. Later evidence, which will be listed, indicates that son Thomas died before his mother, thus leaving the property to be divided among her grandchildren.

For \$75, "...all right title and interest to the land on waters of Fall Creek... Being one-third of whole."

This deed clearly shows that the property on Fall Creek, on which Ariadne and her children lived, had been the property of William and Rachel Cross and had passed to the children of Richard Cross, son of William, after Rachel's death sometime before 1856. By 1860, Ariadne had consolidated all the property.

To Richard Cross 100 acres vacant land adjoining lands of George Cain and Richard Cross heirs.

I believe that the clerk confused the heirs and placed Richard's name when it should have been Thomas. This would be a correction to my Cross Ties reference to this transfer. Richard, son of William, was still alive in 1850, and the Richard whom I believed married Ariadne (see previous e-mail) was not active until the 1850s.

The key marriage for this follow-up research is that of Thomas Cross and Chloe Lassiter. The Cross-Lassiter connection was long-standing and can be verified in Abstracts of Record of Wills, Inventories, Settlements of Estates, 1802-1812, Wake County, N.C. by Frances Holloway Wynne, pp. 35, 97.

The logical interpretation of this material, combined with what you have accumulated from local tradition, is that the land on Fall Creek belonged to William Cross who left his wife, Rachel, a life estate in the property. It was to go to his son, Thomas [not to be confused with Thomas L., son of Richard and brother of Silas], but this Thomas died before his mother. At least some of the Fall Creek land then went to Ariadne, Silas, and Thomas L., children of Richard and grandchildren of William and Rachel. Ariadne acquired all the land and had a home there. She seems to have married a Richard Cross, son of Thomas and a cousin, who died in late 1859 or early 1860. In the latter year, Ariadne gave the property to her three children: Anne Rebecca (Becky), John Richard, and Nicholas. John Richard later married Louvenia Cross, his first cousin, and apparently made his home on the property about where the Cross Cemetery is now.

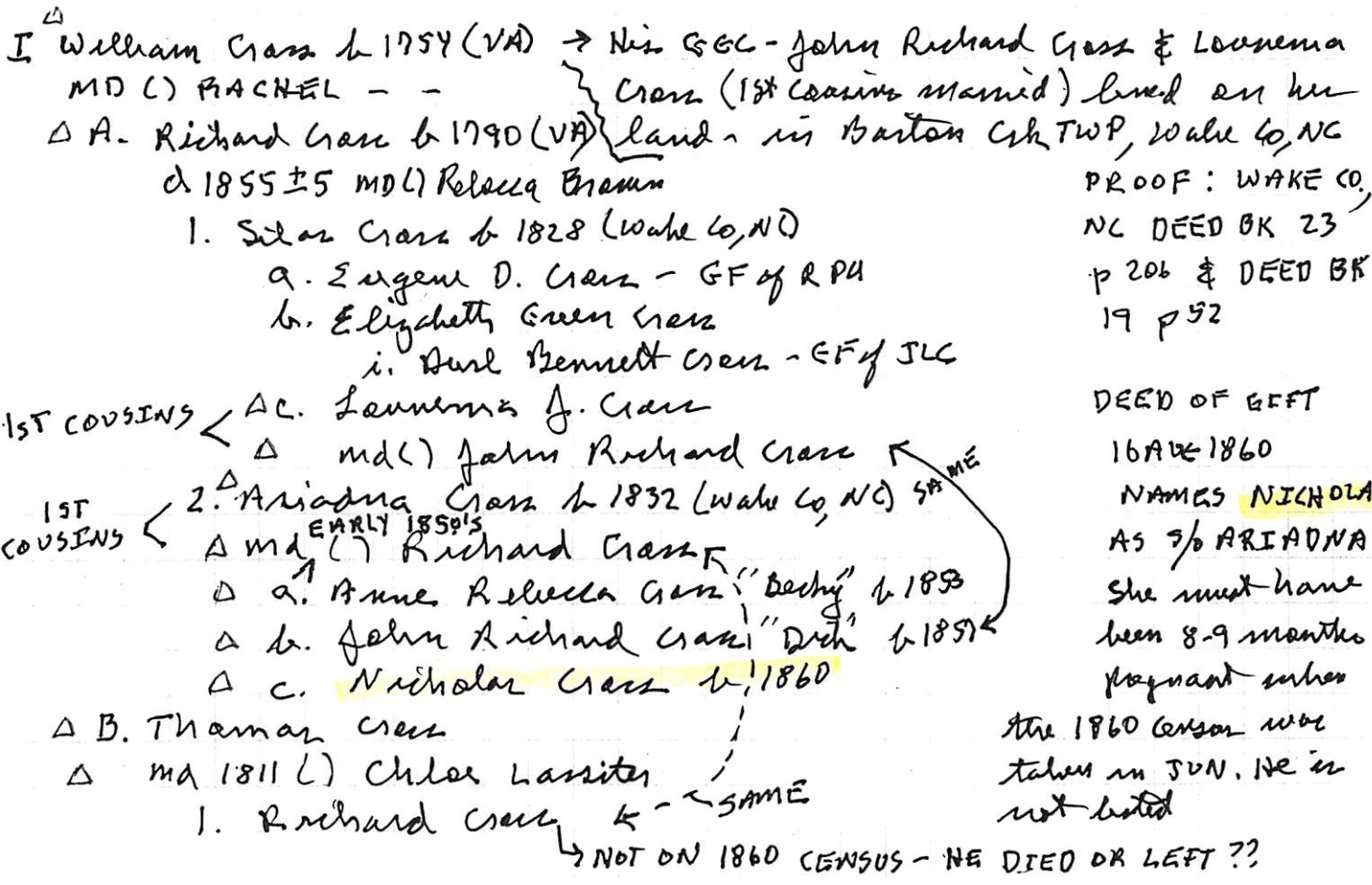

After some delay, I finally returned to the search for the elusive John Richard Cross. Guess what? I found his mother! She was Ariadna (aka Ariandna, Andriana, Arey, and Adda) Cross, daughter of Richard Cross and Rebecca Brown. That means she was also Silas Cross's sister. Proof without doubt can be found in Wake County Deed Book 23, p. 206 and Deed Book 19, p. 52. John Richard had an older sister, Anne Rebecca (Becky) and a younger brother Nicholas. Of course, this means that Silas Cross was John Richard's uncle and that John Richard and his wife Louvenia were first cousins.

So far I have been unable to positively identify John Richard's father, but there is enough circumstantial evidence to put together a good theory. The details are too extensive for this e-mail, but I can put it all together for you if you want. I wanted to let you know about my findings as soon as possible, but I can give you a summary.

It is my belief, at this point, that John Richard's father was a Richard Cross, son of Thomas Cross who married Chloe Lassiter in 1811. Thomas was the son of William and Rachel Cross and the brother of Richard, father of Silas and Adriana. I think he married his cousin Adriana in the early 1850s and fathered Anne Rebecca (1853), John Richard (1857), and Nicholas (1860). Richard is missing from the 1860 census and so is Nicholas, but the August 16, 1860 deed of gift clearly names Nicholas as Adriana's son. She must have been eight or nine months pregnant when the 1860 census was taken in June. What happened to the father of John Richard Cross is unclear. He may have died prematurely or possibly abandoned the family. I doubt that all three of Adriana's children were illegitimate, not in the 1850s.

I can also give you a good idea of where the land was located which had belonged to William Cross, was passed down, and on which Adriana and John Richard lived. I hope this data is helpful. I will continue when I can. Let me hear from you soon.

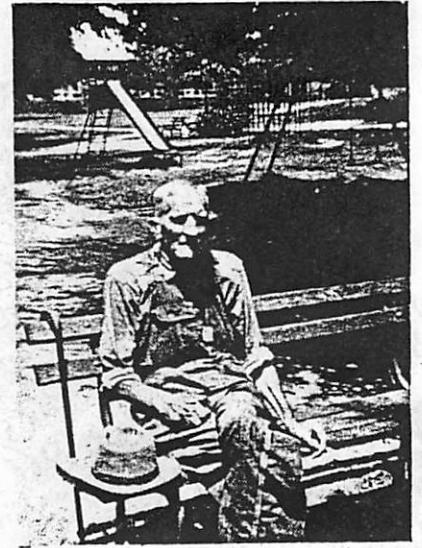

THE CROSS FAMILY

Parrish Cross is our first proven ancestor of the Cross family. According to family records, he was born in Suffolk, VA, and moved to North Carolina in the 1770s. He had one known brother, John Henry Cross, who married in Gates County, NC, listing himself as from Nansemond Co, VA. Several Cross families were found in Nansemond County, VA, but none have been proven as relatives. The book, The Cleggs of Old Chatham, lists the father of Parrish Cross as Richard Cross. No verification of this has been found, and the reference is too obscure to be accepted at present.

The Cross family apparently arose in Charles City County, Virginia. The will of John Cross, probated the first Wednesday of March, 1730/1, Westover Parish, in Charles City County, mentions his wife, Jane, and children, William, John, Richard, Charles, Elias, Parrish, Featherstone, Judith, Hannah, and Jane. This Parrish was a seagoing mariner and was at sea when the will was probated. It was reported to the court that Parrish Cross had been seen lately in Newport, RI. He is too old to be our Parrish and appears to have had no children. Thus, there is a one generation gap in the family history. Presumably one of Parrish Cross' nephews named a child for his seafaring Uncle. The family moved from Charles City County toward open land south into what is now Nansemond County and the city of Suffolk.

In 1743, a survey was made in Amelia County, VA, for an access road for William Cross. In 1759 John Cross married Elizabeth Cock in Amelia County. In 1779, Hardy Cross of Nansemond County, VA, gives a deed. Hardy Cross had land in both Nansemond County, VA, and in Gates County, NC. The brother of our Parrish Cross, John Henry, lived in Gates County, NC, and named one of his children Hardy. Both John Henry and Parrish used the name Henry as a middle name with their children. John Henry Cross listed his residence on his Gates Co, NC, marriage license as Nansemond Co, VA

Thus, it appears that we have the trail for the family but no concrete evidence as to who was the father of John Henry and Parrish Cross. The best supposition is that a son of John and Jane Cross named a child Parrish after their brother, the sailor. This would have been in Nansemond County, VA, where David, Hardy, Jonathan, Samuel, and William Cross lived. But, which one is the parent of Parrish and John Henry Cross?

Parrish is evidently the older brother as his children are older. I have no estimate of the age of John Henry Cross. His wife, Sarah (Lee) Cross, was born in 1782 in Virginia. Her will was probated in the February term of court, 1853, in Gates County, NC. So, we begin with Parrish:

Parrish Cross, born ca 1760, Suffolk, VA, moved to Chatham County, NC, as a very young man. He married ca 1792 Elizabeth Williams, b. 1776, daughter of Burwell and Mary (Pickney) Williams of Chatham County, NC. Parrish Cross was a successful farmer and his will shows his holdings as extensive. He lived in the southeast corner of Chatham County in the area of Buckhorn community. He

constructed and owned mills on Buckhorn Creek. His holdings give improbability to the myth that Parrish fled an unsatisfactory apprenticeship in Virginia. He would have inherited from his very wealthy father-in-law, Burwell Williams, only about 146 acres of land. Obviously he came with resources which he spent for his own additional property. Parrish Cross could evidently read and write as his estate included books and a bookcase.

His will was written 20 Jun 1837 and was proven in the month of October, 1837 in Chatham County. The text is as follows:

In the name of God, Amen. I Parrish Cross of the county of Chatham and the state of North Carolina being in a feeble state of body and health but in a perfect and disposing state of mind thanks be to God for the same, do make, ordain, and publish this my last will and testament in the following manner, to wit, I give my body to the earth from whence it came to be buried in decent Christian burial nothing doubting but that I shall receive "the same" again in the hands of Almighty God who gave it and as to my earthly goods and chattel I give and dispose of them in manner and form as hereinafter mentioned-

Item 1st. I lend to my beloved wife Elizabeth Cross one lott of land containing ninety acres which I purchased from William Utley, also one other lott which I purchased from William Buttrell, whereon the dwelling house I now live in stands, also one other lott of land which I purchased from William Boylan containing fifty three acres all of which I lend her during her natural life. I also lend my beloved wife Elizabeth one third of my mills on Buckhorn Creek during her natural life. I also lend my beloved wife Elizabeth Cross five negroe slaves, to wit, Hardin, Beby, Fanny, Milly, and Gray. I also lend her my carriage and two mules, and one sorrel mare, three cows and calves, ten head of sheep, ten head of hoggs, one yoke of oxen and cart, and also all such household and kitchen furniture as she may think proper to keep, except such as shall be hereinafter disposed of, also I leave my wife all such of the plantation tools as maybe thought necessary to use on the farm, also one years provisions and one hundred dollars which I give her.

Item 2nd. I give and bequeath to my beloved son Henry Cross that part of a tract of land I purchased from George Schult not divided to Deberry Chapman. Also twenty eight acres I purchased from Gabriel Utley it being a part of the Temperance Hinton lott. I also give my son Henry Cross all the land that is herein devised to my wife at her death also one negroe slave named Sandy, one cow and calf, one sow and pigs, one bed and furniture, and a rifle gun.

Item 3rd. I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Elizabeth Cross two negroe slaves named Mariah and Penny and their increase. I also give her one feather bed and furniture also one trunk and a dripping table. I also give my daughter Elizabeth one yellow filly and a saddle and bridle.

Item 4th. I give and bequeath to my beloved sons William and Richard Cross each one third of my mills on Buckhorn Creek during the lifetime of my wife and at her death I give them the mills jointly to them both. I also give to my two sons William Cross and Richard Cross one acre of land on Beaver Dam Creek it being an acre I got from Seth Cotten. I also give my two sons William and Richard all that tract belonging to the mill tract also the tract I purchased from Jesse S-- except what I have conveyed to Williams Cross by deed.

Item 5th. It is my will that the balance of my land be sold and the proceeds to be equally divided between my daughters and it is my will that all my estate not bequeathed by this will shall be sold by my executors and the proceeds thereof be equally divided between my eight children.

Item 6th. It is also my will that at the death of my wife all the estate that shall remain with her to her death shall be sold and equally divided share and share alike between my eight children and it is my will that my children shall not be accountable to each other for any property that I have heretofore given or conveyed to them sense they have left me.

Item 7th. It is also my will that if my negroes that are left to be sold should be purchased by the legatees that my executors in that case not charge commission on the amount of sales of the negroes.

And I hereby revoke and annul other former wills by me made and I hereby nominate and appoint my two sons Williams Cross and Richard Cross my executors to this my last will and testament. In witness whereof I have herunto set my hand and seal this 20th day of June AD 1837.

There were other documents filed with the Last Will and Testament of Parrish Cross. Elizabeth wanted her provisions and other materials provided her for support as expressed in the will. The following illustrates this process:

North Carolina Court of Pleas and Quarters
Chatham County Session Nov Term 1837

The petition of Elizabeth Cross humbly shows: That her husband Parrish Cross late of said county departed this life in the month of last having first duly made & published a last will and testament in writing - that said will was at the ---bar of this court duly admitted & probated & William Cross and Richard Cross the executors therein named qualified as such - your petitioner shows that by the express terms & provisions of said will she is allowed by her said husband out of his personal estate a sufficiency for the support of herself & family for one year-

Now to the end that the same may be allowed to her, your pet'n'r prays to your worships to appoint a Justice of the Court & three freeholders whose duty be to make the aforementioned contemplated & return their proceedings to the next term of this court.

This was done and the following was returned to the court in December, 1837.

In obedience to an order to us from the Court of Pleas and Quarters Sessions at the County of Chatham to allot and lay out one years support to the widow and family of Parrish Cross, deceased, have met on the premises and allowed the following quantities, viz--55 barrels of corn, 1500 lbs of pork, 20 bushels of wheat, 8 blade stacks, 2 oat stacks, 1 hay stack, 1 pen of shucks, 74 lbs of brown sugar, 30 lbs of coffee, 50 lbs of iron, 3 bushels salt, 5 gallons of molasses, 3 bushels of peas, 50 lbs of clean cotton.

Williams and Richard Cross, executors of the Last Will and Testament of their father Parrish Cross, made an inventory of the property loaned to their mother, Elizabeth. The rules of inheritance were such that the wife inherited nothing but was loaned or given a lifetime estate in the property. On her death, one of the children inherited. The inventory named:

5 negroes, namely Farthing, Edy, Fanny, Milly, & Gray, 2 mules, 1 mare, 3 cows & calves, 10 head of hogs, 10 head of sheep, 1 yoke of steers, 1 cart, 1 pleasure carriage, framing tools, 5 beds & furniture, 2 tables, 1 sideboard, 1 clock, 2 chest, 15 chairs, 3 pots, 2 ovens, 1 bakery, 1 loom, 2 pr fire dogs, 2 looking glasses, 2 smoothing irons, 1 grindstone, knives & forks, 1 dozen silver spoons, 1 set of chiney, 1 desk, 1 bookcase, 1 cutting machine, 1 Dutch fan, 1 pr scales & weights & some books.

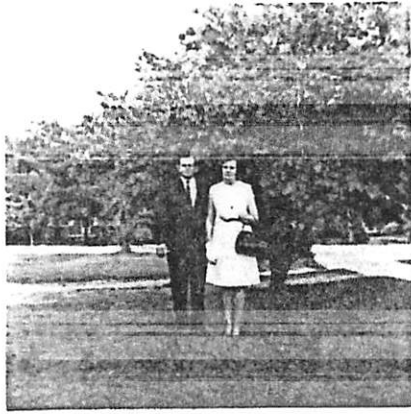

This not only establishes Silas and Ariadne as grandchildren of William and

death. Later evidence, which will be listed, indicates that son Thomas died before
his mother, thus leaving the property to be divided among her grandchildren.

This deed clearly shows that the property on Fall Creek, on which Ariadne and
her children lived, had been the property of William and Rachel Cross and had
passed to the children of Richard Cross, son of William, after Rachel's death
sometime before 1856. By 1860, Ariadne had consolidated all the property.

I believe that the clerk confused the heirs and placed Richard's name when it

The logical interpretation of this material, combined with what you have accumulated
from local tradition, is that the land on Fall Creek belonged to William Cross who left his
wife, Rachel, a life estate in the property. It was to go to his son, Thomas [not to be
confused with Thomas L., son of Richard and brother of Silas], but this Thomas died
before his mother. At least some of the Fall Creek land then went to Ariadne, Silas, and
Thomas L., children of Richard and grandchildren of William and Rachel. Ariadne
acquired all the land and had a home there. She seems to have married a Richard Cross,
son of Thomas and a cousin, who died in late 1859 or early 1860. In the latter year,
Ariadne gave the property to her three children: Anne Rebecca (Becky), John Richard,
and Nicholas. John Richard later married Louvenia Cross, his first cousin, and
apparently made his home on the property about where the Cross Cemetery is now.

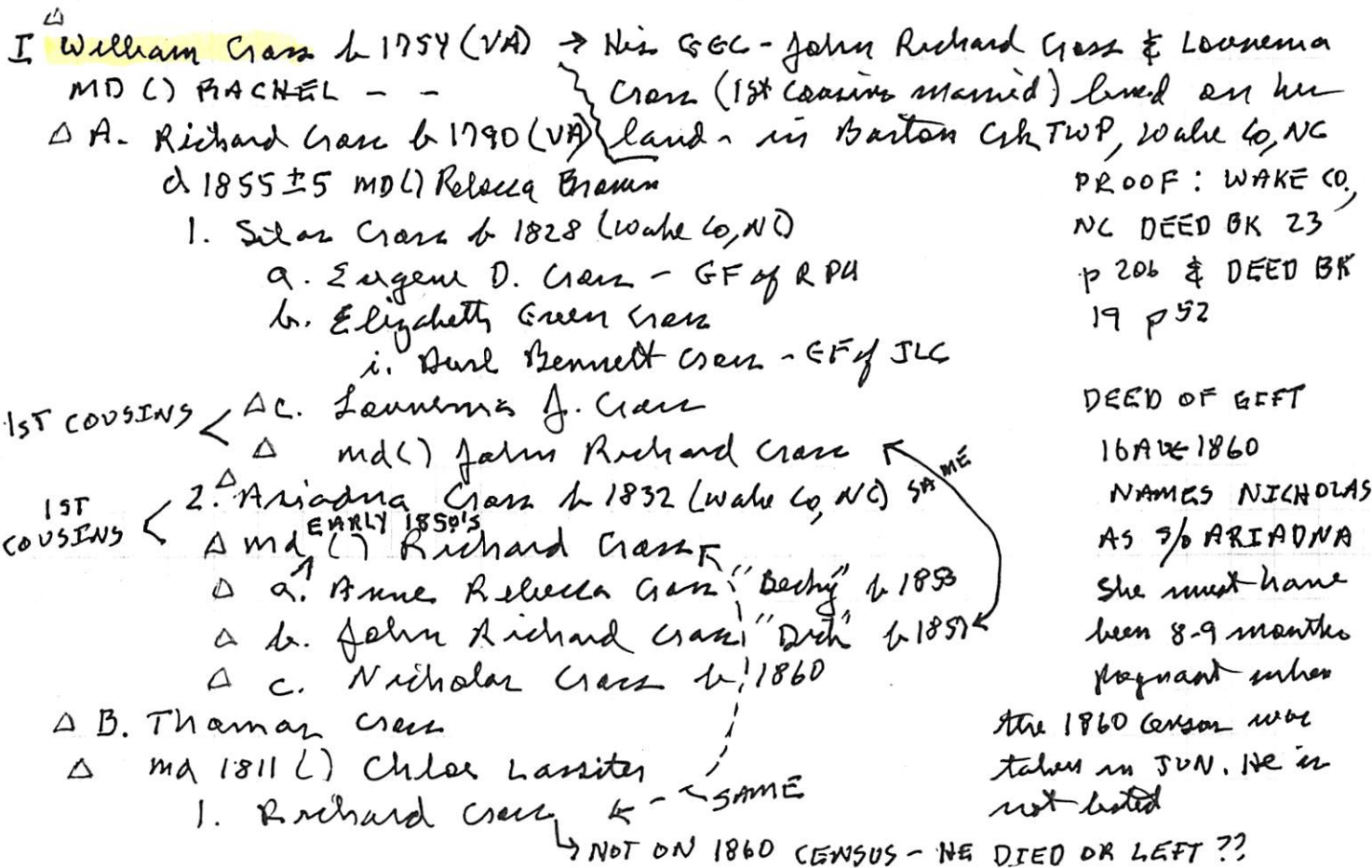

After some delay, I finally returned to the search for the elusive John Richard Cross. Guess what? I found his mother! She was Ariadna (aka Ariandna, Andriana, Arey, and Adda) Cross, daughter of Richard Cross and Rebecca Brown. That means she was also Silas Cross's sister. Proof without doubt can be found in Wake County Deed Book 23, p. 206 and Deed Book 19, p. 52. John Richard had an older sister, Anne Rebecca (Becky) and a younger brother Nicholas. Of course, this means that Silas Cross was John Richard's uncle and that John Richard and his wife Louvenia were first cousins.

So far I have been unable to positively identify John Richard's father, but there is enough circumstantial evidence to put together a good theory. The details are too extensive for this e-mail, but I can put it all together for you if you want. I wanted to let you know about my findings as soon as possible, but I can give you a summary.

It is my belief, at this point, that John Richard's father was a Richard Cross, son of Thomas Cross who married Chloe Lassiter in 1811. Thomas was the son of William and Rachel Cross and the brother of Richard, father of Silas and Adriana. I think he married his cousin Adriana in the early 1850s and fathered Anne Rebecca (1853), John Richard (1857), and Nicholas (1860). Richard is missing from the 1860 census and so is Nicholas, but the August 16, 1860 deed of gift clearly names Nicholas as Adriana's son. She must have been eight or nine months pregnant when the 1860 census was taken in June. What happened to the father of John Richard Cross is unclear. He may have died prematurely or possibly abandoned the family. I doubt that all three of Adriana's children were illegitimate, not in the 1850s.

I can also give you a good idea of where the land was located which had belonged to William Cross, was passed down, and on which Adriana and John Richard lived. I hope this data is helpful. I will continue when I can. Let me hear from you soon.

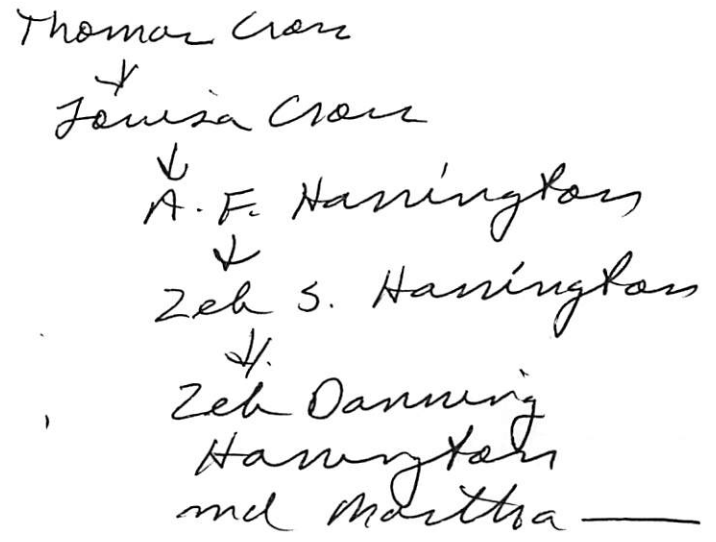
