① The following notes from 28 pg 20 indicate that Sarah U was the dau of John U (XID-150), gd of Richard U (XID-149) & ggd of Michael U XID-146, the original immigrant. ♀

"John (XID-150), the son of Richard U, probably was the John living in New Kent County, VA during the early seventeenth century. New Kent lies just north of Surry County, across the James River. The following entries in the Register of St. Peter's Parish Church, in that county, are strong indications of that such was ~~the case~~ a fact:

Sarah, dau of Jno. Upshew, bapt ye 15 OCT 1707.
