Nathan U, I is unlikely as an ancestor as he had only one son who had unnamed daughters and family history (oral) indicates there was only one male child.

MOSES U had 3-sons who had unnamed dau of the right age to have been the father of Claudia U.

I had some correspondence in 1957 with the D.A.R. and with Etta Belle Lewter West in Detroit, Mich., concerning the Upchurch line. Several women had joined the D.A.R. on the Moses Upchurch record/line. His wife was Mary Simms. According to the D.A.R. records, Moses Upchurch had a son, Whitney Upchurch (his wife was Elizabeth Goodwin), born in 1793. The Wake County census for 1830 shows Whitney Upchurch and in his household there is one male between 30 and 40 years old; thus it is possible this is the Whitney who was born in 1793.
