PERCY BRYANT UPCHURCH, former pastor of The Memorial church in Greenville for 16 years, died recently after suffering a heart attack. He was 80. *w.c.*

The Apex native was a graduate of Wake Forest University, Brown University and Yale Divinity School. In addition to his Greenville pastorate, Upchurch also served with the congregations of First church, Monroe, and First church, Mullins, S. C. He retired from the full-time pastorate in 1970.

During his ministry, Upchurch served as chairman of the Wingate College trustees, a trustee of Wake Forest University and a member of the state convention General Board.

He is survived by his wife, Mildred Stewart Upchurch; a son, Joseph Upchurch of Birmingham, Ala.; a daughter, Sarah Browning of Richardson, Tex.; and four grandchildren.

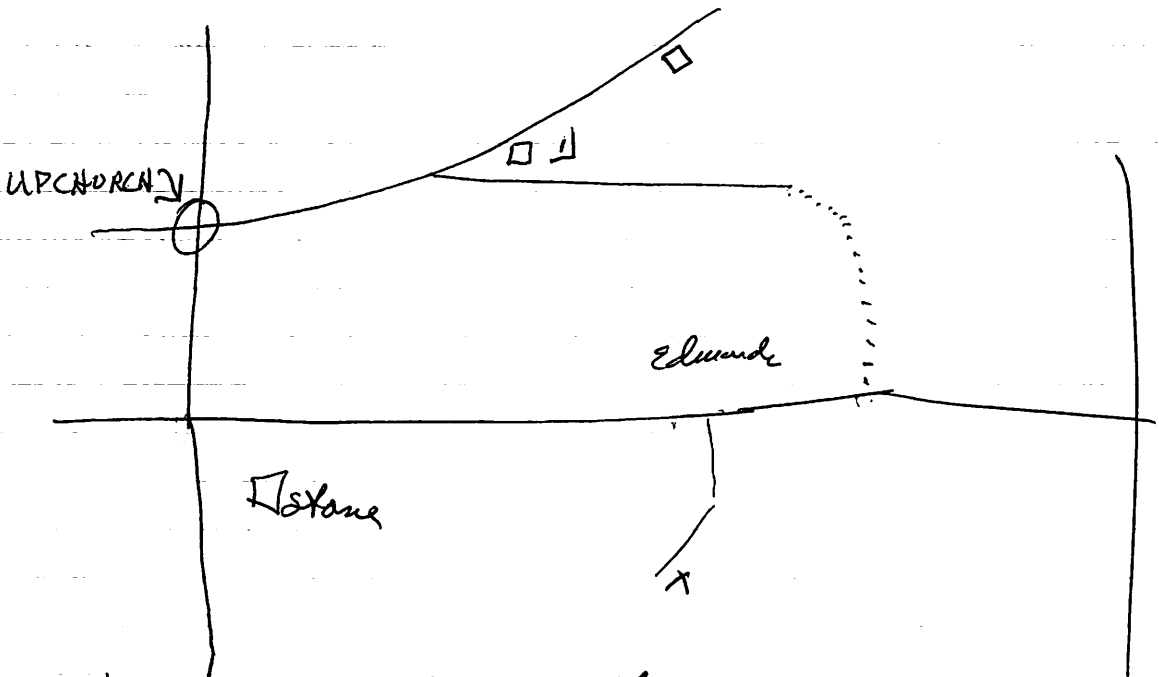

Mrs. Mildred Stewart Upchurch, 95, wife of the late Rev. Percy B. Upchurch, died Monday, June 3, 2002, at her home.

The funeral service will be conducted Wednesday at 11 a.m. at The Memorial Baptist Church. Entombment will follow in the Mausoleum at Pine-wood Memorial Park.

Mrs. Upchurch, a native of Henderson, N.C., was the daughter of the late Hamilton and Eunice Wortham Stewart. She attended Trinity College and graduated from Longwood College in Farmville, Va. She taught school for several years before her marriage to Rev. Upchurch.

She was a member of The Memorial Baptist Church. She was also a member of the Chatham Book Club and was a former member of the American Legion Auxiliary, as well as several women's clubs and garden clubs.

Mrs. Upchurch loved people and was active in many areas of the church. She capably assisted her husband in his ministry at First Baptist Church in Nashville, N.C., Monroe, N.C., Mullins, S.C., and The Memorial Baptist Church, Greenville, N.C., from which he retired in 1970.

After retirement, they moved to Williamston, N.C. They enjoyed meeting and making many new friends as Rev. Upchurch served as interim minister to many churches of northeastern North Carolina, including Edenton, Elizabeth City, Piney Grove, Reddicks Grove, Windsor and Washington.

In addition to her husband and parents, she was preceded in death by her sister, Jane Stewart Bergeron; her brothers, Albert, Macy and Percy Stewart; and a nephew, John H. Bergeron.

She is survived by a daughter, Sarah Upchurch Browning of the home; son, Joseph B. Thank you very much for your letter of July 26 and for all the details. They have been extracted for the Master Outline and for the various profiles.

I have many correspondents from the extended Upchurch family but very few from the Nathan U I clan to which you and I belong. I therefore value very highly your participation in the quest for more details on our family. In recognition of your willingness to be of help I am sending herewith a copy of that part of the Master Outline that pertains to William Buster U I and his descendants. Note that descendants beyond the 9th generation are accommodated on continuation sheets referenced on the left (41A, 42A, 1A etc). I hope that you will have a general interest in this outline or it pertains to your close relatives and that

from it you will learn what is yet to be collected. These few sheets represent many hundreds of hours on the part of myself and collaborators such as yourself. I am proud of what we have collected so far.

As a reminder I collect the following:

I have put red marks on the first two sheets to highlight what is missing. Perhaps you will find some cross in what is already recorded.

In your interaction with other family members you may have an opportunity to refer to the Upchurchs Bulletin some flyers are enclosed which may be useful in this regard. If you are interested I would be happy for you to have a full set of the bulletins which I will loan, give or sell to you. Finance is of some consequence but of much greater importance is my desire to spread the word about Upchurches and to have the participation of key people such as yourself.

We have a fine sketch for the descendants of our GGGF Nathan & I but, of course, many details remain to be added.
