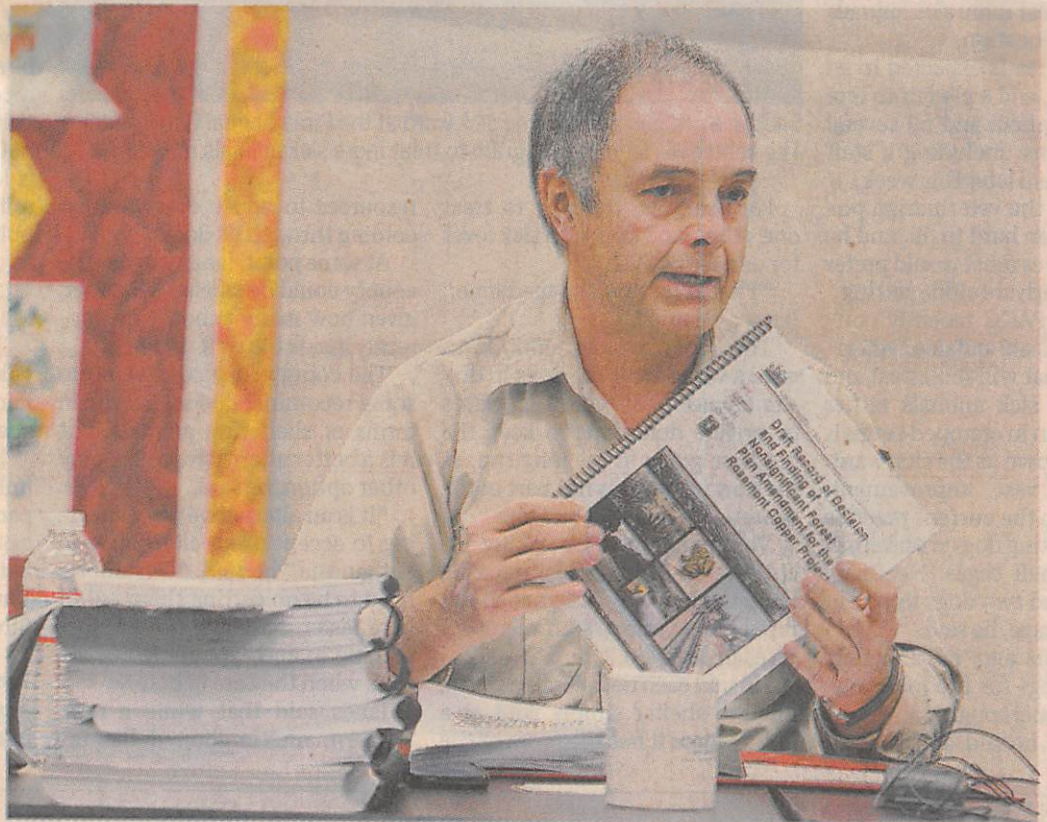

White House panel now acting as mine 'referee'

Agencies' differences over Rosemont are focus of discussions

A White House advisory body is now informally involved in the contentious Rosemont Copper Mine dispute.

The White House's Council on Environmental Quality is, in a sense, acting as a referee among various federal agencies that have taken different positions on the mine, Coronado National Forest Supervisor **Jim Upchurch** said.

A council spokeswoman confirmed later that the "CEQ

has brought agencies together to coordinate with one another on their environmental reviews on this issue."

If agencies can't agree on the mine issue, it's possible one could refer the dispute to the council for more detailed action. Upchurch declined to speculate on that possibility.

Upchurch's comments Monday came at a news conference to discuss his draft decision that would, if ratified, approve the "barrel alternative" — the proposal will leave untouched neighboring McCleary Canyon, which the service said is more ecologically valuable — as the layout for the proposed \$1.2 billion mine in the Santa Rita Mountains southeast of Tuc-

son. That decision was released Friday.

He said the discussions involving the council deal with mitigation of water quality and water quantity concerns, and could include air quality matters.

"As part of its facilitating role, the Council on Environmental Quality frequently brings agencies together to provide a forum for them coordinate on their environmental reviews and discuss any outstanding issues," council spokeswoman Taryn

Tuss in Washington, D.C., said Tuesday in an email.

"However, agencies are responsible for their own implementation of the National Environmental Policy Act, and CEQ does not tell agencies how to conduct (such) reviews," added Tuss, the council's associate communications director.

Upchurch's statement comes amid a lengthy debate among federal agencies about the mine's potential impact on a creek in Davidson Canyon and Cienega Creek. They're both legally protected by the state as "outstanding waters."

The Environmental Protection Agency and the Bureau of Land Management have expressed big

concerns that groundwater pumped out of the mine site for creation of the Rosemont open pit could reduce flows or even dry up sections of the two creeks and their tributaries. Of particular concern has been the creeks, including Cienega, in BLM's Las Cienegas National Conservation Area that lies across Arizona 83 from the mine site.

The Forest Service, using predictions from three computer models, had been much less pessimistic about such impacts. But in its Nov. 29 final Rosemont environmental impact statement, the service gave other agencies' concerns more credence than before, and acknowledged large uncertainties about impacts.

For Upper Cienega Creek in Las Cienegas, for in-

stance, the final environmental report wrote that the least possible groundwater decline under the creek over 150 years is .15 feet if water loss from tributary Empire Gulch is taken into account. The most is .53 feet.

The .15 feet decline translates into an increase of annual days of dry or extreme low-flow conditions from four days today to 88 days in 150 years. The .53 feet decline translates into up to 352 days annually of dry or extreme low-flows in the creek, the environmental report said.

Upchurch said that overall, "We've made great progress in figuring out the effects." That's even since Nov. 7, when EPA wrote a pointed letter to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers urging the Corps to reject

a separate permit for the mine based partly on its effects on Davidson and Cienega, Upchurch said.

"We've been working directly with EPA on that, and the outstanding issues are now more towards mitigation that needs to be done," Upchurch said. "I've told you there's going to be an effect. That's really not up for debate."

Twice in two days the EPA declined to comment on the Rosemont issue.

A top BLM official at the news conference, however, agreed that his agency and the Forest Service have made "a lot of progress" toward meeting the bureau's concerns, expressed in formal comments on an earlier version of the environmental impact statement and in an Oct. 29 letter to the service.

The bureau had originally threatened to write a dissenting view to accompany the final environmental impact statement. But it later acknowledged that the Forest Service review process doesn't allow that.

"I think right now we are in a pretty good position with the Forest Service," said **Tim Shannon**, manager of BLM's Gila District office in Tucson. "The resource specialists at BLM are pretty happy with the how the mitigation and monitoring discussions are going. They have addressed quite a few of our earlier concerns."

Three James Upchurches in Brunswick County, Virginia

How very confusing to have three James Upchurches living in the same vicinity all at the same time. For the sake of clarity, Belle Lewter West came up with a designation for each of them James I was the son of Richard Upchurch, and grandson of Michael Upchurch I. Next was James II, thought to be the son of James I. James III was the son of John I and a cousin to James II. ^{R06134gg}

When digging through all the Brunswick County records, it's difficult to distinguish just which document goes to which James Upchurch. West did a great job of making the determination and pointing the rest of us in the right direction. Below are abstracts of Brunswick County land transactions. They are being offered merely to provide fodder for future researchers, and because of the name similarity.

Note that the name *Moseley* appears in some of these abstracts. We do know that two daughters of James Upchurch, III, were married to Moseleys.

△ Item 1 – Possibly James Upchurch I

Indenture made the 28th day of November, 1758, between Jacob Woolsey and John Woolsey, his son, for good will that he beareth to his son, conveying 400 acres adjoining lands of Elias Morgan, Benj. Britt, William Johnson, and **James Upchurch**. Witnesses were John Morris, William Neal, and Thos. Walton (his mark). Indenture acknowledged in Court on January 23, 1759, by Jacob Woolsey. ^{R06140c}

△ Item 2 – Possibly James Upchurch III

Indenture made the 21st day of March, 1759, between Richard Smith of Granville County, North Carolina, and Peter Hines, for 50 pounds, conveying 400 acres, adjoining lands of **James Upchurch**, Rattlesnake Creek, and Richard Ledbetter, and being the tract of land granted to Richard Smith by Letters of Patent bearing date of June 26, 1755. Witnesses were William Neale, Jacob Adams (his mark), and Elias Morgan. Indenture proved in Court on April 24, 1759, by the oaths of the witnesses. Document on page 110. ^{R06140d}

Item 3 – Possibly James Upchurch I

An indenture, February 20, 1762, between Abraham Jones of Halifax County, Province of North Carolina, and Benjamin Mosely conveyed 335 acres, for 12£, adjoining lands of Benjamin Mosely, and **James Upchurch**, and Middle Run. Witnesses were Isaac Mosely, Thomas Mosely, and **James Upchurch**. Indenture and Memorandum of Livery of Seizin were proved in Court on February 22, 1762. ^{R06140a}

Item 4 – Possibly James Upchurch I

An indenture made February 20, 1762, between Abraham Jones of Halifax County, Province of North Carolina, and Thomas Mosely, for 8£, conveyed 186 acres adjoining Middle Run and Lizard Creek. Witnesses were Benjamin Mosely, Isaac Mosely, and **James Upchurch** (his mark). Indenture and Memorandum of Livery of Seizin were proved in Court on February 22, 1762. ^{R06140b}

Item 5

In an indenture made February 20, 1762, between Abraham Jones of Halifax County, Province of North Carolina, and **James Upchurch**, 200 acres were conveyed, for 10£, adjoining lands of Benjamin Mosely, Thomas Bracey, and Richard Burnet. Witnesses were Benja. Mosely, Thomas Mosely, and Isaac Mosely. Indenture and Memorandum of Livery of Seizin were proved in Court on February 22, 1762. ^{R06140c}

A chancery court Loose Court record states the following:

Gillum Upchurch died intestate, in Jackson County, Tennessee. A lawsuit, H.R., Upchurch vs. Byrd Anderson et al. It involved land he owned in District #11, Buffalo Hollow, Flynn's Lick in Jackson Co. Gillum's first wife Sarah Anderson, daughter of Caleb Anderson, inherited the land.

A deposition of Gillum Upchurch made before his death stated "I am the reputed father of two children each by different women" He stated his brother was Thomas Upchurch, father of T.B. Upchurch; stated his wife Sarah died when their 3rd child was born and it lived 15 days; that their son H. Ross Upchurch was age 2 and Carter Upchurch was age 4 when their mother died.

A deposition by Asia Jackson states 'H.R. Upchurch and John M. Upchurch are my uncles and Gillum Upchurch my grandfather. Thomas Upchurch was my father...my grandmother Eliza Upchurch died about five years before Gillum. Another deposition by unreadable Upchurch stated John M. Upchurch was his brother, and James Jones was a son of my mother.

RPH Analysis of #7, #8 & #9 as of 6 SEP 2000. Rachel J. U age 30 is in the home of her father Silas U age 64. There is no evidence of a husband for her. She is thought to have had one or more illegitimate children although some propose a James U was the father of one or more of her children. I can find no real basis for this. Our total array of information shows she had 6 children born 1865-1883 - all with the last name of Upchurch - and no evidence of a husband. The youngest of these was James Washington U b. 8 OCT 1865 (must be #8 above). Among the 6 children of Rachel there is no General W. U. I suggest he was General Washington U, that he is the same as #9 above and that he died young. Note that James Washington U ^{named a son} General Francis U, possibly after his presumed brother General W. U. - RPH

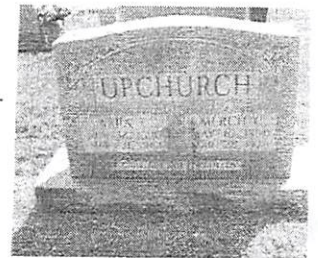

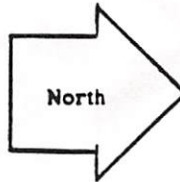

This letter includes a history of the family of Samuel U written by his ggc Robert Franklin U. In it there is a statement that Samuel U had 12 children but only 11 are listed. The one left out is James U (Note: The puzzle about this youngest son of Samuel U remains. Robert Franklin U was no doubt writing in his latter years and was using recall and some written reference. He knew enough to claim 12 children but not enough to name the 12th one - RPU)

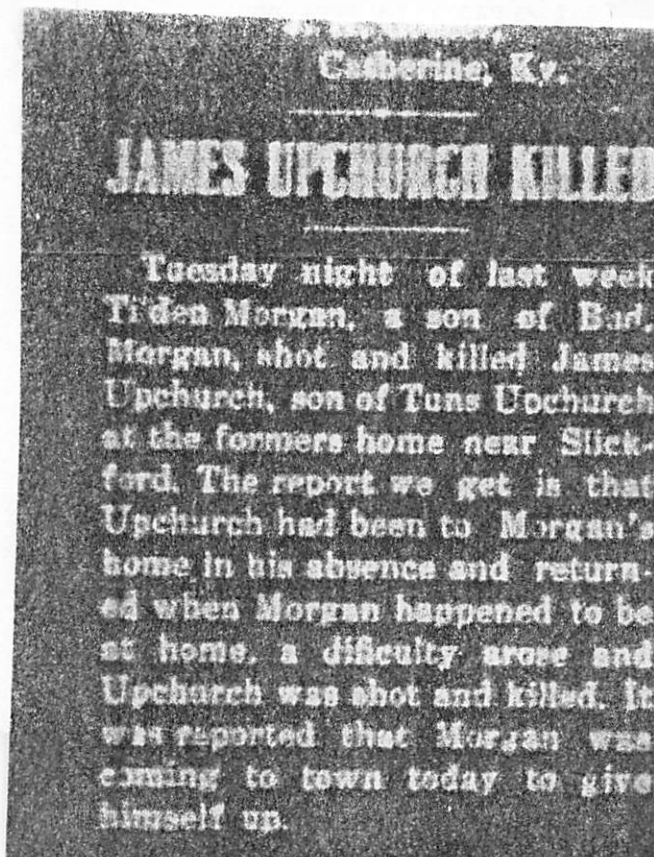
