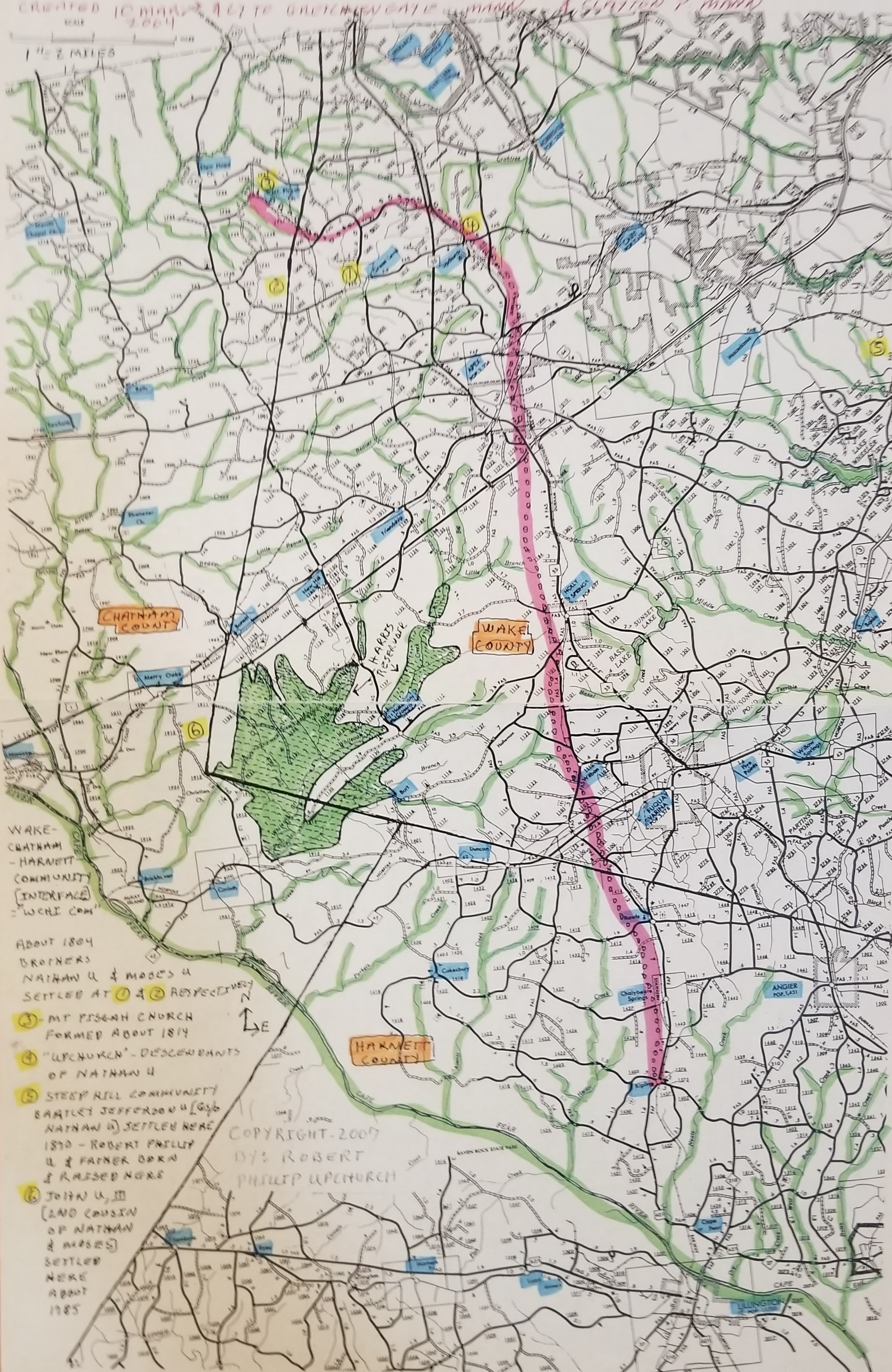

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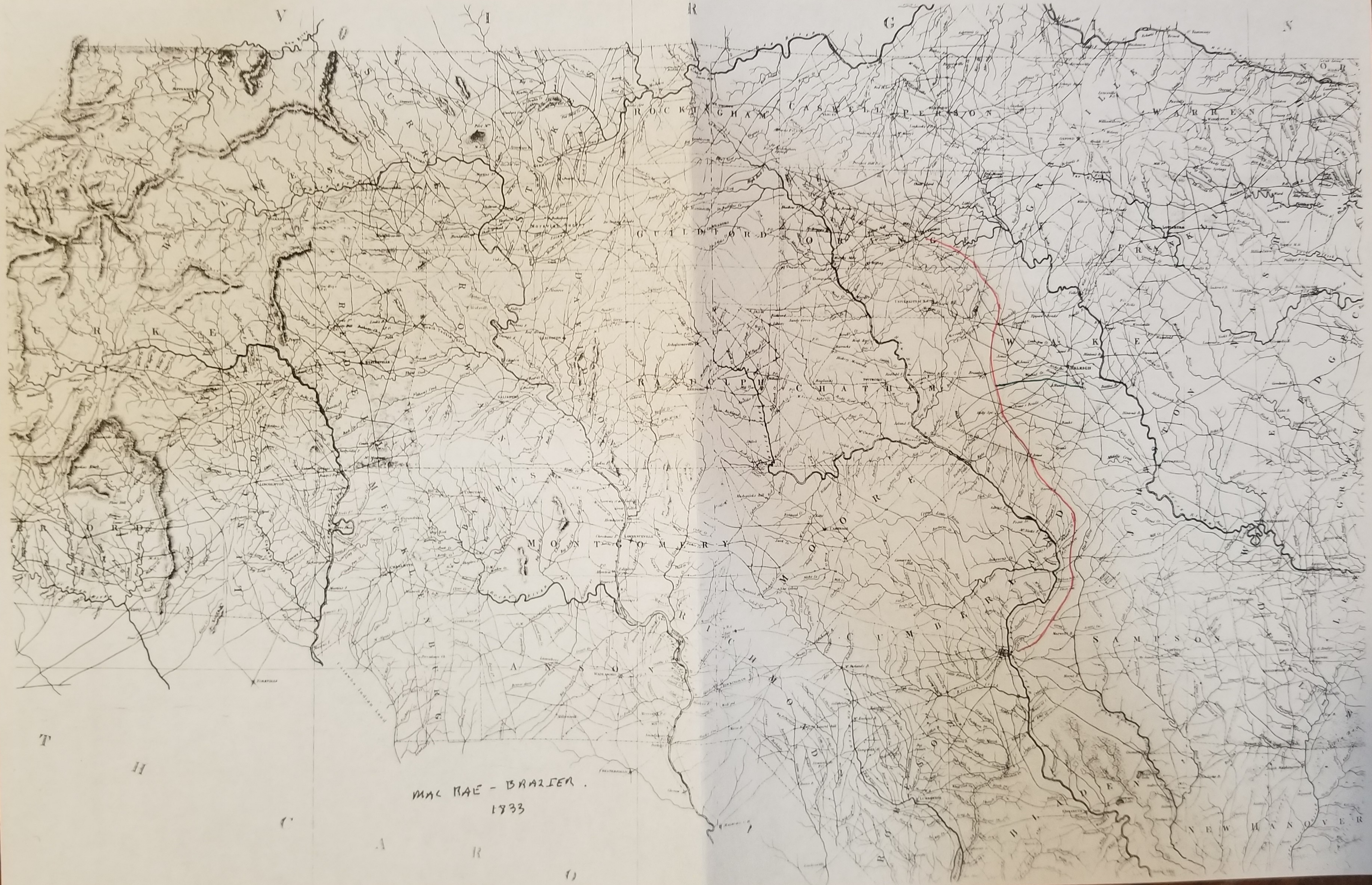

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## THE WESTERN WAKE TRACE

- 1) Concept - RPK came up with the idea that in ancient times Indians would have created a path in western Wake County, NC along the headwaters of streams this being the path of least resistance for travel to avoid crossing swollen streams. Europeans would have noted, used and expanded these trails. Today Highway 59 follows the path/trail/trace. My first version had the path go from Mt Pisgah in Durham County to Kaysler in Harnett Co, NC. An extended version was from Hillsboro, NC to Fayetteville, NC.
- 2) Maps 11" x 17" representing the two versions were created by RPK on 10 MAR 2004. Copies of the shorter version were sent to Clayton P. Mann & Gretchen P. Mann.
- 3) Re Rhamkatta - I propose that the 1771 Movement from New Bern to Hillsboro and back in the "war" of Regulations took him through that part of Stuart Wake FWP called Rhamkatta. see Wake - Capital County of NC Vol I Pg 53 for details. I have added a purple line on the longer ~~shorter~~ version to represent the passage of General Tryon through the area.
- 4) The two versions were posted and mentioned in my Talk at Apex, NC on 12 MAY 2009. Tyre Larrier requested more details which I sent to him.



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
