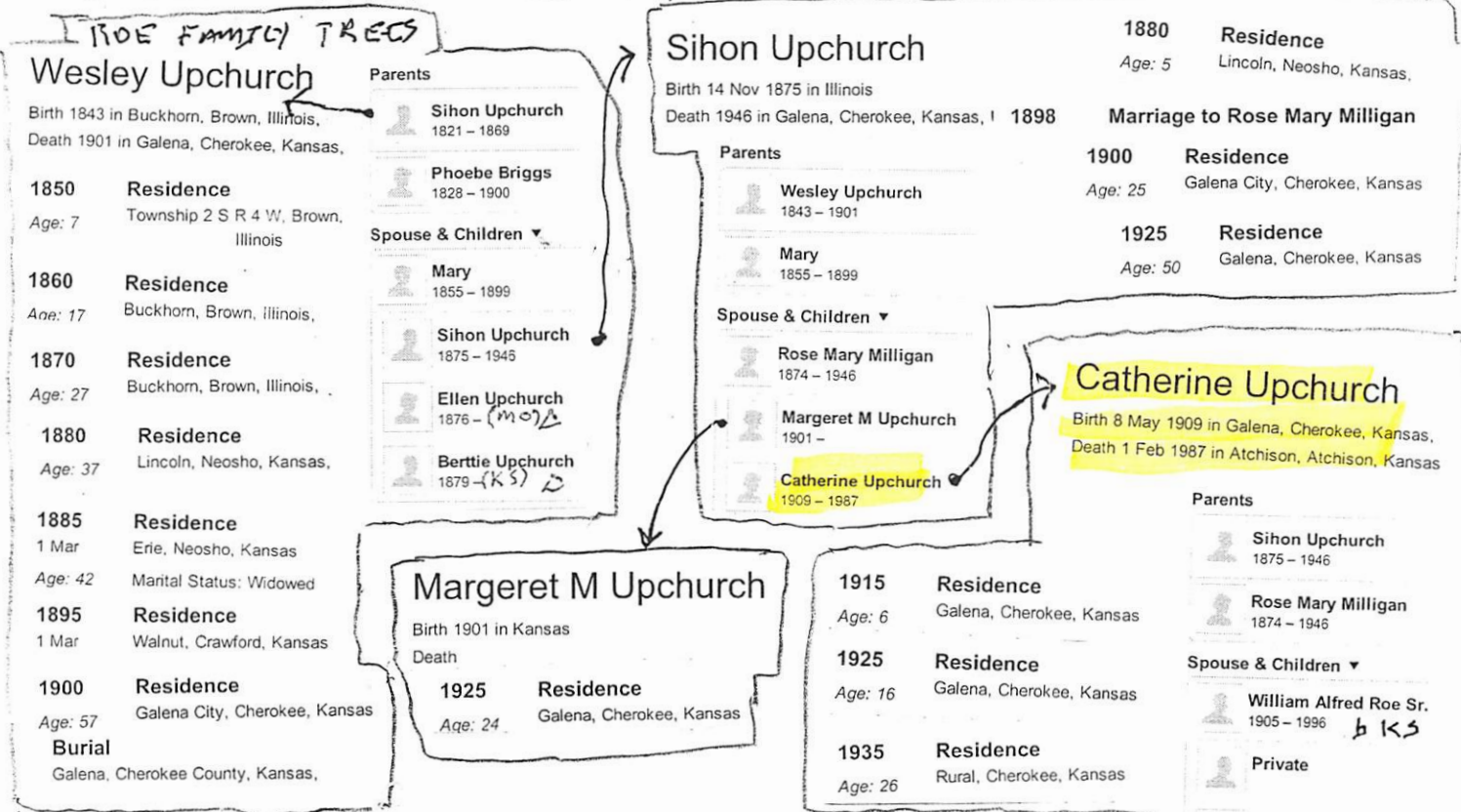

I also asked her about the Celia Darnall (b. 12 June 1784; d. 27 Apr. 1852) buried in the Upchurch Cemetery in Henry Co., TN

About Celia, she said that she was the wife of Nicholas Darnall, Sr. (father of Thomas L. Darnell <6241>) and had been named as said wife in Nicholas' Will in Henry Co., Tn.

"Celia Darnell will. To Mary Jane Aycock (formerly Mary Jane Upchurch) to have negro girl. To Celia Elizabeth Wynns (formerly C. E. Upchurch) to have negro. To Bayliss House Upchurch have negro. To John F. (not 21 years of age) and George W. Upchurch to have negroes. To Eli Upchurch a negro girl. To Jennetta Darnell for life certain property. Appoints Thomas J. Wynns and Jordan T. Aycock executors. 10 May 1848 (Wills 1844-56, p. 433)" HENRY CO, TN

This seems to indicate that Celia Darnell was closer to the Upchurches than just mother-in-law of Jeanette Darnell. In fact, it seems to say that she was closer to the Upchurch side of the family than to the children of her husband whom are not even mentioned in her Will.

All of the Upchurches listed in her will are (purportedly) children of Joshua U. and Jeanette -- although I sure wish I could find proof of that in the case of Celia Elizabeth U. who married Thomas Jefferson Wynns (which is one of my lines). John U.'s Will (dated 1853, prob. 1854) names four sons of his deceased son Joshua, as John, Bayless, George and Eli, which is the same 4 males as in Celia Darnell's Will (who died in 1852). John's Will further says "and the five remaining heirs of my son Joshua Upchurch dec'd." Does this mean that there were only 5 still alive or that there were 5 more besides the ones that he'd named?

In 1850, Jeanette Upchurch Darnell, John F., Bayliss, G. W. and Eli Upchurch were in household of Thomas L. Darnell as was Celia Darnell <Household #115-Dist. #16>. Celia Upchurch Wynns was in household of Thomas Jefferson Wynns (with a 6 mo. girl named Jennette) <Household #116-Dist. #16>. Mary Jane was in household of Jordan T. Aycock <Household #58-Dist. #1>

In 1860, I find in D#1856, Jennetta Darnell and George Upchurch; D#1969, John F. Upchurch and his family; D#1950, Bayliss Upchurch and his family; D#1833, Celia E. Wynns in household of Thomas J. Wynns - don't find Eli Upchurch or Mary Jane and Jordan Aycock.

I guess Mary Jane could have died after the writing of Celia's will and before John's will, making Celia, John, Bayliss, Eli and George the five remaining children of Joshua. I guess the first thing I need to do is see if I can get a copy of a Will for Joshua. Then be on the lookout for a marriage between Nicholas Darnell and a Celia which may give me a clue as to who Jennette is.

Avlyn Conley indicated that the Darnell family had been in Marshall Co., Ky. earlier.

Hi Cathy---

I am delighted you found my website. Please let me know if you had any trouble getting the password and using it to reach and search the Upchurch Bulletins . This is very important as the UB contains a lot of what I know about your line. Please do some searching for the names Hubbard, etc and let me know what you find. I also hope you were able to view some of the videos. We will soon have one of Nathan Upchurch to view

I do have your family in my records and basically you have it correct. I have great interest in this group as Patrick Upchurch was a 2nd cousin of my father. The only problem with what you report is that it is my belief that the Green Berry to whom you refer did not serve in the Civil War, or at least he is not the Green Berry U who is buried in Oakwood Cemetery in Raleigh, NC and who did in fact serve. The situation is that there were two individuals named Green Berry Upchurch both born in and died in NC and both of whom were in Wake County at one time or another. This has been hugely confusing and I have visited the records often. You can let me know how much we should get into this confusion. I would very much like to work with you to expand our records on the Nathan U., I/Hubbard U. Subclan. Many years ago I walked the land once owned by Hubbard U. looking for a grave that was supposed to be there but had no luck. This is just one tidbit and I hope we can share many more. Please let me have your questions and let me know about your willingness to share/collaborate. There is a huge amount we could do but it is probably best to start sharing small amounts of information at each exchange so that we do not get overwhelmed.

Hello again Phil,

I was so thrilled to hear from you. Yes, I did enjoy viewing some of the videos and the website. I had no trouble with the password and had searched some of the Bulletins. I would be glad to share any information that I have.

I had noticed some discrepancies on Green Berry and just saved everything I found with that name thinking I would just sort it out as I could. Who would have thought that there could be two people named Green Berry Upchurch? I suppose that was not such a strange name in the 1800's. I am quite crushed to learn that the soldier may not have been my husband's ancestor... A review of his military records showed he was present (and captured) during the fall of Richmond. I thought how amazing to have been present in the city during the evacuation, looting and burning during which time he must have been captured and then to be present when Abraham Lincoln was there to tour the city - just amazing really. I noticed that one of your UB's did indicate that the soldier was the son of Hubbard but maybe that was printed before you found additional information? I would love to know how you were able to separate the two. Did our G.B. just stay home and do nothing during the war? Do I have my lines correct? I would really love more information on Patrick...he seemed even more confusing to me than Green Berry. You wonder when you find multiple records whether it is two separate people or do they just get around a lot. I am definitely a bit of a novice at this. I started trying to help my mother research a brick wall she had on my father's side a few years ago. I have always loved history so it is really fun for me to try to link these ancestors to what was occurring in their lives from a historical perspective and try to put them into context within the time that they lived. I would love to help you any way that I can. It's fun to dig around in the past.

Hi Cathy---

It looks like we are set to collaborate. Let me make a small start and we can elaborate over time.

I collect full names (full maiden names of females) dates of birth/marriage/death and places of birth/marriage/death/burial and names and places of cemeteries. For places I like to include town/county/state. Sometimes it is hard to get all of this but a good family history has as much as possible. I am always happy to share what I have. Of course family stories enrich the record.

Let's start with the structure of the family of Lattice Delova U. Here are some questions:

1. Where was he buried?
2. Where was Ila Mae buried? and was she born on Feb. 9, 1910 or Feb.9, 1911?
3. I show they had 6 children including one who died on Nov 28, 1939 (Johnston Co., NC) (and on whom I have nothing more). Is this correct?
4. What was the full maiden name of Joyce U. and how many children did she have?
5. Do I have it correct that Peggy U. is Margaret Louise U. ? and how many children did she have?
6. What was the full maiden name of Stella U. and how many children she have?
7. What was the full name of Millard R. U. and did he have children? How many?
8. Do you have more on the child that died on Nov.28, 1939?
9. I show W. D. U., Sr had three children and two step children. Is this all?
10. What is the full maiden name of Gladys U.? Did she have just two children?
11. Do you know how Lattice U. came to have the middle name "Delova" ? This is an unusual name and there must be a story behind it. Also, was it intentional that the name was carried forward in the family with a different spelling. I find that exploring the sources of given names in a family is a very interesting and informative part of family history that is often lost over time if we do not learn and record it.

Later we can back up to Patrick U. and see what we can uncover-share. Also if you are up to it I would like to share with you my Biofiles on Green Berry U. and to have you study, critique, and add to them. I actually have four Upchurches by that exact name.

So you have my thoughts on how to proceed. If you have other or additional ideas please let me know. If you have something in electronic form you would like to send that would be fine.

I am hoping you have not given up on me. I have been doing some research and will report what I have thus far. I will start by answering what I can of your questions.

I am told and records indicate that he and his wife (Ila Mae Wheeler) are buried in Randolph Memorial Park, Randolph County, NC. One of his grandchildren (One of Peggy's daughters) told me that she has been to the cemetery and confirmed this but there is no marker on the grave. She told me that she talked to the folks there who showed her where they are buried. My online search of the cemetery did not show them buried there but that may be due to the lack of a marker. An obituary for him (Lattice) in the High Point Enterprise (dated 2-29-1964) also indicates this along with his death certificate. I understand that Ila Mae Wheeler is buried there also - again no marker. I am not sure on her date of birth. Like you, I have seen both dates. The six children that I am aware of are Willard Deolivar, Millard D., Gladys, Stilla (Stella) Joyce and Martha Louise (aka Peggy). The date you refer to (11-28-1939) is the date that I have for Willard Deolivar's birth date so I think that could be a mistake in your records. I do not know of any deaths of infants. Joyce's maiden name would have been Joyce Ladora Upchurch and she married a Donald Leonard and had one son Donald Leonard Jr. who they called Junior. She was born on 6-20-35 and died on 3-8-2012 and is buried in Greenwood Cemetery in Macon, NC.

Peggy is Martha Louise (not Margaret) and she was the youngest of the children and is the only one still living. I actually saw her recently at my husbands Mother's house. She is the only one of Lattice and Ila Mae's children who is still living. I am told she has a photo of Lattice and Ila Mae. I am trying to get a copy of that - if I can I will scan and load it to Ancestry and send you one as well. W.D.U. Sr. did have three children (Tammy Rose, Anthony Ray and my husband Willard D. Upchurch Jr.) He remarried after his divorce from Molly Faye Gunter (mother of Tammy, Anthony and Willard Jr.) to Betty Deaton of Reidsville, NC. Betty had two children Karen and Missy who would have been his step children. That is all that I am aware of. I am still working on researching Gladys. I show her birth as being recorded as Gladys Marine but have also seen it listed as Gladys Marie. Her husband was James Jackson and she lived in Wake Forest. Peggy is the only one left for me to ask about the name Delova. She told me her Dad's name was "Deolivar" but I am pretty sure she is mistaken. There are too many records showing Delova. I think that you have to take into consideration that most of these folks did not have a tremendous amount of education so.... Some of it may remain a mystery but I will continue to poke around to see if I can clarify that. I did find where Lattice had two 1/2 siblings one Lumis Lee of Four Oaks and Ida West of Erwin who were listed in his obituary. Lumis I have researched some and find that he appears to be Martha (Mattie) Layton's son with Oscar Lee. I am still trying to locate Ida West.

In response to your question on Peggy's children that one is a bit more complicated. She has been married several times and while I have met some of her children, I have no idea who might belong to who. I do know that she has had the following married names: Taylor, Spain and Canoy and I think I may have missed one in there. I will try to talk to her and see if I can clarify any of that for you. I am told that Millard died in or around Mobile Alabama and I did find an obituary for his son (Bobby Ray) and he had a daughter Martha who I believe is still living. I hope to reach out to her to see what she might know.

I have most of the documentation for what I have on my mother's ancestry account (She started the tree for my kids and began asking me the questions that ultimately let me to you)  
It is listed as Upchurch Family Tree and her name is mutherbear and it is a public tree. We may have some errors because we started out blind and just saved what looked right. Please notify me if you are aware of errors so I may correct them. I don't think I realized that others would even be looking at it...

I am interested in learning more about Patric and Martha Layton and their ancestors and anything else you might find interesting.

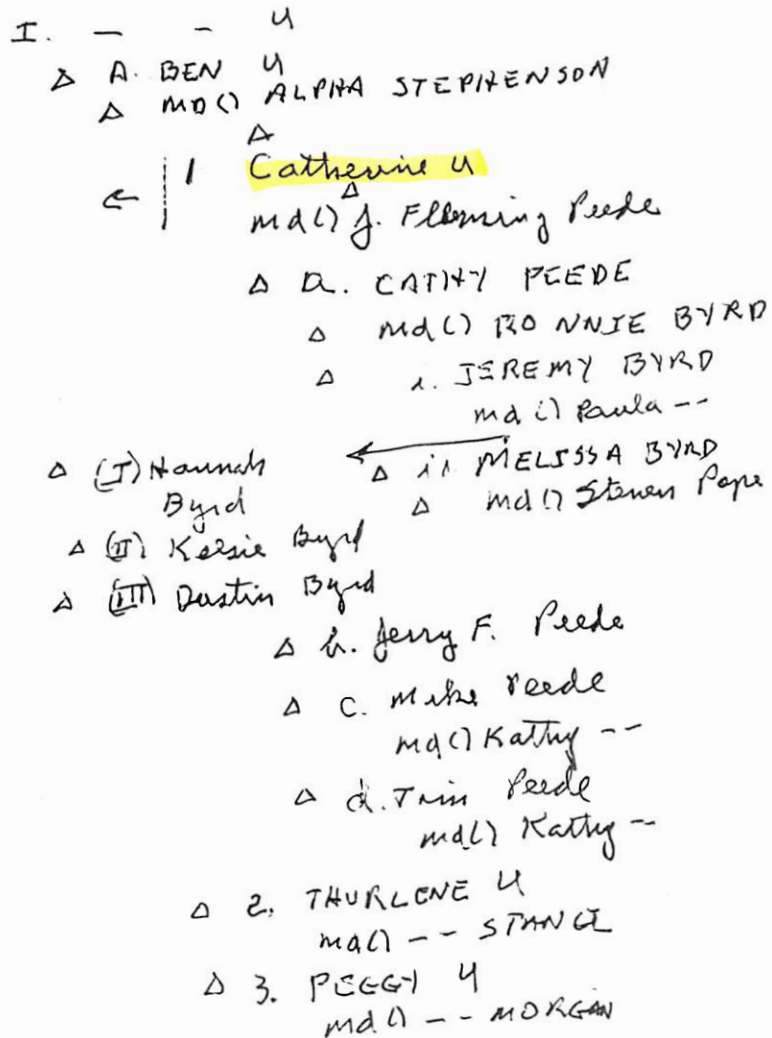

This caught my eye, even tho I have a different last name in my records for the marriage.  
Catherine Upchurch m. George Cook on 6 Jan. 1867 in Itawamba Co., MS.

Catherine was one of five Upchurch siblings, with the others being Emily A., Sarah C., Martha, William A., who were listed on 7 Aug. 1860 Itawamba Co., MS records when John A. Bryant and Sarah Bryant applied for guardianship of the 5 children.

Of these siblings: Sarah C. Upchurch m. Joel Springer on 10 Feb 1874 in Lee Co., MS. On 18 Dec 1871 Lee Co., MS a marriage license was taken out for Martha Upchurch and Frederick Schumpherd, but a return never filed. William A. Upchurch took out a marriage license on 2 Jan 1882 in Lee Co., MS to marry Maggie Cunningham but a return was never filed.

There is speculation that these are the children of A. Upchurch found on 1850 DeSoto Co., MS census in household of Elias Beall, who had moved from GA to MS. At this time this A. Upchurch was 23, b. NC around 1827. An A. Upchurch is then found on 1855 directory for Bolands, Itawamba Co., MS.

There is speculation that this A. Upchurch might also be the A. Upchurch of 1849 that was headed from MS to MO to be outfitted to go out west during the Gold Rush.

There is also an A.G. Upchurch, possibly Alexander or Almenean Gaston, who took out a marriage license on 14 Dec 1852 in DeSoto Co., MS to marry Susannah B. Vaughan, with no return ever filed. He is found on 1860 DeSoto Co., MS census with family. He then either deserted his family or something as his wife married Frank Rowland in 1866. By 1867 A.G. Upchurch is in Panola Co., MS, with mentions of DeSoto Co. and Tate Co., MS. In 1873, he married Mariah/ Mona C./E. Long/Longe, but my 1880 this wife had married Berry Matthews and was in Attala Co., MS.

As you've probably noticed, I spell Catharine's name with a second "A". I do this because it is spelled so on the will of her husband Allen Deese I (23 JAN 1886) and on her tombstone. Should I spell it this way or the more modern way of Catherine. [I conclude to adopt 2 "A"s - RPM]

A story passed through the descendants of William Boyan Deese maintains that Allen Deese, I was illiterate and that "Kattie" maintained the financial resources, when Allen Deese I wasn't farming he worked at a sawmill, I instead of counting his wages on payday like everyone else, he would take them home to Catherine to insure he wasn't shortchanged.

Enclosed is the death certificate of Atlas Burgan Deese which shows his parents as Allen Deese I and "Kattie" U. This is the most legitimate proof of my Upchurch link.

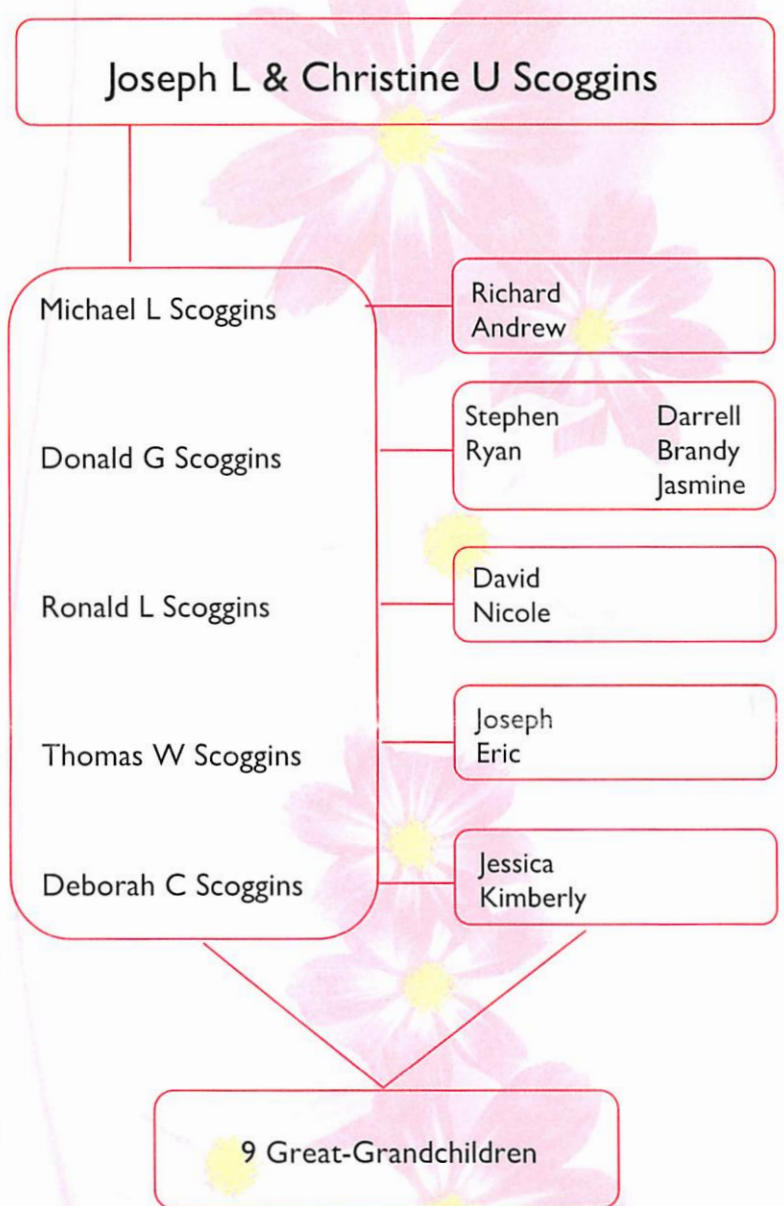

The question about where Sarah M. McGregor U. Bryan and her family<sup>are buried</sup> is not settled as far as I am concerned. That would be 5 graves plus the children of JBU and Julia HU 3, a total of 8 graves. They have in last few years tried to plot the graves and identify lost graves. I was told there are only a few unmarked graves. None of them are in area where the Upchurches and M McGregor are buried. Plus there is not record of where Julia Hardison's father and his brother are buried. The other factor that bothers me about where they are buried or not buried in Boxelder cem. is that we always had cemetery cleaning days 2-3 times a yr. Mother always had us to go with her and Aunt Mary always attended. I feel if the graves ~~had~~ were in Boxelder C Aunt Mae would have cleaned the graves and had us helping her. It would make sense for them to have been buried there because Sarah was a founding member of the church. The Alston family donated the land for the church and for the cemetery. A clause in the papers state that if the church is ever closed, the land goes to the cemetery. I vaguely remember my mother telling me that when the cemetery opened up, some people who had family members buried in the old cemetery moved them to the new cemetery. I donot remember for sure why she told me this, but I think I asked questions about the old cem. I donot remember if I asked about our family.
