LUPR first got the 5 pieces of furniture from the father of the Bartley Jefferson & home & passed it on to Dan FHT who passed it on to Dan Lisa.

FHT says she drove her mother LUPR and her Aunt Frances to Erwin in Harnett Co, NC to see Aunt Maudie. LUPR said that Frances Jefferson & 81 more Aunt Maudie had to the Raleigh, NC area which he did.

LUPR wanted to be buried in Oakwood Cemetery in Raleigh, NC but this could not be arranged

At the time George Malcolm & died in Rex Hospital on St Mary's Street in Raleigh, NC he was attended by Lena who lived on Hogan Street. Frances Holt Tilley tells of how she surprised her mother, Lena, by showing up in her mother's dress to look older so she could see Uncle Mac. . Frances Holt Tilley tells the story of how Lena, as a child, would be taken by her under up to the store and placed on the counter and taught to "count".

Lena would be called when her nephew Percy B. Perry would have a seizure (they called it a "spell"). He had epilepsy.

Lena & Husband Holt in their early married life lived in Uncle Frank's house that burned at the Ramble at the Cross Roads.

Lena stayed with Upchurch Grandparents until age 10 but then returned to her home (at 1919) to start school at about age 11 at <sup>A</sup>J. Y. Joyner School. The notes tend to indicate that prior to this time she attended a one-room school at Inwood and that this one-room structure preceded the school house in which I lived about 1933 and which had 3-4 rooms and was described as having vertical siding. One resource Lena walked from the Miley Perry home on Inwood Creek Road to the <sup>A</sup>J. Y. Joyner School.

Pg 12 - Frances Holt Tilley says her parents (Holt Tilley & <sup>A</sup>Lena Perry) moved in with George Cewan Atlettes when they first married but had to leave when Frances Holt was born as George did not like babies. They moved to the Centerville Park Home and then to 3-4 successive houses in Raleigh.

Pg 13 Holt Tilley

- △ Holt Tilley first worked for the company that installed Bell Systems. This job ended & Dr Kilgore hired him at Free State Creamery. Holt was a tall man for Dr Kilgore.
- △ Holt was kind & helped many without charge.
- △ He adored sister Perry (Lena) and never denied her anything or judged her. She was the other hand, treated him badly. She would spryce up clothes, shoes, pocketbooks.

(15) NOTES OF RPH CALL 30 MAR 2007 TO FRANCES NOLT TILLEY

We discussed "Inwood School". FH thought it had a different name but could not surmise same. Mrs Harriet Shearon was the first teacher. FH was not aware of the J.Y. JOYNER school but said her Aunt Under walked or rode through the woods to attend Myatt Chapel as there was not a regular minister at Inwood. Both her Uncle ALTON & PEERY married ladies from the US 401 area.

FH feels her Mother, Lena, stayed at Grandfathers Upchurch home until Uncle Tex came back from WWI. FH says Lena attended a 2 room Inwood School and that her siblings, who were older, also went to Inwood School or Lena told FH of her siblings experiences at Inwood. They went to Inwood School until they were ready to go to Cary Academy driving a T model Ford. Frances boarded her last year at Cary Academy as she had no one to drive her.

There was a road that allowed the Miley Perry family to have easy access to 401. FH thinks south of the Miley Perry home - I think north. Miley Southern tract (now owned by Edward Todd) was landlocked until the road was extended.

Peter Williamson owned a timber tract east of & adjoining the tract FN & Richard had an Inwood Rd. His home on US 401. He found an old road to use to haul his lumber.

Norall Wilson, Sr went to Enterprise School. Celeste Penny taught there and possibly also MAE (ADAMS) WILSON

Met Monk at 9 AM and started touring SCRSP to take pictures and mark places on the map. Took picture of Hobie his 7-day old mule colt. Went to SE corner of original Upland Trail on Inwood Church Rd. To the East & North lie a 180 Acre tract where the Holt Family once lived. Alton could have bought this for \$2500. It was bought by two Attorneys - ALDRIDGE & STEWART about 1940. They also got Percy's adjoining 25 Acres.

Monk says there was a spring in the part of the Upland Land which was used to keep huts cool. Monk has seen the concrete remnants. He said Uncle Getha reported that it took ~~two~~ people to operate the church. There was a path across the field to the 1334 home as that is where Miley Perry got her mail. Beyond Perry's 25 Acres there lay 25 Acres on either side of the road. This was land that went to Clyde. Then came the 50 Acre home place which eventually went to Francis. Next came 17 Acres for Lena & Lena at the 60 Acre Pace Tract.

Frances Welt Tolley remembers the following about the children of Ralph Barker Scott.

- Lena had one of the daughters as a <sup>LENIA</sup> <sub>UPCULTURE</sub> <sup>PERRY</sup> playmate - named KATIE - based on age - probably Lenora or Allie but Frances remembers neither - she will ask Marie [Frances knows Marie by first name of Matthe] until she die before telling her husband. It was at ~~an~~ <sup>an</sup> occasion.
- Carrie b/t Scott b 1907 (GA) - taught Sunday School at Imwood. Her class were known as the Carrie Scott (Carrie Carroll?) class. She and (?) - - CARROLL. Had 2 daughters. Corbie taught at Swift Creek School. The Mrs <sup>A</sup> I. RUTTER CARROLL - still living - taught school at Fuguey. Never married. She was very active at Imwood but left suddenly - seemed to go off her rocker when someone died.

Lena got 17 acres where FH built their house on Inwood Church Road + the 48 Acre Park Tract which was no good for farming and had access problem. Eddie later built his house there. They had to get an easement from the Jones Family. Later a man bought 100 Acres below this tract.
