This call reviewed certain details recorded in ⑧. Ouida had agreed to go play cards with an elderly group but felt nauseated & lay down. We, nevertheless, had a spirited conversation. First I asked about the operations on Carl Michael U. He went in on 19 OCT 94 and had his first operation on his head on 20 OCT 94. This was followed by a main operation on the SAT after Thanksgiving. There was also a third operation. It seems to have been a great success and the seizures have not reappeared. He has some pain in the head because nerve endings in muscle were disturbed. He has medication which will be gradually decreased over the next year. Michael is very upset. He still lives with Ouida.

Ouida Upchurch, 85, of Bethesda, Maryland, died Jan. 12, 2001 at Washington Hospital. She was born in North Carolina. She received her diploma in nursing, BS in Administration, MA in Counseling and extensive graduate study in psychology, group dynamics and research.

She joined the navy as a registered nurse in 1941. She was aboard the first ship to enter Tokyo at the end of World War II, a member of Hiroshima inspection team, aboard the fleet present at Japanese surrender in 1945. She retired as Captain in

1974.

She was founder of SIRC (Seniors Interfaith Resource Center) in 1992 and still served as their president.

She was a member of the North Bethesda United Methodist Church.

She is survived by a brother, Carl Upchurch of Tulsa, Okla., a sister Carmeta Bolt of Columbia, S.C., nephews Carl Michael Upchurch of Bethesda, Bruce Upchurch (Shirley) of Beach Park, Ill. and Waylon Upchurch of Texas; cousins, Ireland Upchurch of Wilmington, Arliss Upchurch, Melvin Upchurch and Avron Upchurch, all of Sanford, and Doris Sanders of Fayetteville, and many other nieces, nephews, great nieces and

nephews and one great-great-nephew. She was preceded in death by her parents Carlie and Anne Upchurch, a sister Garnetta, all of North Carolina, and a brother Tasker Upchurch of Winthrop Harbor, Ill.

Ouida Catherine Upchurch, 85, a retired Navy captain and nurse who was a 1992 founder and president of the Seniors Interfaith Resource Center of Washington, died Jan. 12 at Washington Hospital Center after a heart attack. She lived in Bethesda.

Capt. Upchurch, a North Carolina native and registered nurse, was a graduate of the Bellevue nursing school in New York and Columbia Teachers College. She also received a master's degree in counseling from Columbia.

She began her career as a Navy nurse in 1941 and served in the Pacific during World War II. She was present at the Japanese surrender in 1945 in Tokyo Bay and had been a member of the team that inspected Hiroshima, where this country had dropped an atomic bomb. She later served in Washington and lived in this area on her retirement from active duty in 1974.

Capt. Upchurch was a member of North Bethesda United Methodist Church.

Survivors include a brother and a sister.

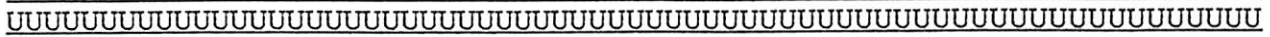

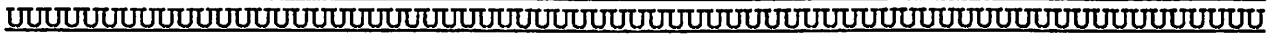

Upchurch honored for aiding seniors

The Montgomery County Department of Family Resources, Division of Elder Affairs, recognizes Ouida C. Upchurch of Bethesda for her significant contributions to the well-being of older adults in Montgomery County.

Since 1978, Upchurch has been the driving force behind two Montgomery County community organizations that have focused on coordinating religious congregations' response to seniors in need.

Upchurch is a board member of GROWS — Grassroots Organization for the Wellbeing of Seniors. She is also the founder of Seniors' Interfaith Resource Center serving Bethesda, Chevy Chase and Kensington. The center at St. Luke's Church, 6030 Grosvenor Lane, is staffed by more than 60 volunteers representing many congregations. A 24-hour answering machine is available and the center is open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Upchurch received her undergraduate and graduate degrees from Columbia University. At the time of her retirement after 33 years in the Navy, she was a program manager for the Department of Defense. She was stationed in the Pacific during World War II and retired in 1974 as a captain. After her retirement, she formed her own management consulting firm; her clients included universities and government agencies.

She has been a member of the Bethesda First Baptist Church for 35 years. Her magnificent garden in Bethesda attests to her creativity and gardening skill. She also enjoys cooking. When asked what she gets out of volunteering, Upchurch said, "I just enjoy doing it; I like working with people. From a selfish viewpoint, I like to do something I can do well."

How nice to make your acquaintance through our phone conversation in Washington on January 14, 1980. I do hope you will pursue your interests in Upchurch genealogy and that we will be able to work cooperatively. There is much to be done on the Puffin U group.

Provided herewith is the flyer on the West Book which I promised to send. It is the key book for you to buy. When you write to her I also suggest that you ask about the cost and availability of her Fenters (Tuler) Book. The Fenters lived in the Apex, NC area and intermarried with the Upchurches and particularly with descendants of Puffin. The 3rd book of interest is 'The Upchurch Story' by Olive A. Morgan 8916 Walnut St, Kansas City, MO 64114. The 2nd edition is available for \$15.65 post paid. You will enjoy all three of these books but especially the West book.

Provided herewith is a single sheet outline of the 1st five generations of Upchurches in America (The Colonial Upchurches). I have designated the 23 5th generation members (more will be discovered) as heads of class. The head of your class is

Moses U (XID-1). His brother Nathan U (XID-78) is the head of my clan. Your line is:

Moses U → Ruffin U → Rufus U → Rufus Cary U → Carl Emil U
Note that Ruffin U is not the father of Rufus Cary U or I indicated over the phone but that there is a Rufus in between. My line is:

Nathan U → Edward U → ^{Bartley} Jefferson U → ^{Robert} Jefferson U → ^{Robert} Phillip U

Hence your father and I are 4th cousins! I presume that makes you and me 5th cousins once removed.

I have had some difficulty reconciling the notes I took from our phone conversation on 14 JAN 80 and those I took from Waylon Cline U on 22 MAR 79. Accordingly I am sending you a heret copy of my Waylon Cline U notes and will document below my presumptions as to the errors in them based on the information I got from you. (Note that I could have recorded improperly in either case.) If you will let me know about the correctness of my presumptions I will revise my Ruffin U outline and send you a copy.

Presumed error in notes taken by ROLL in 22 MAR 79 phone conversation with Waylon Cline U.

- (1) The "Carley U" listed as a son of Rufus Cary U is an improper spelling of Carl Emil U and there is no "Carley" U.

(2) Kurley Ustoye U is not a son of Carl Emil U ("Carley U") but rather is his brother

(3) Norrie U does not seem to fit under Carl Emil U ("Carley U") since you did not list him as one of your brothers but then where does he fit?

I will anxiously await your comments on the above three items as well as any other information you have to offer. In due course, if you are interested, I will be able to cite some documents bearing upon proof of your lineage from Ruppis U.

I did get to spend one day in the DAR Library in Washington and it is excellent. My stay in Washington had to be extended one day so I got home Friday night.

Soon I will be sending you a flyer on Upchurch Bulletin. It is to be published quarterly starting this quarter and has an annual subscription of \$10. In the meantime I am collecting addresses of individuals to whom flyers can be sent. If you have addresses of Upchurch relatives, descendants, spouses, etc they would be most useful to me.

I trust that your visit to the hospital was encouraging and that by this time you are out with a "clean bill of health"
