Nuncupative will. On 29 Apr 1815 Britton Upchurch deposed before Thomas Dunn that in September last "on the day of the General muster at Louisburg," sd Jesse Averit said he "had substituted himself to go a Tour of duty to Norfolk for Burkley Upchurch;" should he not return, he wished WILLIAM OWENS & his wife TEMPERANCE to have his property & that Old Baker was not to have anything. On May 5 1815, Elizabeth(x) Alford deposed that a few days before sd Jesse Averit started to Norfolk,

he stated that if did not return from Norfolk that he wanted TEMPERANCE OWENS to have his property "for she had done more Him then any of the rest."

To my son ASA - 390 acres where I now live with the land I had from Sampson Brasswell, on both sides of the creek & my mill, only my son NATHAN is to have his "truck ground soul Free as Long as he will Help to keep hir in order after his Mothers Deceas or Widdowhood;" also to sd Asa, 140 acres that was the rest of my land that was formerly my father's to the sd Great Branch, & 45 acres in my first survey joining Obadiah Strickland, Benj Upchurch, being 575 acres in all; also negro girl Pat, but her first child is to go to my daughter LUCY, & his mother is to keep all these as long as she lives or is my widow; etc.

To my son WARREN - the last land I surveyed below the Wolf Harber for 400 acres.

To my wife SELAH - her choice of beds & furniture; lend to her "the Rest of My Living" to raise my children during her widowhood; should she die before my young children are grown, my son NATHAN "to have the care of My Children and keep them togehter if posable."

To my 6 youngest daughters SALLEY, LIDDEA, LUCY, SELAH, ELIZABETH & ZILPAH - all that is left after my wife's death or widowhood, but not to be sold if possible but rather divided.

I give my right of all the property I have given bond to return that I had by my last wife & these are her sons-in-law: ISRAEL BAILEY, JOHN UPCHURCH & LO JACKSON; I also give them my rights to the land her former husband left to her, & certain other personal property. To my wife - the horse I had with her, negro man Jacob, for her life. I have already given my children as much as I have. To ISHAM FULLER's children - \$200. To my daughter SEALY FULLER's children - \$200 but her son JONES & her son HENRY I give them the land that Arthur Fuller now lives on. To my son ARCHEY - my negor boy Sam. To my son BARTHOLOMEW - negro Ben. To my son HENRY JONES & SARAH HOLT I have already given 2 negroes apiece. ZILLEY MILLER has already had 2 negroes. To my son DEMCY - negro man Tamer. To my daughter MILLEY YARBROUGH - negro girl Jeny. To my daughter MARY JURDON - the child my negro woman Ab is now big with; lend to her negro girl Sender "while Faney maris or Comes of age." To my daughter OLLIF BAILEY - my young filley & \$100. To my daughter FANEY FULLER - negro girl Sender whom I lent to Mary Jordan while Faney comes of age or marries; also give to Faney negro boy Sandy, etc. To my son WORRIN - negro boy Jacob & girl Pat & 1 horse I had from my son Ephram; also the land where I now live, after taking out Epraim & Jordan's parts, but FANNEY FULLER is to have a house & home as long as she is single or comes of age. To my son JOHNNATHAN - 40 acres in the fork of the creek above Daniel Fuller's joining George Williams; also I give him negro woman Grace. To my son EPHRAIM - land on Little River, joining Cole Branch, Jeffris. To my son JORDAN - the land I have from Jere Peace where sd Jordan now lives joining Michal Dent. After my son Worrin & daughter come of age, I give my negro girl Easter to my daughter POLLEY JORDAN & at the same time I give my negro woman Ann to my daughter OLLIF BAILEY. Other legacies & provisions.

"... taking into consideration the faithfulness of my slave Chany through life I desire and do make provision for her comfort and liberation after my death;" I leave her in the care of my executor as her guardian & also \$100 for her benefit & support; should she die before the money is expended, then the sd \$100 divided as follows. "... wishing to gratify my slave Molley and her children that she now has," they may choose with whom they wish to live after my death provided such person will pay fair valuation. \$25 to my executor to give to Molley for the benefit of her & her children. To my sister DEBY William Farris' wife - \$100. To my sister RUTHEY NORRIS' family - \$100, but if she is not living at my death, then the sd \$100 to go to Kelan Upchurch's first wife LURANY UPCHURCH's heirs. To EATAN UPCHURCH's wife FRANCES - \$100, but if she is not living then to her children. The balance after my property is sold & debts paid to go to Jas Hartfield's first wife Martha's 4 children, namely WILLIAM HARTSFIELD, WILLIAM KING's wife ALLY, FANNY PAGE & SARY GIBS, & the sd \$100 not used by Chany to the last 4 named children after Chany's death.

To my son CARTER B. - 1840 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres on both sides of Davis' Creek which is a branch of Cedar Creek, joining Eppa Timberlake, a white oak marked with the letters DJ, David Jones, Jones Cook, Jeremiah Perry (fork), Moses Neal, Ephraim Conyer, Richard Timberlake, the line of the lands I purchased from John Journeau; also slaves Ralf a blacksmith age 40, man Arthur age 22, woman Celia age 40 & all her children, namely Dill age 22, Aifred age 18, Needham age 14, Henderson age 12, Calvin age 10 & Penina age 4; also girl Eliza age 6. Tharp, James Baker & James Hartsfield to act as guardians to my daughters Elizabeth H. Harrison & Martha Harrison until they are age 21 or marry. My executors to receive \$200 each.
