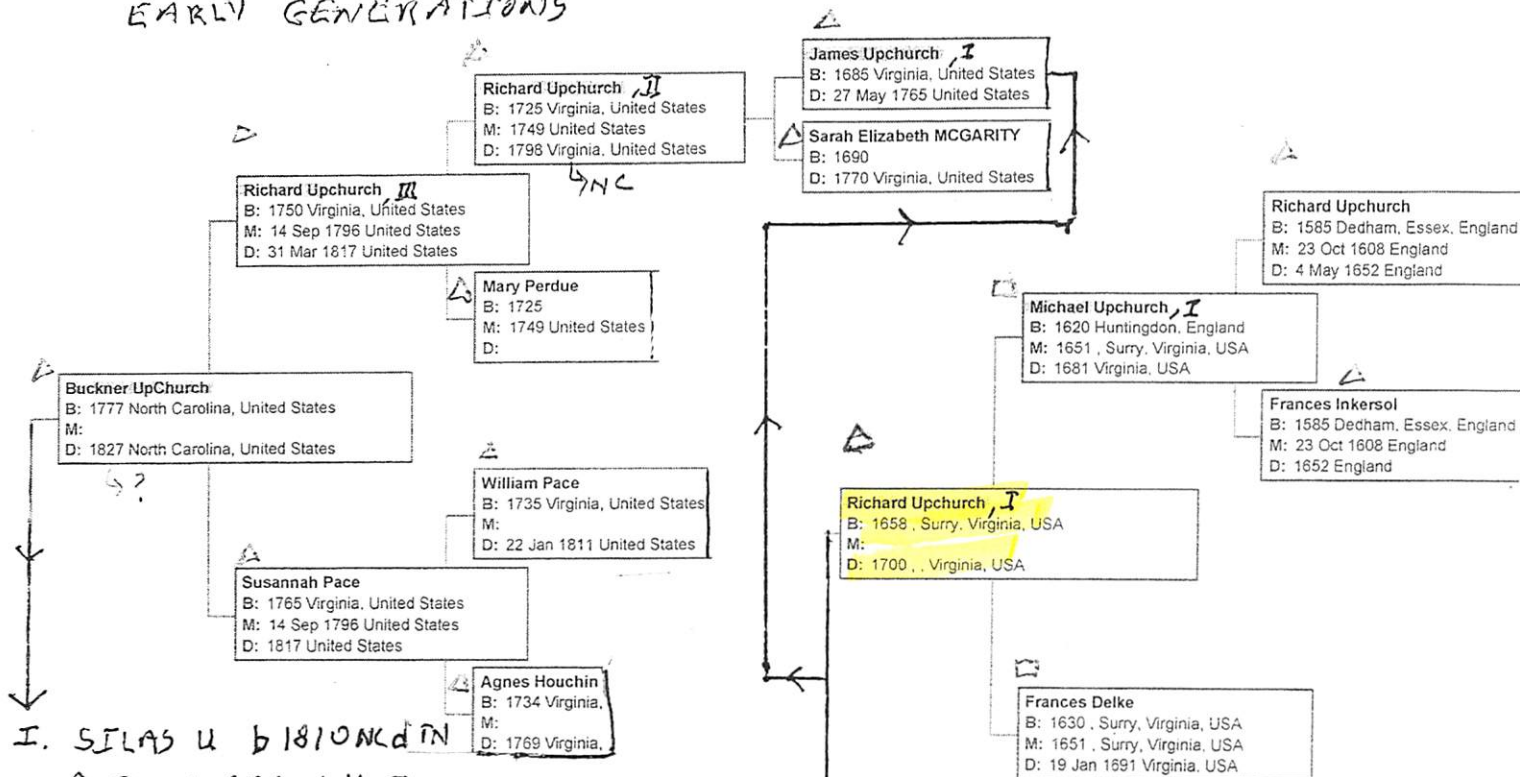

COLONIAL U RICHARD U. I (SON OF MICHAEL I)

- ① "Richard U, who seems to have been the oldest son of Michael and Frances U, apparently married and lived elsewhere than Surry County, VA. He appeared back on the home scene as living with Michael II, probably on the property of their father, according to the Tithe List of the 10th of June 1694. Richard was listed again on the 9th of June 1699, as living with Robert Reynolds, who was probably his mother's half-brother (Surry Co. VA Mills & Deeds No 5 1694-1701 Part I). There is no further record of Richard U. Circumstances and dates of the appearance of John and James U, of whom later, lead us to believe they were sons of Richard" (28)
- "On the 29th of June, 1739, James U I, who seems to have been the son of Richard of Surry County, therefore a grandson of Michael I, was granted 117 acres of land for 15 shillings on the S side of Fountain Creek (later called Rattlesnake Creek) in Brunswick County. This Creek lies just north of the North Carolina line almost all the way across Brunswick County (VA Land Grants, Archives in Richmond VA."

SON(S) OF MICHAEL UPCHURCH

1684, 5 June - Widow Upchurch for Michael Upchurch. A List of Tithables belonging to Lawnes Creek Church taken ye 5th day of June 1684.

1687, Militia, Surry County, Va.

1691, 19 January. Robert Reynolds and Roger Delk entering security of Michael Upchurch's due performance of his administration on the estate of Frances Upchurch, his mother. A certificate of administration was granted.

1691, 1 March. Appeared in Court this day Michael Upchurch and made Oath that the within specified contents is a true and perfect inventory of the estate of Frances Upchurch, deceased. Book 4. page 248. W. Edwards, Clerk of Court.

1694, 10 June - Michael Upchurch and Ri. Upchurch on the Tithing List for Surry County, Va.

After this Michael disappears, but no death, settlement of estate or anything more concerning him has ever been found.

1694, 10 June - Richard Upchurch on the Tithing List with Michael.

Michael may have had another son, John, as a John Jr. has been found in New Kent County in 1701. This John Jr. died in 1713. He may have been a son of John and a grandson of Michael I. His father may have been dead and he was called junior because John, the son of Richard was living.

JOHN U, I

RICHARD UPCHURCH (1660 - 1696)

probably son of Michael (1620-1681)

1694, Ri. Upchurch listed on the Tithable List of Surry County with Michael.

1699, 9 June - Richard Upchurch is listed with Robert Reynolds on the Tithable List.

When Michael I died in 1681 Robert Reynolds assisted the widow Frances in the settlement of the estate. When Frances died in 1690 Robert Reynolds assisted Michael II in the settlement of Frances's estate.

After 1699 Richard is no longer found on the Tithable List. Did Richard marry a Reynolds or was Frances a Reynolds?

Richard must have died shortly after the 1699 list. He seems to have left three sons - (James, John and William.)

D Now comes the interesting info.... on the 1679 Tithable record for Lawne's Creek Parish of Surry County, Virginia, Michael Upchurch is listed.... and SO IS HIS SON, MICHAEL. I have a copy of the actual record in my hand as I speak... and it's quite clear and easy to read: "Michaell Upchurch & Michaell his Son..... 2"

E This really excites me. Now we can see that he'd reached 16 by 1679, making him born after June 10th, 1662 and before June 10th, 1663.

F Could it possibly be that since Michaell II was born earlier than thought, that he might be the father of John, William, and James, instead of Richard (abt. 1658-1700)? When we thought he wasn't old enough to have fathered John (born 1678), it made sense that Richard was the father. But now we can see that Michael II would have been abt 17 years of age.

G I've never really studied the two sons of Michael (1624-1681) so I'm not sure of the validity of whether Richard Upchurch (1658-1700) or now this son Michael would have been the father of John, William, and James.

What do you think?

C First though, let me give you this from Belle Lewter West's book:

Michael Upchurch II, in Surry Co., Va., seems to have been the youngest son of Michael and Frances UPCHURCH. He was first mentioned in records as a tithable at Lawne's Creek Parish Church by his mother, FRANCES, on the 12th of June 1683, indicating that he had just reached the age of sixteen....

So we've all used that information about Michael II as nothing else had ever surfaced to make us think differently. Ms. West's findings suggested that Michael II was born about 1667.

X. This is absolutely fascinating, and you could be onto something really significant. It will need to be thought out, but Michael II would've been really young, still. I notice that John apparently had a daughter, Elizabeth, born 25 Dec 1701 - which (usually) would mean having been born ca 1670-1675, and there were at least two boys, John Jr. and James, for whom I do not have a birthdate, and if they were before Elizabeth, then John's marriage might have been a little earlier (or not). In any event, this would imply that Michael II would need to have been born not much later than 1650ish.

this she asks if Michael U, II could be the Father of John U, I, Wm U, I & James U, I (see G) - In C Mae shows that West straight Michael U, II to abt 1667 - RPU's response is given in X

Γ RPU COMMENTS: I will agree that the dates for the first 4 generations need to be revisited and any new data analysed with changes in parentage if needed. However, I agree with Ray that even if Michael U, II

was born 1662 he would have been only about 16 when John U, I was born in 1776 - hence not likely father & son. NOTE: Mae is writing a book on Michael U, I RPU 4/1/2010

Michael and Frances' other son, Michael II

Michael II was most likely the youngest child of Michael Upchurch, I, and his wife, Frances. Little is known about Michael II and he may have died quite young. He shows up in the June 12, 1683 tithe record at Lawne's Creek Parish Church indicating he has reached his sixteenth birthday.

In 1685 and 1688 he is also listed as a tithable. He was in the Militia of Surry County in 1749. ^{R06098a} The last time he appears in any record is a listing with his brother, Richard, on the 1694 tithe list. ^{R06110b}

No records or documents have been found to indicate he married or had children.

No TIMELINE is being given for Richard, I, as this page contains all that has been found on him.

Richard is believed to be the oldest son of Michael and Francis Upchurch, and is thought to be the only son to have children to carry on the Upchurch name.

Where did Richard Live?

By 1678, Richard had reached about twenty years of age, and wasn't listed in records of Lawnes Creek Parish where his parents and siblings lived. He is thought to have left Surry County at this point. At some point he married and they had children. Nothing has been found to tell us who he married, nor where they married.

When his mother died in 1691, Richard's younger brother, Michael, II, was appointed administrator of her estate. That's puzzling since the oldest son usually handled those chores. It also supports the theory that Richard had left Lawne's Creek Parish, and perhaps even Surry County.

Return to Surry County

Tithe records dated June 10, 1694, show Richard back in Surry County, Virginia, living with Michael II, his brother, who is thought to have made his home on their father's property. Possibly his wife and children were with him at this time. ^{R06135g}

Again in 1699 he is listed once more as living in Lawnes Creek Parish as a member of the household of the Robert Reynolds family. ^{R06134r}

After that entry, there is no further trace of Richard.

Children of Richard

Earlier researchers proposed that Richard married and had children prior to his return to Surry County, and so we continue with information they produced:

* William may or may not be a son of Richard. Author Belle West named two sons, but not William. Other researchers have speculated there was a third son. ^{R06102a} Since there is a possibility that William was a son of Richard, his name is being included as such.
