UPCHURCH HISTORY

- Allen Upchurch, who died 1848, was also a large landowner and among other things raised horses and cows on his farm. His last will and testament is recorded in book No. 1, pages 64 and 65 in the office of Clerk of the Superior Court of Stanly County. The will was probated at the August session of the county court, 1848. His sons, Patrick B. Upchurch and Benjamin Upchurch qualified as executors of the estate. He gave a tract of land together with money and personal property to each of his five children, that is William, Patrick B., James, Benjamin and John.

$\Delta + \Delta$ Patrick B. Upchurch married Munice McSwain, daughter of

$\Delta + \Delta$ Charles McSwain and his wife Luraner (Washburn) McSwain, on April 30, 1837. She was born August 12, 1819. They had

heirs in the year 1901, since their share from the sale of the dower lands of Charles McSwain to his 2nd wife Sarah L.

$\Delta + \Delta$ Throgmorton McSwain was paid to the clerk of the Superior Court of Stanly county. The said heirs were not residing in Stanly County in 1901, else the money from the dower lands would have been paid to them personally.

In the Allen U census in Stanly Co., NC there is a marker for W. A. U. It seems likely that this is for a gr (or gd) of Allen U - possibly sired by Benjamin A (XID-4422) or James U (XID-4432) - thus son of Allen U.

In my research, I discovered that the 2nd wife of John David Smith [b FEB 1776 & 15 JUN 1852] is said to have been an Upchurch, Mrs John Tilly confirmed this. The name was Elizabeth II and she was presumably another daughter of Allen II. The grave of this John David Smith and his 1st wife (Elizabeth —) is located on property owned by our family and it is situated one mile of the Allen II graveyard and within two miles of the Allen II I and Catherine II Deese graveyard.

- I believe he would have been born in Virginia. According to the *Brunswick County, Virginia Personal Property Tax list* from 1782 through 1899, Harmon is listed being there. So if Allen was born about 1799, then that would have been during the time they lived in Virginia. Also, Allen's death is recorded on the *Stanly County, North Carolina, Mortality Schedule for the year up to June 1, 1850*. In it he is listed as having been born in Virginia. [I might note here, that I have copies of most documents I've referred to in these notes and they will be in my book. I've assumed that you have all the census records and other pertinent documents, however, if you'd like me to send any particular one, just let me know.]

Allen's date of death is also confusing. Most everywhere I look I find he died "21 June 1848." However, according to the previously mentioned document, he would have died during the year leading up to June 1, 1850! It could have been 21 June 1849. I'm just not certain on this. Do you have anything that ties it down definitely?

When did Allen marry: Another unclear date. I keep finding mention all over the Internet that he married Mary Dudney about 1808. That makes me wonder though. If their first child, Elizabeth Ann, was born about 1805, wouldn't they have been married by then? Or was he perhaps married to someone else before Mary? Actually it appears the first two children were both born before 1808.

Item 1. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Mary, my plantation and land on which I now reside, together with all improvements, during her life and at her death to be divided equally between my sons in manner hereinafter named. ⁴⁴¹³

Item 2. I give also unto my wife all my stock (with exception of two cows) consisting of one horse, cows, hogs, sheep and ect. to have during her lifetime.

Item 3. I give and devise to my wife all my household and kitchen furniture (with the exception of two beds) together with my farming tools and wagon and wagon to have and to hold during her lifetime. And I also devise that a sufficiency of corn, wheat, bacon and fodder hay and etc. be given her and her family for one year.

Item 4. I give and devise unto my son William, one-fifth part of my land to be laid shafts to include the house and plantation on which he now lives, together with my blacksmith tools. ⁴⁴¹¹

Item 5. I give and bequeath to my son P.B. UPCHURCH, one-fifth part of my land to include that part plantation on which he formerly lived. ³⁵⁶⁵

Item 6. I give and devise to my son James, one-fifth part of my land to be located as to include the house in which I now live, and it is my desire that the remaining two-fifths be equally divided between my other two sons, Benjamin and John. ⁴⁴³²

Item 7. I give and bequeath to my son John, one cow and bed and furnitures. ⁴⁴¹⁰

Item 8. I also give unto my son James, one cow and bed and furnitures. ⁴⁴³²

Item 9. I will and desire that the remainder of my estate (if there be any) be sold by my executor hereinafter named and further devise that all my just debts be paid as speedily as possible.

Item 10. I further devise that at the death of my wife, that my two youngest sons, John and James, shall each receive fifteen dollars in my money and the remainder of my estate be equally divided among all my children. ^{4410, 4432}

Item 11. I do hereby appoint PATRICK B. UPCHURCH and Benjamin Upchurch my executors of this my last will and testament and desire that they will act according to the true intent and meaning of same. I do hereby revoke all other wills whatsoever made by me.





They are charged with an attempt to conceal the birth of a child of which Blanche Winfree is the alleged mother. The prosecution was instituted by Beauregard Temple, of St. Matthew's township, a neighbor of Allen Upchurch. After hearing the evidence, the prosecuting attorney withdrew the charge and the case was dismissed.
