Perry [MILEY ALBERT PERRY]

Monk reports that Miley Perry owned several hundred acres of land. He had a will which set aside the home tract for his wife (My Aunt Bessie) and he gave the remainder in tracts to his children but with the restriction that the tracts could not be sold but would pass to his grandchildren. However, Monk said lawyers convinced to sell Perry's tract. Francis did not get a tract right away but eventually got the home place per Miley's will. Monk says he & Bryan got their increments when their father died & they bought other tracts of the original Miley Perry Farm. They traded this for NC state wooded land on Yates Mill Pond Road & built a subdivision there. Monk says his current tract was bought by his father from a M - - [Bartley Jefferson] who must have sold it to M - -. Monk says Aunt Elie & Aunt Bessie had 50± acre tracts on Mill Pond Road.

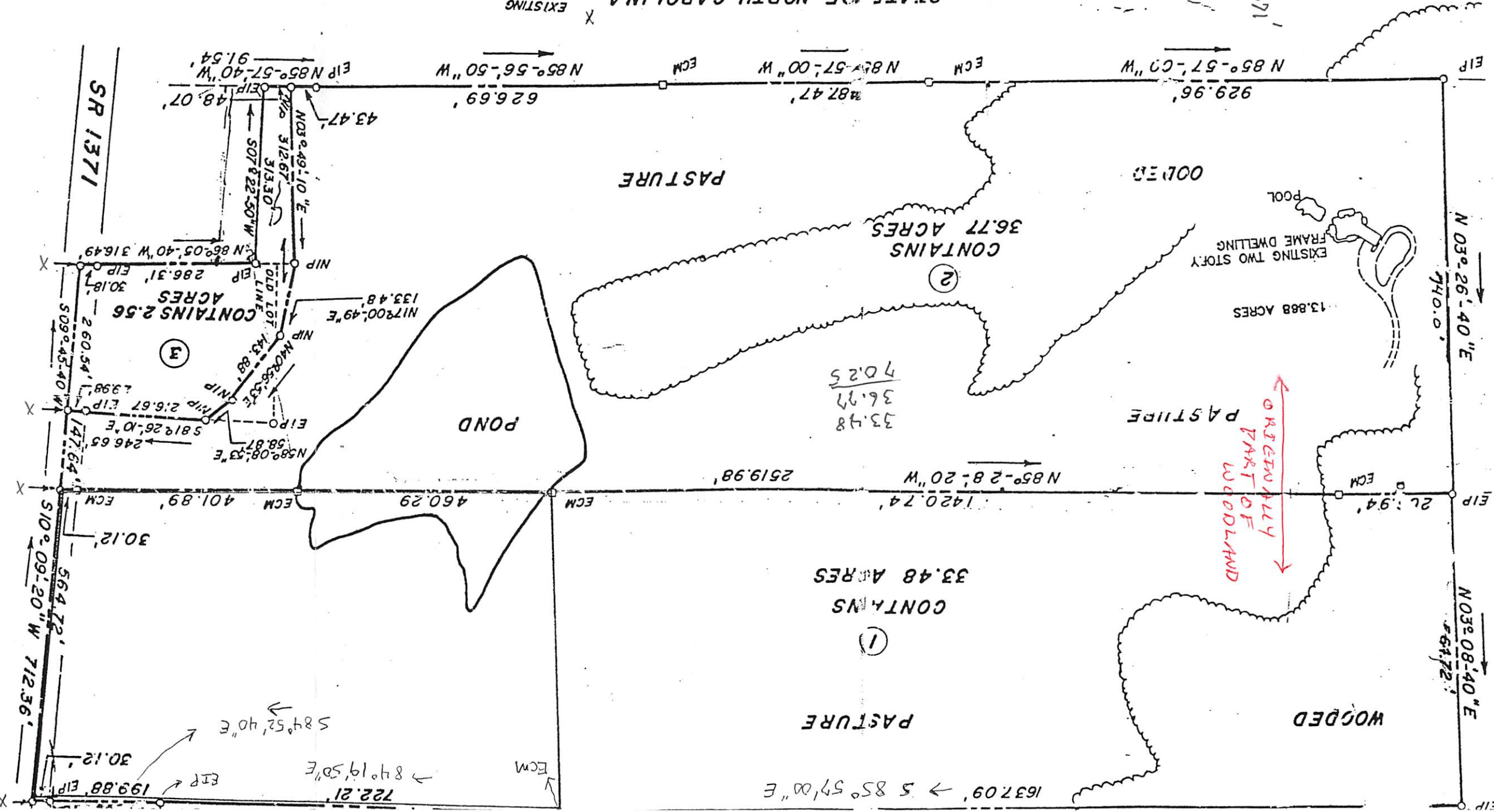

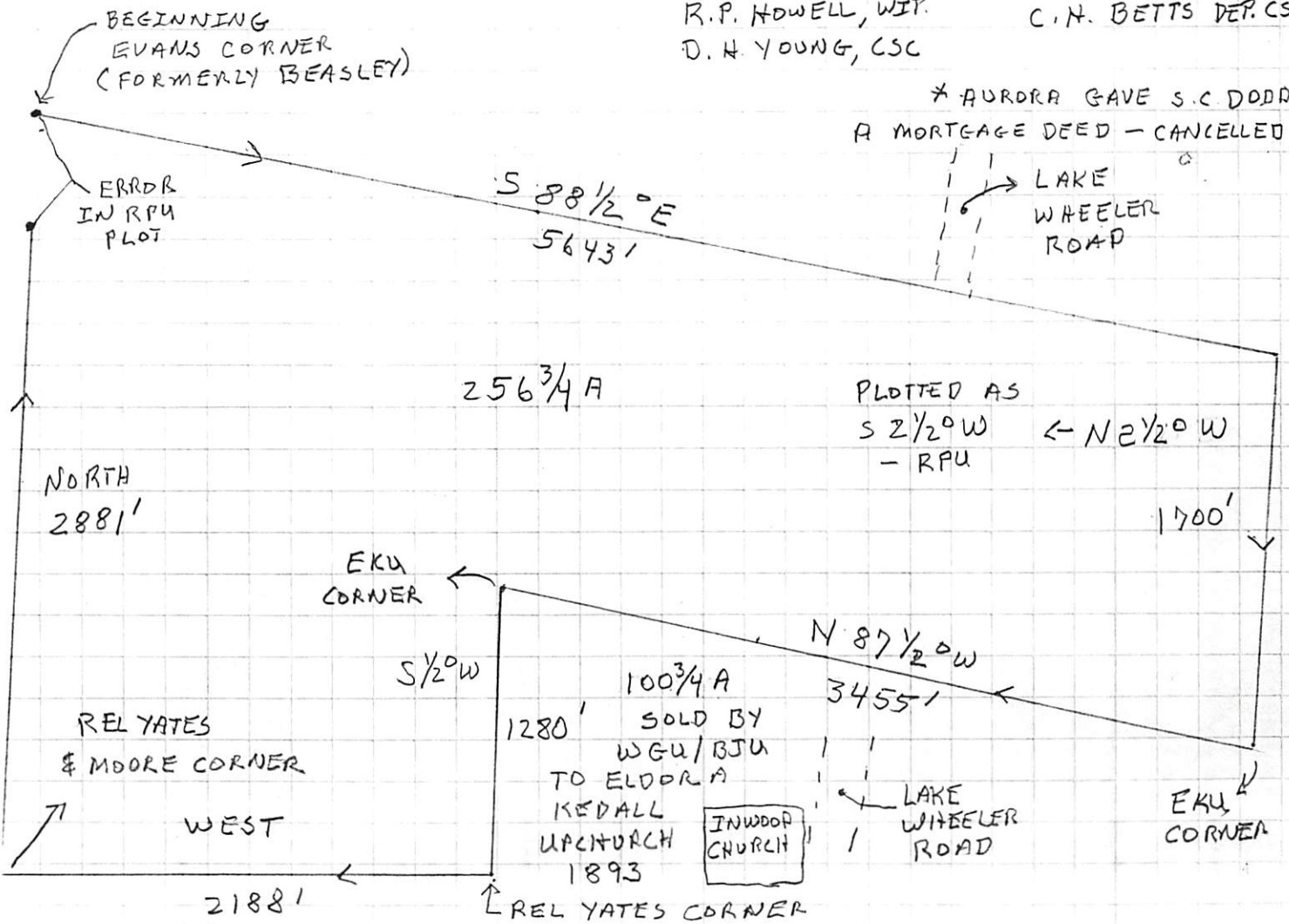

She knew B.J.U and Miley Perry but was not able to tell much about them. Clydia worked many years in the School Lunch Program and was a Supervisor - Gets Retirement & Social Security.

Clydia says Miley Perry always had a large garden - cellars, turnips, etc. - he took them to town for sale.

Clydia in 1947 bought 1/2 Acre from Mr Atkins for \$50 and had a few room house built for \$400. The only child of Mr Atkins was Margaret Atkins who m'd John Henry Johnson. Margaret & John were said to be the most beautiful of all.

For some years the upkeep of the parsonage had proved to be costly. In the meeting of the deacons on December 3, 1985, Elizabeth Lassiter raised the question of "purchasing Perry property next to the church rather than spending a lot of money on the presently owned parsonage." At the next meeting (January 7, 1986) Willis Harris was asked to contact the owner to discover whether the property was available. The matter moved rapidly, and the owner met with the deacons at their next meeting (February 4, 1986). The minutes state:

Mr. Perry later met with the deacon board to discuss the possibility of the church purchasing property from him. Mr. Perry also told the board that the property that his father, Alton O. Perry, had wanted to give to the church some years ago and could not due to stipulations in HIS father's, Miley Perry's will, had not been deeded to the church and that the deed only needed to be signed for the transaction to be finalized. Mr. Perry also informed the board that he had an appraisal done on the house, utility building and land that the church is interested in purchasing. He would like for the church to have its own appraisal done and then we would consider the price. He also stated that he would like to give a gift to the church. Mr. Perry is also interested in buying the present parsonage and the land that goes with it. He said there would be no problem if the church wanted to keep the present parsonage, but that he would like the first option on the property if the church should decide to sell it. The deacon board agreed to have an appraisal done on the Perry property and on the parsonage property.

At the church conference a week later (February 12, 1986), the deacons recommended the purchase of the Perry property, "which consists of 2.07 acres of land, a one story brick house and a one story metal office and warehouse building," at a cost of \$230,500, and the sale of the parsonage to Mr. Perry for \$70,000. So that the congregation would have plenty of time to think about and to discuss the proposal, action was deferred until a called church conference one week later.

There was opposition to the proposal. At the called church conference on March 16, 1986, a substitute motion was passed asking that "a committee be elected to investigate the options available to our body and presented to our congregation 30 days later." The properties and space committee, the finance committee, one trustee, and the chairman of the board of deacons were appointed to make this investigation. Their report, presented at the conference on April 25, was carefully written and attractively presented. After describing all options and estimating the cost of each, the report concluded with a recommendation that the original motion be approved. Finally, on May 4, by a vote of 102 to 27, the congregation approved the transaction. The deal was quickly completed, a loan was negotiated to pay for it, and appeals were made for pledges for the payment of that loan. Within weeks the pastor and his family had moved into the house, and the young people began to use space in the metal building for recreational activities. A year later Albert and Bryan Perry donated to the church another tract of land adjacent to the church property.

Miley Perry arranged the disposition of his property well before his death. He was influenced by the fact that George Strother wanted no children & in fact could not child them. This was instituted in all of George's wills by their Mother. The first set of heirs could use the property but not sell it or cut timber (but some was cut). As the heirs died the land had to stay in family but they could sell. Dan Frances was to get the home place after Aunt Bessie died - Aunt Bessie was to have use of home place for life. Timber was cut on the home place & Harold Wilson, Sr got the proceeds on behalf of Frances - all of this caused all well.

Redden Perry lived in the area of Auburn in Wake Co, NC and his wife nee Nancy Denton died there [need to look for records of Miley NMM Perry & relatives in that area]

Miley NMM Perry had a new (1930?) coupe. He was hit by a carnival washer & lived 2 weeks.

The house to which Miley NMM Perry took his lands was one he had bought from O. L. Stungfield.

FN & I had debate on whether Alden Perry place was Upchurch land - FN thinks so & that it was the land Aunt Bessie got from Bailey J. H. FN says Miley Perry built the house for Walters

met Mank at 9 AM and started touring SCTSP to take pictures and mark places on the map. Took picture of Hokie in 7-day old mule colt. Went to SE corner of original Upchurch Tract on Inwood Church Rd to the East & North line a 180 Acre Tract where the Holt Family once lived. Alton could have bought this for \$2500. It was bought by two Attorneys - ALDRIDGE & STEWART about 1940. They also got Perry's adjoining 25 Acres.

Mank says there was a spring in this part of the Upchurch Tract which was used to keep hutter cool. Mank has seen the concrete remnants. He said Uncle Gethro reported that it took two people to operate the churn. There was a path across this field to the 1334 home as that is where Miley Perry got his mail. Beyond Perry's 25 Acres there lay 25 Acres on either side of the road. This was land that went to Clyde. Then came the 50 Acre home place which eventually went to Frances. Next came 17 Acres for Lena & Lena got the 60 Acre Pace Tract.

Of the 75 (73.5A) Tract given to Alton - the front 25A was given to Aunt Bessie but Mank wonders if she ever got rent. Mank recalls that Lena would collect money from her siblings for clothes for Aunt Bessie, when Bessie was in a rest home the cost was not equally shared.

600 NATHANIEL PERRY

Nathaniel Perry was one of the 7 brothers who came from Virginia (probably Brunswick County) into old Granville County NC by 1752 when he was first listed in Granville County tax records a 1 tith (meaning he was over 21 years old). He was the second eldest of the brothers, William being the eldest. (The parents of the 7 Perry brothers are not proven; it is unlikely that Phillip Perry was the father as

Nathaniel Perry married, but his wife's name is not proven. Although tradition has it that his wife was Rebecca, she is not named in his will, and Rebecca Perry outlived Nathaniel; it is likely she was a daughter, not his wife.

Nathaniel also had children that were not named in his will (written 8/25/1790 and probated in September Court 1790). The tax records and his will prove that he had at least the following children: Isham or Isom, Ephraim, Simon, Sarah (married a Taylor), Drury, and Mary (married Thomas Sanders). (Note the 1790 census records are off slightly on the ages of the children in relation to the tax records.) Nathaniel died in 1790 leaving a will and naming sons Ephraim and Drury as co-executors. Isham and Simon are not named in the will, but that frequently happened when the testator had already given that child his portion of the estate, usually at marriage. Simon (and probably his brother, Isham) had their own Franklin Co. household on the 1790 census. (Note: interactions with the Sanders family occurred only with brother Nathaniel Perry's family and help distinguish between Perry brothers descendants.) Nathaniel's 1790 cen-

sus record shows 3 males under 16 in his household. The author and researcher of this article believes two of these sons were James Perry and Nathaniel Perry, both of whom moved into Little River District of Wake Co. but retained their Franklin Co. land until their deaths.

It is extremely likely that Isham or Simon or both had children before their death. Simon obtained land in 1786 (100 acres from the state of NC) on the waters of Cypress Creek. He also is listed in the 1790 census, but then we cannot find any additional records of him. The author and researcher of this article believes he was the father of Benjamin Perry, below.

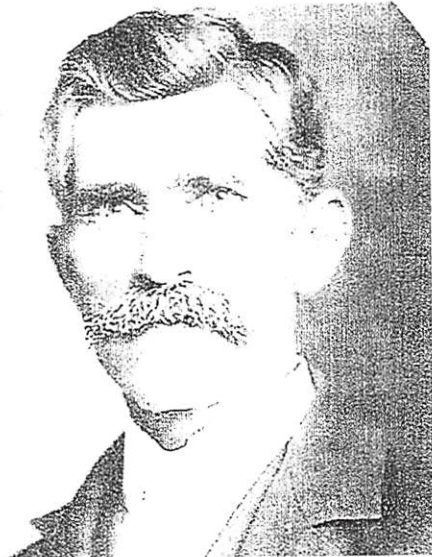
Benjamin Perry was born about 1778 probably in Bute County as Franklin was formed the following year. He married Nancy (surname unknown), and they bought 40 acres of land May 28, 1803, from James Perry (of Franklin Co. and Wake Co.). Benjamin and Nancy had the following children: Elizabeth, Abraham, Wilson, Isham, Kimbrough, and Lloyd Bryant. In 1817, Nancy starts paying the taxes on the land, most likely indicating that Benjamin had died (he does not show up in records again after this date). Wilson later begins paying the taxes on this land; October 16, 1843, all the children sold this land to Ephraim Perry, son of James (from whom Benjamin had bought the land).

Descendants of this family had extensive interactions with James Perry of Franklin Co. and Little River District Wake County and Nathaniel Perry.

Wilson was born about 1814. He married Amanda Carter, January 10, 1837, in Franklin Co. Their children were Mitian, Jane, Pennina, Burrell, Redden, Green, and John. Redden was born, June 22, 1852, in Franklin Co. He married Nancy Helen Denton, July 22, 1875, in Franklin Co. at her mother's house (Cynthia Denton). Redden's and Nancy's children were Miley, Roxanna, Festus, Martha Rae, and Louisa. Miley was born, May 7, 1876 on a farm owned by his father, Redden. This farm was located in Neuse Township, Wake County. After several moves to different farms they settled on a small farm in Saint Mary's Township, in Auburn, N.C. In about 1900, Miley moved to the Swift Creek area of Wake County renting a 169 acre farm. The following year he purchased this farm. He then met and married Bessie Estille Upchurch (daughter of Bartley Jefferson Upchurch and Aurora Olanda Ray) on December 19, 1900 in Wake County. (Note: Bartley Jefferson Upchurch and Aurora Ray married in northern Wake County but moved in 1870 to Swift Creek Township, Wake County.) In later years, he bought two more farms. Miley was diversified in his farming operation, cotton being his main crop.

The children of Miley and Bessie were: Clyde Mancy, Alton Owen, Percy Barrett, Lena Upchurch and Frances Lane. Alton Owen Perry was my father. He was born July 17, 1904. He married Anne Elizabeth Bryan, November 26, 1942. He was a cotton buyer for L.M. Parker and Company and a dairy farmer until his death on July 2, 1982. I married Nancy Belle Allison: we have two children, Allison Banks and Alton Owen Perry, III.

(When all the 7 brothers bought their original land in present-day Franklin County all the land touched each other except possibly Joshua's, whose land was in the northeast corner of the county.)
