△ NATHAN MILLS

Nathan Mills, son of Naaman Mills and _____, was born 1792 in Edgecombe Co., NC, and died 10 Aug 1875. He married 19 Dec 1817 Celia Morgan (b ca 1798, d ca 1834). They were married in Wake Co., NC - bondsman was Nathan's brother, Shadrack Mills. Nathan, Celia, and Candis (2nd wife) are buried at Mills Fam. Cem., Apex, NC. Nathan and Candis' gravesites are marked with concrete gravestones manufactured by the author, which were installed 23 Mar 1994. Celia's gravesite is marked with a fieldstone.

On 1 Jun 1825, Nathan purchased a 20 acre tract of land from Rial Ferrell for \$40. On 1 Aug 1832, he purchased a 160 acre tract from Rial Ferrell for \$228.75. On 24 Jan 1840, Nathan purchased a 106 acre tract from his brother, Shadrack for \$107. These three tracts are located in western Wake Co., NC. Nathan owned this land until he died in 1875, and it was divided according to his will. For more info see ch. THE LAY OF THE LAND ALONG WHITE OAK CREEK.

After Celia's death, Nathan married secondly 20 May 1835 Candis Wilson (b ca 1810, d May 1894), daughter of John Wilson and Sarah Hobby, of Chatham Co., NC. They were married in Wake Co., NC - bondsman was Seth Jinks. Nathan's brother, Shadrack had married Candis' sister, Martha "Patsy" Wilson ca 1820. Two MILLS brothers had married two WILSON sisters.

Nathan's father, Naaman Mills died 2 Sep 1835. Nathan served as security when his brother, John was appointed as administrator of Naaman's estate, as documented by Wake Co., NC CPQS (Nov. 1836-pg. 511): "Ordered that John Mills be appointed administrator on the estate of Naaman Mills, deceased, who enters into bond in the sum of one hundred dollars, with Seth Jinks and Nathan Mills as securities, and comes into open court & qualified according to law."

In 1842 and 1844, Nathan served on the Grand Jury. For more info see ch. COURT DATES ETCHED IN TIME (Nov 1841-pg. 476), (Feb 1842-pg. 12), (May 1844-pg. 327), and (Aug 1844-pg. 341).

Nathan was a farmer. They resided in Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) on FC/1830-1880. In 1850, Nathan owned real estate valued at \$306. In 1860, he owned real estate valued at \$500 and a personal estate valued at \$1,122. In 1870, Nathan owned real estate valued at \$1,300 and a personal estate valued at \$1,000.

The FC/1850-1880 contained the following info on the Agricultural Schedules regarding Nathan's farm. His son, William operated the farm during 1880:

1850 - 50 acres of improved land. 160 acres of unimproved land. Cash value of farm - \$306. Value of farming machinery and implements - \$10. 3 horses. 4 milch cows. 5 other cattle. 24 sheep. 50 swine. Value of livestock - \$206. 22 bu. wheat. 450 bu. Indian corn. 8 bu. peas and beans. 30 bu. sweet potatoes. 15 lbs. butter. 2 tons of hay. Value of animals slaughtered - \$30.

1860 - 50 acres of improved land. 159 acres of unimproved land. Cash value of farm - \$500. Value of farming machinery and implements - \$50. 3 horses. 3 milch cows. 1 working ox. 4 other cattle. 11 sheep. 37 swine. Value of livestock - \$382. 42 bu. wheat. 351 bu. Indian corn. 40 lbs. tobacco. 6 lbs. wool. 20 bu. peas and beans. 100 bu. sweet potatoes. Value of orchard products - \$15. 52 lbs. butter. 3 tons of hay. Value of homemade manufactures - \$10. Value of animals slaughtered - \$160.

1870 - 50 acres of improved land. 120 acres of woodland. 140 acres of other unimproved land. Present cash value of farm - \$2,000. Present value of farming implements and machinery - \$75. 2 horses. 1 mules and asses. 3 milch cows. 5 other cattle. 4 sheep. 25 swine. Value of all livestock - \$340. 30 bu. spring wheat. 125 bu. Indian corn. 40 bu. oats. 18 lbs. tobacco. 11 450-lb. bales of cotton. 30 lbs. wool. 10 bu. Irish potatoes. 150 bu. sweet potatoes. 100 lbs. butter. 3 lbs. beeswax. 100 lbs. honey. Value of home manufactures - \$50. Value of animals slaughtered or sold for slaughter - \$700. Estimated value of all farm production, including betterments and additions to stock - \$2,500.

1880 - 35 acres of tilled land. 50 acres of woodland and forest. 130 acres of other unimproved land. Value of farm, including land, fences and buildings - \$1,600. Value of farming implements and machinery - \$35. Value of livestock - \$150. Cost of fertilizers purchased in 1879 - \$30. 10 weeks of colored hired labor in 1879 upon farm. Estimated value of all farm productions sold, consumed, or on hand for 1879 - \$500. 1 horses of all ages on hand 1 Jun 1880.

Candis' father, John Wilson left his will 15 Apr 1859, and appointed Nathan to be co-executor. Transcribed portions of that will follow:

Item 3rd - "I give and devise unto my daughter Candis Mills (the wife of Nathan Mills) the first chosed bed, bed-stead & furniture, to have and to hold to her and her heirs forever."

Item 7th - "I desire that at the death of my beloved wife Sarah Wilson, all my property of every description & kind not herein before mentioned, shall be sold or equally divided between my son William B. Wilson & Candis Mills, to them, their heirs to hold and have forever."

"And lastly, I do hereby constitute and appoint my son William B. Wilson, and son-in-law Nathan Mills, my lawful executors, to all intents and purposes, to execute this my last will & testament according to the true intent and meaning of the same, and every part and clause thereof, hereby revoking and declaring utterly void, all other wills and testaments by me made heretofore."

At least four of Nathan's sons served in the Confederate Army during the Civil War - Green Clemmons, Britton T., Joseph Hinton, and Nathan Manly Mills. For more info see ch. GRANDSONS OF NAAMAN MILLS: SOLDIERS IN THE CIVIL WAR.

On 14 Mar 1872, Nathan left his will in Wake Co., NC. Following is a transcript:

March 14th A.D. 1872

In the name of God Amen

I Nathan Mills of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina, being of sound mind and memory, considering the certainty of death & the uncertainty of life, do make this my last will which is as follows to (wit)

1st - That my executor herein after mentioned shall give my body a decent burial, suitable to the wishes of my family, and pay all funeral expenses together with all my just debts.

2nd - I give to my beloved wife Candis Mills, all of my property, both real and personal, not otherwise disposed of in this will, her lifetime or widowhood.

3rd - I give to my two sons Nathan M. Mills and John Haywood Mills, all of the land that I bought of Henry Jones, containing about one hundred & eight acres, to be equally divided.

4th - I give to my son William H. Mills, sixty acres of my home tract on the north end of my land, running the line east and west, so as to contain sixty acres.

5th - I give to the heirs of James Mills, deceased, two dollars each in money.

6th - I give to my son Green Mills, ten dollars in money.

7th - I give to my son Britton Mills, twenty dollars in money.

8th - I give to my daughter Martha Babb, ten dollars in money.

9th - I give to my son Joseph H. Mills, ten dollars in money.

Item 10th - I give to my daughter Julia An Mills, sixty dollars in money.

Item 11th - I give to my daughter Aneliza Sears, two dollars in money.

Item 12th - I give to my daughter Isley Jane Mills, sixty dollars in money.

Item 13th - The remainder of my real estate not disposed of in this will, to be equally divided between my four sons to wit, Joseph H. Mills, Nathan M. Mills, John Haywood Mills and William H. Mills, and the remainder of my personal property to be equally divided between Joseph H. Mills, Nathan M. Mills, John Haywood Mills, William H. Mills, Martha Babb, Julia An Mills, Aneliza Sears and Isley Jane Mills. Julia & Jane is to have a home on my old land until they get married or die.

Item 14th - In case I should not give my son William H. Mills a horse or mule in my lifetime, he is to have one hundred dollars before my personal property is divided.

Item 15th - In case I should not give my son Nathan M. Mills a horse or mule in my lifetime, he is to have fifty dollars before my personal property is divided.

Item 16th - I leave my sons Joseph H. Mills & Nathan M. Mills executors to this my last will.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal, March 14th A.D. 1872. Nathan (X his mark) Mills.

Nathan died 10 Aug 1875, and was later buried at Mills Family Cemetery, Apex, NC. The following info is from his loose estate records at the NC State Archives:

On 12 Aug 1875, Joseph H. and Nathan M. Mills applied for Letters Testamentary at the Wake Co., NC Probate Court. The application stated that: "the property of the said Nathan Mills, consisting of real & personal property is worth about \$1,200 so far as can be ascertained at the date of this application." During the settlement of Nathan's estate, funds were disbursed to the family members mentioned in his will. Various legal fees and the following were also paid: On 23 Oct 1875, Nathan's physician, Dr. John E. Fearrington was paid for "medical attendance from July the 8th 1875 to August the 10th 1875 - to thirteen visits at two dollars a trip - \$26". On 11 Oct 1875, J.R. Maynard was paid \$14 for providing a coffin for Nathan. An inventory of Nathan's estate is transcribed below:

INVENTORY OF THE ESTATE OF NATHAN MILLS, DECEASED.

About 198 acres of land in Wake County, adjoining the lands of Basil Yates, Jos. Johnson, N.M. Mills & others. One horse. Six head of cattle. 14 head of hogs. 19 head of sheep. 4 beds & furniture. 1 side board. 1 clock. Lot of cooking utensils. 13 chairs. One rifle-gun. 1 loom. 1 spinning wheel. 1 wagon & harness. 1 cart & harness. 1 carriage. Lot of farming tools (including 4 plows, 2 sweeps, & 1 harrow).

Joseph H. Mills makes oath that the above is a true & correct counting of the property estate & effects belonging to the estate of said Nathan Mills, that were on hand at the time of his death. Qualification of said J.H. Mills and Nathan M. Mills as his executors.

J.H. Mills, extr.
Sworn & subscribed before me this 11th Nov. 1875.
J.N. Bunting, Probate Judge.

The final settlement of Nathan's estate was made 11 Aug 1877, which is recorded in Wake Co., NC Record of Settlements on pgs. 442 & 443. Candis lived at the homeplace for 19 years after Nathan's death. In May 1894, she died and was laid to rest beside Nathan. Following is an account of the estate sale:

ACCOUNT SALES OF PERSONALITY OF NATHAN MILLS' ESTATE, which was given by his will to his widow for life. She died in May 1894, and the executors of Nathan Mills sold this property October 5th 1894, by Joseph H. Mills & Nathan M. Mills, executors of Nathan Mills.

Nathan lived to about age 83. The author is hopeful that Nathan's descendants will someday place a "proper" tombstone on his gravesite. The gravesites of Nathan's twelve children have all been marked. Eight of them are buried at Mills Family Cemetery, Apex, NC. The author manufactured concrete gravestones for: James, Martha, Sarah, and Julia Mills. Green Clemmons, Ann Eliza, and Isley Jane Mills are buried at Olive Chapel Baptist Church Cemetery, Apex, NC. Nathan Manly Mills is buried at Womble Family Cemetery, Apex, NC.

The author is not aware of any photographs of Nathan or Candis. If any exist, a reward will be offered for the opportunity to copy such photographs.

This entry was discovered 23 Sep 1993 while the author was reading the original Wake Co., NC CPQS minutes at the NC State Archives. Until this document was found, no one had successfully become a member of the Daughters of the American Revolution (D.A.R.) under Naaman Mills' lineage. He is now listed in the D.A.R. PATRIOT INDEX.

Naaman's wife died between 1810 and 1830. It is not known if she was alive when Naaman and his family moved to Wake Co., NC about 1812. Perhaps she may have died about 1811 and this is what triggered Naaman to move away from Edgecombe Co., NC.

Naaman Mills and his wife had at least 10 children and 51 grand children. During 1996, eight generations of Naaman's descendants number well into the thousands - many of them are listed in this book.

Of the 4 children of his first wife the heirs of JAMES MILLS who died in 1856 were left \$2 each - not much GREEN CLEMONS MILLS & BRITTON T. MILLS were left \$10 & \$20 respectively. The 4th child MARTHA L. (MILLS) BABB was left \$10 and shared in the non real estate residue.

Fuller, a witness thereto." Deed recorded 20 Mar 1841 in Wake Co., NC Deed Book 14, pg. 321. A transcript of the 1840 deed follows:

SHADRACK MILLS TO NATHAN MILLS } This indenture made this twenty fourth day of Jan. one thousand eight hundred and forty, between Shadrack Mills of the one part and Nathan Mills of the other part, both of the County of Wake and State of North Carolina. Witnesseth that the Shadrack Mills for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seven dollars, to him in hand, paid by the said Nathan Mills, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, doth give, grant, bargain and sell, and by these presents hath given, granted, bargained and sold unto the aforesaid Nathan Mills, one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being situate in the county and state aforesaid on the waters of White Oak Creek, and bounded as follows, viz, beginning at a sassafras on White Oak Creek and running south to a stake, Whitney Upchurch's corner, thence east to the spring branch, James Mills' line, thence north along down said branch to White Oak Creek, said Nathan Mills' line, thence down said creek to the beginning, containing one hundred and six acres, more or less. To have & to hold the above bounded land and premises to the only proper use and behoof of the said Nathan Mills, his heirs and assigns the right & title whereof I do for myself, my heirs, and assigns forever warrant and defend, in testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal.

His highest rank attained was Private. Nathan served in the 7th NC Regiment, Co. G, known as "Wake Rangers". This Co. was from Wake Co. and organized at Cedar Fork. They were ordered to Petersburg, VA 17 Jun 1864 and arrived the next day. 22 Jun 1864 the 7th NC was engaged with Union troops at Weldon Railroad and prevented a Union lodgement. 28 Jul 1864 they were engaged at Gravel Hill. 16 Aug 1864 Nathan & Co. were engaged at Fussell's

Mill. 25 Aug 1864 they were engaged at Reams' Station, and then moved to Petersburg. 30 Sep 1864 the 7th NC was engaged at Jones' Farm. Mid Nov 1864 they went into winter quarters near the Jones House.

26 Feb 1865 Nathan & Co. moved to High Point, NC by railroad. 5 Apr 1865 they moved to Danville, VA and 11 Apr 1865 were ordered to Greensboro, NC. 16 Apr 1865 the 7th NC was assigned to D.H. Hill's Division, Army of Tennessee. 19-24 Apr 1865 they rebuilt the railroad bridge across Deep River. 26 Apr 1865 the Army of Tennessee was surrendered and the 7th NC Regiment was a mere skeleton of its former self, with only 13 officers and 139 men. 1 May 1865 Nathan was paroled near Greensboro, NC and returned home to Wake Co., NC.

7 Jul 1924 Nathan applied for a soldier's pension from the State of NC, for his service during the Civil War. He made the application in Wake Co., NC. Arch J. Wood was Nathan's witness, and the application was approved. Nathan died a few months later.
