A brief genealogy of the Johnston family, timelines of the mill establishment and operations, aerial photographs, and maps are provided at the beginning of the publication. What follows is a very detailed, chronological history of the mill, which is accentuated with photographs of the mill remnants, drawings, plats, maps, deed transcripts, and images of original documents held at the North Carolina State Archives. Other families mentioned in the publication include Allen, Blackwood, Couch, Hogan, King, Mullholland, Patterson, Tate, and Young. This book is an amazing collection of information, and Mr. Dunaway should be commended for his hard work. Researchers with Orange County ancestors would find this publication useful—not only for its family history data, but as a good example of how genealogical and historical information can be combined to create a solid, interesting family history.

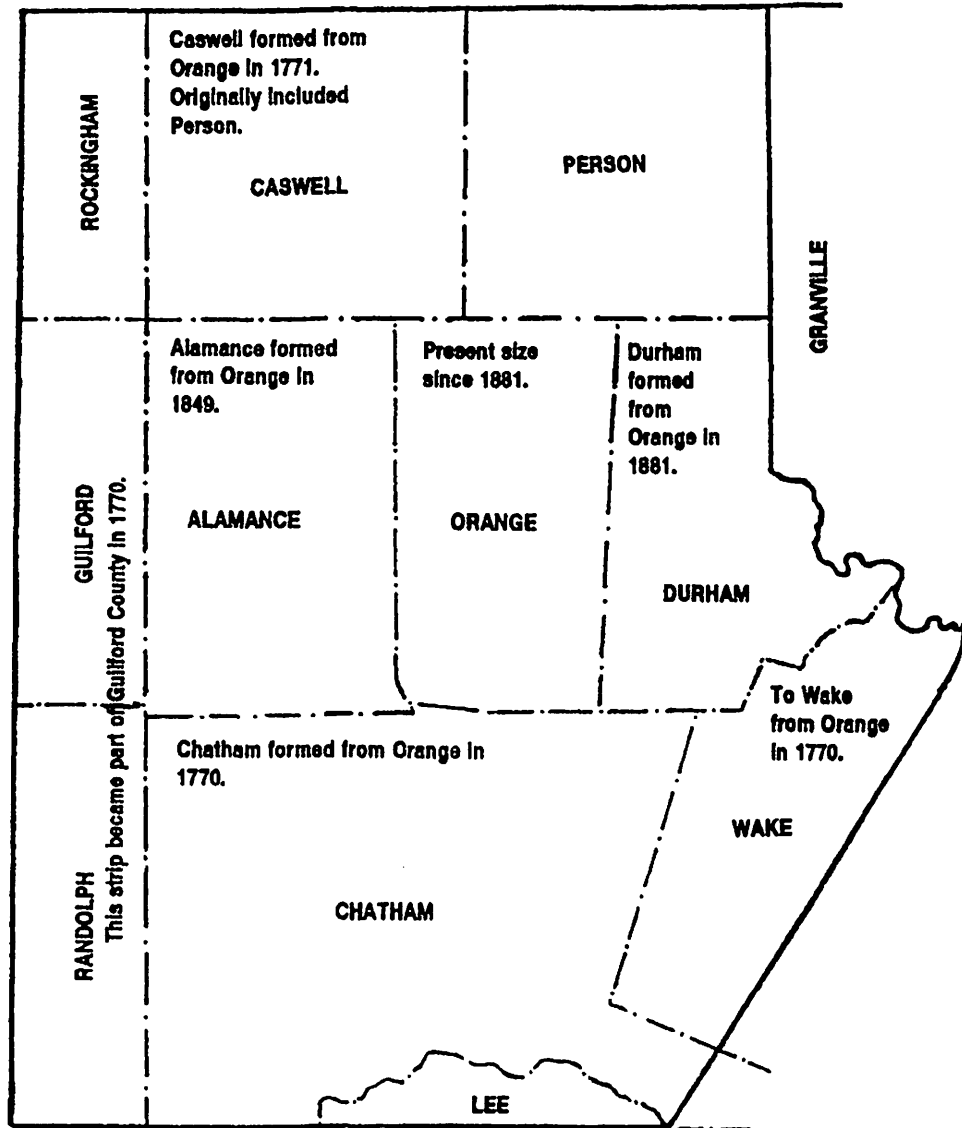
File View #2 shows the evolution of the original counties in the area by date, with the present day counties outlined with dotted lines. (Source: Orange County Records, Volume I, Granville Proprietary Land Office, Abstracts of Loose Papers, ed. by William D. Bennett, 1987.) Of particular importance are the locations of major watercourses. It appears that the original counties were marked off to include the drainage basins of key watercourses, e.g., for Craven Co, it was the Neuse River basin, for Bladen Co, it was the Cape Fear River basin. Each basin includes the major river flowing to the coast plus all the feeder stream networks flowing into it. Jim.

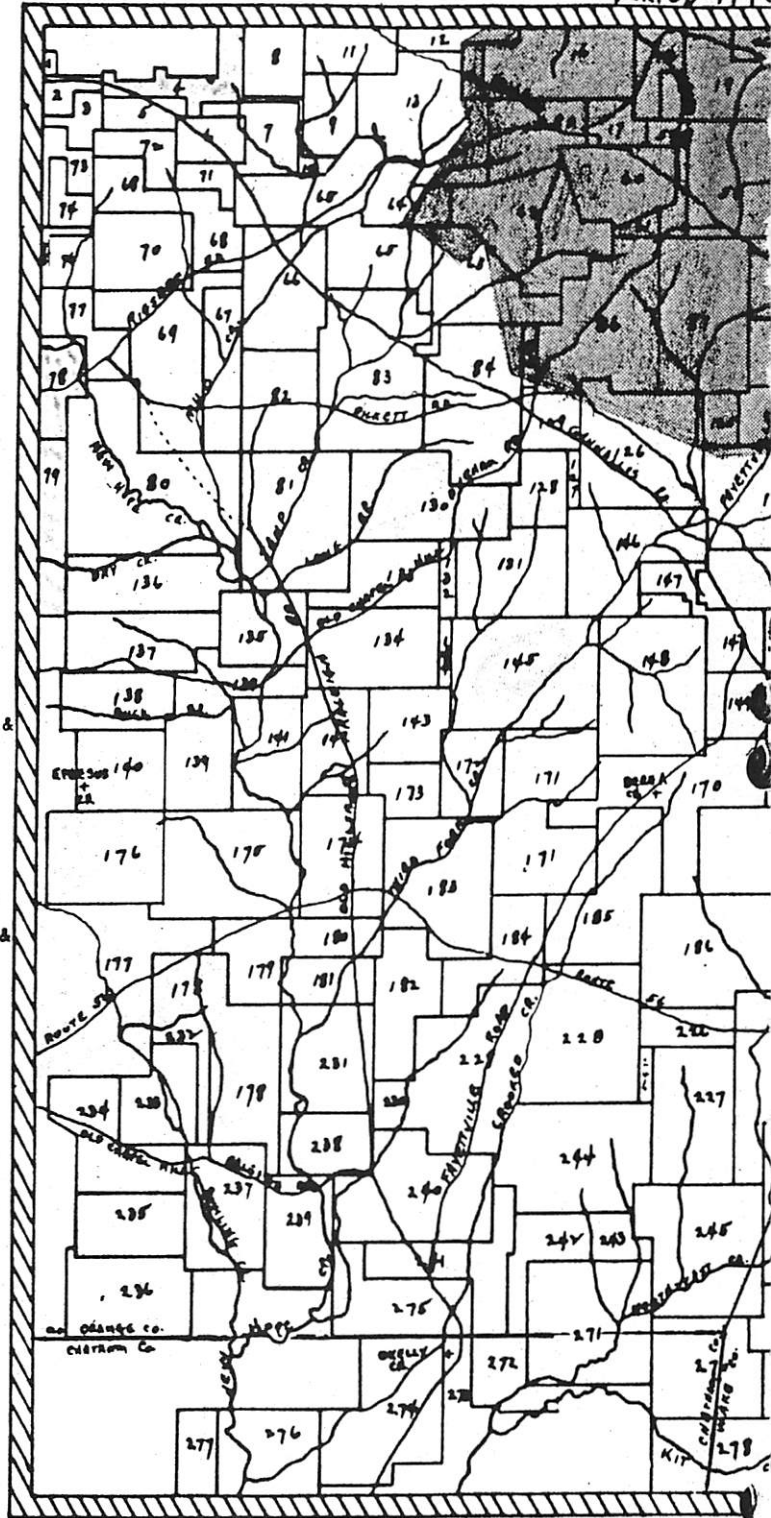
MAP OF CHAPEL HILL

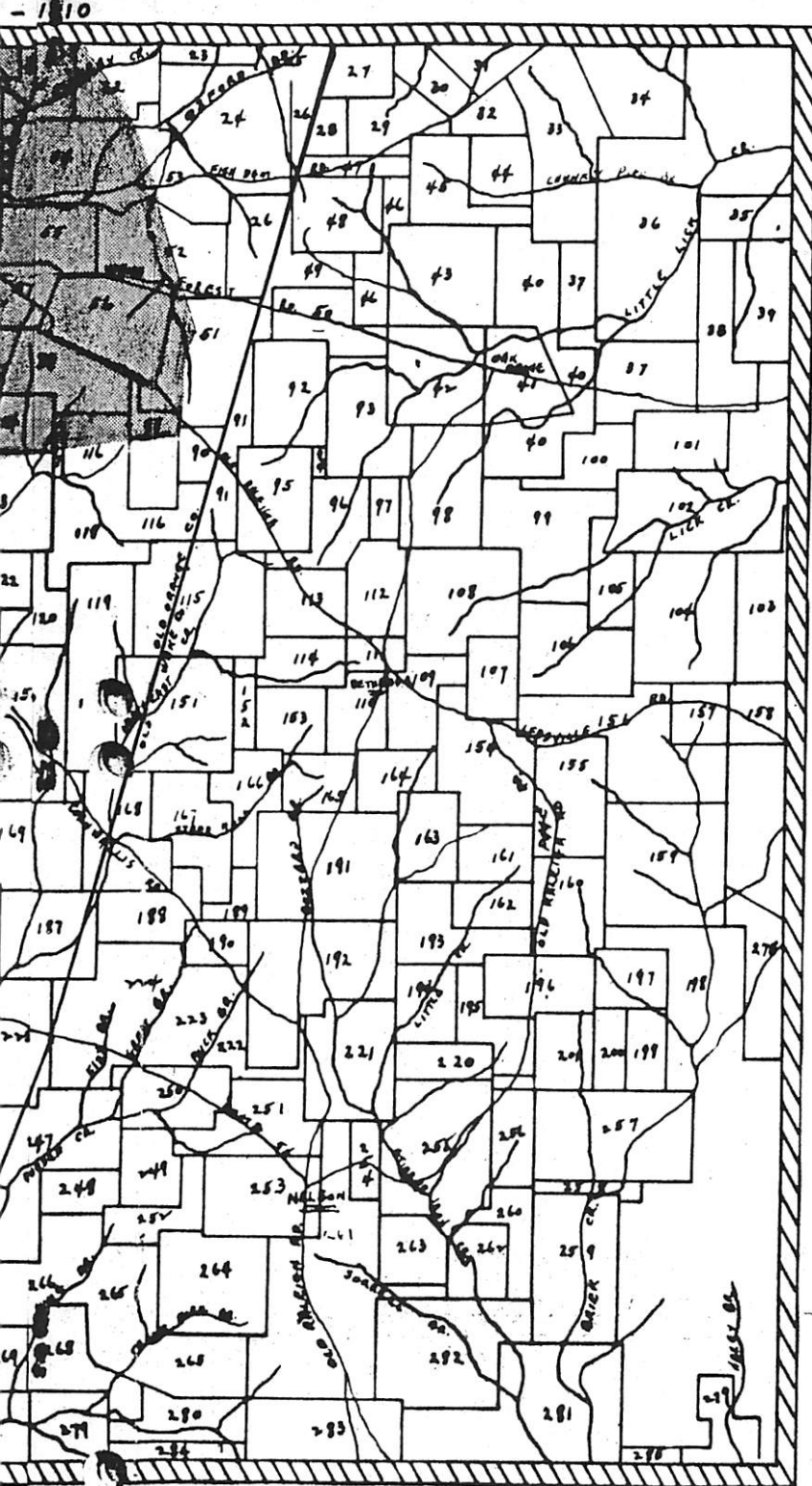

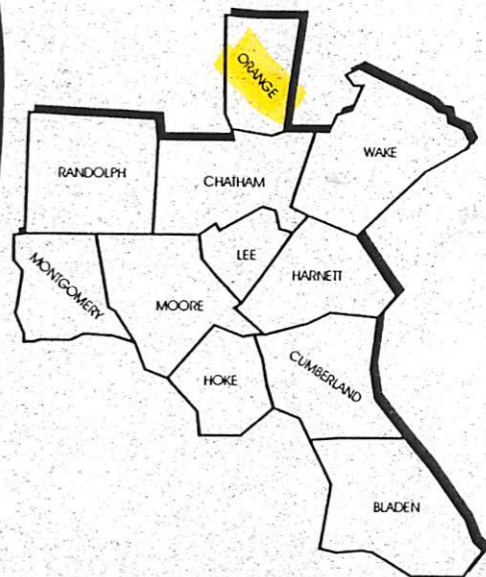

Historic Hillsborough

In Hillsborough, an old grain silo stands near stylish condominiums, and contemporary homes stand next to 200-year-old historic landmarks. The old sits next to the new, and sometimes, they are one and the same.

From the time American Indians made this area the center of their trading to present-day activities where the townspeople live and work in 200-year-old buildings, something's always happening in Hillsborough.

Near the Eno River in Orange County, Hillsborough has been a center of activity since the late 1600s, when Occaneechi Indians fled from Virginia and gathered here to trade with other tribes.

But the Occaneechi weren't the only

people who moved south and decided to make North Carolina home. Between 1740 and 1752, settlers from the North, mostly Scotch-Irish and German emigrants, migrated here. The increased population resulted in the creation of a huge new county, named Orange for the clay soil. In 1754, William Churton surveyed the land for the county seat, and Corbin Town was built. In 1766, Corbin Town was renamed Hillsborough to honor the Earl of Hillsborough, British

secretary of state for the colonies. As time passed, the townspeople affectionately shortened the name to Hillsboro, until 1965, when the North Carolina General Assembly restored the name to Hillsborough. As some people noted, "the ugh was put back."

Meetingplaces

By 1767, Orange County was the most populated county in North Carolina, and Hillsborough had earned the title of the "Capital of the Back Country." Within a few years, the area evolved into a center of political activity. In one of the town's most historic events, a group known as the Regulators protested unfair land taxation by the

English government, and, in a final battle, fought troops led by North Carolina's Governor Tryon. Their loss ended the Regulator movement, and six of their leaders were tried and hanged just outside Hillsborough.

During the Revolutionary War, many great conventions were held in Hillsborough. The Third Provincial Congress of 1775 was attended by 184 representatives who provided for an army and regional government, and after the colonies declared independence from Great Britain, five general assemblies met here.

The most notable meeting here occurred in 1788 when the North Carolina delegation to the Constitutional Convention met to ratify the U.S. Constitution, which has a Bill of Rights thanks to their recommendation.

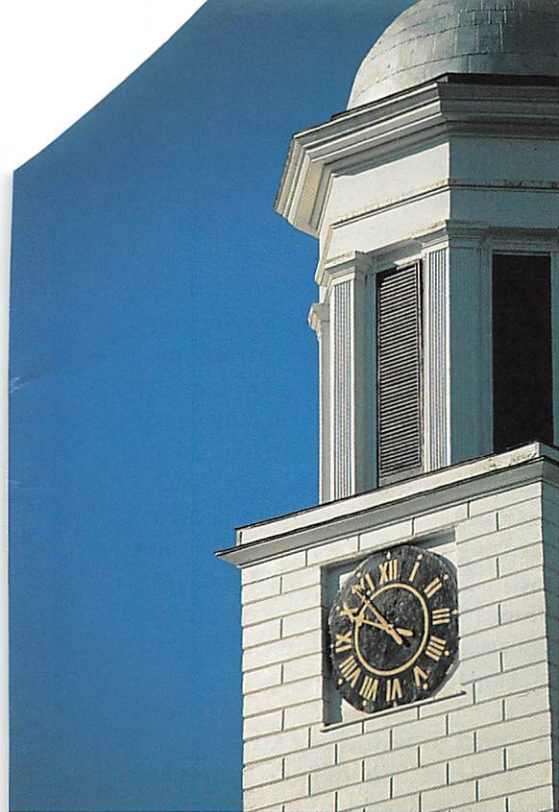
Hillsborough uses an old and a courthouse to function as Orange County's seat. One is an architectural masterpiece built in 1845. This red brick, Greek Revival structure is accented with doric columns, hand-forged window panes, and a cupola that contains the town clock — one of the most famous in North Carolina and a purported facsimile of Philadelphia's Independence Hall clock. Many believe the town clock was made in Birmingham, England, and was given to the town in 1769 by a representative of King George III. According to legend, just before a Tory raid in 1781, the townspeople hid parts of the clock in the Eno River so it could not be melted for ammunition.

The path of history

Today, people continue to move to Hillsborough. As Craig Lloyd, executive

director of the chamber of commerce, explains, "They get that orange clay soil between their toes and they can't get it out." Residents include young professionals who work in nearby Research Triangle Park, retired university professors, and descendants of families who have lived here for 200 to 300 years.

In Hillsborough, the old sits next to the new, and sometimes, like the visitor's center and chamber of commerce, they are one and the same. Located in the 230-year-old Dickson House on King Street, this is the best place to start a tour to Hillsborough. Excellent information on self-guided walking tours is available, and for those who would rather ride, mobile guided tours also are available. And as the spot where Confederate General Johnson met with leaders before negotiating his surrender to General Sherman, ending Confederate resistance in the middle South, the Dickson House itself is worth noting.

Hillsborough and the surrounding area exhibit a variety of architectural styles, including more than 75 buildings from the 1700s, 1800s, and early 1900s. More than a dozen are on the National Register of Historic Places and one, the Nash-Hooper House, is a National Historic Landmark. The beautiful downtown area is a designated National Historic District.



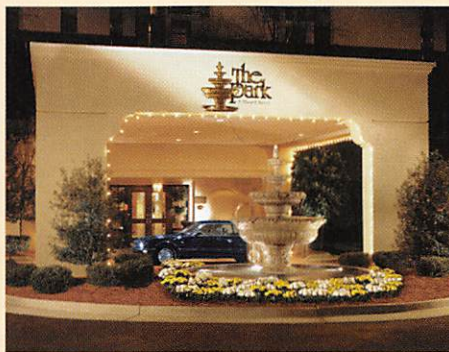
On West Queen Street stands the stately Hasell Nash House, also known as Pilgrim's Rest. Built in 1819 by Eliza Hasell, the house is one of Hillsborough's most sophisticated.

The spirit of Hillsborough resides in these old buildings. "The charm of Hillsborough is that it has maintained its historical and architectural integrity while remaining a livable community," says Cathleen Turner, executive director of the Alliance for Historic Hillsborough.

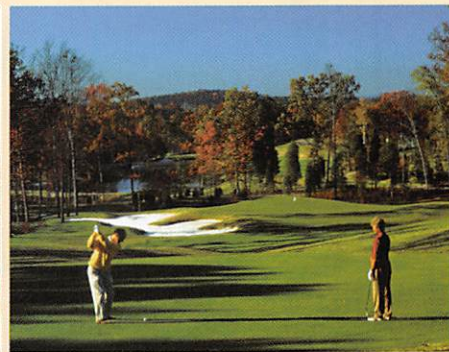
A prime example is the town hall, also called the Ruffin-Roulhac House, built in 1803 and restored through the hard work of the community. In the town hall, the mayor's office is in the dining room; the tax office is in the kitchen.

The town's most sophisticated house is

Keeping HILLSBOROUGH HISTORIC

THE RICHNESS OF THIS ONE-TIME CULTURAL AND GOVERNMENTAL OUTPOST OF YEARS AGO HAS BEEN WELL-PRESERVED.

A visit to historic Hillsborough reveals an important truth: something old is much better than something new.

Dating back to 1754, when William Churton laid out the first lots, the town is a study of how history's homes, gardens and public buildings are not only preserved but used in the context of today.

Hillsborough's historic district features at least 100 structures built in the late 18th and early 19th centuries. The homes, for the most part, still serve as private residences. Congregations still gather in the churches each Sunday, and court continues to be held in parts of the Old Orange County Courthouse. Circa 1844. The Colonial Inn, built as a tavern in 1759, still offers fine food and lodging.

Other examples abound. The Alexander Dickson House, where Confederate General Wade Hampton and his troops camped in the latter days of the Civil War, is now the site of the Hillsborough Chamber of Commerce and the Orange County

Visitors Center.

The Ruffin-Roulhac House, once part of a 10-acre estate in the 1820s, served for a time as the home of North Carolina Chief Justice Thomas Ruffin. He died there in 1870. The house and its various outbuildings now serve as Hillsborough's Town Hall. Residents routinely go there to pay their water bills, to apply for permits and to air their gripes at meetings of the town commissioners.

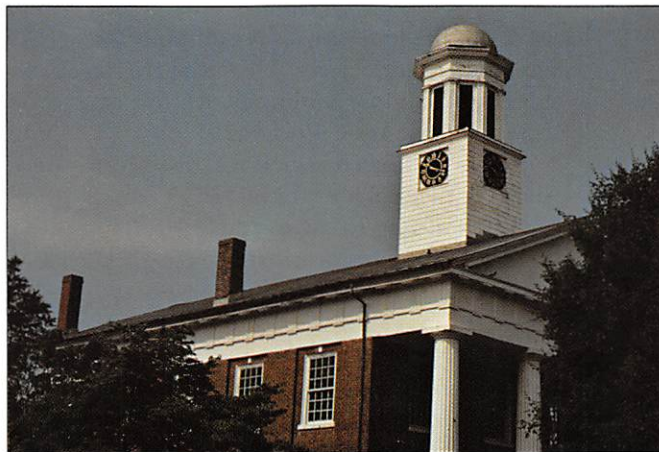
The Hillsborough Historical Society, fittingly enough, is housed in Ruffin's law office in the back yard of the main

house that now serves as town hall offices.

"To me, Hillsborough is certainly atypical of small towns" in North Carolina, says Clarence Jones, a local historian and member of the historical society. "Most small towns grow out of something that stimulates or attracts growth, like a seaport or a cotton gin or a railroad . . . while Hillsborough was a planned community."

"For so much of the land around here, the deeds are from Lord Granville," Jones says. "William Churton was handling those transactions. I suppose as a bonus or something, Lord Granville gave him 400 acres of land. He could have farmed it, or he could have sold it. Instead, he conceived of the idea of laying out a town.

"Some of the lots he sold were sold to well-to-do people. Hillsborough would become a western outpost of North Carolina, both in government, politics and community activities, too. Particularly politicians wanted to be here. It's had a certain culture a lot of towns wouldn't have probably for 100 years."

HILLSBOROUGH'S HOLIDAY SHOWCASE: THE CHRISTMAS CANDLELIGHT TOUR

For a glimpse behind a few of Hillsborough's finest homes, catch the Christmas Candlelight Tour set for Sunday, December 5 from 1 to 7 p.m.

The tour traditionally includes both historic and contemporary homes, churches and public buildings. It gives Hillsborough a chance to show off its Christmas finery and celebrate the holidays through intimate concerts at sites throughout the tour.

The afternoon includes a yule-log lighting ceremony at the Burwell School, caroling at the Alexander Dickson House and a tree lighting ceremony at the Old Courthouse. The day ends with the lighting of luminaria. The tour can easily be walked, but free shuttle service is also provided.

The event, now in its seventh year, is sponsored by the Hillsborough Chamber of Commerce.

"We try to have a range of homes that span the history of Hillsborough," says Tony Cain, co-chairman of this year's event. "We don't limit ourselves to the old homes in the Christmas tour."

The tour celebrates Hillsborough's history and its modern-day use of historic buildings.

"We have 75 to 100 structures 100 years old or better," says Sara McKee, who owns the historic Colonial Inn with her husband, Carlton. "It has

been lived in continuously and not been rebuilt. It's a living history. You can see the houses with the different periods represented. In one house you may have a Colonial structure with Victorian windows and a Victorian staircase."

Among the highlights of the tour this year is Ayr Mount, considered one of the finest early houses in Hillsborough. Built in 1815 by merchant and planter William Kirkland, the house served as home for Kirklands until 1975. Its present owner painstakingly researched the location of original outbuildings and restored the original landscaping design.

Regular stops on the walking tour each year include some of Hillsborough's oldest churches. Hillsborough United Methodist Church, dedicated in 1861, still has its original pews, pulpit and Bible. The congregation of First Baptist Church laid its cornerstone in 1860. Both were designed and built by architect John Berry, who also is responsible for Hillsborough's most famous landmark, the Old Courthouse, erected in 1844.

St. Matthew's Episcopal Church,

built in 1824, features eight stained-glass memorial windows, including one of early Tiffany glass. Dickerson's Chapel, bricked in 1947, is actually the old frame courthouse built in 1790. It was purchased and moved to its current site by the Baptists in 1845. It became an A.M.E. church in 1862.

The Alexander Dickson House, home of the chamber of commerce and the Orange County Visitor's Center, is a classic late-18th century farmhouse and

part of Civil War history. The Ruffin-Roulhac House, now Hillsborough Town Hall, was the last home of Chief Justice Thomas Ruffin, who died there in 1870. And the Colonial Inn has served guests, including British Commander Lord Cornwallis, with food and lodging since 1759.

The tour is a community-wide effort, with performances by the high school brass ensemble, local musicians and church choirs. Civic clubs sponsor the various ceremonies, and countless volunteers work at the sites. Light refreshments are available at the Burwell School, but downtown also features a number of quaint cafes and restaurants.

uated strategically between Interstate 85 and Interstate 40 north of Research Triangle Park. Hillsborough and the surrounding area seems destined to grow.

Townpeople wrestle with the drain growth has placed on water supplies as well as roadways. Voluntary water restrictions are generally routine by late summer. And the N.C. Department of Transportation prevailed where the railroads did not. State Highway 86 runs down the center of town on Churton Street, and it serves as a route for heavy truck traffic to Virginia. State officials have promised a bypass around Hillsborough now for 20

years.

But the influence of the Hillsborough Historical Society has helped shape public and government opinion on preservation. In the 1940s and '50s, the Hillsborough Garden Club hosted home and garden tours, and in 1956 it established the Orange County Historical Museum. The Hillsborough Historical Society, formed in 1962, evolved from those efforts.

Today, a town-affiliated Historic Hillsborough Commission oversees the district, ensuring that property owners maintain strict standards on everything

from signs to the color of exterior paint. A tree commission even keeps an eye on the district's trees.

"You better not cut down a tree without permission in the historic district," Jones says with a laugh. "You would have thought that with such strict things as that people would have bucked up. But it has gone very well, and people have cooperated wonderfully with it."

William Churton would have been proud.
