

We the undersigned Commissioners, having met on the premises of St. Emory Lewin deceased together with R. B. Clegg, on this the 29<sup>th</sup> day of September 1887. After being duly sworn proceeded to lay off, divide and allot said lands as per order of Court as follows.

Lot No 1

Beginning at a Stake and point in on Pitts Creek, John W. Upchurch corner. Thence North 88° West with his line 78 poles to a stake his corner in Martin Lewins heirs line. Thence North 3° East with said line 79 poles to a dogwood. Thence South 87° East 95 poles to a pine stump and point on Pitts Creek. Thence down the meanderings of said Creek to the beginning estimated to contain 43 Acres and valued at \$258.00 and is to pay to Lot No 3 \$28.00 and was drawn by Barber Lewin as a heir of Lewis Lewin dec'd.

Lot No 2

Beginning at a pine stump and point on Pitts Creek, corner of Lot No 1. Thence North 87° West 95 poles to a dogwood corner of Lot No 1. in Martin Lewins heirs line. Thence North 3° with said line 30 poles to a stake and point in Martin Lewins heirs corner. Thence North 87° West with said heirs line 43 poles to a stake formerly a black gum. the Barber gives corner. Thence North 5 1/2° East with said Barber gives line 39 1/2 poles to stake and point in. Thence South 87° East 104 1/2 poles to a stake and point in from O Lewins line. Thence South 86° West with said line 36 1/2 poles to a pine stump J. O. Lewins corner. Thence South 88° East 41 1/2 poles to a sweet gum. J. O. Lewins corner on Pitts Creek. Thence down the meanderings of said Creek to the beginning estimated to contain 44 1/2 Acres and valued at \$232.00 and is to pay Lot No 3 \$2.00 and was drawn by the heirs of Joseph Lewin dec'd.

Lot No 4

Beginning at a Stake and point in corner of Lot No 2 in J. O. Lewins line. Thence North 87° West line of Lot No 2. 42 1/2 poles to a Pine. Thence North 87° East 105 poles to a stake and point in in Lerner line. Thence South 88° East with said line. and J. O. Lewins line 80 poles to a stake and point in J. O. Lewins corner. Thence South 87° West with J. O. Lewins line 79 poles to a stake. Thence North 88° West with J. O. Lewins line 36 Poles to a stone formerly a Red Oak, and pine J. O. Lewins corner. Thence South 4° West with J. O. Lewins line 27 1/2 poles to the beginning. Estimated to contain 46 Acres and valued at \$230.00 and was drawn by the heirs of Kinchen Lewin deceased.
