Monk reports that Miley Perry owned several hundred acres of land. He had a will which set aside the home tract for his wife (My Aunt Jessie) and he gave the remainder in tracts to his children but with the restriction that the tracts could not be sold but would pass to his grandchildren. However, Monk said lawyers convinced him to sell Percy's tract. Francis did not get a tract right away but eventually got the home place per Miley's will.

Monk says he & Bryan got their inheritance when their father died & they bought other tracts of the original Miley Perry Farm. They traded this for NC State wooded land on Yates Mill Pond Road & built a subdivision there.

Monk says his current tract was bought by his fat from a Mr. -- [Bartley Jefferson] It must have sold it to Mr. --. Monk says Aunt Ellie & Aunt Jessie had 50+ acre tracts on Mid River Road.

FHT says Percy was an epileptic and would have seizures from time-to-time which were then called "spells". FHT saw him have a spell. On these occasions his mother would always be called. A pill had to be placed under his tongue.

FHT reports an one instance in which Percy hit Uncle Frank (Frank senior II). This incident happened on a public road in Durham. FHT did not know the reason for the altercation or follow-on implications, if any.

FHT knows of no special reason Percy would have been involved in the sale of Uncle Moiz' land in 1941 when he had been designated an executor in a will.

DETAILS: George Malcolm A "Uncle Mac" died in 1938. This  
Deed records the disposition of the 37 A (Trust #4) given him by  
his father in 1919 or 1920. It is unclear why it took until 1941  
for the resolution of his estate. It is not clear as to whether  
Uncle Mac left a will or not. However, the Deed in 1941  
shows his nephew P. B. PERRY [PERCY BARRETT PERRY] as being  
the Administrator of the G. Malcolm A, Decedent. Per the Deed  
there had been a Proceedings (special) in the Superior Court of  
Wake Co, NC wherein W. T. SHAW was appointed a Commissioner  
to carry out the order of the court. The Deed shows a Proceeding  
of P. B. Perry, Administrator against the siblings (& their spouses)  
of Uncle Mac (all listed). They would have been heir-at-law  
of Uncle Mac if he left no will. One must have sued for  
distribution of the estate. In any case a sale took place  
on 26 MAY 1941 and L. A. JOHNSON for \$16.74 became high bidder  
for the 37 A [8.56/A] (Trust #4 = Southern part of the 4 1/4 Tracts  
owned by B. J. II on Mid-Triee Rd)

It was bought by two Attorneys - ALDRIDGE & STEWART about 1940. They also got Percy's adjoining 25 Acres.

Monk says there was a spring in the part of the Upchurch Land which was used to keep huts cool. Monk has seen the concrete remnants. He said Uncle Getha reported that it took ~~ten~~ people to operate the churn. There was a path across the field to the B.J.H. home as that is where Riley Perry got his mail. Beyond Perry's 25 Acres there lay 25 Acres on either side of the road. This was land that went to Clyde. Then came the 50 Acre home place which eventually went to Frances. Next came 17 Acres for Lena & Lena got the 60 Acre Pace Tract.





The exceptions of appellants, grouped as assignments of error, as we read them, present only this basic question:  
Did defendant, Percy Barrett Perry, acquire under the will of his father, Miley Perry, an alienable life estate in and to  
the lands sought to be sold in this action?

The trial judge held that he did acquire such life estate, and with the ruling this Court is in agreement.

The contention that the clause reading: "This tract of land is to be held and owned by my said son, Percy Barrett  
Perry, during his natural life . . ." grants a life estate with no power to sell for his life, is untenable. The words "to

"be held and owned" are synonymous with the clause "to have and to hold" common in conveyancing, -- that is, the habendum which defines the extent of the ownership in the thing conveyed to be held and enjoyed by the grantee. The word "hold," as here used and as defined in Black's Law Dictionary, 3rd Edition, means "to possess in virtue of a lawful title, as in the expression, common in grants, 'to have and to hold.'" And the word "own" as here used and as defined by the same author, means to "have a good title; to hold as property; to have a legal or rightful title to; to have; to possess." Thus the clause "to be held and owned" as used in the Miley Perry will merely defines the extent of the ownership in the land devised to be held and enjoyed by devisee, Percy Barrett Perry. It is not a restraint upon alienation of the life estate.

Thus, holding that Percy Barrett Perry acquired, under his father's will, an alienable life estate, the challenge to the sufficiency of his deed to convey to his then wife, the plaintiff, his life estate, must fail as a matter of law. Walker v. Long, 109 N.C. 510, 14 S.E., 299; Fort v. Allen, 110 N.C. 183, 14 S.E., 685; Sydnor v. Boyd, 119 N.C. 481, 26 S.E., 92; McLamb v. McPhail, 126 N.C. 218, 35 S.E. 426.

► X In the Sydnor case, supra, it is stated that while at common law the husband and wife, being deemed one person, were incapable of contracting with each other, and it was necessary to convey to a third person, as a conduit, in order to pass the title to property from one to the other, the wife is now allowed to acquire title to property conveyed to her by the husband. And in the McLamb case, supra, Clark, J., stated that "Now, by virtue of the constitutional provision (Art. X, Sec. 6) it is held that a deed from the husband to the wife is valid."

It may be noted that appellants, in their brief under heading "The petitioner received no vested conveyable interest in the land by said purported deed," say that "the grantor and the grantee (the petitioner) in this instrument were husband and wife at the time the instrument was executed, having taken the lands as tenants by the entirety under a conveyance from L. S. Brassfield, Commissioner." However, as the record on this appeal does not show that the trial judge made any finding of fact as to the authority of the commissioner to make the conveyance or as to what estate it purports to convey, or that he made any conclusion of law in respect thereto, and the appellants not having offered any evidence in respect to it, nor taken exception to the failure of the trial judge to find the facts and state his conclusions of law on facts found, the question as to the legal effect of this conveyance is not presented on this record for decision.

Hence, on the questions presented, the judgment below is

Affirmed.

Disposition

Affirmed.
