Miriam makes the point that William U ↑ of Jackson Co TN and Stephen U of Wilson Co, TN had children named Gilliam. She suggests that a Gilliam (U?) was a neighbor of these people in Chatham Co, NC and that perhaps they came to TN after Samuel U (brother of Stephen U above) made his 1810 trip from TN to VA to Chatham Co, NC and back to TN.

Stephen summarizes his understanding of our knowledge of the family of William U b about 1778 (TN) as follows:

William (sr) is the only Upchurch in Jackson County in the 1820 Census of Middle Tennessee. Two of his children (Thomas and Elizabeth) are born in N.C. (1806 & 1808), and the remainder of his children are born in Tennessee, beginning with Gillum in abt. 1810.

By the 1850 Census, Elizabeth Upchurch, 42, is listed in the household of my 3<sup>rd</sup> ggrandfather, John Morgan Burris. We can assume she never married, as she is listed by my grandaunt May in her journal as being Miss Betty Upchurch and saving the "Hickory Hill" Burris Bible in 1864. In 1864 she would have been 56, and if still a "Miss" @ 56 I think it is safe to assume she never married.

In the 1850 Census, Craven Haywood Upchurch is listed as a 24 year old farmer in the household of Alfred Pryor.

Brother to Elizabeth, William (jr) has married Francis and has children Washington, Job, Emilly, Mary and Gillum.

Sister to Elizabeth, Mary "Polly" has married William Burris and has kids.

So when William Burris' dad has him evicted from the family farm in 1859, Mary "Polly" and sister "Miss" Elizabeth Upchurch move to Hickory Hill, MO.

selected - R P U

Both should have been on
