As Allied Families grows we may add more Allied and Associate families.

I will follow with interest the collaborating you and Jay are going to pursue on behalf of our shared Upchurch interests.

Sgt York was mentioned in the video. His youngest son, Thomas Jefferson York married a descendant of George Upchurch, Margaret Dishman. You will find Margaret's family listed in the Dishman family information. I met Margaret a few years ago. Sgt York's family is still living in the area. Margaret was still living last fall but I didn't get to see her. Her son, "Jeff" was working at the "general store" that is close to the park in Tennessee.

I also saw that you had reviews for some of the Upchurch family books with Riley McGinnis', "The Meal Is Gone" listed. I have a copy of that book. The information may no longer be correct due to the addresses being changed a few years ago for the "911 system". I contacted his daughter-in-law, Janet, to confirm his mailing address, phone number and to also see if he had any more books available to sell. I have not been in contact with Riley for a few years. She said she would ask Riley.

Many of the Upchurch descendants, including Melva Henninger, Riley McGinnis' wife Peggy, and yours truly are Sumpter descendants. General Thomas Sumpter/Sumter was our ancestral uncle. We are descendants of "the Gamecock's" brother, Captain William Sumpter, both of whom were Revolutionary War veterans.

Rev War veteran, Benjamin Hancock, one of his descendants, Elmina Hancock married George Upchurch's descendant, Silas Dishman. Another Rev War veteran, William Doss shared descendants with the George Upchurch clan. I am his descendant. Many of his descendants live in Fentress Co, TN and Wayne Co, KY

...and the list continues. Would this be what you would consider another branch of an "allied family" or just more of a connection?

I am willing to share GEDCOM files for any or all of these families. With over 40,300 individuals listed in the family tree database, I have a lot to share!

Just let me know if you would like for me to share them for the Upchurch family.

\*WILLIAM THOMAS SUMPTER was born 18 Aug 1695, in Bapt, Histon, Cambridge, England.

He died 07 Jul 1752, in Louisa, Virginia. He married Elizabeth Patience Iveson, born 1695 in Histon, Cambridge, England, died 1806. They had three sons who fought and survived the Revolutionary War, Captain William, John and General Thomas, for whom Fort Sumter was named.



General Thomas Sumpter by Charles Mason Crowson, in the Museum-Archives of the Sumter County Historical Society. He married Marie Louise Stephanie Beatrix Natalie duLage de Volode from France in 1802. Many relatives in Wayne County, Kentucky.

John E. H. Lowe is buried in Mulhall OK. The following is from the pension record of John E. H. Lowe.  
 "On this 8th day of Nov. 1889, personally appeared before me, the undersigned, a Notary Public in and  
 for the county and state aforesaid, John E. H. Lowe, aged 49 years, a resident of Belle Plaine, Sumner  
 County and State of Kansas, who being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is a pensioner of  
 the United States, duly enrolled at the rate of eight dollars per month, under pension certificate n. 197521,  
 by reason of right ingru?nal hernia, incurred in the service of the United States while a private of Co. "H",  
 1st Kentucky Cavalry vols. That his pension was first granted for above disability and was to commence  
 January 1st, 1865, at the rate of four dollars per month and continued at that rate to April 3rd 1884 at  
 which latter date is was raised to eight dollars per month. That he believes himself to be entitled to eight  
 dollars per month instead of only four, from January 1st 1865 to April 3rd 1884; wherefore he asks that he  
 be allowed four dollars per month from said January 1st 1865 to April 3d 1884. signed, John E. H. Lowe"  
 Also from the pension record is a declaration of pension, dated Feb 26, 1907, from Logan County,  
 Oklahoma in which it is declared that John E. H. Lowe is living in Meridian(?), OK, and that he was  
 honorably discharged from the service at Nicklesville, KY on the 31st of Dec, 1864; and declares that he  
 was born on June 21, 1840.

This led me to create the Upchurch Bulletin, now in its 37th year, and my website [www.upchurchstory.com](http://www.upchurchstory.com) password 2013upchurch# established in 2007. There all the Upchurch Bulletins are available for all to see for free. Also note the 35 videos including one on your ancestor George Upchurch.

Then in 2013 I felt a more powerful tool was needed to add to, share , and preserve online far into the future our records on Upchurch and allied families. I and five others created Upchurch and Allied Families Association, Inc a tax-exempt organization--see our website [www.alliedfamilies.com](http://www.alliedfamilies.com) password 2014allied#. Note especially the concept of enrolling families who had a patriarch who lived about the time of the Revolution. We have made considerable progress on enrolling the family of your ancestor George U. but have much more to do and we would like to enlist you as a volunteer. There are several tasks we could ask you to help with. In order to specify a task it would be helpful to know how you fit into the Upchurch family. Could you send me a brief sketch on this.
