I thank you kindly for all of the information presented with your letter of 7 FEB 81. I have it all extracted and cross-referenced.

You asked about the prospects of joining various societies. I can't give you exact information but I could give you some ideas and some addresses to write. I am not sure but think you would be eligible to become a member of the Colonial Dames of the 18th Century. This is because of your descent from Michael U.I. To find out for sure and to learn what you would have to do you should write to:

On the byproducts side I doubt that you could join the DAR your ancestor Barnwell U. was not born until 2 MAR 1782 and hence was too young to be in the Revolutionary War

as my father James U III died in 1800 and hence
 may have been too old. However, my judgement
 is not final and I don't have a lot of
 experience in these matters. James U III may
 have performed some kind of service which
 entitled him descendants to DAR status. I
 hope to publish some hints on this sort
 of thing in U B in due course. I would be
 happy to learn anything you find out.

I do not have any information on
 Lady Huntington and would welcome any
 details of her possible relationship to
 Huntington in England.

Thanks for your \$10.00 check for U B 51. The

I am still working over your letter
