Dorothy Etheridge was married to William Henderson Jeffreys for 23 years. That union, lasting from 1902 until 1923, produced 12 children. In attempting to trace her heritage, one is confronted with a collection of records that are sometimes as difficult to find as they are to interpret.

A good starting point for a narrative on Dorothy Etheridge would be to establish a date of birth. But one immediately runs into an abundance of contradictory evidence and claims. The license issued for Dorothy's 11 Nov 1902 marriage to W.H.Jeffreys (Jefferys)* shows her age as being 18. If this were true, then her year of birth would be around 1884. This year is supported by the 1900 US Census, which gives her birth as Oct 1884. But the 1910 US Census, taken 8 years later, seems to show her age as 22. That would suggest circa 1888 for her birth year. A 1920 census lists W.H. Jeffreys' wife Dortha as being 16 years of age. This record suggests an error on the part of the census taker, as will be discussed later. Another possibility, as provided by her husband on Dorothy Etheridge's 18 Jan 1925 death certificate, is May of 1887. And finally to compound the confusion, her cemetery marker at Knightdale Cemetery in Franklin, NC, lists her birth date as being March 15 of that same year. The mystery surrounding Dorothy's date of birth, as with other aspects of her life, may be difficult to resolve.

Dorothy first appears on a US Census taken in St. Mathews Township, Wake, NC in June of 1900. Members of the household are as follows:

Just over two years later, on November 11, 1902, W.H. (Willie), son of A.P. and Jennie Jeffreys married Dorothy, daughter of (?) Etheridge (Ethridge)* and Rebecca Etheridge, His age is given as 25 and hers as 18. They married in St. Mathews Township, Wake County, North Carolina. The marriage ceremony was conducted by a Justice of the Peace at the residence of H.H. Knight. From all indications, it appears that Rebecca is the Becky mentioned in the 1900 census, and that she is the mother of Dorothy

In looking at the 1920 census, one is struck by the strong possibility of confusion on the part of the census taker. Annie should be 16, Mammie 14, Bessie 13 and so on. Did the census taker fail to line up the names on the census form with the correct ages? If you compare this census with the one taken in 1910, it appears likely that he did.

On 18 Jan 1925, Dorothy passed away. On her death certificate, her father's name is given as Henry Etheridge and her mother is listed as Rebecca. Rebecca would pass on two years later on 24 Dec 1927. It would be appropriate at this time to trace the possible heritage of Rebecca.

According to her death certificate, Rebecca's age at death was 87. She was buried at Knightdale Cemetery, a final resting spot for many members of the Jeffreys family. Her name is found on a marker at that cemetery between the names of her daughter and son-in-law. Her marker gives a date of birth of 6 May 1841. The death certificate goes on to describe Rebecca as being a widow, although evidence for a husband, other than a reference to a Henry Etheridge on Dorothy's death certificate, has yet to be located or established.

As seen earlier, Rebecca appeared in both the 1910 and 1920 US Censuses as a member of W.H. (Willie) Jeffreys' household. Dorothy and she also appeared in the 1900 census as living in the household of H. Knight.

In 1880 we find a Rebecca Etheridge (age 35) living in the household of Solomon and Harriet Brown in Wake County, NC. Also listed is Cora L. Etheridge, age 7. The census goes on to describe Cora as afflicted with "fits". No other listing for Cora has yet to be found.

A 13 year old Rebecca Etheridge appears in the household of Michael and Emily Etheridge of Wake County, NC in the 1860 census. It is possible that this Rebecca is the same as the one in the Brown household of 1880. Wake County borders Franklin County and Rebecca's age difference (13 to 35) over the passage of twenty years would not preclude this from being a match.

It is reasonable, almost certain, that the Bicky in the 1850 census is the same as the Rebecca of the 1860 census. What is not certain, and needing of further examination, is the certainty that the Rebecca of 1880 and beyond is the daughter of Michael Etheridge of Franklin County. If we can establish this as fact, then we can look at Michael Etheridge and his life, including his role in the Civil War.

In conclusion, this seems to be the status of Dorothy Etheridge as of 15 Mar 2016.

1. She was married to William Henderson Jeffreys from 1902 until her death in 1925.
Together, they had 12 children.
2. Dorothy's mother is Rebecca Etheridge. She was born circa 1841 and died on 24 Dec 1927. Rebecca, Dorothy, and William Henderson Jeffreys are all buried in Knightdale Cemetery in Wake County, NC.
3. Rebecca Etheridge may be the daughter of Michael Etheridge of Dunn's Township, NC. If so, then more work will be unveiled regarding Michael.
