

Hi James (or Mike?)---

Thanks for introducing yourself and for explaining how you fit into our shared heritage. I am delighted that you are interested in participating in our family history effort. It will take time and several exchanges to give you the full story. I will offer a few pointers and we can dig deeper later.

First, thank you for your military service which was significant. I retired as a Captain in the USAF after 18

years in the Reserves having served actively 1955-1957 at Eglin AFB--but no hazardous duty..

Before 1950 no one seemed concerned about Upchurch history. It was then that two ladies organized separate efforts that led to two Upchurch books in the 1970's. One was your great aunt Ada Morgan and the other was Belle West. I came to know both well when I became serious about Upchurch history in 1970. Both gave me permission to use the contents of their books in my Upchurch Bulletin which started in 1980 and concluded in 2016 after 37 years. In July of 1975 Ada hosted me for lunch in her home in Kansas City.

Ada, Belle, and I all worked manually and my records grew to be massive. In 2005 while on the verge of retiring from family history work I got a computer and started using email (now have 950 contacts). This was followed in 2007 by my website www.upchuchstory.com password 2013upchurch#. There all the UB issues are search-able and 35 videos are posted including ones for George Upchurch and his ancestors.

The more I thought about my massive manual records and the power of the Internet it became clear there was more work to do. So that the efforts of Ada, Belle, and I would not disappear five cousins and I in 2013 created Upchurch and Allied Families Association, Inc.. Our website is www.alliedfamilies.com password-2014allied#. A key feature is the enrolling of families including one for the George Upchurch Clan to which you belong. This unique approach is being successful and has great potential. The site contains other resources and is evolving.

Our continued and long-term success depends on participation by descendants of the enrolled families. Can we exchange some more about time, talents, and resources you might offer?

The George Upchurch Clan is a huge one. I have been to Wayne County, KY where George lived and also to Fentress County, TN where his son Joseph lived. I also visited Douglas County, MO where descendants lived. Read the charming story about how a part of this group moved on to AR.

As an aside regarding P&G my daughter married Robert Heck. His sister married Bob Cortner who was with the Coffee Division of P&G in Purchasing. He also served in China and in Switzerland and went with another outfit when they bough the P&G coffee business. Maybe you crossed paths.

807 Laura Irene Stevens born 4-29-1906 died 4-8-1909 bur Upchurch Cem. near Slickford, KY.

808 Clyde Albert Stevens b 6-4-1915 d 5-26-1952 md (1) Naomi Crump dau of Juanita and Murril Crump md (2) Virginia Benedict of Boise, Idaho. Clyde, (called Steve) and his family were living in Bluford, West Virginia when WWII started. He was a representative of Smucker's Food Products but a shortage of sugar meant he could not fill orders taken. So he decided to join the Army Air Force. He completed basic training, which amounted to almost a college education, and received his wings at Roswell with the rank of 2d Lt. Steve was based overseas, and wrote V-mail letters home. In one he said"The 461st Group has really grown into a big outfit now. We have about three thousand men in it as compared to the original three hundred thatactivated back at Gowen in August. Of course, you have to go overseas full strength and that calls for eighteen combat crews for each of the four squadrons. All the rest are needed to keep those seventy-two crews in the air! Steve was squadron leader and flew fifty missions, returning from one with flak holes peppering the plane. He and his crew were recommended for the Distinguished Flying Cross. They received the Oak Leaf with clusters. Steve was advanced to the rank of Major before his enlistment came to an end with WWII. His first mg ended in divorce and he started a new career with the Westinghouse Corp. in Idaho. Virginia had been married before and had a son whom Steve adopted. 
