I am interested in learning more about the descendents of HARMON UPCHURCH since it appears that my family is related to this line, although I have not been able to find proof. We have not been able to trace back further than HOWELL UPCHURCH, born about 1780, who was my great-great-great grandfather. It seems likely that Howell Upchurch and Allen [△] Upchurch of Montgomery (later Stanly) Co. were two of the sons of Harmon Upchurch shown in the Montgomery Co. census for 1810. Howell Upchurch has numerous descendents and an Upchurch reunion is held each year in Stanly Co., primarily for the descendents of Osborne Howell Upchurch. [△] If you have any more information about Harmon Upchurch I would very much like to know about it.

Dear Dr. Upchurch:

Since my last letter I have spent some time in the NC Archives and have a little more information on the DUDLEY/DUDNEY family name. I feel that the family used the spelling DUDNEY for the following reasons:

- 1. The Allen Upchurch deed (Montgomery Co. Deed Book Vol. 14, page 127, 17 Sep 1835) clearly says Dudney for both John and Elizabeth. I am having copies made and plan to send you a copy. (copy enclosed) → SEE DEED FILE - RPU
- 2. A deed from Sarah Ross (widow of Wiley Ross) to Elizabeth Page (widow of Sherwood Page) for land inherited from her father John Dudney clearly says Dudney twice. (Stanly Co. Deed Book Vol. 2, page 33, 29 Mar 1847). The deed is incorrectly titled Elizabeth Page to Sarah Ross, should be the reverse.
- △ 3. The index to the 1820 Montgomery Co. census lists Betsy Dudney and another Dudney, name unclear to me. The same names appear in the 1830 index. However, there are no Dudneys listed in the 1850 census anywhere in NC. I have only checked the indexes, not the original record.

Since the Allen Upchurch deed lists only female heirs for John Dudney it is interesting to speculate that the name may have ended with John's death in this family. Further work will be necessary to learn the names of John Dudney's parents to establish the origin of the name. If you find out anything else concerning this I would appreciate having the information. I enjoyed your newsletter a great deal and look forward to future issues.

From your letter of April 27, 1980 it seems that you have clear and adequate evidence that the proper spelling is DUDNEY.

Thanks for the supplementary information.

In studying the information provided in your 27 APR 80 letter some questions come to mind. They are not central to the Upchurch line but do bear upon the Upchurches. They are:

- (1) Can you match the names from the 17 SEP 1835 deed (Allen 4) and the 29 MAR 1847 deed [Sarah (Dudney) Ross]

The 1835 deed shows Sarah (Dudney) Ross had a sister Nancy Dudney who m'd a Page and a sister Elizabeth Dudney who m'd an Upchurch.

The 1847 deed shows that Sarah (Dudney) Ross sold land to Elizabeth (?) Page, widow of Sherwood Page. In this latter case is Elizabeth (?) Page a sister of Sarah (Dudney) Ross? and if so how do you account for the fact that the 1835 deed shows Sarah's sister Elizabeth m'd to an Upchurch and not a Page whereas her sister Nancy was married to a Page??

Dear Dr. Upchurch:

Thank you for your letters of March 15 and 16; they and the accompanying materials were very interesting to me. My branch of the family has felt rather isolated since we had no real proof as to the ancestry of Howell Upchurch. Also, I had wondered if you were the same R. P. Upchurch I remembered from NCSU. I finished my BS at State in 1965, then stayed on for my MS in soils. I am located at the Tidewater Research Station in Plymouth as soils specialist for high organic matter soils and have worked for the Dept. of Soil Science since 1968. You may be aware that there is a considerable amount of land development going on in this area now. Unfortunately the Mayflower is no longer in business, but has been replaced with several fast food outlets in the past few years.

I am enclosing some materials on my Upchurch line.

1. Dudley, Dudley: I will check this in the state archives as soon as I can. The Dudley spelling is the one my family has used. (See one-sheet history of Ross family by Jack Ross, DAR application of Lucy Upchurch Johnson.) I have seen the original of the Allen Upchurch deed and made this copy, but you have put doubt in my mind and I will check it.
2. Wife of Howell Upchurch: The only name I have is Rebecca. I had thought that the Elizabeth Upchurch mentioned in the Allen U. deed might be the wife of William U., son of Allen U. The 1850 Stanly Co. census has William U. age 43 and wife Eliza age 46. If you have any proof on either family I would like to have the reference. (I think this is William Allen U., the W. A. U. buried in the Allen U. cemetery)
3. Your Howell U. page 2 left out my father, John Upchurch Lilly as a son of Jesse Ada U.

I have been working on my family genealogy for about four years and have a lot of loose ends that need to be checked. As a result my materials are spotty in places. I have detailed information on the Upchurchs since William Riley U. and will continue to send materials as I can get them

organized. I also have addresses for a number of Upchurchs and their children and will start compiling them. As I mentioned in my first letter, we have an Upchurch reunion each year, and of course send out notices on it.

I really look forward to receiving your Newsletter, and found the first one to be extremely interesting. Please feel free to use anything I send as you see fit since I try to document the information I have, or at least label it as speculation. I hope the enclosed materials will be of some interest to you, and I hope to keep in touch as we each try to uncover new information.
