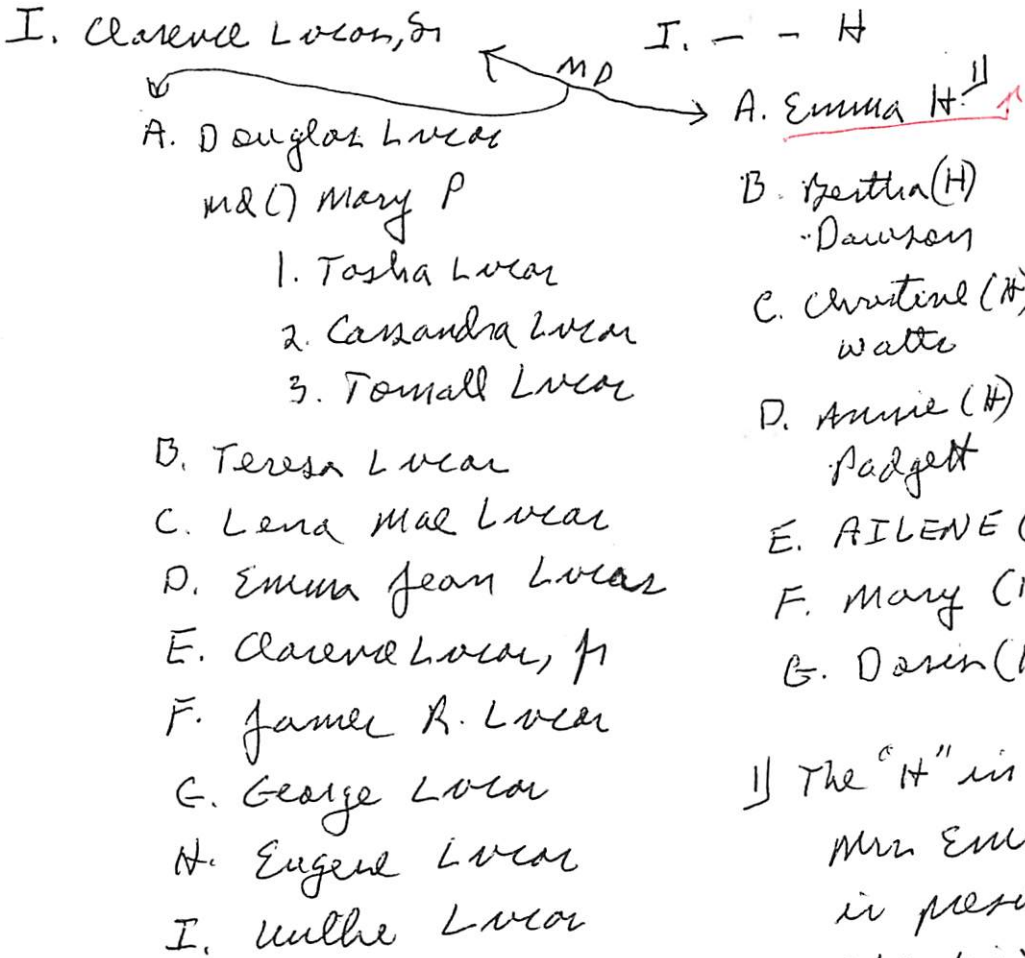

Miscellaneous Holmes County UPCHURCH's

Holmes County, Mississippi presented a big mystery in the UPCHURCH history. Two of the children of Moses UPCHURCH(498) went to Holmes County to marry, Walter Lane UPCHURCH(506) and Peter J. UPCHURCH(505). William Harrison UPCHURCH(509), son of Mark Wesley UPCHURCH(499) and nephew to the above men, also married here. However, there are additional UPCHURCH members in Holmes County that have not been tied in with any of the other UPCHURCH lines. Family history has it that Moses UPCHURCH(498) had one or two additional daughters that are not accounted for in this history. Perhaps part of all of these Holmes County lines are some of his descendants.

On 24 January 1894 Mrs. L or T.M. UPCHURCH married W.S. MADISON. The bride was eighteen and the groom twenty-one.⁶⁸⁷ On 3 January 1895 Maude UPCHURCH married Henry ALSTON.⁶⁸⁸ Nothing more is known about these girls. Due to the age of the first bride, the Mrs. could be in error. The two brides could be UPCHURCH sisters, sisters who had previously married UPCHURCH men, or totally unrelated.

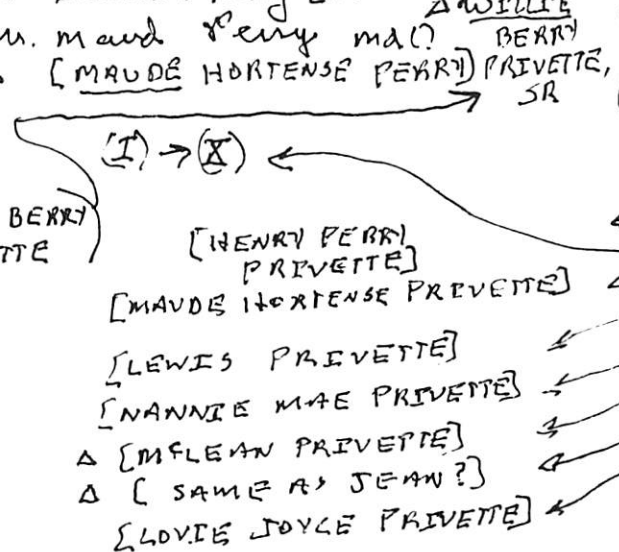

John R. Harrison was a wagon & buggy maker in Raleigh in the 1840's-1860's. Born in North Carolina in 1808, to John & Delia Harrison, he was in his 40's when he entered into a business partnership with Wiley W. Johnson in 1848 opening a shop at the corner of Morgan & McDowell, Streets in Raleigh. The partnership later dissolved when Harrison left to go into the business of manufacturing railroad cars for the North Carolina Railroad opening business on West Street in Raleigh.

John R. Harrison married Mary Lucas of North Carolina about 1834 and were parents to two known children: (CSA) Lt. John W. Harrison (1835-1883) and Julia Louisa Harrison (1837-1912) who married architect, William Jackson Hicks.

John Harrison died in 1874 at age 66. His wife of 40 years survived him another 21 years, spending her widowed years living with her married daughter. Mary Lucas Harrison died in 1895 at age 80.

Notes for Lt.-John-W Harrison:

Bio notes: John W. Harrison was born 1835 in Raleigh, Wake County, NC the eldest of 2 known surviving children (1 boy/1 girl) born to buggy and railroad car manufacturer, John R. Harrison and his wife, Mary Luca.

John W. was 26 when Civil War broke out, and he served as 1st Lieutenant with the NC 14th, Company E. "Oak City Guards". This regiment with more than 1,000 men, moved to Virginia where it was placed in the Department of Norfolk. Later it was assigned to General Colston's, G. B. Anderson's, Ramseur's, and Cox's Brigade, Army of Northern Virginia. The 14th participated in the various campaigns of the army from Williamsburg to Cold Harbor, fought with Early in the Shenandoah Valley, and ended the war at Appomattox. It sustained 17 casualties at Williamsburg, 102 during the Seven Days' Battles, 139 in the Maryland Campaign, 4 at Fredericksburg, and 142 at Chancellorsville. Of the 306 engaged at Gettysburg, twenty percent were disabled, and there was 1 killed and 4 wounded at Bristoe. It surrendered 7 officers and 107 men at Appomattox.

Following the war, John returned to Raleigh and became a merchant. He married to a woman named Sadie (ca. 1872) and was father to one known child, Lucas (b. 1873).

John W. Harrison died in 1883 at age 48. It is not known what became of his wife and child. He is buried in Oakwood near his parents and sister.

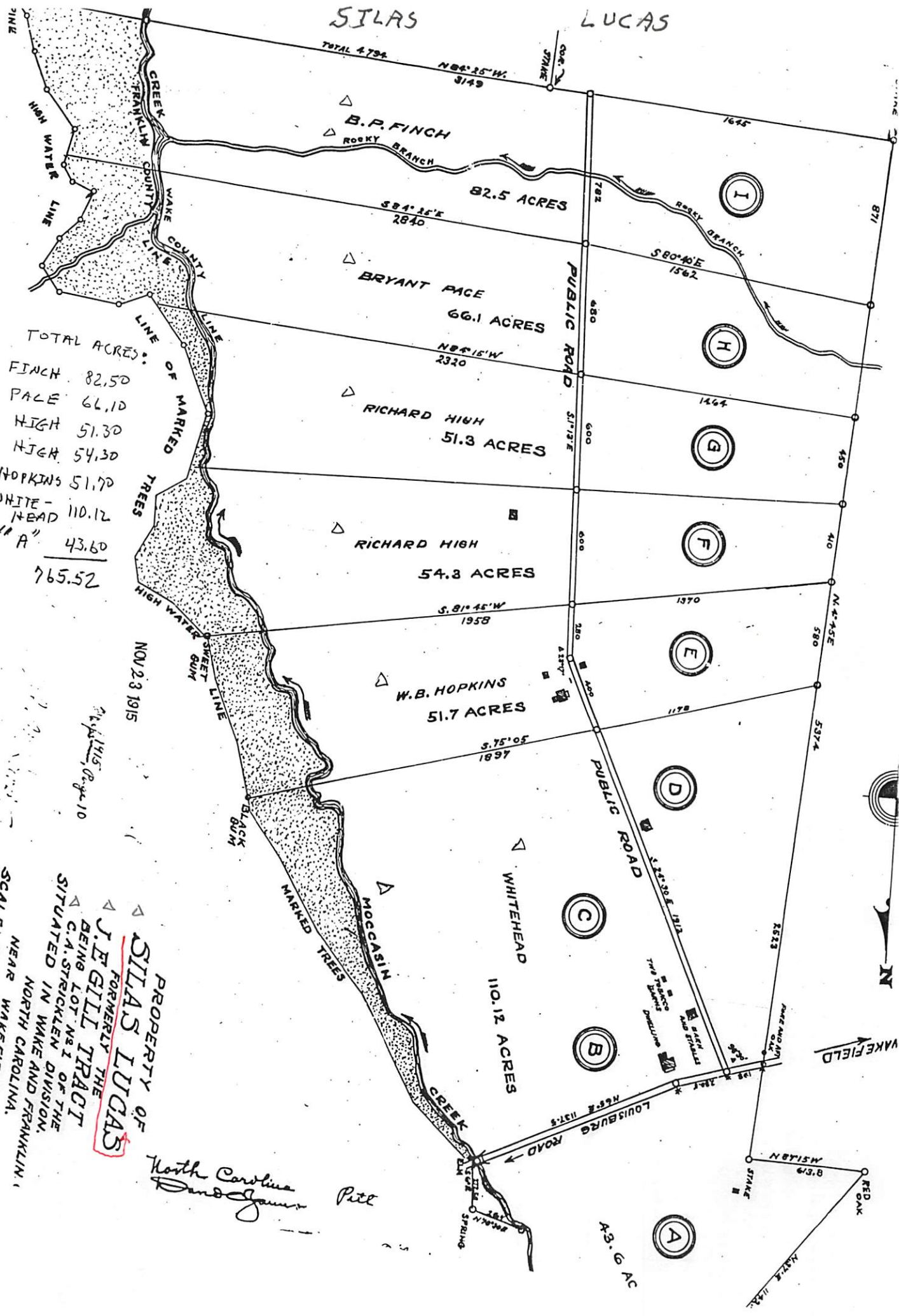

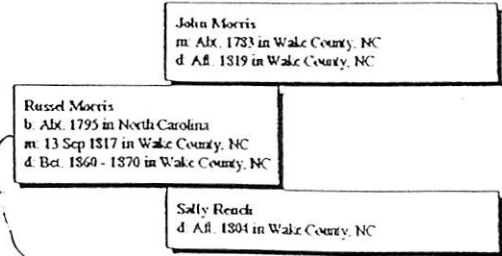

It appears that even before his Granville grant, he purchased some land. There is a deed showing a John Rench in Johnston County in 1755 ^{box} William Speight, Johnston Co., sold land to John Rench.

His early grants include John appearing to have bought a different piece of land in Swift Creek Township ^{box}:

Subsequently, William Speight Snr deeds the land to his son, and this transaction mentions the above sale from John Rench. So, these select entries tell us something of the history of John Rench's land, though since he appeared to acquire his land via purchase, we know nothing more of his ancestry ^{box}.
