Von Ray and his second wife, Alma Harrison Ray, had seven children during their 24 year marriage (five sons and one daughter--one unnamed child was still born) as listed below:

1. Mack Eunice Ray was born on May 23, 1915. Mack (age 18) married Euva Frances Cotton (also age 18) on November 27, 1933. They had one daughter (Joann). Mack was a Sergeant First Class in the Army in World War II. Mack died at the age of only 33 on February 9, 1949 while on active duty stationed at Ft. Myer in Arlington, Virginia. He is buried at Arlington National Cemetery (Section 12, Gravesite 1247).
2. Junius Hub Ray born in April 1916. Junius (age 22) married Ola Keith (age 18) on June 25, 1938. Junius and Ola had three children (Alma Lee, Nancy Ann, and Gene). Junius rented out his farm (property formerly owned by his father) and worked at textile mills in Butner and Durham, North Carolina. Junius died at age 69 in 1985 at Rex Hospital in Raleigh, N.C. (The same hospital where his father, Von Ray, died 46 years earlier.) He was over six feet tall and had blue eyes and black hair.
3. Alfonso Columbus Ray, Jr. was born in April 1917 and was known as Von. Von (age 23) married Eleanor Marshall in January of 1941 and they had six children (James, Joyce, Judy, Janice, Jerry and Johnny). Von worked at a lumber yard and also at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Von died of a heart attack at age 49 in 1966.
4. Woodrow Wilson Ray was born on May 22, 1918. Woodrow was named after the 28th President of the United States (1913-1921). Apparently Von Ray was a Democrat. From the age of about 16 until almost 21, Woodrow worked on his father's farm "in the production of crops." Woodrow enlisted in the Army on April 7, 1939 six weeks before his twenty-first birthday. While stationed at nearby Fort Butner in Granville County, North Carolina, Woodrow met his future wife, Coma Watson, at a post dance. Due to World War II, Woodrow's tour of duty was extended and he served six and one half years on active duty. Woodrow attained the rank of Staff Sergeant and spent his last year in the Army in Germany in Battery A of the 903rd Field Artillery Battalion. Woodrow was awarded three decorations and service medals: (1) European-African-Middle Eastern Campaign Medal with three bronze stars signifying participation in three combat campaigns (Rhineland, Ardennes, and Central Europe), (2) Good Conduct Medal and (3) American Defense Service Medal. Woodrow married Coma Watson and they had seven children (Ronald Wilson, Linda Carol, Robert Lee, Ann Sherrill, Bradley Wayne, Susan Gayle, and Teresa Lynn). Woodrow was a policeman in Durham from 1945 until his death at age 52 on July 15, 1970. Woodrow was five feet eleven inches tall and had brown eyes and dark brown hair.
5. Frances Caroline Ray born on August 23, 1919. Caroline was a beautiful woman. She married Coy J. Forsythe and they had seven children (J.C., Crystal, Jean, Peggy, Eddie, Ray and David). Caroline died at age 62 on July 1, 1982.
6. Joseph Ray was born on August 29, 1923 and he was 16 years old when his father died in 1939. At age 21, Joe married Nina Dillard on October 28, 1944 and they had one child, Betty Ray. Joe worked as a machine adjuster at Leggett & Myers Tobacco Company. Joe died at age 57 on November 13, 1980. Joe was approximately five feet seven inches tall and had blue eyes and black hair.

Ola Keith married Junius Ray in 1938 and she lived with her husband in the home of Von Ray, her father-in-law, for the last eighteen months of his life. Ola recalls Von stating that Joe was his seventeenth son. Joe is still referred to as Joe #17. Von Ray had twenty children — 17 sons and 3 daughters, but only 11 lived to be adults. Two of Von's sons, Percie and Mack, and one of his grandsons, Albert Ray, are honored by burial at Arlington National Cemetery. They rest on Virginia land across the Potomac River from the Lincoln Memorial on property once owned by Confederate General Robert E. Lee. Best known of more than one hundred national cemeteries in the United States, Arlington's green slopes shelter veterans from every war that has involved this nation. Percie (1893-1948) was a Corporal in the Army during World War I. Mack (1915-1949) was a Sergeant in the Army during World War II. Albert Ray (1923-1992), son of Percie and Elsie, served in the Navy for twenty years during World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. Albert retired as a Petty Officer First Class.

The account of their wedding (9/3/1876) was in the Raleigh Sentinel 9/5/1876.

"Our cotton merchants were never more hopeful of futures... At Piney Grove Church Sept. 3, 1876. By Rev. M. Holleman, Mr. M.T. Norris of this city was married to Miss C.A. Norris, daughter of Jesse A. Norris. A sumptuous feast was set at the home of the bride's father and many handsome presents were received." Cornelia's father purchased property at 421 N. Blount St., Raleigh, for the couple, and they built a large Victorian home there. Italianate in style, it was purchased by the Heartts in 1928.

The Heartts made extensive changes in the appearance of the house, eliminating Italianate features and replacing them with columns across the front. The place is now owned by the State.

Matthew Tyson Norris was son of William H. Norris & Mary Yates Norris & grandson of Col. Samuel Pearson Norris (11/21/1787-2/20/1856) & 1st wife Matilda Utley.

Matilda Utley was daughter of John "Jack" Utley Jr. & Charity Jones Utley, Wake Co.

Thus, the fathers of Cornelia Alice Norris & Matthew Tyson Norris were half-brothers, making

Cornelia and her husband half-first cousins, and they were both grandchildren of Samuel Pearson Norris.

She became a successful businesswoman in her own right, and her children became well known as community leaders in Raleigh.

An accomplished athlete, she won state golf championships repeatedly over a period of 50 years.

Henry V. Marshall

24 years watching agriculture advance

Henry V. Marshall, superintendent of agricultural research units at N.C. State University, can't imagine why anyone would want to write a story about him.

After all, he has been at NCSU for 30 years, 24 in his present job.

But after years of quietly watching over a variety of farm animals, horticultural and field crops — covering 3,600 acres mostly scattered around Raleigh — Marshall is calling it quits. Today is his last day on the job.

The work has been "interesting and it has been fun," Marshall said with characteristic simplicity. "If it wasn't, I'd have been a fool to stay."

Marshall, 57, is the only superintendent of agricultural research units NCSU has ever had. Before 1964, individual departments managed their own research stations. Marshall was hired to oversee centralized research and to smooth over any hard feelings from departments unhappy with the change.

Roy L. Lovvorn, who retired in 1969, hired Marshall while he was director of the agricultural research service. But he admits Marshall was not his first choice.

"I wasn't sure he was what we wanted," Lovvorn said in a telephone interview. "He's a little short fellow. I sort of got the impression he was sort of a

"We live in a different age," Marshall said in an interview at his office in Patterson Hall. "You've got to have more smarts now than we used to think. But I don't think they're a bit more productive. Everybody's got just 24 hours in a day."

Agricultural research itself has changed. The focus used to be on applied research, on things that were "immediately useful" to farmers and growers. Marshall said.

Through the years, NCSU's research has become "more sophisticated," Marshall said. It has taken on "more of an academic interest, and it's going to be a long time before some farmer benefits from a lot of it."

Marshall, a bespectacled man of small build with short-cropped white hair, is an old-fashioned sort who marvels at how much things have changed.

"It used to take 5½, 6 pounds of feed to make a pound of pork, now it takes three," he said.

Other things have changed, too. Marshall used to spend only about 40

percent of his time in the office. The rest he spent in his pickup truck surveying the land he supervises.

But as Marshall's domain has increased from 84 buildings to 260, so has the time he spends in the office. About 80 percent of his 10-hour to 12-hour day is spent doing paperwork.

Marshall's love for the soil and outdoors could be inherited. Both sets of grandparents were farmers, and his parents once sharecropped.

Marshall grew up in Forsyth County. What drew him into research rather than farming was his keen interest in "new things."

"This is what research is all about, trying new techniques and new varieties," he said.

"The rewarding part comes in when . . . a product of research becomes useful to the farmer, and he benefits. I've always felt I was out on the cutting edge."

Marshall's replacement, Wallace R. Baker, has been a research station superintendent for more than 20 years. He has worked alongside Marshall since June 1.

"My advice to him is for him to do it his way," Marshall said. "Work hard, be smart and don't ever let your shirttail touch your back. That's what my old daddy always said."

In talking about what he'll do after retirement, Marshall's humor comes forth in earnest.

"Now you've gone to meddlin'," he said. "I've told somebody I'm going to get 30 years in with another outfit. I told another I'm going into business with my brother-in-law, and he's got doing nothing down to a science. I'm going to do like my uncle used to say: 'Whatever I'm going to do I'm going to do it tomorrow.'"



smart-alecky guy. But I was convinced by senior staff people who know him real well.

"He far exceeded my expectations," Lovvorn said. "It's not easy to satisfy 30 or 40 project leaders. Henry has finesse, a way about him that just makes people like him."

Thurston J. Mann, a former assistant director of tobacco research at NCSU, said Marshall's wit masked great intelligence and know-how.

"If you were isolated on a desert island and didn't have a man Friday, what you'd need is Henry Marshall," Mann said. "He can make do with what's available."

Things have changed quite a bit since Marshall, a 1958 graduate of NCSU, was hired. Back then agricultural research meant physical labor. Computers and instrumentation were the exception rather than the rule.

And we the members of the William Utley Memorial Association hereby place on record, for permanent preservation, our high esteem of Mrs. Norris as a lady of culture and high character whose long and useful life was unselfishly devoted to her family, friends, and all who sought her services which she rendered gracefully and graciously and whose memory we will cherish always as one worthy of our fondest recollections.

Mrs. Norris was the daughter of the late Jessie Norris of Apex; and was born August 3, 1857. She therefore lacked only a few weeks of having reached her 78th birthday. For many years she had been a resident of Raleigh and an active member of the First Baptist Church. Her husband, the late M. T. Norris, preceded her in death by more than 25 years. She leaves three children (daughters), all of Raleigh, Mrs. J. K. Marshall, ↑ Mrs. James McKimmon and Mrs. J. L. Primrose.

Mrs. Norris was for many years a member of the Caswell-Nash Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution, had done much work along genealogical lines for the Chapter, and represented it frequently in Washington City. Her funeral was conducted by Dr. E. McNeil Poteat, pastor of the Pullen Memorial Baptist Church of Raleigh.

Enlisted in Wake County on July 15, 1862, for the war. Present or accounted for until wounded at Winchester, Virginia, on June 15, 1863. Reported as absent wounded from that date through December, 1864.

△ CREEL, J. J., Private
Resided in Onslow County and enlisted in Wake County at age 32, July 15, 1862, for the war. Reported as absent sick from September 25, 1862, through December, 1862. Present or accounted for until captured on May 12, 1864, at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, on August 10, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 23, 1865.

△ CUMMINGS, JOHN, Private
Born in Pitt County where he resided prior to enlisting in Wake County at age 31, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died September 15, 1862, in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, of "febris remitens."

△ DEAL, JOHN, Private
Resided in Onslow County where he enlisted at age 18, March 25, 1863, for the war. Wounded May 3, 1863, at Chancellorsville, Virginia. Absent wounded through December, 1863. Captured May 12, 1864, at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland. Transferred from Point Lookout to Elmira, New York, on August 10, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on June 27, 1865.

△ FIELDS, KINCHEN E., Private
Resided in Chatham County and enlisted in Wake County at age 50, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, December 9, 1862, of "variola."

△ McCAULEY, S. H., Private
Born in Moore County where he resided prior to enlisting in Wake County at age 26, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died October 10, 1862, of wounds received in battle at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862.

△ McKETHAN, NEILL, Private
Resided in Moore County prior to enlisting in Wake County at age 20, July 15, 1862, for the war. Company muster rolls state that he was sent to the rear on September 17, 1862, while the company was in Maryland and was "supposed deserted." Appears on a parole of prisoners of war dated Office of the Provost Marshal General, Army of the Potomac, October 3, 1862. No further records.

△ McLEMORE, JOHN H., Private
Resided in Moore County prior to enlisting in Wake County at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Maryland, on September 17, 1862. Present or accounted for until reported as absent sick from April 6, 1863, through August, 1863. Captured at Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 20, 1864, and confined at Point Lookout, Maryland. Transferred to Elmira, New York, on July 6, 1864. Released at Elmira after taking the Oath of Allegiance on July 11, 1865.

△ McLEOD, NEILL, Private
Enlisted in Wake County on July 15, 1862, for the war. Muster rolls state that he was "missing since September 17, 1862." Appears on a parole of prisoners of war dated Office of the Provost Marshal General, Army of the Potomac, September 27, 1862. Also appears on a roll of prisoners of war at Fort McHenry, Maryland, dated October 14, 1862, which states that he was paroled and sent to Aiken's Landing, James River, Virginia, for exchange. This roll states that he was captured on October 1, 1862, at Antietam, Maryland. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, on October 24, 1862, with "wound of right hip" and was furloughed on December 20, 1862, for 50 days. Present or accounted for until captured near Spotsylvania Court House, Virginia, May 12, 1864. Confined at Point Lookout, Maryland, until transferred to Elmira, New York, on August 10, 1864. Died December 10, 1864, at Elmira of "pneumonia."

△ MANNING, A. A., Private
Resided in Pitt County and enlisted in Wake County at age 21, July 15, 1862, for the war. Died on September 23, 1862, in hospital at Warrenton, Virginia, of "rubeola."

△ MARSHALL, JOHN R., Private
Resided in Onslow County where he enlisted at age 24, May 13, 1861, for the war. Discharged on July 16, 1861. Reenlisted in Wake County on July 15, 1862, for the war. Wounded at Sharpsburg, Maryland, September 17, 1862. Admitted to hospital at Richmond, Virginia, on September 28, 1862, with "gun wound in shoulder." Absent wounded until detailed for hospital duty on March 1, 1863. Absent detailed until admitted to hospital at Richmond on April 7, 1863, with "hernia and debility." Returned to duty August 18, 1863. Reported as present on the August, 1863, muster roll. Absent sick from October 15, 1863, until detailed as a nurse at hospital at Lynchburg, Virginia, on December 10, 1864. Paroled in April, 1865, at Lynchburg.

△ ★ VANN, THOMAS N., Private
Resided in Moore County and enlisted in Wake County at age 34, July 15, 1862, for the war. Accidentally wounded at Fredericksburg, Virginia, December 10, 1862. Killed at Chancellorsville, Virginia, May 3, 1863.

Resided in Chatham County and enlisted in Wake County at age 30, July 15, 1862, for the war. Left in hospital at Richmond, Virginia, August 17, 1862, and never returned to company.

"Our cotton merchants were never more hopeful of futures... At Piney Grove Church Sept. 3, 1876. By Rev. M. Holleman, Mr. M.T. Norris of this city was married to Miss C.A. Norris, daughter of Jesse A. Norris. A sumptuous feast was set at the home of the bride's father and many handsome presents were received." Cornelia's father purchased property at 421 N. Blount St., Raleigh, for the couple, and they built a large Victorian home there. Italianate in style, it was purchased by the Heartts in 1928. The Heartts made extensive changes in the appearance of the house, eliminating Italianate features and replacing them with columns across the front. The place is now owned by the State.

Matthew Tyson Norris was son of William H. Norris & Mary Yates Norris & grandson of Col. Samuel Pearson Norris (11/21/1787-2/20/1856) & 1st wife Matilda Utley.

She became a successful businesswoman in her own right, and her children became well known as community leaders in Raleigh.

An accomplished athlete, she won state golf championships repeatedly over a period of 50 years.
