## MASSEY NOTES FOR WAKE, FRANKLIN, JOHNSTON, NASH COUNTIES, NORTH CAROLINA

### FRANKLIN CO NC

Superior Court Halifax, April term 1794 (published in "State Records of NC" at UCLA law library)

William Massey; in Feb 1780 he was "seized in fee in Franklin Co"; Green Hill, admn of estate of Thomas Bell, dec., sued William Massey for recovery of money due Bell; William Massey eventually moved away

James Massey (William named him as his son in conveyance of land July 2, 1782)  
(from "Abstracts of Franklin Co NC" Deed Book 4, #590):

William Massie of Franklin Co to James Massie same July 2, 1782 for L500 a tract of 325 acres situated on south side of Tar River where William Massie now dwells, it being the lower half of a tract of 650 acres granted by deed from Earl Granville to James Brogdon dated April 27, 1754 and sold from Brogdon to William Massie and by William Massey to Osborn Jeffreys and was later sold by Osborn Jeffreys unto William Massie. Wit: Joel Parish

(#591, p56) James Massie of Franklin Co to Green Hill of same, June 22, 1784 for 433/6/8 a tract of 325 acres south bank of Tar River joining Golden (now Seawell). Wit: Jno Stokes.

ASA (ASEY) MASSEY (received land from his father, Pettepool Massey) 4/6/1794

In will of father, Pettepool Massey Asa received "plantation where I now live", all the land formerly of Sampson Braswell 390 acres and my mill", also rest of land of Pettepool not otherwise granted amounting to 575, also "1 young horse or mare when he comes of age, 1 cow and calf". The following individuals sold land to Benjamin Bunn received as heirs of Asa 2/25/1814, which are probably brothers and sister, or children of Pettepool (compare will and this deed):

ELIJAH "Lige" MASSEY - Remembrances by his grandson, Hezekiah (Ref: *Annals of Northwest Alabama*, Carl Elliott, oral history given by Hezekiah Massey, (old Massey family bible)

Elijah Massey and family moved to Alabama abt 1829 in a two-wheeled cart. Hezekiah Massey was 9 years old when he moved to Alabama. Elijah Massey and family and the Bonds family moved from Pickens Co to Franklin Co AL and settled on Cedar Creek, with the exception of Hezekiah Massey.
