1. JAMES MILLS, son of Nathan Mills and Celia Morgan, was born 4 Oct 1818 in Wake Co., NC, and died ca 1856. He married 12 May 1841 Elizabeth Pittman (b ca 1815, d 1876-1880). They were married in Wake Co., NC - bondsman was William Ferrell. They are buried at Mills Fam. Cem., Apex, NC. James' gravesite is marked with a concrete gravestone manufactured by the author, which was installed 23 Mar 1994. Elizabeth's gravesite is marked with a fieldstone.

James was a farmer. They resided in Wake Co., NC (White Oak Twp.) on FC/1850. His widow and children continued to resided there on FC/1860-1870. In 1850, James owned real estate valued at \$225. In 1860, Elizabeth owned real estate valued at \$500 and a personal estate valued at \$411. In 1870, Elizabeth owned real estate valued at \$300 and a personal estate valued at \$200. The FC/1850-1870 contained the following info on the Agricultural Schedules regarding James' farm. Elizabeth operated the farm during 1860 and 1870:

1850 - 40 acres of improved land. 110 acres of unimproved land. Cash value of farm - \$225. Value of farming machinery and implements - \$8. 1 horse. 3 other cattle. 20 swine. Value of livestock - \$120. 11 bu. wheat. 150 bu. Indian corn. 9 lbs. wool. 15 bu. peas and beans. 3 bu. Irish potatoes. 100 bu. sweet potatoes. 1 ton of hay. Value of homemade manufactures - \$12. Value of animals slaughtered - \$36.

1860 - 30 acres of improved land. 132 acres of unimproved land. Cash value of farm - \$500. Value of farming machinery and implements - \$15. 2 horses. 2 milch cows. 11 swine. Value of livestock - \$212. 18 bu. wheat. 100 bu. Indian corn. 1 400-lb. bale of ginned cotton. 25 bu. peas and beans. 7 bu. Irish potatoes. 500 bu. sweet potatoes. Value of orchard products - \$10. 52 lbs. butter. 3 1/2 tons of hay. 25 gal. molasses. 50 lbs. beeswax and honey. Value of homemade manufactures - \$25. Value of animals slaughtered - \$226.

1870 - 15 acres of improved land. 30 acres of woodland. 135 acres of other unimproved land. Present cash value of farm - \$500. Present value of farming implements and machinery - \$25. 1 horse. 1 milch cow.

1 other cattle. 3 swine. Value of all livestock - \$108. 75 bu. Indian corn. 10 lbs. tobacco. 1 450-lb. bale of cotton. 5 bu. Irish potatoes. 50 bu. sweet potatoes. Value of animals slaughtered or sold for slaughter - \$150. Estimated value of all farm production, including betterments and additions to stock - \$650.

In 1850, James and Elizabeth were two of the founding members of Olive Chapel Baptist Church, Apex, NC. After James' death, his brother, Britton was appointed as administrator of his estate. Elizabeth made several trips to court in order to obtain her widow's year support, dower in her husband's land, and guardianship of her own three children. For more info see ch. COURT DATES ETCHED IN TIME (Feb 1857-pg. 330), (Feb 1857-pg. 361), (May 1857-pg. 386), (Nov 1858-pg. 547) and (Feb 1859-pg. 575). There are loose estate records of James at the NC State Archives. James lived to about age 38.

45. Feb 1857 - pg. 330 - "Upon the relinquishment of the widow being filed, ordered that Britton Mills be appointed administrator upon the estate of James Mills, deceased. And he enters into bond in the sum of one thousand dollars, with Kindrick Johnson and John Scott as sureties, who are approved and accepted by the Court. And the said Britton Mills is in open Court & duly qualifies as administrator aforesaid by taking the oath prescribed by law. Ordered that said administrator have leave to sell the perishable property of his intestate upon a credit of not less than six months."

46. Feb 1857 - pg. 361 - "Petition for a year's support. On motion, Kindrick Johnson, a Justice of the Peace, William Yates, Jesse Howell, and Johnson Olive, free holders, are appointed commissioners to view the estate of James Mills, deceased, and to allot and set apart to his widow Elizabeth Mills, so much of the stock, crop and provisions belonging thereto, as may be adequate to the support of her and family for one year, and if then shall not be a sufficiency on hand to afford such an allowance, then to assess the deficiency in money. Said commissioners are to report to the next term of this Court under their hands and seals."

48. May 1857 - pg. 386 - "ELIZABETH MILLS, WIDOW VS. THOMAS J. UTLEY, GUARDIAN AD LITEM } Petition for dower. On motion, it is ordered by the Court, that a writ be issued to the Sheriff of Wake County, commanding him to summon a jury of twelve free holders unconnected with the parties, to allot to the petitioner, her dower in the lands of her late husband, James Mills. Which said land is described in her petition according to the Act of the General Assembly in such case made and provided."

50. Nov 1858 - pg. 547 - "Ordered that Willie J. Fuller, Wm Jenks, and Golden A. Upchurch be appointed a committee to audit and settle the accounts of Britton Mills, administrator of James Mills, deceased, and to report to the next term of this Court."

51. Feb 1859 - pg. 575 - "On motion, Elizabeth Mills is appointed guardian to her children, Henry B. Mills, Jesse J. Mills, and Green W. Mills. 1. Jacob (b. abt. 1761 probably in Johnston County, NC, d. bet. 1835 and 1840 probably in Gwinnett or Madison Co. GA) m. Annie Pearce or Peace 3/16/1783 in Franklin Co. NC. Moved to Anson Co. NC then to Madison Co. GA after 1805, and possibly to Gwinnett Co. GA by 1835; no Madison Co. GA 1810 census exists, and tax records except for 1840 do not survive. Lived on Brushy Creek in Madison County, GA.
 2. Priscilla (b. abt. 1765 probably in Johnston County, NC, d. between 1801 and 1805), m. Jacob Lewis Seagraves (b. abt. 1762 or 1763, d. June 7, 1835 Clinton Co., Illinois) By 10/21/1800 this family was in Franklin Co. GA; by 1805 Jacob had probably remarried Elizabeth Hanes in GA; by 1810 they were in Rutherford Co. TN; by 1820 they were in Maury Co., TN; by 1829 they were in Clinton Co., Illinois
 From court records filed by her brother-in-law Braswell Strickland in Wake Co. NC we know that she was dead by 1805 and left at least six children.
 3. Isaac (b. abt. 1770, d. abt. 1834 probably in Jasper Co. GA*) Moved to Jasper Co. GA by 1812. His land was originally in Washington Co., then Baldwin Co., then Randolph Co., then Jasper Co. GA. His land was sold by his son Kinchen in January, 1835, so he was probably dead by that time. No will or estate have been found at this time. There is a slight chance he may have moved to Upson Co. GA before his death to be with his children who had moved there.

 7. Kinchen (b. abt. 1780/1781, d. bef. 10/8/1863 when his will was probated in Madison Co. GA) Married first Mary (possibly Baker). Married second Sarah H. Branch 3/30/1836 in Madison Co. GA Further research is needed.
 8. Charity (cannot find dates) m. James Johnston (cannot find further info on this family) This family was in GA in 1805.
 9. Elizabeth (b. unknown, d. bef. 1805) m. Hardy Griffin bef. 2/23/1795 (b. bet. 1770 And 1780, d. aft. 1850) He m. 2nd Divinity Strickland
 10. Ruth (b. and death date unknown but probably dead bef. June, 1805) marriage info unknown
