Dear Cousin Phil,

I am so sorry, I did not realize that the cost was \$10.00 per issue. I just sent the money requested on the form you sent, a year ago. (Yes, I was very late!) I have several missing and would like to send the money for them, if they are still available. In the meantime, enclosed is a check for \$10.00 for vol 27, number 2.

I was under the impression, several years back that Melva Henninger & I were to take care of George's, Shadrack's, Joseph's tribe. The last time I heard from her, I gave her the updates I had at that time and loaned her my Doomsday Book. She said something about moving. I haven't heard from her since that time. (I gave up and replaced my book.) Since that time I have had one major operation, several minor ones, surprised by diabetes, and not looking forward to two cataract operations. Between diabetes, which requires special meals and exercise at a gym, church work, artist society, and the inlaws, time is at a premium leaving only a few hours each week for any genealogy. I am trying to input all my people into the LDS PAF free software, from around the nineteenth century through the present. Perhaps once I get used to my new schedule I will be able to spend more time on genealogy and will pick up George, that is if no one else has volunteered by that time. But now, I do not feel that I can go any further back than Joseph (Mabel Olgia, William Sherman. John Lafayette, and Joseph, the son of Shadrack, the son of George.), and that it is stretching it somewhat. I have gently ventured into Samuel Greer's ancestry and descendants because of marriages of two of his daughters to two of my father's brothers. Once the Upchurch datum has been entered, I will be able to send you a GED file which can be read by any of the genealogy software programs with which I am acquainted. If you were closer, I would come over and download the LDS programs and show you how to use them.

As far as increasing interest, I really don't know. Can't get my brother's children interested. Perhaps the professionals (DAR and Indiana Historical Society workers) can give us some advice. Will check with them.

Please keep me on your Upchurch mailing list. I am sometimes slow, but I don't discard anything in my in basket until the item has been processed.

The really big issue is finding someone to take leadership. I can, with some effort, find good cooperators. One problem is they keep dying on me. Melva has been a great cooperator but she is increasingly involved with her family and anyway is not inclined to good organization. One just has to take what she has to offer - which for me has been a lot over the years.

I am still trying to grasp what the Internet has to offer. I am currently exchanging ideas with Bob BARRS in VA about this. He tells me there is a special Web Site on the Uplandover (of Wayne Co, KY - I guess). He says there are 7 "members". Perhaps you are one. So far it seems the Internet and EMAIL are great tools for exchanging information. So far I don't quite understand how the Internet presents a setup for the exercise of leadership - maybe I'll catch on.

Another matter you and I have not conferred about is the matter of ultimate disposition of records. I have been working on this for my records for about five years. Just this month an agreement has been reached for North Carolina State University - Special Collections to take all of my "stuff" - personal, professional, business, and family history. This amounts to the equivalent of about 40 years-drawers

file cabinets. About 60% of this is on family history. I'll transfer this over a period of time holding on to the family history stuff as long as I want to be active - maybe another 10-15 years. Sallaine and I will drive to NC for a 2-3 week visit next month.

We will take the equivalent of two file cabinets of "stuff". This is an exciting development for me.

I am making excellent progress on several projects on family history for Wake Co, NC where I was born & raised and lived for many years.

To close on a positive note, we should be proud of what we have been able to do so far on Upchurch Family History. And, we should be pleased that we can still make additional contributions, large or small, as the months go by.

I'll look forward to our continued collaboration.
