It has been long known that the Scott Family and the Upchurch Family of Wake County, NC lived close to each other in this County and nearby counties going back into the early 1800's. Some details of their interactions including some marriages. However, there is an ongoing need to explore the historic relationship of the two families more fully.

On 9 SEP 2019 UAFPA Cooperator Kimberly (Beach) Wrenn of Durham, NC reported on the existence of a Scott Family History Collection. Kim will try to acquire this collection and it may eventually become a Special Collection in the UAFPA archives to be maintained in our UAFPA Headquarters in Wake County, NC.

The 9 SEP 2019 from Kim and follow-up emails are made a part of this entry and one shown as sequential entries which follows of special note are the remarks by Stanley Smith, of Wake County, NC, a UAFPA Board Member whose wife has Scott heritage.

As you know Ada Upchurch of Wake County, NC who married John Scott is one of our Missing Links.

UAFA will be keenly interested in the Scott records. I would hope they would fit as part of our UAFA Special Collections to be housed in our Wake County, NC Headquarters. In order to evaluate acceptance we would need to have a description of the Margaret Scott Collection to make sure we would be the right entity to preserve and curate the materials.

As of September 8, 2019 Judy Rysdon was appointed UAFA Librarian. We are working to define her duties which will likely embrace Special collections.

However in 1762 one JOHN SCOTT of Wake Co., N.C., was buying and selling land on Crabtree and Walnut Creeks. He left a will, recorded on the first of November, 1819 (Wake Co., N.C. WILL BK. 15/347), naming his wife, Hannah and children, without naming his children. Presumably JOHN SCOTT who was later active in land deals in this same section was one of those unnamed children.]

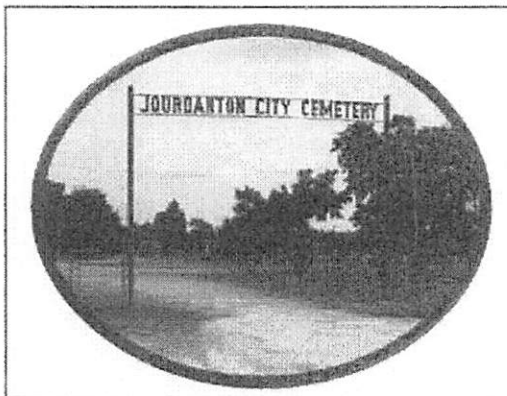

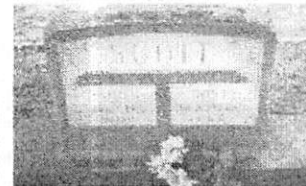

I was so excited to find your website! I had already decided to push through my natural reticence and send you an e-mail, and here you are reaching out to me! My church (The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints) encourages its members to "find" their ancestors, and much research had already been done on my parents' ancestral lines, but none of it by me. It was time for me to do my part, but I was reluctant because I knew how time-intensive it would be (I am in awe of your 40+ years of dedication to the work). A light went on! Surely Family History was a worthy thing to do of a Sunday! I knew my dad was stuck on one particular line, so I logged onto FamilySearch.org on Sunday, with grand ideas of succeeding where others had failed. There she was -- Adah M Upchurch. Her name "spoke" to me. Linked sources included 1850, 1860 and 1880 censuses, and the death certificate for Winfield Scott (also my dad has a facsimile of John Scott's Last Will and Testament mentioning his wife Adah). But because I am a complete novice and hadn't done my homework, I didn't know how to use the website to its full potential and soon got frustrated -- so I exited the website and went to the internet to see what I could find. After googling several search terms, I noticed repeated references to the "Upchurch Bulletin" and finally figured (duh!) I should check it out. When I read that most if not all Upchurches in America are most likely descendants of 1638 immigrant Michael Upchurch I thought, How cool is that! My missing Ada is surely soon to be found! But, alas! I could only find two references, viz.: Upchurch Bulletin Vol. 5 No. 2, April 1984 page 71, Item K. "Margaret U., b. ca 1844, md. 22 JUL 1859 William C. Scott, (son of Ada U.), b. 1830"; and Upchurch Bulletin Vol. 11 No. 3, July 1990 p. 111, under Missing Links (ML20) Item A. "Ada U., b. 1806 (Wake Co., NC), d., md. John Scott, Jr., b 1796, d. (By age should be a dau or gd of Nathan U. I or Moses U. but no unfilled slot appears available. Other possibilities: 1. She is a widow of an Upchurch male. 2. She came from the John U. III Clan. 3. She came from a fourth clan.)"

So ... has anything new turned up in the intervening years? My connection to the Upchurch line: My parents are Homer Thomas Scott and Marceline Hunter Scott, my paternal grandfather is Lewis [Louis] Lorenzo Scott, his father is James Alexander Scott, his parents are John Scott and Adah M Upchurch.

(Sorry, there are altogether too many exclamation marks in this e-mail, but I was pretty excited.)

I have listed the link to the 1940 census below. I have also attached a file that I hope you can open that is a screenshot of my family tree back to John and Adah. (Not sure where the "M" in Ada's name comes from.)

Incidentally, you will notice that there are members of the Byrd family in my tree too, which I noticed when I was noodling around that there appear to be a lot of Byrds (Birds) and Upchurches living in the same county at that period of time. I halfway remember seeing other marriages between these two families as I was surfing the internet, but I can't remember where.

I also find it interesting that William Scott (see my mention of him in last e-mail), son of an Upchurch (i.e. Ada), also married an Upchurch (i.e. Margaret). Cousins perhaps?

I John Scott of the county and State aforesaid being of sound mind and memory but considering the uncertainty of my earthly existence do make and declare this my last will and testament in manner and form following that is to say:

First, that my Executor (herein after named) shall provide for my body a decent burial suitable to the wishes of my relatives and friends and pay all funeral expenses together with my just debts however and to whomsoever owing, out of the money's that may first come into their hands as a part or parcel of my estate.

Item, I give and devise to my beloved wife Adah all my real and personal estate The ready money if any on hand at my death to be managed by my Executor to her interest) to have and to hold to her the said Adah Scott for and during the term of her natural life or Widowhood.

Item, At the death of my wife Adah, My will and desire is that my real estate shall be distributed as follows.

Item, I give and devise to my youngest son Winfield Scott fifty acres of land on the West side of Flat Branch to be set out by metes and bounds so as to include the place whereon he now resides, to have and to hold to him in fee simple forever.

Item, I give and devise the residue of my real estate to my sons Sidney Scott and C.R. Scott, and My Daughter Ellen Scott to be equally divided between them, according to valuation. The same to be so divided that my Daughter Ellen Scott shall have the mansion house provided she remains single.

Item, My Will and desire is that at the death or marriage of my wife Adah, the whole of my personal estate shall be sold the debts owing to me collected and the whole amount distributed as follows.

Item, I give and bequeath to my daughter in law Margaret Scott and her two sons Oscar and William Scott the sum of One Dollar each.

Item, I give and bequeath to my son in law Weston Larwarnee and my Grand Daughter Kealon the sum of one Dollar each.

Item, The residue to be equality divided between Sidney Scott, C.R. Scott, Winfield Scott, Ellen Scott and my Granddaughter Sarah Larwarnee. Thomas Scotts' four children one share

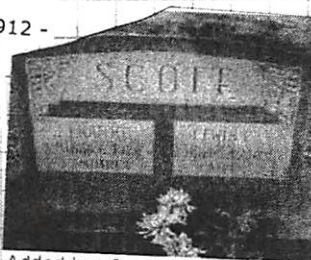
