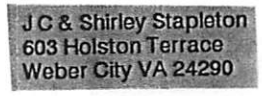

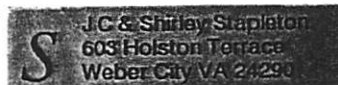

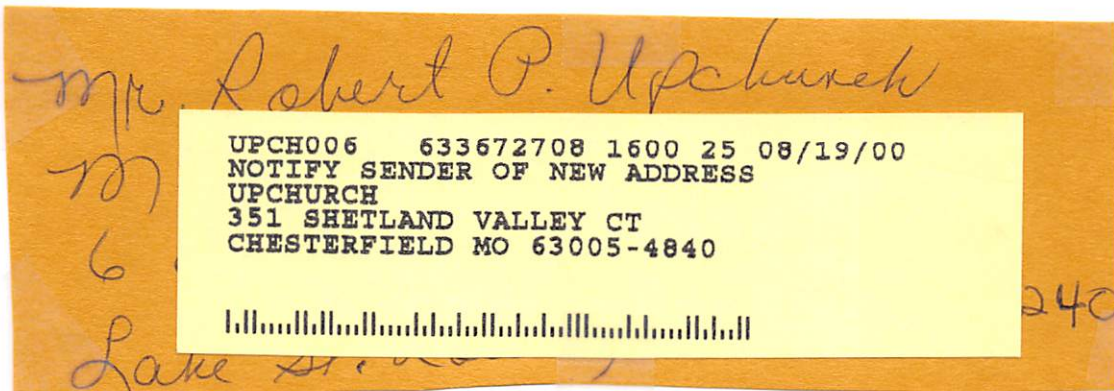

MORTIMER MANLY CRITCHER

A Biographical Sketch

Mortimer Manly Critcher is the son of Anson Critcher and Tabitha (Barnett) Critcher. He was born at Oxford, North Carolina, January 12, 1863. "Monnie" (as he is called by his family and boyhood friends) Critcher is the youngest of a family of 14 children. His father was married twice. His first wife was Phoebe Mallory, and by her he had 8 children, the names of which were as follows:

Joseph, William, John Charles, Lucy Ann, Rebecca Jane, Elizabeth.

By his 2nd wife, Tabitha Barnett, he had Emma, Robert, Roger, Webb, Patty, and Mortimer. Mortimer spent his early boyhood at Oxford.

Mortimer's father was a man of considerable property and was engaged in various lines of business, among which was farming, drug store, sawmilling, tannery. In addition, he was Sheriff of Granville County for many years. Anson Critcher was a big landowner before the Civil War, and had many slaves.

Mortimer came up during the reconstruction period. That never to be forgotten period suffered by the people of the South after the crippling blows from the invading army had leveled everything in the South. He remembers well, many of his father's ex-slaves; many of whom never left their master while he lived, nor ever considered themselves emancipated. The social status of Negro slaves and ex-slaves, in this section of the country, as well as elsewhere in the South, depended upon the social and economic status of their white masters. A gentleman planter who owned a large number of slaves, imparted to his Negroes considerably more social prestige than that enjoyed by the slaves

of a planter whose wealth permitted only a few. An only slave owned by a poor master was social trash among his own color. Impecunious whites are still referred to as "po' white trash." "Po' buckra" is the term more commonly used in designating this class in the State of South Carolina.

Some Negroes continue to bear the names of the families owning their forbears, but many more have assumed surnames that happened to appeal to them. There are white families today that take pride in the number of Negroes bearing their names, regarding it as an indication of the families' wealth.

Among Mortimer's earliest recollections is the mutual affection existing between himself and his father's ex-slaves, the house servants in particular, among which the most salient in his memory are: Dolly, the cook; Friday, the coachman and house boy; Big Mary, the house maid; and Little Mary, the nurse or Mammy. Dolly and Friday remained in the employ of Mortimer's mother, as her personal servants, as long as she kept house after the war.

~~The Catches lived at their town house in Oxford,~~ ^{The Catches lived at their town house in Oxford,} a part of the year, and the other part they spent at their plantation house ~~which was situated about five miles from Oxford.~~ ^{which was situated about five miles from Oxford.} It was at this large, old-time country house that Mortimer loved to go as a boy, and here he played many boyish pranks, aided and abetted by the older brothers and the servants.

His father was a strict Presbyterian, of Scotch descent. He was a God-fearing man, upright and honorable in all his dealings, and brought his family up under the strictest discipline. Mortimer's sister Emma, used to tell a little story, which will serve for an illustration.

Once while on vacation from college in Raleigh, she was entertaining her little brother by playing the piano for him. On this particular evening, she and "Monnie" were in the parlor, while their parents were reading in an

adjoining room. The old gentleman was hard of hearing. He could hear the music, but there was something else which he couldn't quite figure out. He turned to his wife and said, "Dear, it seems that there is a mighty bumping and thumping going on somewhere." "Oh," said she, with the utmost gravity, "it's nothing except the children playing. Continue with your reading." She knew better than to expose the fact that the "bumping" was Monnie's dancing to his sister's music, this being strictly against his father's religious principles.

Another little story which his mother used to love to tell was the following:

It seems that one of her favorite formulas for colds and sore throat was a mixture of vinegar, honey, black pepper and butter, made into a syrup. A spoonful of this brew was considered very effective; it was also very tasty. One night she had prepared this remedy to be taken before going to bed, and had set it near the fireplace to keep warm. On this particular occasion the minister was a guest in the house. It seemed that the prayers were unusually long when the preacher was present. Anyway, the little boy, Monnie, got very tired kneeling down, but being nearest to the dish of syrup, and everyone else having their backs turned as they knelt in prayer, the temptation was more than he could bear, so he thought he'd just taste it. He tasted several times. Surrepticiously at first, but becoming bolder with each taste. And till the company knelt. So, when prayers were finally over, and his mother returned to get the dish of syrup, lo! it had completely disappeared. There were traces of it still around the mouth of the culprit.

Mortimer went to school at Oxford as a boy, among his teachers and school mates were.....? He did not have the advantages which some of his brothers and sisters had who came up before the war. His father died when Mortimer was

17 years old, and he is buried in the family burying ground on the ancestral plantation near Oxford. After the decease of his father the boy had to make his own living. He went to work with the realization that much had been accomplished by the stimulus of the empty purse, and during his life he became very successful.

In a few years he went to Franklin County where he engaged in the culture of tobacco. In 1886, while sitting at his barn one night, where he was curing tobacco, and leaning against a rail or "snake fence", he said he heard a noise that sounded like the fence was falling. He looked and the lantern which was hanging by the barn, was swaying violently. There was no wind stirring at all, and for a time he was very mystified, but it soon dawned upon him what it was. News traveled slowly in those days, but in a few days he read an account of the terrible disaster in Charleston, S. C., caused by the earthquake.

In 1887 he married Miss Lula Creekmore, daughter of Josiah Gordon Creekmore and Ann(Gay) Creekmore, of Franklin County, N. C. Mrs. Critcher was born February 1, 1870, in Franklin County, N. C. She is the eldest of seven children, 5 girls and 2 boys.

In 1897 Mortimer Critcher moved with his family to Williamston, N. C. where he continued farming, chiefly the culture of tobacco, for about 10 years. In 1902 he went into the mercantile business in Williamston. He soon sold this business, however, and moved to Darlington County, S. C. Mortimer Critcher has, all his life, dealt in tobacco in some way, either growing it, or buying it for speculation.

He has always had a great love for blooded stock of all kinds, and always had plenty of it on his place. In his younger days he was very fond of horses

and the races, and has owned at one time some very fine specimens. Two of his horses held local track records. Before his eye sight became impaired he was quite a Nimrod, and loved to fish. He always kept fine dogs. Chiefly pointers, setters, and sometimes a pack of hounds. The latter of the breed having large, drooping ears, and voice of characteristic tone.

The writer feels that the propensity for animals is worth much in the tracing of the subject's character.

He had wonderful skill in barbecuing, that accomplishment which is now almost a lost art. It is a singular fact that all other industries except this have improved. The following is method:

When he once puts down his pigs, flesh side down, over the pit of coals, they are never turned until the drying of the skin shows that they are nearly done, and then when turned the flesh is nicely browned and cracked open in deep fissures, so that when the hot gravy of butter, vinegar and black pepper is poured on it, penetrates to the bone - a far superior mode to frequently turning and basting. To such delicious feasts his friends were bidden by the dozens. These feasts, which have been compared to the "fiestas" in Mexico, have been an institution in his home, principally on the 4th of July, for a period of at least 40 years or more. They also served as "round-ups" for the scattered members of the family. It is a matter of pride with him that he was appointed chairman of the committee to prepare the barbecue given at Lamar, S. C. in 1906, in honor of the late Benjamin R. Tillman.

Mr. Critcher is a democrat. While always interested in politics, he has never taken active part in them. ~~He belongs to the Order of Ancient Free and~~

Williamston were Dr. William Harrell and the Honorable Harry M. Stubbs. In Darlington County, South Carolina, perhaps his most intimate personal friends were the late Dr. Dudley Harrell and Mr. William DeWitte.

Mr Critcher is an attentive observer of nature and society. He has always been a diligent reader.

In appearance, Mortimer M. Critcher has more than average attraction. He is possessed of a magnificent physique, being 6 ft. in height, and weighs 225 lbs. Now, at the advanced age of 78, he is as erect as a soldier. A noble head, covered with luxuriant white hair, is borne proudly aloft. His eyes, gray, with dark eyelashes, expressing thoughtfulness. His forehead high and expansive, his nose of the Roman type, his entire countenance indicating courage and unyielding firmness of purpose, and invincible will-power. His manners are commanding.

As a separate but related matter my wife was born in Franklin Co, NC & raised in nearby Nash Co, NC. Many Franklin Co, NC families are intricately connected. The article you sent helped unfold some of these as indicated below.

Page 2 is the extract I made from the article you sent. Lula King Creechmore & Lula Kinsey Creechmore are one and the same. See Page 1 for more detail. Note that Lula was the daughter of Eunice (Lyndhurst) Gay. [I have yet to identify the father of this Eunice U but am building a file on her. She has to be a GDAU or GGDAM of Richard U, II]. Note that Lula's Aunt Catura and Benjamin Washington U. I know how he fits in: Both my wife & I trace some aspects of our family heritage back to the GAY family of Franklin Co, NC. My wife's (nee Eva Sallaine Sledge) Grandmother was nee Lanie Batchelor whose family is detailed in The Batchelor Family book. Sallaine is no doubt a distant cousin of all of those listed on Page 1 of the Lula Creechmore Profile.

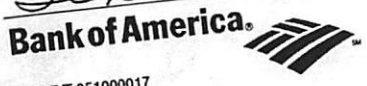

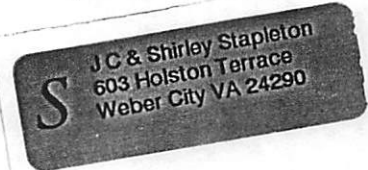

My sister, Bernice Bledsoe, brought a book by Olive Morgan some time back and when I saw the picture of John Jordan Upchurch, I thought he resembled our grand-father.

My material may have some errors and is definitely unorganized. I have tried to document things I have found. I have looked in Court houses and local libraries. I am having some copies of my grandfather Water Mode and I will send you one when I get them back.

I am 56 years old. My husband, Cecil, and I have 2 children and 5 grand-children. They all live close by. My mother Mary M. Lamb lives in Duffield, Va. and is 82 years old. She has help me know about a lot of the people. My father Luke W. Lamb died in March of 1987.

I guess because of lack of transportation the Upchurch's in Walter's generation did not visit much so we did not know them very well. My mother ^[NANCY EARNESTINE U.] did say that great grandpa John ^[JOHN G. U.] would walk across the mountains into Kentucky and visit with his people there ^{[EDDIE LEE U., D. [OF George U.] [Buddahh SE]]}

There is a man by the name of Oliner Upchurch in Greenville, Tenn. whose father is Sherman Up. ^[WILLIAM SAERMAN U.] He says they were from Kentucky but we could not recognize any of the names. ^[ELIZABETH NEU]

We had always been told that the Upchurches were from Greenville, North Carolina. We had been told that one of our grandmothers was from a prominent family that did not want her to marry the Upchurch man. Maybe that's why we were sort of a lost generation. ^[AMBROSE U.]

If it had not been for the Oline Morgan book we would still be wondering about our people.

There is another man on page 87a that looks an awful lot like our grandfather Walter.

Several of my mother's brothers and two sisters are still living. Her oldest sister Maxie will celebrate her ninetieth birthday July the 12th.

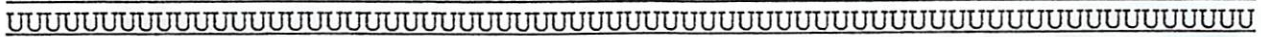

Dear Cousin Shirley,

I am gradually taking care of the family history backlog that accumulated as a result of our move from AZ to MO. It is taking much longer than I thought because some of my non-family history projects have been time consuming.

Shortly after your packet of details arrived on 27 FEB 1995 I worked on extracting some of the details and then put it aside. I have just returned to it and have spent several days on it. All the details are now recorded in the various profiles and on the master outline. It does not seem like it should take so much time but it does. I deeply appreciate the packet you prepared and all of the work that went into it. You have helped to improve the John U, IV / Ambrose U Subclan greatly. There are four lines in this Subclan. The lines are headed by the children of Ambrose U - namely John Jordan U, Priscilla M U, Mary Ann Elizabeth U

and William Henry U, I.

I enclose a copy of the John U, IV/Ambrose U subclass Master outline concerning generations 6, 7, 8 and 9. For the William Henry U, I Line I have enclosed continuation sections 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, ¹⁹₁ and 20. These continuation sections cover the descendants of the Grandchildren of William Henry U, I. You will note that we have made great progress on the William Henry U, I Line since I last sent you a Master outline. This is due in large measure to your interest and work. As usual there is more to do. I would appreciate it if you would go over these documents to me if you spot any errors or if you can add any of the missing details. I have included a set of specific questions on your mother's family and will appreciate any details you have or can get.

It is a little strange that William Henry U, I had only five children. Possibly his wife could not have more children after she gave birth to Christopher Columbus in 1850. She would have been only 35 years old at the time. The details we have on Ambrose U (XFD-20595) and Alexander U (XFD-20596) are quite sparse. My guess is that they were killed in the Civil War and never married. Perhaps we will learn in due course.

The census records you sent all fall into place except for the 1900 census for the family of William U (b JAN 1864). A copy of this is enclosed. Can you shed any more light on this family. Note that this couple had been married 5 years (were married ca 1895) - but they had a son b 1893 and a dau b 1894. Maybe the wife or the husband had been married before and their two older children are from an earlier marriage of one or the other. My census records for VA for earlier & later decades are not complete but the records I do have do not allow me to place William U b 1864.

This week-end we are working on U.S. Vol 16 No 3 and we hope to have it in the mail before Labor Day. As matters stand now I plan to include the picture of John Gordon U and a story about him.

Please let me know if you have questions. It is a great pleasure to have you as a very active, interested cooperator and I look forward to our continued collaboration.

The Upchurch Story

As I begin to attempt to organize all the information I have acquired about the Upchurch people in America , I find I hardly know where to begin. I must give a lot of credit to all the people whose hard work and money brought an awful lot of this information to my desk.

- When my sister Berniece Bledsoe brought a book entitled The Upchurch Story by Olive A. Morgan, we were looking through it and found a picture that looked just like my grandfather. The book seemed to lose our line somewhere in North Carolina. I was curious to know if this really was a great grandfather.

I begin to do research at our court house and library. I also started asking questions of my mother and my aunt. Later a lady came to visit my mother and she was doing the same thing.

- Her name is Ameilia Taylor. She is from Witchata Falls, Tx. So many things have come to light through the work she has done. I also learned she had been to this area before looking for information on her grandmother who turned out to be our great- grandfathers sister. Small world isn't it. Ameilia also told us about Michael Enterprises, a publication about the Upchurch genealogy. The author is Robert Phillip Upchurch. He resides in Pheonix, Ariz.

- According to the book by Olive A. Morgan the Upchurches came to America in 1651. Michael Upchurch was the first Upchurch to arrive in America. He came from a little town called LITTLE GIDDING in England. The LITTLE GIDDING CHURCH still stands today.

- When Michael Upchurch came to the new world , he settled in Surry county, Virginia and later migrated to Granville, North Carolina. Some of them left and came to Scott County Virginia. They settled in the Robinett Valley area.
