BESSIE VIOLA STOCKTON, born January 10, 1906, married July 29, 1923, Willie Dudley McElroy, born December 25, 1902, died March 29, 1979, and is buried in Henry's Chapel Cemetery of Cherokee County. Willie was the son of Homer Dudley McElroy and Allie Mae Musick McElroy.

Bessie was less than two years old when her father died. She was very close to her mother during childhood. Bessie learned the skills of tatting, crocheting, quilting, sewing and other handiwork at an early age from her mother and older sisters.

When Bessie was growing up, she loved to help milk the cows so she could share some of the fresh milk with her pet cats.

Bessie and Willie McElroy lived at Mixon until their first child was born. They were living at Troup when the second child was born, and in that same year Willie was seriously injured on his job at the cotton gin. The couple moved back to Mixon when his condition improved and lived for a while in one of the rent houses on the Stockton farm where Bessie grew up.

Bessie and Willie McElroy purchased a seventy-five acre farm in the Buncombe Community of Smith County, Texas, in 1928. On the farm they grew cotton, corn, peanuts, watermelons, potatoes, peppers, tomatoes and other produce. They also grew hogs for market, and their other livestock consisted of two big red mules and one or two milk cows. Chickens were kept for home use, and at one time they grew a few turkeys. Willie peddled the produce in the oil field during the 1930's. He also hauled to the Dallas and Houston markets. The five youngest children were born at Buncombe.

The McElroys sold the Buncombe place in 1945, and purchased land near Whitehouse, Texas, with Willie's brother, Cecil McElroy. The land in that location was sold for purposes of Lake Tyler. Today a road named "McElroy" winds through the lake area land where the brothers once grew cotton and other farm products.

Bessie's present farm located near Troup has been the McElroy homestead for over forty years.

Being the oldest McElroy child, this writer shares a few memories. When the children were growing up, it was not unusual for Bessie to help them build a playhouse or make clay toys at the spring-fed branch. She often took her youngsters on long hikes in the woods to look for wild grapes or pick sweetgum.

During the depression years almost everything had some recycle value. Bessie bleached flour sacks and made muslin-like diapers for her babies. She bleached sugar sacks, animal feed bags and fertilizer bags and sewed the family sheets, pillow cases and towels. She once sewed a beautiful white sailor dress for a daughter from one-hundred-pound sugar sacks. From the muslin-like bags she also sewed cool summer gowns for the family.

Willie cut and sold pulpwood from the Buncombe farm. He was also the family barber.

Bessie and Willie McElroy were married over fifty-five years. They believed that one of their best-accomplished goals was seeing to it that all of their children received a high school education.

Bessie remains a devoted mother, grandmother, and great grandmother. She has blessed her family and friends with many gifts of her handiwork. Her descendants gather at her home often on holidays for visiting and celebrating. 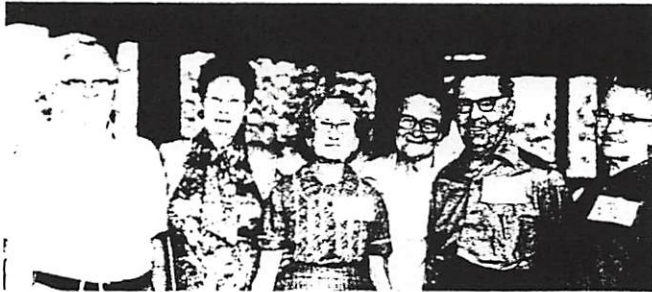

MATTIE ELIZABETH "LIZZIE" STOCKTON, born January 4, 1890, died March 24, 1985, and is buried in Mixon Cemetery. She was married December 22, 1912, at Mixon to Rufus Gladstone Thompson Sr., born August 3, 1892, at Wills Point, Texas, died August 23, 1975 and is buried in Mixon Cemetery. Gladstone was the son of Fielding Edward Thompson and Mattie Ham Thompson.

As a young girl, Mattie Elizabeth was ambitious to become a school teacher. At age nine, she started to school at Mixon. Miss Lillian Pope was Lizzie's first teacher, and grades one, two and three were all taught in the same room.

Lizzie finished eight grades at Mixon. She then attended high school in Troup, which is about seven miles north of Mixon. While attending the Troup school, she boarded in the homes of Mrs. McAlister, the Hugh Tipton family and her kin, the Robert Egbert Salmon family.

Lizzie received her first college education at the Baptist College in Jacksonville.

She began teaching at the age of nineteen. Her first school was at Sycamore Grove, a community between Mixon and Mt Selman. She taught eight grades in one room.

Lizzie was teaching at Shiloh, a community now called Turney, when she married. After her marriage, she continued to teach. She also continued her education by attending summer school at Lon Morris College of Jacksonville and Stephen F. Austin State College in Nacogdoches. On August 22, 1952, at the age of sixty-two Lizzie received her Master of Education degree. The commencement program was at the Vista, an outdoor auditorium on the campus of Stephen F. Austin State College. The Honorable Lyndon Baines Johnson, U. S. Senator from Texas, was the speaker.

Other schools where Lizzie taught during the forty-five year span of her teaching career were New Hope, Cove Springs, Barsola, Ponta, Pleasant Hill, Union Grove, Summerfield and Nome. She taught grade levels of one through eight.

She retired from teaching at the age of seventy. In early retirement, she traveled and made two trips that were special- one to New York and one to Hawaii.

Lizzie was a member of The First Presbyterian Church of Jacksonville for over sixty years. She was also a member of the Wednesday Study Club of Jacksonville and of the Home Demonstration Club of New Hope.

Mattie Elizabeth and Rufus Gladstone Thompson were married sixty-two years.

Gladstone owned and operated a grocery store in Jacksonville for many years. Several years prior to World War II, he was a salesman at the Thad Ray Men's Store of Jacksonville. During the War he was employed at the ship yards in Orange, Texas. After retirement, his hobby was farming.

Samuel Louis Stockton was "Pa" to his children and "Louis" to others who knew him. He learned to read and write in the little log school house near the place of his birth in the community now known as Tecula. As a young man, he sold his share of the land that he inherited from his parents. He purchased a farm in the Mixon Community about six miles north of Tecula. It was there where he built a one-room log cabin and settled with his bride in 1888. The cabin was a few hundred yards west of the old barn that exists on the place today.

Ophelia Stockton was "Ma" to her children and grandchildren and "Felie" to others who knew her.

Louis and Felie Stockton's farm grew to several hundred acres as they purchased more land.

After their second child was born, they built a new home that was located a few yards north of the home that exists on the place today.

Louis Stockton had a keen sense for business. He belonged to the Woodmen of the World Society. He was interested in the religion of The Watch Tower Bible and Tract Society, which became Jehovah's Witnesses in 1931. It was not unusual for him to travel to Jacksonville to attend religious meetings.

Louis Stockton had spent the day prior to his death at the hard labor of stripping ribbon cane.

At Christmastime, only a few weeks after Louis died, the family home burned. The children had popped firecrackers in the back yard a short time before the family left the house to visit neighbors. The house burned while they were visiting. It is believed that a firecracker was carelessly tossed into a barrel of feathers on the back porch and started the fire.

The death of Louis and the loss from the fire caused difficult times for Ophelia and the children.

Neighbors helped, and a new home was built. The family worked hard, and their farm operation continued to support them.

All of the Stockton children attended school at Mixon, which was about one and one-half miles from their home.

On July 20, 1914, Ophelia Dickey Stockton married Samuel Patrick Wood. He died in 1916 at the age of sixty-one and is buried in Mixon Cemetery.

Ophelia was Mrs. S. P. Wood for only a few months when Mr. Wood took leave of the family without telling anyone where he was going. He returned from the mysterious journey almost a year later, bearing gifts for the family.

When I was growing up, Ma still owned her gift from Mr. Wood, which was a beautiful hand-made cedar chest. Had it not been for the much admired chest, which had Mr. Wood's and Ma's names carved on it, we might not have heard as much about Mr. Wood.

His absence from the family and the briefness of the marriage are probably reasons why Ophelia continued to be known as Ophelia Stockton.

In 1918 a new family home was built by a carpenter and the Stockton sons. This home was one of the finest in the community. It was a large white house with five rooms and an enclosed hallway and a closet to store quilts from the floor to the ceiling. The windows had screened frames, and the two entrances had screened doors. The back porch was screened in and extended the full length of the house. There was also a large front porch that housed the water shelf where the wooden bucket of water sat with the common dipper that everyone drank from.

After the family moved into the new home, the old one was torn down, and Chester, the oldest son, used the lumber to build his first home.

We, Ma's grandchildren, remember her Victrola and some favorite records, "Turkey in the Straw," "My Blue Heaven," and "Red River Valley." We enjoyed the porch swing and took care not to bump the wall with it. Stories about the remains of the old ash barrels that once produced lye for making soap and the ruins of a storm cellar, caved in many years before are among our memories. There was also the old well that according to family tradition was dug in the early 1890's by Ma's stepbrother, Billie Penland, who received a gold watch for digging the well. It was a forbidden well to children; however, we would occasionally dare to lean over its curb and peep into the deep hole at the shimmering water below, even knowing that the consequence would surely be death if we fell in.

One of Ma's nephews, J. C. Griffin from Stockton lineage, boarded with her during the 1930's and 1940's and took care of the farm chores.

For many years Ophelia Stockton sold milk, butter and eggs produced from the farm. She traded at J. L. Brown's general store in Jacksonville, purchasing what she needed and saving the balance.

The great depression of the late 1920's and 1930's caused many banks to foreclose and pay only a percentage on each dollar deposited with them. At that time Ophelia had money deposited in one such bank and was one who took a loss. After that she had very little faith in banks.

During the depression many people lost their farms, and some families had very little to eat. Vegetables, fruits, chickens, eggs and milk, all produced on the farm, helped in those lean years, and Ma managed to keep her land and recover financially.

Ophelia Stockton had two sons who served in World War I, and during World War II, each of her children had one or more sons who served in the U.S. Military forces.

Ma Stockton was a Christian of the Methodist religion. As a young woman, she was converted into this faith at her home by a traveling minister. She attended the church in Mixon that served both Presbyterian and Methodist worshippers.

Ophelia Stockton suffered several years of poor health prior to her death from a stroke.

Louis and Ophelia Stockton had nine children, all born at Mixon in Cherokee County, and here are notes on them.

SAMUEL LOUIS "SAM" STOCKTON JR., born February 22, 1897, died May 22, 1983, and is buried in Mixon Cemetery. Sam was married September 29, 1923, to Nellie Emily Watson, born December 30, 1903, at Mixon, died August 29, 1989, and is buried in Mixon Cemetery. Nellie was the daughter of John Silas Watson and Josephine Melissa Dansby Watson.

Sam Stockton was a child with courage and endurance. During his youth he spent many hours alone learning to speak fluently. He was determined to conquer the speech problem that was causing embarrassment to him in his childhood. Sam achieved this goal when he was nearing his teen age years. It was over sixty years later when he learned what had caused his long-forgotten speech problem. An observant doctor performing a physical examination discovered that Sam was tongue tied. When asked by the doctor if he desired the simple operation required to correct the infirmity, Sam politely refused the surgery. After returning home, he told his friends of the doctor's discovery. They expressed surprise, because for as long as they could remember, Sam didn't talk much, but when he did speak they had no problem understanding him.

Sam and Nellie Stockton owned a farm in the Mixon Community. During the 1930's they made railroad cross ties from timber on their land and sold them for one dollar each. The ties were made with hand tools, and on a good long day the two of them could make twenty ties.

Sam served in the U. S. Navy during World War I.

Sam and Nellie became the owners and operators of the Stockton home place after Ophelia Stockton's death. The home on the Stockton place burned a few years after they moved there. Sam and Nellie replaced the burned home with the brick home that is in existence at the site today.

Sam was an interesting, busy individual all of his life. He had milked his cow and delivered the bucket of milk to the kitchen table only moments before his death at age eighty-six. He died within fifty yards of where he was born.

Nellie Stockton served as a nurse for many years in the Jacksonville area. She was active in the community church groups, who helped needy families. If a neighboring family had a death of one of its members, she was there with sympathy and a helping hand. She played the piano and her favorite songs were the gospel hymns.
