I have enjoyed reviewing the details provided in your letter of 11 FEB 1999 and thank you for them; very much. Several of the master outlines have been revised because they were getting so cluttered. This is the price I pay for my manual system.

Enclosed is a copy of the Master Outline for the Archibald Ashman Line in the George W/ Lydia W Subclan. This covers Archibald, his children & grandchildren. Descendants (if any/ if known) of the grandchildren are covered in continuation sections as indicated on the left hand side of the page.

As a part of this Master Outline I include (after the pink sheet) Continuation Sections 1, 4, 5 & 6. Thanks for the input on the spelling of DISHMON / DISHMAN. I have decided to use these two spellings interchangeably for the present.

Re your Morgan Ancestor - enclosed is a "Morgan" packet I have prepared. A copy of the "Context" sheet has been placed in my Profile System for each individual mentioned so I will recognize if some relevant information appears later. In the meantime the packet includes what I did uncover - it is probably not helpful but you can judge for yourself.

Enclosed are two sheets I have marked with a red "X". Can I assume Grace Ann's daughter Deborah Ann Crane is Mr (or) Roy Gene Page and Mr (2nd) Alden Namby? If I have it right, Arya simply neglected to tell me in her letter of 8 AUG 1981 that her granddaughter had been previously married.

Valerie, it's great to have you as a cooperator. I hope there is more we can do to help each other. Just let me know if you need something special from me or have a question. I'd welcome any additional input you have now in the future. If you spot reference to any Upchurch in newspapers, a copy of the details would be most welcome.

I do have a question for you but I have to give you some background. One mystery I am wrestling with is the family of my father's grandmother. My father's family came from Cumberland County, KY (this is located on the Cumberland Plateau, as is Fentress Co., TN). His mother was named Rebecca Tabitha Morgan. She apparently didn't talk much about her ancestry and so no one in the family can tell me who her parents are. Her only remaining children, my great aunts Edith and Vernie, were orphaned at a very young age. Census records have so far not conclusively identified her. I've turned over every rock I have been able to find with no luck. To this end, I am researching likely families with the surname Morgan from the area around Cumberland Co., KY. My question: George Washington Crouch, who married Millie Dishman, had a sister named Elvira Malinda Crouch (I believe she was called Linda) who married a John Morgan and they lived in Whitley County, KY. Do you have any information on their descendants? You may not as they may not be of the Upchurch clan, but I am fishing.

Dear Cousin Phil:

I got back from a short vacation to the Caribbean and found the back issues of the UB which you sent. I am delighted with the detail and the documentation. If all my family lines were so thoughtfully researched this would really be an easy job. Little by little I will order some of the other back issues.

Thank you so much for the additional information. I will try to answer the questions you posed in your letter of January 25 in the order in which you asked them.

1. Ona Mae Dishmon. I hope you will be able to get information regarding "Aunt Onie" (she always referred to herself as that even though we were cousins) from a better source than me. A good source would be former Fentress County teacher Glen Barton, her son, or his wife Christine Barton, former Fentress County librarian. I don't feel at all qualified to be a source as my information is second hand from my mother.

I refer to her by the name Dishmon and not by Ona Greer because I am not sure if she ever took Sam Greer's name. She was not Sam's child, according to my mother. She was born out of wedlock before Mary and Sam married. Mom either cannot remember who her father is or isn't telling. You know how touchy people can be about illegitimacy and I don't want to upset anyone. Mom says Sam was very good to Ona and treated her like a daughter but I don't know if he ever adopted her. If I am wrong and she took the name Greer as she was growing up and before she married Herman Barton, please correct me.

2. Forbus in Pickett County. My bad. You are absolutely correct about my mistake in placing Forbus in Pickett vs. Fentress County. I do know better, but I got sloppy. Forbus is very close to the Pickett County line and probably straddles it (see my next item) and most of that generation are buried in the Wayne Davidson Cemetery which I believe is in Pickett, so I just goofed. Thanks so much for pointing it out. I need a proofreader!

3. Ona's Grandchildren. Until I got your printouts all I had was from information Mom told me and also what I had from Ona's obituary. There is no date or mention of the paper (I assume the Fentress County Leader-Times) but it reads, "Mrs. Ona Mae Barton, age 90, wife of the late Herman Barton, of the Forbus Community of Pickett County, passed away Tuesday, April 2nd at Fentress County General Hospital following an extended illness. Mrs. Barton, a homemaker, was born January 29, 1901 in Pickett County. She was a member of the Travisville United Methodist Church. Survivors include three sons, Glenn Barton, Jamestown, Boyd Barton and Bruce Barton both of Forbus; three daughters-in-law, Christene Barton, Jamestown, Norma Jean Barton and Sue Barton both of Forbus; three grandchildren, Lonnie Barton, Jamestown, Glenda Chaffin, Crossville, TN and Jeanetta Barton, Forbus. Funeral services were held Thursday, April 4, 1991 at 2 p.m. in the Chapel of Mundy Funeral Home...with interment in the Davidson Cemetery at Forbus. Pallbearers included Mickey Clark, Eules Evans, Dale Chaffin, David Choate, Gary Crockett and Billy Crockett." I would guess that Dale Chaffin was Glenda's husband. Note that Forbus is listed here as being in Pickett County.

4. The children of Dora and Spence Crouch: My information is very poor regarding my second cousins. Your information is much better here than mine is. I didn't grow up in Fentress County and when I did go for visits, I spent most of my time with my first cousins, the Crocketts. My information on my second cousins is very sketchy as I really don't know them well at all. I only began my family history efforts back in the Spring and I don't have complete information by a long shot. I figured I would eventually go back and do more complete research on "collateral relatives" as I get time and as I get to know them at family reunions and such. Sorry I am not a better source here. I am, however, a good source for my family and for my first cousins, the Crocketts.

Dora's obituary (just a clipping, no date or what newspaper, but I assume Fentress County Leader-Times)says, "Mrs. Dora Crouch age 82 of Forbus, Tn., passed away November 21, 1986 in Nashville, Tn. She was born June 9, 1904 in Pickett County, Tn. She was a homemaker and a member of Travisville United Methodist Church. She is survived by two daughters Mrs. Janice Billingsley of Rickman, Tn. And Mrs. Janie Brown of Albany, Ky. One brother Mr. Oat Dishman of Forbus, Tn. One sister Mrs. Arza Upchurch of Jamestown, Tn. 6 grandchildren. Funeral services were held November 23, 1986 at 2 p.m. in the Chapel of the Mundy Funeral Home ... Interment in the Davidson Cemetery in Pickett County, Tn. Pallbearers were: Eddie Brown, Joe Billingsley, Kevin Cross, Stephen Billingsley, Guinn Dishman, and David Poore."

5. The spelling of Dishman/Dishmon: I was always told that the MON spelling was preferred by the family but I really don't know who began spelling this way. The name is spelled every which way (including DEASHMAN) in the census records. Most of the tombstones I've seen in the Davidson Cemetery show the MON spelling. I suspect this began with old Archie Dishmon my 3 greats grandfather. He was the first, apparently, to get an education and was a teacher, justice of the peace, etc. I only know that Mom says she was always told that *our* family spelled the name Dishmon. At the beginning of my research I consistently spelled the name this way, but later realized that most of the family do not. I have tried to correct the spelling so that only from Archibald Dishmon (1806-1879) and his descendants is the name spelled with an o. I will try to find out more about this and get back to you.

I hope this information helps. I'm sorry not to be a more thorough researcher but I am trying.

I do have a question for you but I have to give you some background. One mystery I am wrestling with is the family of my father's grandmother. My father's family came from Cumberland County, KY (this is located on the Cumberland Plateau, as is Fentress Co., TN). His mother was named Rebecca Tabitha Morgan. She apparently didn't talk much about her ancestry and so no one in the family can tell me who her parents are. Her only remaining children, my great aunts Edith and Vernie, were orphaned at a very young age. Census records have so far not conclusively identified her. I've turned over every rock I have been able to find with no luck. To this end, I am researching likely families with the surname Morgan from the area around Cumberland Co., KY. My question: George Washington Crouch, who married Millie Dishman, had a sister named Elvira Malinda Crouch (I believe she was called Linda) who married a John Morgan and they lived in Whitley County, KY. Do you have any information on their descendants? You may not as they may not be of the Upchurch clan, but I am fishing.

Of interest in the article: "Kimberly, the daughter of Ralph and Nancy Upchurch of Allardt, was a senior at Middle Tennessee state, where she was scheduled to graduate this summer. Miss Upchurch and Miss Kline were reportedly enroute to Cookeville from Murfreesboro to watch the Lady Raiders championship contest against Morehead State when the accident occurred. From the Fentress County Leader-Times (no date) entitled "Two Die In Fire Las Week at Residence In Forbus" states "Joint funeral services were held for Mrs. Dishmon and her son Wendell Friday, September 12, 1980 at 10:00 a.m. at the Mundy Chapel... Interment in the Davidson Cemetery. Mrs. Dishmon is survived by one son, Guinn Dishmon of Forbus; two brothers, Alvin Upchurch of Jamestown and Elam Upchurch of Anderson, Indiana; one sister, Mrs. Carl (Helen) Crabtree of Jamestown. Also three grandchildren. Wendell Dishmon is survived by two sons, Darnell dishmon of Montgomery, Ala. And Tony Dishmon of Montgomery; one daughter, Tammy Dishmon of Montgomery and one brother Guinn Dishmon of Forbus." In this article the paper says the home was located at the Fentress-Pickett County line. It also consistently spells the name with the O spelling.

I do have a question for you but I have to give you some background. One mystery I am wrestling with is the family of my father's grandmother. My father's family came from Cumberland County, KY (this is located on the Cumberland Plateau, as is Fentress Co., TN). His mother was named Rebecca Tabitha Morgan. She apparently didn't talk much about her ancestry and so no one in the family can tell me who her parents are. Her only remaining children, my great aunts Edith and Vernie, were orphaned at a very young age. Census records have so far not conclusively identified her. I've turned over every rock I have been able to find with no luck. To this end, I am researching likely families with the surname Morgan from the area around Cumberland Co., KY. My question: George Washington Crouch, who married Millie Dishman, had a sister named Elvira Malinda Crouch (I believe she was called Linda) who married a John Morgan and they lived in Whitley County, KY. Do you have any information on their descendants? You may not as they may not be of the Upchurch clan, but I am fishing.

In the year ahead we should be able to exchange considerable information based on our mutual interest in the Uphursh Family. In the meantime let me take a couple of approaches.

FIRST - Let me comment on the details provided in your letter of 19 JAN 99.

#1 - Re Ona Mae Ashman vs Ona Mae Green - see enclosed sheet with questions.

#2 - your printout shows Anja Alma Ashman as born in Forluc, Richett Co, TN. I assume ~~that~~ should be Forluc, Fentress Co, TN [she & I had a number of nice exchanges several years ago]

#3 - Re Ona Mae Ashman's Grandchildren - I show Glenda named Danny Dale Guffey & married. Do I interpret your record to say she married (2nd) - - CHAFFIN?

#4 Re Children of Sara Ashman & David Spencer Crow:

#A I show their daughter Janie and Eddie Brown & had children Crystal & Tanya - but not a Sheila Brown as shown in your records. ??

#B I show their daughter Janice and Joe Bellingsley and had a dau Sheila Bellingsley + 3 other children Stephen Bellingsley [NOT IN YOUR LIST], Sharon Bellingsley, and Stephanie Bellingsley. Did Stephanie marry - - CARLSON before she and Kevin Crow?

#5 I can't DISMAN/DISHMON or the same. In your printout you prefer the spelling

DISHMAN. Can you tell me when the DISHMAN spelling got to be the preferred spelling in your line?

SECOND - you have my earlier version of the Master outline for the family of Archibald Dishman born 28 FEB 1860 - except for cases where I recorded descendants on a different Master outline because the family members belonged to another line as well. Let me provide you with some of these supplementary Master outlines as follows:

- # a Master outline for Luanda Crouch [Continuation section 6A] re DNA GREEN/DNA DISHMAN
- # b Master outline sheet 17I from Continuation section 17 of the George W/ Shadrach & Subdan. Note portion dealing with other Emma Dishmans
- # c Master outline sheet 63A for Martin Hancock showing descendants of Florence Jefferson Dishman [From George W/ Shadrach & Subdan]
- # d Master outline sheet 4A for Joseph Daily Crouch of the George W/ Lydia & Subdan showing descendants of Sara Dishman
- # e Master outline sheet 5C for Arza Alma Dishman line in the George W/ Shadrach & Subdan
- # f Master outline sheet 7H for Harley Paul Crabtree of the George W/ Joseph & Subdan showing descendants of Thekla Chloa Green.

This should give you a reasonably complete picture of the descendants of Archibald Ashman b 28 FEB 1860 as they exist in my organized files. No doubt there is more to add one way or another. I am sorry some of the master outlines are somewhat cluttered. When they get bad enough I re-copy them. They should be in a computer format making this job unnecessary - but that is another story.

Perhaps you will respond with some more comments on the family of Archibald Ashman b 28 FEB 1860 based on details provided herein and on any other information you think relevant. We can then see where we go in pursuit of our mutual interests. I would welcome any questions or suggestions you may have. At some point I would like to back up and see if we have anything to share on the siblings of Archibald Ashman b 1860 & their families.
