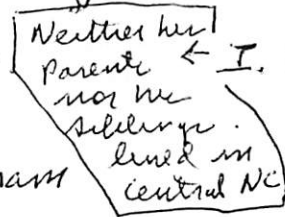

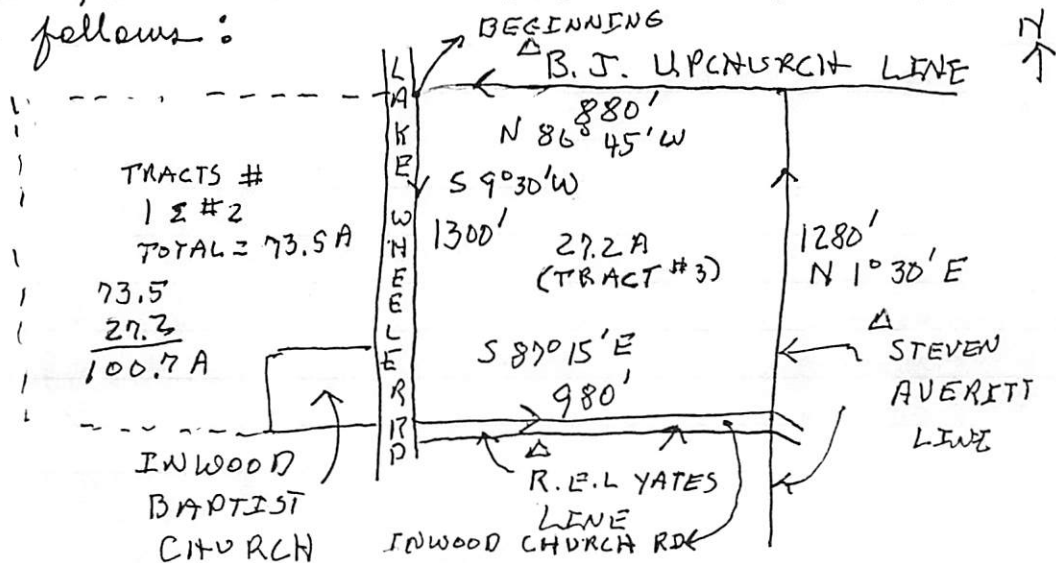

The Deed for 27.2A was made on 16 MAR 1915, the date the parcel was bought by Yates at public auction at the site. The deed was recorded on 8 FEB 1934 in Book 663, Page 183. See Deed File for complete and easily readable copy.

This 27.2A parcel lies in the SE corner of the large Woodland Plantation to which ^ΔB. J. Upchurch moved about 1871. In 1893 Woodland owners ^ΔB. J. and ^ΔW. G. Upchurch and their wives sold 100 A to Eliza Kendall (Wright) Upchurch; ^ΔBk 127, Pg 48, 15 JUL 1893; ^ΔBk 663, Pg 183 provides metes and bounds for the 100 acres but seems to omit some bearings & distances - need to net. Lake Wheeler Road is referred to as Aunt Feny Road and Penny's Pond Road.

^ΔE. K. W. Upchurch and husband ^ΔJohn William Upchurch, Sr. mortgaged on 9 DEC 1913 against the 100 A and gave a Deed of Trust to secure same (^ΔBk 282, Pg 468, 11 DEC 1913). The lender ^ΔI. J. ALLEN utilized Trustee ^ΔW. N. JONES who foreclosed as the debt was not serviced. Jones arranged for ^ΔRIDDICK and ^ΔMANN to survey the 100 A in MAR 1915. They divided it into Parcel 1 & 2 on the west side of Lake Wheeler Rd (73.5 A) and Parcel 3 on the East side (27.2 A)

^ΔR. E. L. YATES, already owning adjoining land on the South, was the high bidder for the 27.2 A - \$2525.60 (\$85.50/A). The 16 MAR 1915 Deed describes the 27.2 A as follows:

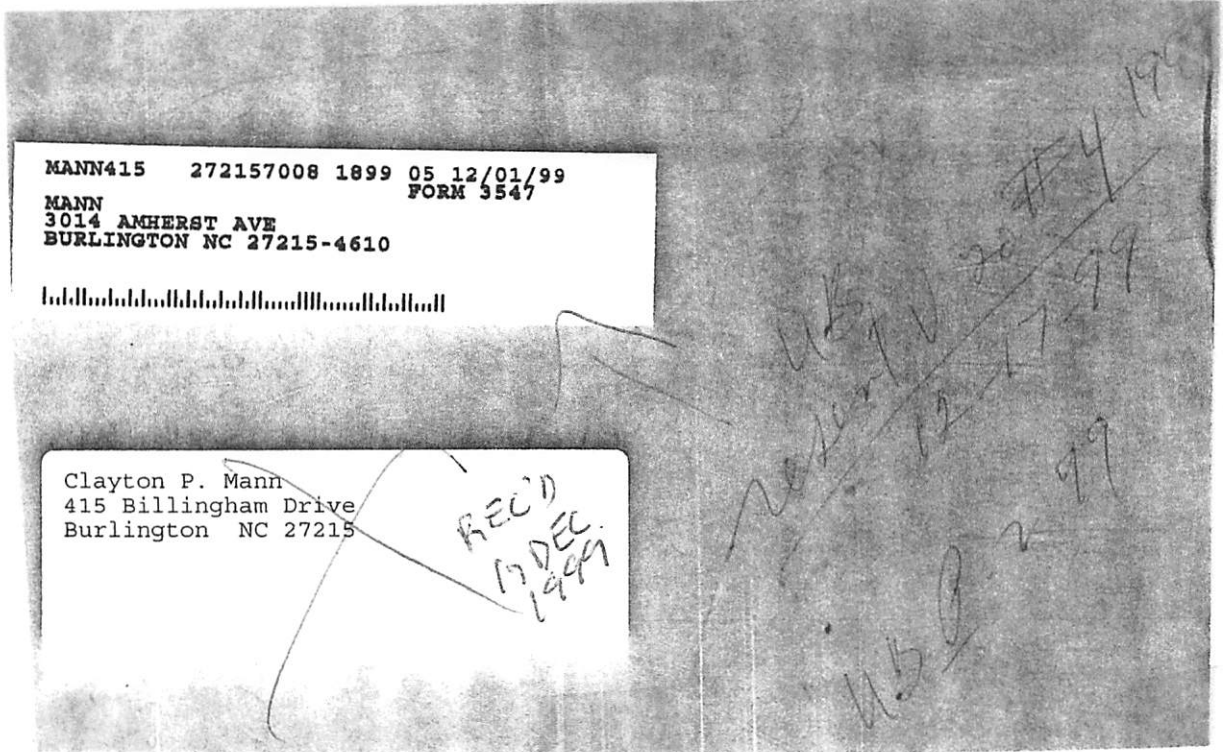

I've attached the copies of the Whitney Upchurch estate papers I just a few months ago became aware even existed. See this URL to see where I located the attached images:

As you can see, these papers remove any lingering doubt anyone may have that Candace Upchurch was the daughter of Whitney Upchurch. The papers also show what year Whitney died (1863) and when Elizabeth Goodwin Upchurch died (April 1869), as well as other interesting family information including the oldest daughter, Nancy, being identified, as well as Nancy's husband, William M. Hobby. However, the first page of the estate papers, a document from August 1883, lists a couple of names I can't fit into the immediate family:

Ephraim L. Upchurch and W. S. (or W. L. or D. L. ??) Upchurch. Perhaps the former is really Duncan L. Upchurch who is shown in other estate papers and who did not pass away until 1903. He is not shown on this document as Duncan. Bennett A. Upchurch would have been deceased by 1883 and so he would not be listed, and I guess these papers put to rest somewhat the fate of Bennett's brother James M. Upchurch who I cannot locate after June 1865 when he was released from a Union prison in Virginia after taking the Oath of Allegiance. He is not listed either. I'd like to learn what became of James. Perhaps you've seen these estate papers before, but regardless, please review and let me know what you see revealed in these papers.

By the way, many of the Holleman family researchers are looking for a web site to locate all their genealogical information. Their web site hosted by Ancestry was recently shut down. I was going to help them as my small company designs web sites and hosts them as well as performing IT support for many small companies. I was still considering what to do for them and how best to proceed when I received your information on Allied Families. I now think that would be the best place for them to go with their information. They have several very active, dedicated researchers, are very nice people, and as you know the Hollemans were early residents of Buckhorn District. Should I let them know about AlliedFamilies.com and give them your contact information?

Weebly is one of those, but as you noted it's definitely limited in what it can do. However, what it allows for is very well put together. Does the \$1200 year cover hosting and some maintenance, i.e., changes and additions, etc.? \$1200 should cover at least an hour of design work each month plus hosting costs. We build most of our web sites in DotNetNuke (DNN), a Microsoft ASP.net based content management platform. It is very flexible, extensible and scalable; it lends itself well to a site where large amounts of data need to be stored and easily accessed. It has back-end hooks to Amazon Web Services and other Cloud data storage platforms so if the data is quite large in size, which genealogical collections can be as you know, it can be accommodated. The changes can be made easily online once the structure for the site is in place. And it can provide for multiple mini-sites, really separate web sites, under one roof which could work well for the allied families approach. However, if we go this way it does work best if the approach to one site is very much like the approach to another in terms of media presentation modules, discussion forum modules, FAQs, contact forms, image sliders, etc. I can explain more in detail later on this.

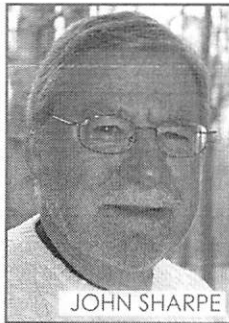
