I was giving your William Haywood a second look today and was wondering if you have any new info.

Also, the more information from Halifax about the Gov. John, the more we know that your Wm. Haywood Branch is not his son. The Gov.'s son was William Henry Branch...I am sorry, I am sure that the elders in the family want to believe the connection to the famous Gov. John Branch.

I am sending the info to a fellow researcher who has the New England Branch database and see if any of the names ring a bell....since you mentioned

your aunt remembers something about New Hampshire. Just thought we should check.

I do have a question for you on the Collins side...do you know where the 'Benton' in Tho. Benton Collins name comes from? Do you have the parents of Thomas Benton Collins. There is a Branch family that intermarried with the Bentons, all from Halifax Co., NC.

Can't remember what I sent you last....but, here is what the research and a lot of circumstantial evidence makes me believe is basically right....and now we have to find proof...

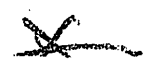

I believe the last time we emailed was in Aug/Sept of 1999.

I told you I would contact you if I got any information on your William Haywood Branch.

Well, I have been doing work on the Wake County, NC, Cumberland Co., NC and Hargett Co., NC Branch families. #1 comes from Duplin Co., NC family. #2 and 3# come from Cumberland Co., NC. I believe that John Branch, may be son of a Benjamin Branch of Cumberland Co., NC.

Please look over this information, comparing it to all your notes. Check to see if any mention of Cumberland or Harnet Counties is mentioned anyway.

I know that in one census he is Haywood and another place William H. and in other places Wm. Haywood, but, I believe it is the same person. I think maybe different people's spelling changed Martha's name from Pearson to Priest.

With this info, I think you could get some of the census records and find your family on them. The census info I have is from another researcher who only had copied down a couple of the names that interested her. You do need the whole entry for William and Martha 1850/1860/1870....and these will all have all the kids listed...

So, anyway, let me give you this new information and see what you think.....

Incidentally, the name of the plantation where my sister Ruth married was Glover -- not Grover -- Plantation. The four of us were all raised there, just south of Memphis, in the section of the state of Mississippi that is called the Delta. Glover used to belong to the family of Colonel Bedford, the famous Confederate military leader in the War Between the States. There was much tradition among those who lived at Glover, a beautiful rose garden and many Magnolia trees. Most of the Blacks had been born right there on the "Place", and their grandparents and great-grandparents had been slaves there. The same bell that rang during Civil War times was rung every morning at six by Nick Branch, whose father and grandfather and great-grandfather had rung the same bell. He also rang it at noon, one in the afternoon and six in the evening.

My father, for whom I am named, was a Planter and Gentleman of the "Old School". He had been named for Patrick Layton, a South Carolinian who was the brother of Delitha Layton who married my second great grandfather, William Sanders, of Kershaw District, South Carolina. During approximately the same time period the Upchurches migrated to Greene County, the Sanders family migrated West, through Pickens County, Alabama, to Neshoba and Attala County, Mississippi. It is fascinating to me that the Layton name appears in the Upchurch family, as well, and perhaps one day I will be able to explore that connection.

P.S. The slave bell was high off the ground, in a wisteria-covered tower.

The town of Apex had its beginning with the close of the Civil War. Among its first settlers were J. McC. Ellington, H. C. Olive, Q. I. Hudson, W. F. Utley, W. H. Harward, Brinkley Olive, A. N. Betts and others, who contributed to its life in the beginning and afterwards. It was incorporated by the Legislature of 1871-'72, with the late Hon. H. C. Olive as its first mayor. It derived its name from being the highest point on the survey of the Raleigh & Augusta Air Line Railroad.

Until 1905 it was but a small town, where the standard of virtue, intelligence and patriotism was high, but where little progress in material things had been made. In that year, beginning with the organization of a bank and the establishment of a tobacco market, began a new life for the town and surrounding community. Fire later destroying a number of unsightly frame buildings, the first brick structure was soon erected. Again, in June, 1911, nearly all the remaining old frame buildings in the business section were also consumed by fire. Now the principal street of the town (Salem) is lined with handsome pressed-brick-front stores. Business houses have continued to increase in number, until now nearly everything to complete a small city is here represented. This metropolis of western Wake is one of the busiest, most attractive and substantially built towns of its size in North Carolina. Its streets are well laid out and splendidly shaded in the residential sections, while the business part of the town is marked with buildings of beautiful architectural designs and substantial construction.

Apex has a population of about one thousand, and, being located in the centre of one of the best agricultural sections of the State, has a large rural territory from which to draw life and sustenance. It is in the limited "Old Belt" tobacco lands of North Carolina and Virginia, which produce the finest yellow-wrapper tobacco. The tobacco market at Apex is one of its chief industries. It is equipped with two splendid warehouses, three large prizehouses, markets about two million pounds of tobacco annually, and enjoys the distinction of making the highest average price per pound of any market in the State. It is the centre of a fine cotton-production section, the receipts of this staple being from three to five thousand bales of cotton per year.

Public education in Wake County has always found some of its most potent advocates and influences at Apex. Notable among those who have wielded an influence throughout the county in this respect are the late Hon H. C. Olive, State Senator and for many years chairman of the Wake County Board of Education; Hon. L. J. Sears, at present, and for many years past, chairman of the same board, and Hon. Percy J. Olive, an ex-representative and a public man who has taken an especial interest in the schools. That these gentlemen are and were but the exponents of the sentiment around them is witnessed by the fact that Apex has one of the finest and best-equipped schools in the county, and that every school in White Oak Township levies a local tax to supplement the general education fund.

Few communities in the State have had more additions to their population within the past five years than has that of which Apex is the centre. Those seeking desirable homes have found here a happy combination of advantages—fine lands, intelligent, virtuous and hospitable neighbors, good markets, good roads, good schools and good churches. No fictitious values have been placed upon the lands; for, with the true idea of progress, the efforts of those who have done most for the community's upbuilding have been directed to keeping the real estate at its true value. Contributing mostly to this and at present forming the most valuable of its citizenship, without disparagement to others, may be mentioned Messrs. W. F. Utley, W. H. Harward, A. B. Hunter, L. S. Olive, Percy J. Olive, Dr. W. Wade Olive, S. W. Stone, J. B. Mason, J. W. Lassiter, W. B. Upchurch, J. H. Sears, A. V. Baucom, A. C. Hughes, C. P. Sellars, W. B. Johnson, A. D. Upchurch, Samuel Watkins, Jr., A. T. Seymour, C. R. Weaver, S. T. Bennett, B. H. Pate, J. R. Cunningham, S. V. Hudson, S. S. Rogers, J. R. Norris, G. C. Norris, R. J. Bolling, Dr. R. W. △ The town of Apex had its beginning with the close of the Civil War. Among its first settlers were J. McC. Ellington, H. C. Olive, Q. I. Hudson, W. F. Utley, W. H. Harward, Brinkley Olive, A. N. Betts and others, who contributed to its life in the beginning and afterwards. It was incorporated by the Legislature of 1871-'72, with the late Hon. H. C. Olive as its first mayor. It derived its name from being the highest point on the survey of the Raleigh & Augusta Air Line Railroad.

Until 1905 it was but a small town, where the standard of virtue, intelligence and patriotism was high, but where little progress in material things had been made. In that year, beginning with the organization of a bank and the establishment of a tobacco market, began a new life for the town and surrounding community. Fire later destroying a number of unsightly frame buildings, the first brick structure was soon erected. Again, in June, 1911, nearly all the remaining old frame buildings in the business section were also consumed by fire. Now the principal street of the town (Salem) is lined with handsome pressed-brick-front stores. Business houses have continued to increase in number, until now nearly everything to complete a small city is here represented. This metropolis of western Wake is one of the busiest, most attractive and substantially built towns of its size in North Carolina. Its streets are well laid out and splendidly shaded in the residential sections, while the business part of the town is marked with buildings of beautiful architectural designs and substantial construction.

Apex has a population of about one thousand, and, being located in the centre of one of the best agricultural sections of the State, has a large rural territory from which to draw life and sustenance. It is in the limited "Old Belt" tobacco lands of North Carolina and Virginia, which produce the finest yellow-wrapper tobacco. The tobacco market at Apex is one of its chief industries. It is equipped with two splendid warehouses, three large prizehouses, markets about two million pounds of tobacco annually, and enjoys the distinction of making the highest average price per pound of any market in the State. It is the centre of a fine cotton-production section, the receipts of this staple being from three to five thousand bales of cotton per year.

Public education in Wake County has always found some of its most potent advocates and influences at Apex. Notable among those who have wielded an influence throughout the county in this respect are the late Hon. H. C. Olive, State Senator and for many years chairman of the Wake County Board of Education; Hon. L. J. Sears, at present, and for many years past, chairman of the same board, and Hon. Percy J. Olive, an ex-representative and a public man who has taken an especial interest in the schools. That these gentlemen are and were but the exponents of the sentiment around them is witnessed by the fact that Apex has one of the finest and best-equipped schools in the county, and that every school in White Oak Township levies a local tax to supplement the general education fund.

Few communities in the State have had more additions to their population within the past five years than has that of which Apex is the centre. Those seeking desirable homes have found here a happy combination of advantages—fine lands, intelligent, virtuous and hospitable neighbors, good markets, good roads, good schools and good churches. No fictitious values have been placed upon the lands; for, with the true idea of progress, the efforts of those who have done most for the community's upbuilding have been directed to keeping the real estate at its true value. Contributing mostly to this and at present forming the most valuable of its citizenship, without disparagement to others, may be mentioned Messrs. W. F. Utley, W. H. Harward, A. B. Hunter, L. S. Olive, Percy J. Olive, Dr. W. Wade Olive, S. W. Stone, J. B. Mason, J. W. Lassiter, W. B. Upchurch, J. H. Sears, A. V. Baucom, A. C. Hughes, C. P. Sellars, W. B. Johnson, A. D. 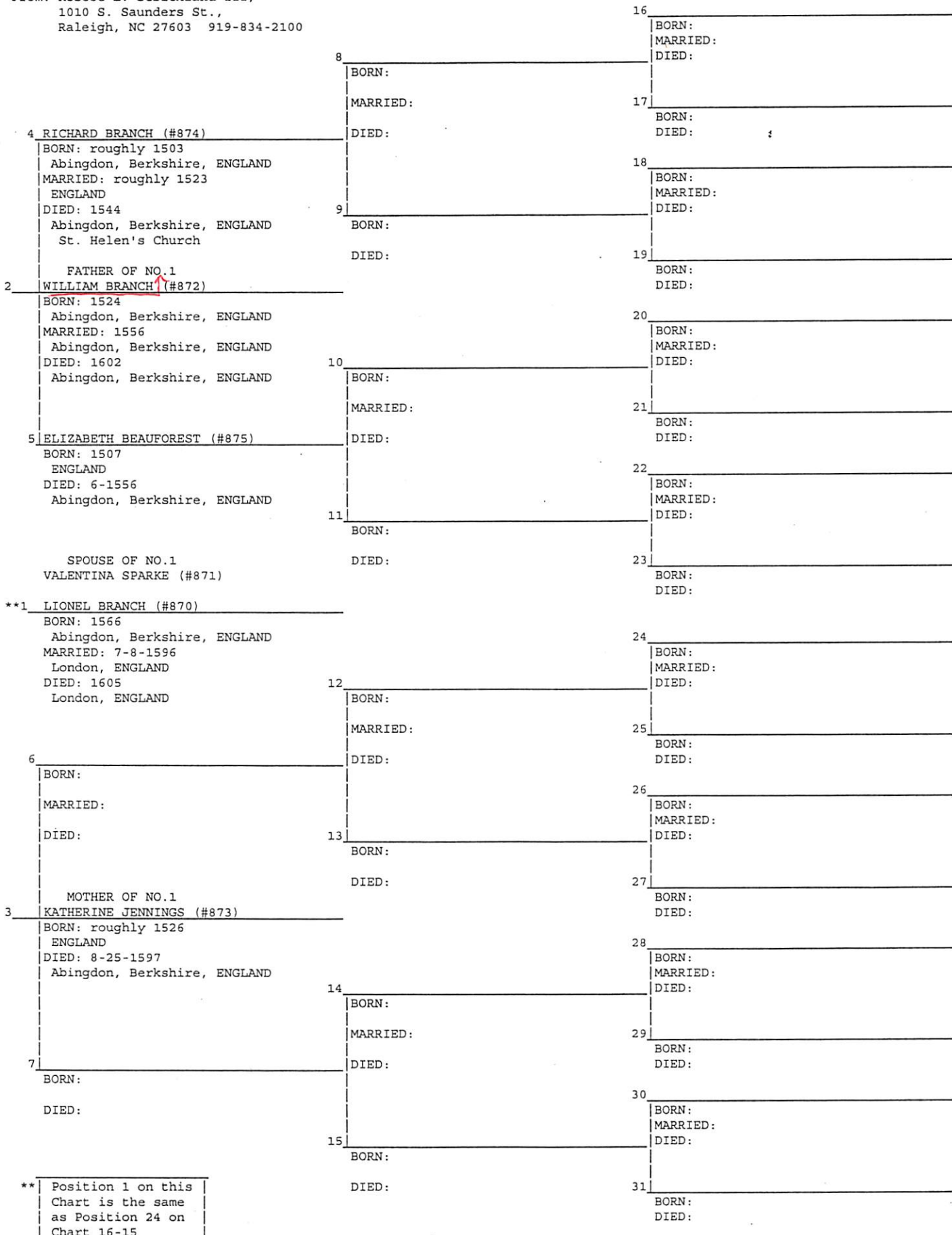
